ORDER OF PROBABLE CAUSE

THIS MATTER was heard by the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) at its regularly scheduled meeting on November 19, 2019, in Tallahassee, Florida.

On October 9, 2019, Staff recommended to the Commission that there was probable cause to believe that the Florida Election Code was violated. The facts articulated in Staff's Recommendation are adopted by reference and incorporated herein. Based on the Complaint, Report of Investigation, Staff's Recommendation, and oral statements (if any) made at the probable cause hearing, the Commission finds that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with the following violation(s):

Count 1:

On or about September 20, 2018, Ryan Morales violated Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes, when he failed to file the campaign's 2018 Termination Report reflecting the disposition of all remaining campaign funds within 90 days after being eliminated as a candidate.

Count 2:

On or around September 20, 2018, Ryan Morales violated Section

106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, when he deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2018 Termination Report.

The Commission finds that there is **no probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO A HEARING

As the Respondent, you may elect to resolve this case in several ways. First, you may elect to resolve this case by <u>consent order</u> where you and Commission staff agree to resolve the violation(s) and agree to the amount of the fine. The consent order is then presented to the Commission for its approval. To discuss a consent order, contact the FEC attorney identified in the Order of Probable Cause.

Second, you may request an <u>informal hearing</u> held before the Commission, if you <u>do not</u> dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. You have 30 days from the date the Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission to request such a hearing. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order. At the hearing, you will have the right to make written or oral arguments to the Commission concerning the legal issues related to the violation(s) and the potential fine. At the request of Respondent, the Commission will consider and determine willfulness at an informal hearing. Otherwise, live witness testimony is unnecessary.

Third, you may request a <u>formal hearing</u> held before an administrative law judge in the Division of Administrative Hearings (DOAH), if you dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. You have 30 days from the date the Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission to request such a hearing. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order. At the hearing, you will have the right to present evidence relevant to the violation(s) listed in this order, to cross-examine opposing witnesses, to impeach

any witness, and to rebut the evidence presented against you.

If you do not elect to resolve the case by consent order or request a formal hearing at the DOAH or an informal hearing before the Commission within 30 days of the date this Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission, the case will be sent to the Commission for a formal or informal hearing, depending on whether the facts are in dispute. STAFF RECOMMENDATION FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(c), Florida Statutes, undersigned staff counsel files this written recommendation for disposition of the referral in this case recommending that there is probable cause to charge Respondent with violating Sections 106.141(1), and 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, and no probable cause to charge Respondent with violating Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes. Based upon a thorough review of the Report of Investigation submitted on September 19, 2019, the following facts and law support this staff recommendation:

- 1. On March 7, 2019, the Florida Elections Commission ("Commission") received a referral from the Department of State, Division of Elections ("Division" or "Complainant"), alleging that Ryan Morales ("Respondent") violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.
- 2. Respondent was a 2018 candidate for State Senator, District 22. Respondent's Statement of Candidate form ("DS-DE 84") was filed on March 6, 2018. (ROI Exhibit 3)¹
- 3. By letter dated June 27, 2019, the Executive Director notified Respondent that Commission staff would investigate the following statutory provisions:

Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes: As alleged in the complaint, Respondent, a 2018 candidate for State Senator, District 22, may have failed to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed on that date because he had not received funds, made contributions, or expended reportable funds during the 2018 termination reporting period.

Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes: As alleged in the complaint, Respondent, a 2018 candidate for State Senator, District 22, failed to timely file his 2018 Termination Report reflecting the disposition of all remaining campaign funds.

Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes: As alleged in the complaint, Respondent, a 2018 candidate for State Senator, District 22, may have falsely reported or deliberately failed to include information in his 2018 Termination Report, as required by Chapter 106.

