ORDER OF PROBABLE CAUSE

THIS MATTER was heard by the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) at its regularly scheduled meeting on August 25, 2020, in Tallahassee, Florida.

On March 31, 2020, Staff recommended to the Commission that there was probable cause to believe that the Florida Election Code was violated. The facts articulated in Staff's Recommendation are adopted by reference and incorporated herein. Based on the Complaint, Report of Investigation, Staff's Recommendation, and oral statements (if any) made at the probable cause hearing, the Commission finds that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with the following violation(s):

Count 1:

On or about February 5, 2018, Jimmie L. Williams, III, violated Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes, when he failed to file the campaign's 2018 Termination Report reflecting the disposition of all remaining campaign funds within 90 days after being eliminated as a candidate.

Count 2:

On or around February 5, 2018, Jimmie L. Williams, III, violated

Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, when he deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2018 Termination Report.

The Commission finds that there is **no probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO A HEARING

As the Respondent, you may elect to resolve this case in several ways. First, you may elect to resolve this case by consent order where you and Commission staff agree to resolve the violation(s) and agree to the amount of the fine. The consent order is then presented to the Commission for its approval. To discuss a consent order, contact the FEC attorney identified in the Order of Probable Cause.

Second, you may request an <u>informal hearing</u> held before the Commission, if you <u>do not</u> dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. STAFF RECOMMENDATION FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(c), Florida Statutes, undersigned staff counsel files this written recommendation for disposition of the sworn complaint in this case recommending that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating **Sections 106.141(1)**, and **106.19(1)(c)**, Florida Statutes, and no probable cause to charge Respondent with violating **Section 106.07(7)**, Florida Statutes. Based upon a thorough review of the Report of Investigation submitted on December 10, 2019, the following facts and law support this staff recommendation:

- 1. On July 25, 2018, the Florida Elections Commission ("Commission") received a sworn complaint from Elizabeth Sewell, City Clerk for the City of Homestead ("Complainant"), alleging that Jimmie L. Williams, III ("Respondent") violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.
- 2. Respondent was a 2017 candidate for the City of Homestead City Council. Respondent's Statement of Candidate form ("DS-DE 84") was filed on January 27, 2017. (ROI Exhibit 11)¹
- 3. By letter dated April 3, 2019, the Executive Director notified Respondent that Commission staff would investigate the following statutory provisions:

Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes: As alleged in the complaint, Respondent, a 2017 candidate for City of Homestead City Council, may have failed to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed on that date because he had not received funds, made contributions, or expended reportable funds during the 2018 termination reporting period.

Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes: As alleged in the complaint, Respondent, a 2017 candidate for City of Homestead City Council, failed to timely file his 2018 Termination Report reflecting the disposition of all remaining campaign funds.

Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes: As alleged in the complaint, Respondent, a 2017 candidate for City of Homestead City Council, may have falsely reported or deliberately failed to

include information in his 2018 Termination Report, as required by Chapter 106.

- 4. On January 27, 2017, Respondent filed two Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Candidates forms ("DS-DE 9") appointing himself as deputy treasurer for his campaign and appointing Teri A. Weinstein as treasurer for his campaign. (ROI Exhibit 1, pages 1 & 2) On November 27, 2017, Respondent filed an additional DS-DE 9 appointing himself as treasurer for his campaign. (ROI Exhibit 1, page 3)
- 5. Complainant (Respondent's filing officer) stated that she provided Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, and the *Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook* to Respondent by hand-delivery. (ROI Exhibit 10, pages 1 & 2) On January 27, 2017, Respondent acknowledged that he had been provided access to read the requirements of Chapter 106, Florida Statutes. (ROI Exhibit 11)

