**NOTICE OF HEARING (AUTOMATIC FINE)**

A hearing will be held in this case before the Florida Elections Commission on, **August 16, 2016 at 9:00 am, or as soon thereafter as the parties can be heard**, at the following location: **Senate Office Building, 404 South Monroe Street, Room 110-S, Tallahassee, Florida 32399**

Failure to appear in accordance with this notice will constitute a waiver of your right to participate in the hearing. Continuances will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

This hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, which governs your participation as follows:

**If you are the Respondent**, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

**If you are the Complainant**, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

**If you are an Appellant**, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

Please refer to the information below for further instructions related to your particular hearing:

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

**SUMMARY:** Florida State UAW Political Action Committee is a political committee (PC) registered with the State of Florida. The PC's chair is Janet Carol Westman and its treasurer is Thomas Gibson.

The PC is appealing the fine claiming that unusual circumstances prevented them from filing the 2016 M4 timely. According to Ms. Westman, "the past Financial Secretary, Christopher Koblentz, had resigned as Financial Secretary effective date 4/27/2016, the DS DE6 was filled out and signed by the incoming Financial Secretary on Saturday, April 30, 2016 and mailed to the Florida Division of Elections on May 2, 2016. I contacted the Division of Elections to make sure that the Financial Secretary would receive the pin number to file the report in time to file before the due date of May 10, 2016 and was assured that we would receive the pin number in time to file. The Financial Secretary received the letter dated May 9, 2016, mailed May 10, 2016, the due date of the report, the evening of May 12 that contained the pin number to file the report. Note: I contacted the Florida Division of Elections the late afternoon of May 12 to inquire the status of assigning the necessary pin. We filed the report due May 10 as soon as possible after receiving the necessary pin for filing reports to the Division of Elections. We received the letter date May 11, 2016 mailed May 13, 2016 stating that our report had not been filed

- The 2016 M4 Report covers the time period from 4/1/16 through 4/30/16.
- The PC reported receiving 9 contributions, while making 0 expenditures during this reporting period.
- The 2016 M4 Queued-Transactions Report reflects that this report was created on 5/13/16 at approximately 9:54 am, before being filed on 5/13/16 at approximately 10:54 am.
- On 7/8/16, FEC staff made contact with the PC's chair to ensure that the chair was aware of this appeal for an automatic fine.

**PRIOR CASES:** This PC has been involved in 2 prior investigations before this Commission. FEC 09-110; found NPC for 106.07(1). 13-293; appeal withdrawn, fine paid for violation of 106.07(8)(b).



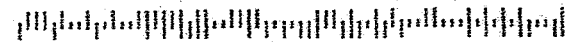

Dear Mr. Gibson:

Our records indicate that you have not filed either your campaign treasurer's report or notification that no reportable activity occurred, whichever is applicable. The filing date was May 10, 2016.

The law (s. 106.07(8)(b), Fla. Stat.) requires the filing officer to immediately notify you about the missed filing date and the automatic fines that will be assessed for late filing of a report, if a report was due.

- If reportable activity occurred and you have not filed a report, statutory fines are automatically assessed as follows until you file your report:
  - \$50 for the first 3 days late
  - \$500 per day for each day after the 3rd day late
  - If the required report immediately precedes a primary and general election, the automatic fine is \$500 for each late day.

The total fine for the untimely report cannot exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the cover period. Even if you end up filing your report late, we cannot waive the statutory fines. We will notify you of the specific amount of fines owed once you file your report. You have 20 days from the day you receive the notice to pay the fine or to appeal the fine to the Florida Elections Commission.

- If no reportable activity occurred for the report date(s), you are still required to notify us in writing, via the Division's Electronic Filing System, that no reportable activity occurred. No automatic fines are statutorily assessed.

However, in all cases, failure to file and/or untimely filing of a report of reportable activity, or if applicable, a notice that no reportable activity occurred, may constitute an apparent violation of chapter 106, Fla. Stat. If we refer such matter to the Florida Elections Commission, the Commission may subsequently impose a civil penalty for each violation under chapter 106.265(1), Fla. Stat.

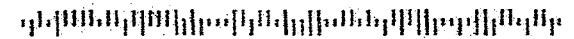

Spoke with Janet Westman, Chairperson, and she had a few issues regarding an audit notice she received for the 2015 M12 report. She wanted to know how to amend the report to make the corrections and explained that she had issues with the treasurer. She wanted to know if she could get another treasurer PIN number to update the EFS system given to her as a backup. I referred Ms. Westman to the Division of Elections website to the EFS's User Guide and explained that once a report is filed, she would have to make an amendment to change it. I told her that the EFS's User Guide explained what she would need to do to make amendments to filed reports. I then referred her to the Political Committee Handbook and directed her to the section explaining how to appoint a treasurer and deputy treasurer. She asked if she could change treasurers and I advised her that she could write a letter withdrawing the current treasurer and appointing a new treasurer but that she would have to send in the required forms naming that person as the primary or deputy treasurer.

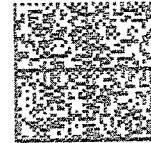

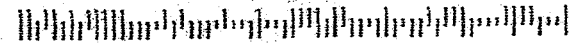

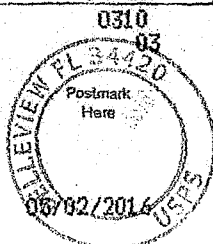