- 4. On March 6, 2018, Respondent filed his Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Candidates form ("DS-DE 9") appointing Ronald Ruiz as treasurer for his campaign. (ROI Exhibit 2)
- 5. By letter dated March 20, 2018, Kristi Reid Willis, Chief, Bureau of Election Records, sent Respondent a letter acknowledging that the Division had received his DS-DE 9 and that his name was placed on the 2018 active candidate list. (ROI Exhibit 4)
- 6. The acknowledgment letter advised Respondent that all candidates filing reports with the Division are required to use the electronic filing system ("EFS"), and provided Respondent with a user identification number and initial password to grant access to the EFS. The letter further advised Respondent that all of the Division's publications and reporting forms were available on its website and directed Respondent to print out Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, and the Calendar of Reporting Dates, as well as other relevant documents. (ROI Exhibit 4)

Alleged Violation: Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes

- 7. Complainant alleged that Respondent violated Florida's election laws by failing to timely file the campaign's 2018 Termination Report.
- 8. Respondent did not qualify and was eliminated as a candidate. Respondent was required to dispose of the funds on deposit in his campaign account and file the campaign's 2018 Termination Report within 90 days after being eliminated as a candidate.
- 9. On September 21, 2018, November 7, 2018, and November 20, 2018, the Division sent letters notifying Respondent that his report had not been received. The notifications were returned undeliverable as Respondent's PO Box was closed. (ROI Exhibits 6 & 8) The Division's records show that staff emailed and telephoned Respondent on several occasions to remind Respondent that his report had not been filed and to provide instructions on how to update his address with the Division. (ROI Exhibit 7)
- 10. A subpoena was issued to Respondent's designated campaign depositories to ascertain whether any financial activity occurred during the relevant reporting period, i.e., June 23, 2018 September 20, 2018. Wells Fargo was unable to locate an account in Respondent's name. (ROI Exhibit 12) Respondent's bank records from Trustco Bank show one or more contributions in the amount of \$400 (transfer from PayPal) and 15 expenditures totaling \$723.99. (ROI Exhibit 16; Attachment A)
- 11. Respondent stated that he was unclear of the process with regard to the final report. He stated that the problem stemmed from the fact that he was told by the Division that he had \$1,981 in his campaign account when he only had \$11. (ROI Exhibit 9) On July 26, 2019, Respondent filed the campaign's 2018 Termination Report. (ROI Exhibit 10) The report was 309 days late. Respondent was not assessed an automatic fine for the late filing of the report as this matter was already referred to the Commission. (Attachment B)

12. As it appears that Respondent had reportable financial activity during the relevant reporting period, Respondent was required to file the campaign's 2018 Termination Report within 90 days after being eliminated as a candidate, but failed to do so.

Alleged Violation: Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes

- 13. Complainant alleged that Respondent violated Florida's election laws by falsely reporting or deliberately failing to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2018 Termination Report.
- 14. Based on the above analysis, Respondent had reportable financial activity during the relevant reporting period. Therefore, Respondent was required to disclose the financial activity on the campaign's 2018 Termination Report.
- 15. To date, Respondent has not disclosed the \$1,123.99 in financial activity but rather disclosed an \$11 expenditure which is not supported by Respondent's bank records. (ROI Exhibits 11 & 16; Attachment A) With regard to Respondent's deliberate failure to include information on the campaign's report, he may have failed to disclose the campaign's financial activity as some of the funds were not disposed of properly pursuant to sections 106.141(4)(a), and 106.11(5), Florida Statutes, but were spent at gas stations, grocery stores, and restaurants, and as the campaign account was overdrawn in violation of section 106.11(4), Florida Statutes. (ROI Exhibit 16)
- 16. Respondent deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2018 Termination Report.

Alleged Violation: Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes

- 17. Complainant alleged that Respondent violated Florida's election laws by failing to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed for the 2018 Termination reporting period.
- 18. Based on the above analysis, the campaign was not required to submit a notice of no activity for the 2018 Termination reporting period as there was reportable financial activity that Respondent was required to disclose on his 2018 Termination Report.
- 19. "Probable Cause" is defined as reasonable grounds of suspicion supported by circumstances sufficiently strong to warrant a cautious person in the belief that the person has committed the offense charged. Schmitt v. State, 590 So. 2d 404, 409 (Fla. 1991). Probable cause exists where the facts and circumstances, of which an [investigator] has reasonably trustworthy information, are sufficient in themselves for a reasonable man to reach the conclusion that an offense has been committed. Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles v. Favino, 667 So. 2d 305, 309 (Fla. 1st DCA 1995).
- 20. The facts set forth above show that Respondent was a 2018 candidate for State Senator, District 22. Respondent failed to file the campaign's 2018 Termination Report within 90

days after being eliminated as a candidate. Respondent deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2018 Termination Report. Respondent was not required to notify the filing officer that he would not be filing his 2018 Termination Report because the campaign had reportable financial activity.

