SUMMARY: Central Florida Dental Political Action Committee is a political committee (PC) registered with the State of Florida. The PC's chair is John Beattie and its treasurer is Chris Cowell.

The PC is appealing the fine claiming that unusual circumstances existed that caused the 2016 D1 Report to be untimely filed. According to Mr. Beattie, "The D1 report waiver was filed late, the letter attached from the Division of Elections states no automatic fine was assessed because of we had no receipts or expenditures during this reporting period. After an internal audit of our records, we found 1 expenditure was posted under the wrong date, it should have been filed on the D1 report; We filed an amended report. I am asking you to consider waiving the fine, the integrity of my staff member should not be penalized for filing the amended report. Thank you for your consideration in this manner".

- The 2016 D1 Report covers the time period from 10/22/16 through 10/28/16.
- The 2016 D1 Queued-Transactions Report reflects that this report was created on 10/31/16 at approximately 8:32 am, before being filed on 10/31/16 at approximately 8:33 am.²
- In a 1/25/17 email with Kristi Reid-Bronson, FEC staff was informed, "The committee filed a notice of no activity (waiver) on 10/31/16. A waiver is not a report. On 12/6/16, the committee filed a report showing \$500.00 of activity. The fine is based on 25% of the activity reported".

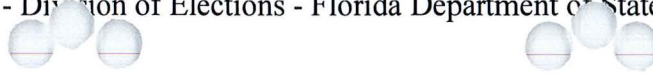