Alleged Violation: Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes

- 6. Complainant alleged that Respondent violated Florida's election laws by failing to timely file the campaign's 2018 Termination Report.
- 7. Respondent was eliminated as a candidate during the 2017 General Election. Respondent was required to dispose of the funds on deposit in his campaign account and file the campaign's 2018 Termination Report within 90 days after being eliminated as a candidate.
- 8. Complainant sent three emails to Respondent notifying him of the due date of his 2018 Termination Report, i.e., February 5, 2018. (ROI Exhibit 2, pages 2 & 3) Additionally, Complainant stated that her office telephoned Respondent three times on the due date of the report and left three voicemails. (ROI Exhibit 2, page 1)
- 9. On February 8, 2018, and March 23, 2018, Complainant sent letters notifying Respondent that his report had not been received. (ROI Exhibits 3 & 5) Complainant's records show that staff emailed and telephoned Respondent on multiple occasions to remind Respondent that his report had not been filed. (ROI Exhibits 2, 4 & 6) On February 8, 2018, Respondent replied to one of Complainant's emails and stated that he was in the hospital. (ROI Exhibit 4, page 1)
- 10. A subpoena was issued to Respondent's designated campaign depository to ascertain whether any financial activity occurred during the relevant reporting period, i.e., November 2, 2017 February 5, 2018. Respondent's bank records show reportable financial activity during the relevant reporting period. (ROI Exhibit 7)
- 11. Respondent stated that he was hospitalized for over 40 days. He stated that he fired his previous treasurer during that time as she authorized checks without approval and failed to release bank information to Respondent. Respondent stated that he contacted the bank for information but that the issue is still not resolved. (ROI Exhibit 9, page 1)

- 12. Respondent was not a first-time candidate as he previously ran for Homestead City Council and Vice Mayor in 2013. (ROI Exhibit 10, page 2) Despite Respondent's initial reasons for not timely filing the report, which are mitigating in nature, Respondent continues to take no action with regard to his responsibility to file the report. As of August 21, 2019, Respondent had not yet filed his 2018 Termination Report. (ROI Exhibit 8)
- 13. As it appears that Respondent had reportable financial activity during the relevant reporting period, Respondent was required to file the campaign's 2018 Termination Report within 90 days after being eliminated as a candidate, but failed to do so.

Alleged Violation: Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes

- 14. Complainant alleged that Respondent violated Florida's election laws by falsely reporting or deliberately failing to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2018 Termination Report.
- 15. Based on the above analysis, Respondent had reportable financial activity during the relevant reporting period. Therefore, Respondent was required to disclose the financial activity on the campaign's 2018 Termination Report.
- 16. As of August 21, 2019, Respondent has not disclosed the \$16,411.21 in financial activity that took place during the relevant reporting period. With regard to Respondent's deliberate failure to include information on the campaign's report, he may have failed to disclose the campaign's financial activity as some of the funds were not disposed of properly pursuant to sections 106.141(4)(a), and 106.11(5), Florida Statutes, but were spent at gas stations, grocery stores, restaurants, and other nonapproved vendors, as the campaign account was overdrawn in violation of section 106.11(4), Florida Statutes, and as contributions were received after Respondent was defeated in violation of section 106.08(3)(b), Florida Statutes. (ROI Exhibit 7)
- 17. Respondent deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2018 Termination Report.

Alleged Violation: Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes

- 18. Complainant alleged that Respondent violated Florida's election laws by failing to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed for the 2018 Termination reporting period.
- 19. Based on the above analysis, the campaign was not required to submit a notice of no activity for the 2018 Termination reporting period as there was reportable financial activity that Respondent was required to disclose on his 2018 Termination Report.
- 20. "Probable Cause" is defined as reasonable grounds of suspicion supported by circumstances sufficiently strong to warrant a cautious person in the belief that the person has committed the offense charged. *Schmitt v. State*, 590 So. 2d 404, 409 (Fla. 1991). Probable cause exists where the facts and circumstances, of which an [investigator] has reasonably trustworthy

information, are sufficient in themselves for a reasonable man to reach the conclusion that an offense has been committed. *Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles v. Favino*, 667 So. 2d 305, 309 (Fla. 1st DCA 1995).

21. The facts set forth above show that Respondent was a 2017 candidate for the City of Homestead City Council. Respondent failed to file the campaign's 2018 Termination Report within 90 days after being eliminated as a candidate. Respondent deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2018 Termination Report. Respondent was not required to notify the filing officer that he would not be filing his 2018 Termination Report because the campaign had reportable financial activity.

