Due to a personnel change during the reporting period, an internal reporting error resulted in April activity being miscoded as May activity. Upon learning the activity occurred in April and in order to submit the activity on the correct report, we promptly gathered the required information and filed an amendment on June 16, 2016. At the time, we were unaware of the fact that the practice of amending a waiver report was prohibited as we could not locate a statutory rule prohibiting such an action. Also, the Division of Elections Online Reporting System allows for an amendment to be created and filed for a report that was originally filed as waiver. As we do not have a history of late filings or issues, we respectfully request that the Commission abate the late fine due to the facts stated above. The waiver and amendment reports were accurately filed on their respective dates with the information available to us at the time of filing".

- The 2016 M4 Report covers the time period from 4/1/16 through 4/30/16.
- The 2016 M4 Queued-Transactions Report reflects that this report was created on 5/10/16 at approximately 2:21 pm, before being filed on 5/10/16 at approximately 2:22 pm<sup>2</sup>.
- In a 10/26/16 email with Kristi Reid-Bronson, FEC staff was informed, "The committee filed a notice of no activity (waiver) on 5-10-16. A waiver is not a report. On 6-16-16, the committee filed a report showing \$6420 of activity. The fine is based on 25% of the activity.

**PRIOR CASES:** This PC has been involved in prior FEC investigations. FEC 11-082; 11-081; and 09-195 were all automatic default final order cases. 09-214 and 09-154 were both resolved together by a joint consent order in the amount of \$375.00 for alleged violations of 106.07(2)(b), 106.07(1), and 106.07(3).