Based upon these facts and circumstances, I recommend that the Commission find no probable cause to charge Respondent with violating Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, and find probable cause to charge Respondent with violating the following:

Count 1:

On or about September 20, 2018, Ryan Morales violated Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes, when he failed to file the campaign's 2018 Termination Report reflecting the disposition of all remaining campaign funds within 90 days after being eliminated as a candidate.

Count 2:

On or around September 20, 2018, Ryan Morales violated Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, when he deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2018 Termination Report.

Pursuant to Section 106.25(2), Florida Statutes, on March 7, 2019, the Florida Elections Commission ("Commission") received information from the Division of Elections ("Division") that Respondent violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes. Commission staff, therefore, investigated whether Respondent violated the following statutes:

Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, failure of a political committee that did not receive any contributions or make any expenditures during a reporting period to notify timely the filing officer, in writing, that no report is being filed; and

Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes, failure to timely file a report reflecting the disposition of all remaining campaign funds; and

Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, prohibiting a person or organization from falsely reporting or deliberately failing to report information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.

I. Preliminary Information:

- 1. Respondent, Ryan Morales, was a 2018 candidate for State Senator, District 22. He was disqualified on June 22, 2018 after failing to submit the Candidate Oath (form DS-DE 301SL) to the Division. Records show this form was later filed on June 25, 2018 along with Respondent's request that the Division reconsider his disqualification. The request was denied. To review Respondent's correspondence and DS-DE 301SL form, please see Exhibit 1.
 - 2. Complainant is the Division.
- 3. Respondent's filing officer is Kristi Reid Willis, Chief of the Bureau of Election Records.
- 4. On March 6, 2018, Respondent's Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Candidates form (DS-DE 9) was filed with the Division, appointing Ronald Ruiz and Wells Fargo as campaign treasurer and bank, respectively. The DS-DE 9 form is attached as Exhibit 2.

- 5. Also, on March 6, 2018, Respondent's Statement of Candidate form (DS-DE 84) was filed with the Division, designating Mr. Morales' office candidacy for District 22's State Senator. The DS-DE 84 form is included as Exhibit 3.
- 6. On March 20, 2018, Ms. Willis acknowledged receipt of Respondent's filed documents and stated that Mr. Morales' name would appear on the "2018 active candidate list." The letter also stated that all candidates filing reports with the Division are required to use the electronic filing system (EFS). The Division provided EFS access by including a user ID, website link, and PIN number for Respondent's treasurer. This letter is included as Exhibit 4.
- 7. The Division's acknowledgment letter also advised Respondent that the Division's publications and reporting forms are available at their website, including: Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, *Political Candidate and Treasurer Handbook*, and the *Calendar of Reporting Dates*. The Division emphasizes: "it is your responsibility to read, understand, and follow [these] requirements."
- 8. On June 22, 2018, Respondent re-filed the Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Candidates form (DS-DE 9), naming Tammy Morales (Respondent's wife) as treasurer. At this time, Respondent also changed the campaign account from Wells Fargo to Trustco Bank. The updated DS-DE 9 form is attached as Exhibit 5.

