**If you are the Complainant**, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

**If you are an Appellant**, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will **not** be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.



**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO A HEARING**

As the Respondent, you may elect to resolve this case in several ways. First, you may elect to resolve this case by consent order where you and Commission staff agree to resolve the violation(s) and agree to the amount of the fine. The consent order is then presented to the Commission for its approval. To discuss a consent order, contact the FEC attorney identified in the Order of Probable Cause.

Second, you may request an informal hearing held before the Commission, if you do not dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. You have 30 days from the date the Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission to request such a hearing. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order. At the hearing, you will have the right to make written or oral arguments to the Commission concerning the legal issues related to the violation(s) and the potential fine. At the request of Respondent, the Commission will consider and determine willfulness at an informal hearing. Otherwise, live witness testimony is unnecessary.

Third, you may request a formal hearing held before an administrative law judge in the Division of Administrative Hearings (DOAH), if you dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. You have 30 days from the date the Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission to request such a hearing. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order. At the hearing, you will have the right to present evidence relevant to the violation(s) listed in this order, to cross-examine opposing witnesses, to impeach any witness, and to rebut the evidence presented against you.

If you do not elect to resolve the case by consent order or request a formal hearing at the DOAH or an informal hearing before the Commission within 30 days of the date this Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission, the case will be sent to the Commission for a formal or informal hearing, depending on whether the facts are in dispute. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order.

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION**

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(c), Florida Statutes, undersigned staff counsel files this written recommendation for disposition of the complaint in this case recommending that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating **Sections 106.07(2)(b)1, Florida Statutes**. Based upon a thorough review of the Report of Investigation submitted on September 14, 2020, the following facts and law support this staff recommendation.

1. On June 29, 2020, the Florida Elections Commission (“Commission”) received a referral from the Division of Elections (“Division”) alleging Ryan Douglas Terrell (“Respondent”) violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.

2. Respondent was a candidate for State Representative, District 7, in the 2020 election. Respondent's Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Candidates form was filed with the Division on September 27, 2019. Respondent appointed himself as his own treasurer. (ROI Exhibit 1)<sup>1</sup> Respondent was disqualified as a candidate on June 26, 2020. (ROI Exhibit 9)

3. By letter dated July 27, 2020, the Executive Director notified Respondent that Commission staff would investigate the following alleged violations:

**Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes:** Respondent, a 2020 candidate for State Representative, District 7, acting as his own treasurer, failed to timely make necessary amendments to the following campaign treasurer’s reports, as alleged in the complaint:

- 2020 M1
- 2020 M2
- 2020 M3

4. By letter dated September 30, 2019, Kristi Reid Bronson, Chief, Bureau of Election Records, Division of Elections, notified Respondent that his name had been placed on the 2020 active candidate list. The letter advised Respondent that all candidates who file reports with the Division are required to use the Division’s Electronic Filing System (“EFS”) and

provided Respondent with a user identification number and initial password to access the EFS. (ROI Exhibit 2, page 1)

5. Ms. Bronson's September 30, 2019 letter further advised Respondent that all the Division's publications and reporting forms were available on the Division's website; reminded Respondent it was his responsibility to read, understand, and follow the requirements of Florida's elections laws; and directed Respondent to print a copy of Chapters 104 and 106, Florida Statutes, the *Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook*, and the *Calendar of Reporting Dates*. (ROI Exhibit 2, page 2)

6. The referral alleged Respondent failed to provide missing information on campaign reports and file amended 2020 M1, 2020 M2, and 2020 M3 Reports reflecting the correct information within seven days of receiving notice from the filing officer.

