You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

ORDER OF PROBABLE CAUSE

THIS MATTER was heard by the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) at its regularly scheduled meeting on May 17, 2017, in Tallahassee, Florida.

On March 23, 2017, Staff recommended to the Commission that there was probable cause to believe that the Florida Election Code was violated. The facts articulated in Staff's Recommendation are adopted by reference and incorporated herein. Based on the Complaint, Report of Investigation, Staff's Recommendation, and oral statements (if any) made at the probable cause hearing, the Commission finds that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with the following violation(s):

Count 1:

On or about July 1, 2016, Ax the Tax violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2016 P1 Report.

Count 2:

On or about July 8, 2016, Ax the Tax violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing

on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2016 P1A Report.

Count 3:

On or about July 15, 2016, Ax the Tax violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2016 P2 Report.

Count 4:

On or about July 22, 2016, Ax the Tax violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2016 P2A Report.

Count 5:

On or about July 29, 2016, Ax the Tax violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2016 P3 Report.

Count 6:

On or about August 5, 2016, Ax the Tax violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2016 P4 Report.

Count 7:

On or about August 26, 2016, Ax the Tax violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2016 P7 Report.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO A HEARING

As the Respondent, you may elect to resolve this case in several ways. First, you may elect to resolve this case by <u>consent order</u> where you and Commission staff agree to resolve the violation(s)s and agree to the amount of the fine. The consent order is then presented to the Commission for its approval. To discuss a consent order, contact the FEC attorney identified in the Order of Probable Cause.

Second, you may request an <u>informal hearing</u> held before the Commission, if you <u>do not</u> dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. You have 30 days from the date the Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission to request such a hearing. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order. At the hearing, you will have the right to make written or oral arguments to the Commission concerning the legal issues related to the violation(s) and the potential fine. At the request of Respondent, the Commission will consider and determine willfulness at an informal hearing. Otherwise, live witness testimony is unnecessary.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(c), Florida Statutes, undersigned staff counsel files this written recommendation for disposition of the referral in this case recommending that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating **Section 106.07(7)**, Florida Statutes. Based upon a thorough review of the Report of Investigation submitted on March 7, 2017, the following facts and law support this staff recommendation:

1. On September 30, 2016, the Florida Elections Commission ("Commission") received a referral from the Department of State, Division of Elections ("Division"), alleging that Ax the Tax ("Respondent") violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.

2. Respondent is a political committee registered with the Division. An Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Political Committees form ("DS-DE 6") appointing Doug Guetzloe as the Committee's treasurer was filed with the Division on February 26, 2004. Mr. Guetzloe is also Respondent's chairperson. (ROI Exhibit 1)¹

3. By letter dated January 27, 2017, the Executive Director notified Respondent that Commission staff would investigate the following statutory provision:

Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes: As alleged in the complaint, Respondent failed to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed on that date because it had not received funds, made contributions, or expended reportable funds during the following reporting periods:

- 2016 P1
- 2016 P1A
- 2016 P2
- 2016 P2A
- 2016 P3
- 2016 P4
- 2016 P7

4. By letter dated February 28, 2004, Phyllis Hampton, Division of Elections, Chief, Bureau of Election Records, sent Respondent's chairman a letter acknowledging that the Division had received Respondent's Statement of Organization and DS-DE 6 forms. The

acknowledgment letter referenced enclosed copies of Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, the Handbook for Committees, and the Handbook for Treasurers. (ROI Exhibit 2)

5. Pursuant to Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, in any reporting period during which a political committee has not received funds, made any contributions, or expended any reportable funds, the filing of the required report for that period is waived. However, the political committee is required to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that no report is being filed on that date.

6. The *Political Committee Handbook* references the statutory requirement regarding written notification and directs political committees to notify the Division by way of the Division's electronic filing system. (ROI Exhibit 3) The *Political Committee EFS User's Guide* shows the process through which to notify the Division. The user's guide instructs political committees to select the relevant reporting period and place a checkmark in a box titled "Waiver" to indicate the lack of reportable financial activity. (ROI Exhibit 4)

7. Respondent failed to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting dates that no reports would be filed for the following reporting periods, as set forth in the table below. (ROI Exhibit 5, page 1)

8. Respondent was offered multiple opportunities to respond to Commission staff's investigation, but did not do so. Respondent's chairman did not return numerous telephone calls placed by Commission staff in attempts to interview him. (ROI Exhibit 7)

9. "Probable Cause" is defined as reasonable grounds of suspicion supported by circumstances sufficiently strong to warrant a cautious person in the belief that the person has committed the offense charged. *Schmitt v. State*, 590 So. 2d 404, 409 (Fla. 1991). Probable cause exists where the facts and circumstances, of which an [investigator] has reasonably trustworthy information, are sufficient in themselves for a reasonable man to reach the conclusion that an offense has been committed. *Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles v. Favino*, 667 So. 2d 305, 309 (Fla. 1st DCA 1995).

10. The facts set forth above show that Respondent is a political committee registered with the Division. Respondent failed to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting dates that no reports would be filed for the following reporting periods: 2016 P1, 2016 P1A, 2016 P2, 2016 P2A, 2016 P3, 2016 P4, and 2016 P7.

Based upon these facts and circumstances, I recommend that the Commission find probable cause to charge Respondent with violating the following:

Count 1:

On or about July 1, 2016, Ax the Tax violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2016 P1 Report.

Count 2:

On or about July 8, 2016, Ax the Tax violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2016 P1A Report.

Count 3:

On or about July 15, 2016, Ax the Tax violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2016 P2 Report.

Count 4:

On or about July 22, 2016, Ax the Tax violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2016 P2A Report.

Count 5:

On or about July 29, 2016, Ax the Tax violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2016 P3 Report.