II. Alleged Violation of Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes:

- 9. I investigated whether Respondent violated this section of the election laws by failing to timely file a 2018 TR campaign report or otherwise provide the filing officer a notification-of-no-activity because no financial activity occurred during the reporting period.
- 10. On September 21, 2018 and November 7, 2018, the Division sent letters for the purpose of notifying Respondent and his treasurer that he was overdue to file either a 2018 TR or a notification-of-no-activity; the deadline was September 20, 2018. These notices were sent to Respondent's address on the DS-DE 9 form, but both were returned to sender, as shown by items attached as Exhibit 6.
- 11. Beginning October 4, 2018, the Division tried multiple times to contact Respondent about returned mail, as noted in paragraph 10. On February 20, 2019, Respondent called the Division about the ongoing issue. The Division's log of contact attempts is included as Exhibit 7.
- 12. On November 20, 2018, the Division sent a Final Notice to Respondent and his treasurer regarding the 2018 TR report. The notice was returned to the Division on November 29, 2018. The letter and its proof of return are attached as Exhibit 8.
- 13. On July 5, 2019, Respondent stated he had not filed the 2018 TR because he was confused by the Division's claims about a \$1,981 campaign deficit, whereas his records only showed a negative balance of \$11. Respondent's explanation is provided in the Affidavit of Background Information ("Affidavit"), attached as Exhibit 9.
- 14. On July 26, 2019, Respondent filed the 2018 TR and provided a time- and date-stamped report receipt, received via USPS on July 29, 2019. This item is included as Exhibit 10.
- 15. Respondent updated the 2018 TR to include an \$11 expenditure on June 28, 2018, noted as "payback of in-kind donation to DelPuma." On his Affidavit, Respondent lists DelPuma Consulting Group, ("DelPuma") as his employer; Secretary of State ("State") records show it is also Mr. Morales' private business. The 2018 TR and State filings are attached as Exhibit 11.

III. Alleged Violation of Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes:

- 16. I investigated whether Respondent violated this section of the election laws by failing to timely file the 2018 TR and disclose the disposition of any remaining campaign funds. To this end, I drafted subpoenas for both Respondent's noted campaign depositories: Wells Fargo Bank, N.A. and Trustco Bank.
- 17. On July 19, 2019, Investigator Cedric Oliver served a subpoena on Wells Fargo, Respondent's first-designated campaign depository. By August 2, 2019, Wells Fargo responded that they were unable to locate any accounts associated with Respondent, which contradicts Respondent's first DS-DE 9 form, filed March 6, 2018. The subpoena and bank letter are attached as Exhibit 12.
- 18. On July 23, 2019, a subpoena was served on Jeffry Jontz, Esq., registered agent for Respondent's second-designated depository: Trustco Bank. Bank records received on August 2, 2019 show Respondent and his wife opened an account on April 14, 2018 but did not report it to the Division until June 22, 2018. The subpoena and affidavit of service are attached as Exhibit 13.
- 19. Campaign treasurer, Ronald Ruiz, was not listed as a signatory on the Trustco account. Respondent stated Mr. Ruiz had already withdrawn owing to a family emergency. The Trustco signature page and pertinent section of the Affidavit are attached as Exhibit 14.
- 20. Respondent entitled the Trustco account, "My Florida Senator, Inc." Respondent also registered this entity name with the State, as shown by documents included as Exhibit 15.
- 21. On July 26, 2019, Respondent filed the 2018 TR, wherein he recorded an \$11 repayment to DelPuma on June 28, 2018 as "payback of in-kind donation." Bank records give no evidence of this \$11 adjustment. The Trustco billing statement and campaign finance activity are attached as Exhibit 16.
- 22. Following disqualification, Respondent's outstanding Trustco balance was exhausted at gas stations, fast-food restaurants, and retail stores, as previously shown in Exhibit 16. These remaining expenses do not appear related to the campaign, as outlined in Table 1:

- 23. On July 10, 2018, Respondent's Trustco account was assessed \$97.00 in insufficient funds' fees and extended overdraft charges.
- 24. Records suggest that Respondent did not bring the campaign account current prior to its closure.