Based upon these facts and circumstances, I recommend that the Commission find no probable cause to charge Respondent with violating Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, and find probable cause to charge Respondent with violating the following:

Count 1:

On or about February 5, 2018, Jimmie L. Williams, III, violated Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes, when he failed to file the campaign's 2018 Termination Report reflecting the disposition of all remaining campaign funds within 90 days after being eliminated as a candidate.

Count 2:

On or around February 5, 2018, Jimmie L. Williams, III, violated Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, when he deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2018 Termination Report.

On July 25, 2018, the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) received a complaint alleging that Respondent violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes. Commission staff investigated whether Respondent violated the following statutes:

Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, failure of a candidate who did not receive any contributions or make any expenditures during a reporting period to notify timely the filing officer, in writing, that no report is being filed;

Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes, failure of a candidate to file a termination report reflecting the disposition of all remaining funds in his campaign account within 90 days after he withdrew, became unopposed, was eliminated, or elected; and

Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, prohibiting a person or organization from falsely reporting or deliberately failing to report information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.

I. Preliminary Information:

- 1. Respondent was a 2017 candidate for the City Council of Homestead, Florida. Respondent was defeated by Jenifer Bailey in the November 2017 municipal election. Respondent was not a first-time candidate.
 - 2. Complainant is the City Clerk of Homestead, Florida.
- 3. On January 27, 2017, Respondent filed his original Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for candidates form (DS-DE 9) with his filing officer¹. Respondent appointed Teri A. Weinstein as his Campaign Treasurer; he appointed himself as his own Deputy Campaign Treasurer. To view a copy of Respondent's DS-DE 9 forms, refer to exhibit 1.
 - 4. Complainant included a list of attempted contacts that were made on February 5,

2018 to Respondent via phone calls to remind him that the 2018 Termination Report (TR) would be due on February 5, 2018². The 2018 TR Report covers the time-period November 2, 2017 through February 5, 2018³. To view a copy of these documents, refer to exhibit 2.

- 5. On February 8, 2018, Complainant sent Respondent a certified failure-to-file letter regarding the 2018 TR Report. This letter was sent to the address Respondent provided on his original DS-DE 9 form (Exhibit 1). To view a copy of the February 8, 2018 failure-to-file letter, refer to exhibit 3.
- 6. On February 8, 2018, Complainant also sent Respondent an email with the failure-to-file letter attached. Respondent replied to this email by informing Complainant that he was in the hospital. Complainant thanked Respondent for replying to the email, but then inquired as to when the 2018 TR Report would be filed. Complainant followed up on February 26, 2018 with another email to Respondent. To view a copy of the February 8, 2018 emails, refer to exhibit 4.
- 7. On March 23, 2018, Complainant sent Respondent a "second and final notice" regarding the 2018 TR Report. This letter was sent to the address Respondent provided on his original DS-DE 9 form (Exhibit 1). To view a copy of the March 23, 2018 second and final notice, refer to exhibit 5.
- 8. Complainant also included another list of attempted contacts with Respondent to remind him that the 2018 TR Report was overdue. This included emails sent on March 23; April 4; and May 29, 2018. To view a copy of these additional attempted contacts documents, refer to exhibit 6.
- 9. The allegations that Respondent failed to report campaign activity, or in the alternative, failed to notify the filing officer, in writing, that no report would be filed for the 2018 TR period will be discussed in the following paragraphs.

II. Alleged Violation of Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes:

- 10. I investigated whether Respondent violated this section of the election laws by failing to timely notify the filing officer, in writing, that no report would be filed due to not having any financial activity during the 2018 TR reporting period.
- 11. Commission staff subpoenaed Respondent's campaign account records from T.D. Bank, the campaign depository listed on his DS-DE 9 form (Exhibit 1). These records reflect financial activity occurring during the 2018 TR reporting period. Several reportable transactions occurred up to November 27, 2017, when the account was closed with a \$0.00 balance⁴. To view a copy of the depository records, refer to exhibit 7.
 - 12. Based upon a review of Respondent's campaign account records, it appears

Respondent was not required to notify his filing officer in writing that no report would be filed for the 2018 TR reporting period; there was activity to disclose during this period. It appears that Respondent was required to disclose these transactions by filing a 2018 TR Report.