Count 6:

On or about August 5, 2016, Ax the Tax violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2016 P4 Report.

Count 7:

On or about August 26, 2016, Ax the Tax violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2016 P7 Report.

I. Preliminary Information:

1. An appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository (DS-DE 6) was filed on February 26, 2004. (Ex. 1)

2. An acknowledgement letter was mailed to the address provided on Respondent's DS-DE 6 on February 28, 2004 advising Respondent that all of the Division's publications and reporting forms are available on their website, including Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, the *Political Committee Handbook*, and the Calendar of Reporting Dates. (Ex. 2)

3. The Political Committee Handbook, discusses filing a notice-of-no-activity when there is no activity to disclose on page 26. (Ex. 3)

4. Pages 12, 13, 45, and 46 of the *Political Committee EFS User's Guide* discuss how to notify the Division on the prescribed reporting date that no report will be filed using the EFS. Specifically, Page 13 instructs the user to click the box next to "waiver" if there is no activity to disclose. (Ex. 4)

5. In a telephone interview on April 2, 2014, Kristi Reid-Bronson clarified that once the waiver box is chosen and a new report is opened as shown on page 12, the only available option on the report summary screen will be "Go To File Report" as shown on page 13. Choosing "Go To File Report" will take the user directly to the screens where the chairman/treasurer PINS are entered as shown on pages 45 and 46

II. Alleged Violation of Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes:

6. Respondent's filing history reflects the untimely filed notifications summarized below. (Ex. 5)

7. Respondent's chairman did not provide a written response to the referral.

8. Respondent's chairman did not return a questionnaire-affidavit, nor did he respond to any of the attempted telephone contacts.

9. During the course of the investigation, I reviewed Respondent's previous filing history. I determined that there were two reporting periods in 2016, prior to the 2016 P1 reporting period, where waivers were timely filed. (Ex. 5)

III. FEC History:

10. Respondent has had prior cases before the Commission.

Conclusion:

11. I attempted to contact Respondent's chairman on two occasions to give him an opportunity to discuss the allegations in the referral. Additionally, a questionnaire-affidavit was mailed to Respondent's chairman on February 7, 2017. As of the date of this report, Respondent's chairman has not returned my calls, nor has he returned an affidavit.

12. Because Respondent's chairman has not contacted the Commission or returned an affidavit, I am unable to ascertain whether Respondent's chairman has read Chapter 106, Florida Statutes and/or the *Political Committee Handbook*. Respondent's chairman signed the Statement of Political Committee form on February 16, 2004. (Ex. 6)

13. The Investigative Phone Log is included with this report. (Ex. 7)

Penalty for Late Filing

However, for the reports due immediately prior to the primary and general elections, the fine shall be \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25 percent of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

Notice of No Activity

When there has been no reportable activity in the campaign account during a reporting period (no funds expended or received) the filing of the report is waived. The political committee shall notify the filing officer in writing on or before the prescribed reporting date that no report is being filed on that date. The next report filed must specify that the report covers the entire period between the last submitted report and the report being filed.



When an election is called for an issue to appear on the ballot at a time when no candidates are scheduled to appear on the ballot, all political committees making contributions or expenditures in support of or in opposition to such issue shall file reports on the 18th and 4th days prior to such election.







Dear Mr. Guetzloe:

On September 30, 2016, the Florida Elections Commission received a complaint alleging that your committee violated Florida's election laws. I have reviewed the complaint and find that it contains one or more legally sufficient allegations. The Commission staff will investigate the following alleged violation:

Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes: As alleged in the complaint, for each of the following reporting periods, Respondent failed to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed on that date because it had not received funds, made contributions, or expended reportable funds during the reporting periods:

- 2016 P1
- 2016 P1A
- 2016 P2
- 2016 P2A
- 2016 P3
- 2016 P4
- 2016 P7

You may respond to the allegation above by filing a notarized statement providing any information regarding the facts and circumstances surrounding the allegation. Your response will be included as an attachment to the investigator's report.

When we conclude the investigation, a copy of the Report of Investigation will be mailed to you at the above address. You may file a response to the report <u>within 14 days from the date the report</u> is mailed to you. Based on the results of the investigation, legal staff will make a written recommendation to the Commission on whether there is probable cause to believe you have violated Chapter 104 or 106, Florida Statutes. A copy of the Staff Recommendation will be mailed to you and you may file a response <u>within 14 days from the date the recommendation is mailed to you</u>. Your timely filed response(s) will be considered by the Commission when determining probable cause.

The Commission will then hold a hearing to determine whether there is probable cause to believe you have violated Chapters 104 or 106, Florida Statutes. You and the complainant will receive a notice of hearing at least 14 days before the hearing. The notice of hearing will indicate the location, date, and time of your hearing. You will have the opportunity to make a brief oral statement to the Commission, but you will not be permitted to testify or call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence.

At any time before a probable cause finding, you may notify us in writing that you want to enter into negotiations directed towards reaching a settlement via consent agreement.

The Report of Investigation, Staff Recommendation, and Notice of Hearing will be mailed to the above address as this letter. Therefore, if your address changes, you must notify this office of your new address. Otherwise, you may not receive these important documents. Failure to receive the documents will not delay the probable cause hearing.

Under section 106.25, Florida Statutes, complaints, Commission investigations, investigative reports, and other documents relating to an alleged violation of Chapters 104 and 106, Florida Statutes, are <u>confidential</u> until the Commission finds probable cause or no probable cause. The confidentiality provision does not apply to the person filing the complaint. However, it does apply to you unless you waive confidentiality in writing. The confidentiality provision does not preclude you from seeking legal counsel. However, if you retain counsel, your attorney must file a notice of appearance with the Commission before any member of the Commission staff can discuss this case with him or her.