IV. Alleged Violation of Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes:

- 25. I investigated whether Respondent violated this section of the election laws by falsely reporting or deliberately failing to include information in the 2018 Termination Report. In order to analyze this issue, I further reviewed all previously referenced bank records and all campaign reports on file with the Division.
- 26. On June 22, 2018, the same date Respondent was disqualified, he also deposited \$200 in the Trustco campaign account. On June 25, 2018, a further \$400 was deposited from the My Florida Senator Paypal account. These deposits were not disclosed in Respondent's 2018 TR, filed July 26, 2019, but only appear in Respondent's Trustco bank statements, previously included as Exhibit 16.
- 27. Respondent's Trustco statement for the period beginning June 18, 2018 and ending July 16, 2018, shows deposits and debits totaling \$600 and \$698.99, respectively. A review of Respondent's 2018 TR, covering the time span June 23, 2018 to September 20, 2018, does not show any record of these deposits or debits. Rather, the only item reported during this period is the \$11 "in kind" reimbursement to DelPuma on June 28, 2018.
- 28. On June 28, 2018, Respondent's account posted a \$21.35 payment to GoDaddy.com (initiated on June 26, 2018), the only perceivable billing cycle item with potential campaign relevance. The payment, for website hosting, was not listed on the 2018 TR.
- 29. Respondent did not report to the Division any debits or deposits that occurred during the billing cycle extending from June 18, 2018 to July 16, 2018.

Conclusions:

- 30. On April 15, 2018, Respondent recorded a \$250 contribution from Jonathan Bradley in the 2018 M4 report. On August 16, 2018, the Division received a letter from Respondent, explaining that Mr. Bradley made the donation via an "online donation system." Aside from the campaign report and Respondent's letter, there is no further financial trace of these funds in the Trustco Bank records. The 2018 M4 report and Respondent's August 18, 2018 letter are included as Exhibit 17.
- 31. Aside from Jonathan Bradley's \$250 donation, all campaign reports filed with the Division show Respondent's campaign-related financing consisted entirely of in-kind donations

from DelPuma.² This does not correspond with Respondent's Trustco Bank records, which reflect \$600 in deposits between June 22, 2018 and June 25, 2018. Only \$400 of this (received June 25, 2018) is recorded as deriving from Respondent's campaign-related Paypal account.

32. On July 5, 2019, I questioned Respondent about the numerous pieces of returned mail and the status of his post office ("PO") box. To this end, Respondent explained that his PO box lease expired around June 28, 2018. Per my request, Respondent provided an email generated by the United States Postal Service (USPS) with these details, which is attached as Exhibit 18.



In the event that the EFS is inoperable on the due date, the report will be accepted as timely filed if filed no later than midnight of the first business day the EFS becomes operable. No fine will be levied during the period the EFS was inoperable.

Any candidate failing to file a report on the designated due date shall be subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first 3 days late and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

Electronic Receipts

The person submitting the report on the EFS will be issued an electronic receipt indicating and verifying the report was filed. Each campaign treasurer's report filed by means of the EFS is considered to be under oath by the candidate and campaign treasurer and such persons are subject to the provisions of Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes.

An online instruction guide is available to you on the EFS to assist with navigation, data entry, and submission of reports. The Division of Elections will also provide assistance to all users by contacting the EFS Help Desk at (850) 245-6280.





Dear Mr. Morales:

On March 7, 2019, the Florida Elections Commission received a complaint alleging that you violated Florida's election laws. I have reviewed the complaint and find that it contains one or more **legally sufficient allegations**. The Commission staff will investigate the following alleged violations:

Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes: As alleged in the complaint, Respondent, a 2018 candidate for State Senator, District 22, may have failed to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed on that date because he had not received funds, made contributions, or expended reportable funds during the 2018 termination reporting period.

Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes: As alleged in the complaint, Respondent, a 2018 candidate for State Senator, District 22, failed to timely file his 2018 Termination Report reflecting the disposition of all remaining campaign funds.

Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes: As alleged in the complaint, Respondent, a 2018 candidate for State Senator, District 22, may have falsely reported or deliberately failed to include information in his 2018 Termination Report, as required by Chapter 106.

When we conclude the investigation, a copy of the Report of Investigation (ROI) will be mailed to you at the above address. Based on the results of the investigation, a staff attorney will make a written recommendation (Staff Recommendation or SR) to the Commission as to whether there is probable cause to charge respondent with violating Chapters 104 or 106, Florida Statutes. You will have an opportunity to respond to both the ROI and the SR. The Commission will then hold one or more hearings to determine whether the alleged violations occurred and, if so, the amount

of the fine to be imposed. You and the complainant will receive notice at least 14 days before any hearing at which your case is to be considered.


