If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

SUMMARY: Myra Van Hoose is a candidate for Escambia County Commissioner, District 4, in the 2022 elections. Ms. Van Hoose is her own treasurer.

Myra Van Hoose is appealing the fine and claims that she "had a power outage and the report did not go through." According to Ms. Van Hoose, she typically files at the deadline and thought the report was complete. She notes that "the input screen indicated with bold letters across the top of the screen that the report was due within 24 hours when I did file at 7 am on Saturday." She also mentions that the report incorrectly states it was filed closer to 10:00 a.m. Ms. Van Hoose notes that she did not have a primary opponent and that "no harm was done or could have been done by a late filing." She states that a \$500 fine could cause financial hardship.

- The 2022 P7 Original Report covers the period from 08/06/22-08/18/22; it was due on 08/19/22.
- The 2022 P7 Report shows that it was filed on 08/20/22 at approximately 9:58 a.m.
- Myra Van Hoose reported receiving 8 contributions while making 11 expenditures.
- The Escambia County Supervisor of Elections does not have any notes that pertain to Myra Van Hoose's 2022 P7 Report.

I am requesting a waiver for the fine of \$500 imposed upon me due to a potentially late file as referenced in the attached letter.

I make my request based upon several factors:

I have typically filed my reports at deadline and thought I had completed this one as well, however, we believe we had a power outage and the report did not go through.

The report in question was required to be filed on a Friday night by midnight, however the input screen indicated with bold letters across the top of the screen that the report was due within 24 hours when I did file at 7 am on Saturday. Unfortunately, I cannot risk filing late to access this screen again, but perhaps your tech support can.

My report indicates that the time filed was close to 10:00 am and I believe that to be in error.

No office was open to report the details of my report between midnight Friday and 7 am Saturday to make the details of said report public any sooner.

I did not have a primary opponent therefore no candidate was relying on my information to make campaign choices, nor would the public voters be affected in my primary race, again as there was no primary opponent.

My report was approximately only ten percent of my total revenues to date, yet it reflected almost 30% of expenditures, with a net loss for the period reported, therefore would have clearly posed no income stream threat to a candidate if I indeed had a primary opponent.

In summary, I hope you can agree that no harm was done or could have been done by a filing late, only by overnight. In contrast, \$500 at this point in my campaign, albeit out of my own pocket could incur a financial hardship for me, thus skewing the outcome of a general election.

I thank the local supervisor of elections office for calling me Saturday morning! And I will be diligent in ensuring future reports are submitted properly.

Your P7 Campaign Report for the August 06, 2022, to August 18, 2022, reporting period was not submitted on time. The report was due on August 19, 2022.