### **2020 M1 and 2020 M2 Reports.**

7. Respondent's 2020 M1 Report covering the dates of January 1, 2020, through January 31, 2020, was due on February 10, 2020. (Attachment A) Respondent filed his 2020 M1 Report on February 20, 2020, but it was incomplete. (Exhibit 3, pages 1 and 2; Attachment B)

8. Respondent's 2020 M2 Report covering the dates of February 1, 2020, through February 29, 2020, was due on March 10, 2020. (Attachment A) Respondent timely filed his 2020 M2 Report, but it was incomplete. (Exhibit 3, pages 1 and 3; Attachment B)

9. On March 11, 2020, and March 26, 2020, the Division notified Respondent his 2020 M1 and 2020 M2 Reports were incomplete. The Division's letters stated Respondent had seven days from receipt of the notice to correct the errors, provide the missing information on the attached Error Report, and file amended 2020 M1 and 2020 M2 Reports. (ROI Exhibit 3)

10. On April 27, 2020, the Division sent notification to Respondent marked "Final Notice" that his 2020 M1 and 2020 M2 Reports were incomplete. The letter stated Respondent had seven days from receipt of the notice to correct the errors, provide the missing information on the attached Error Report, and file amended 2020 M1 and 2020 M2 Reports. (ROI Exhibit 5, pages 1-3) The Division's April 27, 2020 letter was confirmed delivered on April 29, 2020. (ROI Exhibit 5, page 4)

11. As of January 7, 2021, Respondent has failed to file correct the errors identified by the Division and file an amended 2020 M1 or 2020 M2 Report reflecting the correct information. (Attachment C)

### **2020 M3 Report.**

12. Respondent's 2020 M3 Report covering the dates of March 1, 2020, through March 31, 2020, was due on April 10, 2020. (Attachment A) Respondent filed his 2020 M3 Report on April 12, 2020, but it was incomplete. (ROI Exhibit 4, pages 1-2; Attachment B)

13. On April 13, 2020, and April 28, 2020, the Division notified Respondent his 2020 M3 Report was incomplete. The Division's letters stated Respondent had seven days from



receipt of the notice to correct the errors, provide the missing information on the attached Error Report, and file an amended 2020 M3 Report. (ROI Exhibit 4)

14. On May 15, 2020, the Division sent notification to Respondent marked “Final Notice” that his 2020 M3 Report was incomplete. The letter stated Respondent had seven days from receipt of the notice to correct the errors, provide the missing information on the attached Error Report, and file an amended 2020 M3 Report. (ROI Exhibit 6, pages 1 and 2) The Division’s May 15, 2020 letter was confirmed delivered on May 19, 2020. (ROI Exhibit 6, page 3)

15. As of January 7, 2021, Respondent has failed to file correct the errors identified by the Division and file an amended 2020 M3 Report reflecting the corrections. (Attachment C)

16. On August 31, 2020, Investigator Mellow attempted to speak with Respondent by telephone three times. The first time Investigator Mellow attempted to call, he got a busy signal. The second time Investigator Mellow called, he spoke with Respondent. Investigator Mellow told Respondent he was calling about the case and asked Respondent if he had received an affidavit to complete. At that time, the call was “dropped.” (ROI Exhibit 8, Phone Log Entries 1 and 2)

17. When Investigator Mellow attempted to call Respondent a third time on August 31, 2020, Investigator Mellow reached Respondent’s voicemail. Investigator Mellow left his contact information and requested Respondent to return the call, which Respondent failed to do. (ROI Exhibit 8, Phone Log Entry 3)

18. On September 9, 2020, Investigator Mellow attempted to call Respondent by telephone and the call went to Respondent’s voicemail. Investigator Mellow left his contact information and requested Respondent to return the phone call, which Respondent failed to do. (ROI Exhibit 8, Phone Log Entry 4)

19. “Probable Cause” is defined as a reasonable ground of suspicion supported by circumstances sufficiently strong to warrant a cautious [investigator] in the belief that the person has committed the offense charged. *Schmitt v. State*, 590 So.2d 404, 409 (Fla. 1991). Probable cause exists where the facts and circumstances, of which an [investigator] has reasonably trustworthy information, are sufficient in themselves for a reasonable man to reach the conclusion that an offense has been committed. *Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles v. Favino*, 667 So.2d 305, 309 (Fla. 1st DCA 1995).

