### FINAL ORDER

THIS CAUSE came on to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) at its regularly scheduled meeting held on August 4, 1995.

#### **FINDINGS OF FACT**

- 1. The Commission is charged with enforcing Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, the campaign financing law.
- 2. The Respondent's campaign treasurer's report was not filed with the filing officer on the designated due date.
- 3. The filing officer fined the Respondent for the late filing of the report which the Respondent timely appealed, claiming unusual circumstances.

#### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 1 The Florida Elections Commission has jurisdiction over the parties to and subject matter of this case, pursuant to Section 106.04 or 106.07, Florida Statutes.
- 2. The Respondent's claim of unusual circumstances, as defined in Rule 1D-1 005, Florida Administrative Code, does not justify the Respondent's failure to AUTFORM 001 (9/94)