- 13. On August 21, 2019, Complainant confirmed in an email that Respondent had not filed a 2018 TR Report. "Mr. Jimmie Williams did not file his termination campaign treasurer's report with my office". To view a copy of the August 21, 2019 email, refer to exhibit 8.
- 14. There is no record that Respondent has previously been investigated for violating this section of the election laws.

III. Alleged Violation of Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes:

- 15. I investigated whether Respondent violated this section of the election laws by not filing his 2018 TR Report, due by February 5, 2018, that reflected a disposition of his remaining funds in his campaign account within 90 days after he was eliminated from the election.
- 16. To review the circumstances regarding Respondent's contribution and expenditure activity, refer to paragraphs 11 through 13 of this report.
- 17. There is no record that Respondent has previously been investigated for violating this section of the election laws.

IV. Alleged Violation of Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statues:

- 18. I investigated whether Respondent violated this section of the election laws by falsely reporting or deliberately failing to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, when he failed to file a 2018 TR Report on the prescribed reporting date, disclosing all activity during the reporting period.
- 19. To review the circumstances regarding Respondent's contribution and expenditure activity, refer to paragraphs 11 through 13 of this report.
- 20. There is no record that Respondent has previously been investigated for violating this section of the election laws.

V. FEC History:

21. None.

Conclusion:

22. In an April 19, 2019 telephone interview, Respondent stated that he did not intentionally violate any of the election laws. Respondent also confirmed that he had not filed his 2018 Termination Report. Respondent told me that he had fallen ill and had to be hospitalized with medical issues for over 40 days. Respondent informed me that he had to fire his previous treasurer during that time due to her authorizing checks without his approval, and then refusing to release the bank information to him per his request. Respondent stated that he contacted the bank

for the information but due to his illness, it hasn't been resolved. To review a copy of the phone log, refer to exhibit 9.

- 23. In an April 18, 2019 questionnaire-affidavit, the Filing Officer attests that Respondent received *Chapter 106, Florida Statutes*, and the *Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook*. To view a copy of the Filing Officer questionnaire-affidavit, refer to exhibit 10.
- 24. On January 27, 2017, Respondent filed his Statement of Candidate for Homestead City Council acknowledging that he had been provided access to read and understand the requirements of Chapter 106, Florida Statutes. To view a copy of the Statement of Candidate, refer to exhibit 11.

On July 25, 2018, the Florida Elections Commission received a complaint alleging that you violated Florida's election laws. I have reviewed the complaint and find that it contains one or more **legally sufficient allegations**. The Commission staff will investigate the following alleged violations:

Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes: As alleged in the complaint, Respondent, a 2017 candidate for City of Homestead City Council, may have failed to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed on that date because he had not received funds, made contributions, or expended reportable funds during the 2018 termination reporting period.

Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes: As alleged in the complaint, Respondent, a 2017 candidate for City of Homestead City Council, failed to timely file his 2018 Termination Report reflecting the disposition of all remaining campaign funds.

Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes: As alleged in the complaint, Respondent, a 2017 candidate for City of Homestead City Council, may have falsely reported or deliberately failed to include information in his 2018 Termination Report, as required by Chapter 106.

When we conclude the investigation, a copy of the Report of Investigation (ROI) will be mailed to you at the above address. Based on the results of the investigation, a staff attorney will make a written recommendation (Staff Recommendation or SR) to the Commission as to whether there is probable cause to charge respondent with violating Chapters 104 or 106, Florida Statutes. You will have an opportunity to respond to both the ROI and the SR. The Commission will then hold

A review of our files indicates that you failed to file your Termination Campaign Treasurer's Report due on February 5, 2018. Florida Statutes 106.07 (8)(b) states that:

"Upon determining that a report is late, the filing officer shall Immediately notify the candidate or chair of the political committee as to the failure to file a report by the designated due date and that a fine is being assessed for each late day... For reports required under s. 106.141(8), the fine (for termination reports) is \$50 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25 percent of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. Upon receipt of the report, the filing officer shall determine the amount of the fine which is due and shall notify the candidate or chair or registered agent of the political committee ..."

You were previously notified of this failure to file on February 8, 2018. This is your second and final notice, so I urge you to promptly respond to this matter to limit additional fines. Otherwise, in accordance with Florida Statute 106.07 (8)(d), the Florida Elections Commission will be notified of this failure to file.