20. The above facts show that Respondent was a candidate for State Representative, District 7, in the 2020 election. Respondent filed his 2020 M1, 2020 M2, and 2020 M3 Reports; however, each report was incomplete. Despite the Division notifying Respondent on three separate occasions that his 2020 M1, 2020 M2, and 2020 M3 Reports were incomplete and Respondent had seven days from receipt of the notification to provide the missing information on the attached Error Report and file amended 2020 M1, 2020 M2, and 2020 M3 Reports, as of January 7, 2021, Respondent has failed to do so.

Based on the foregoing, I recommend the Commission find probable cause to charge Respondent with the following violations:

**Count 1:**

On or about May 6, 2020, Respondent violated Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, when Respondent failed to timely provide the missing information identified by the Division and file an amended 2020 M1 Report with the correct information.

**Count 2:**

On or about May 6, 2020, Respondent violated Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, when Respondent failed to timely provide the missing information identified by the Division and file an amended 2020 M2 Report with the correct information.

**Count 3:**

On or about May 26, 2020, Respondent violated Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, when Respondent failed to timely provide the missing information identified by the Division and file an amended 2020 M3 Report with the correct information.

#### I. Preliminary Information:

1. I investigated whether Respondent violated this section of the election laws by failing to file amended reports for the following campaign treasurer's reports after receiving notice from the filing officer: 2020 M1, 2020 M2 and 2020 M3.

2. An Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository (DS-DE 9) was filed on September 27, 2019. Respondent was named as the treasurer for Ryan Terrell, a 2020 candidate for State Representative, District 7.<sup>1</sup> To review the DS-DE 9, refer to Exhibit 1.

3. On September 30, 2019, the Division sent Respondent a letter acknowledging his appointment as the campaign treasurer for Ryan Terrell's campaign. The letter advised Respondent that all of the Division's publications and reporting forms are available on their website, including Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, the *Candidate and Campaign Treasurer*, and the *Calendar of Reporting Dates*. The letter further advised Respondent that it was his responsibility to read, understand, and follow the requirements of Florida's election laws. To review a copy of the acknowledgement letter, refer to Exhibit 2.

#### II. Alleged Violation of Section 106.07(2)(b)(1), Florida Statutes:

4. On March 11, 2020, and March 26, 2020, the Division sent correspondence to Respondent informing him that one or more campaign reports were incomplete. The correspondence was sent to Respondent's address provided on the DS-DE 9 and included an error report referencing the following reports: 2020 M1 and 2020 M2. To review the correspondence and error report, refer to Exhibit 3.

5. On April 13, 2020, and April 28, 2020, the Division sent correspondence to Respondent informing him that one or more campaign reports were incomplete. The correspondence was sent to Respondent's address provided on the DS-DE 9 and included an error report referencing the following report: 2020 M3. To review the correspondence and error report, refer to Exhibit 4.

6. On April 27, 2020, the Division sent Respondent a letter marked "Final Notice" with delivery confirmation informing him that one or more campaign reports were incomplete. The letter was sent to Respondent's address provided on the DS-DE 9 and included an error report referencing the following reports: 2020 M1 and 2020 M2. It was confirmed delivered on April 29, 2020. To review the Final Notice letter, error report and delivery confirmation, refer to Exhibit 5.

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<sup>1</sup> The Division notified Respondent by letter dated July 1, 2020, that he was disqualified as a candidate. To review the disqualification notice, refer to Exhibit 9.

7. On May 15, 2020, the Division sent Respondent a letter marked "Final Notice" with delivery confirmation informing him that one or more campaign reports were incomplete. The letter was sent to Respondent's address provided on the DS-DE 9 and included an error report referencing the following report: 2020 M3. It was confirmed delivered on May 19, 2020. To review the Final Notice letter, error report and delivery confirmation, refer to Exhibit 6.


8. In an email dated July 30, 2020, Division staff confirmed that Respondent has not correctly amended any of the reports at issue. To review the email from Division staff, refer to Exhibit 7.

9. Respondent did not respond to the referral.

10. Respondent did not respond to a questionnaire-affidavit. Because the affidavit has not been returned, I am unable to ascertain whether he has read Chapter 106, Florida Statutes and/or the *Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook*.
