If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

ORDER OF PROBABLE CAUSE

THIS MATTER was heard by the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) at its regularly scheduled meeting on May 16, 2023, in Tallahassee, Florida.

On March 31, 2023, Staff recommended to the Commission that there was probable cause to believe that the Florida Election Code was violated. The facts articulated in Staff's Recommendation are adopted by reference and incorporated herein. Based on the Complaint, Report of Investigation, Staff's Recommendation, and oral statements (if any) made at the probable cause hearing, the Commission finds that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with the following violation(s):

Count 1:

On or about April 1, 2020, Virginia Fuller violated Section 106.021(1)(a), Florida Statutes, when she accepted a contribution with a view to bringing about her election prior to appointing a campaign treasurer and designating a primary campaign depository.

Count 2:

On or about April 20, 2020, Virginia Fuller violated Section 106.021(1)(a), Florida Statutes, when she accepted a contribution with a view to bringing about her election prior to appointing a campaign treasurer and designating a primary campaign depository.

Count 3:

On or about May 8, 2020, Virginia Fuller violated Section 106.021(1)(a), Florida Statutes, when she accepted a contribution with a view to bringing about her election prior to appointing a campaign treasurer and designating a primary campaign depository.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO A HEARING

As the Respondent, you may elect to resolve this case in several ways. First, you may elect to resolve this case by <u>consent order</u> where you and Commission staff agree to resolve the violation(s) and agree to the amount of the fine. The consent order is then presented to the Commission for its approval. To discuss a consent order, contact the FEC attorney identified in the Order of Probable Cause.

Second, you may request an <u>informal hearing</u> held before the Commission, if you <u>do not</u> dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. You have 30 days from the date the Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission to request such a hearing. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order. At the hearing, you will have the right to make written or oral arguments to the Commission concerning the legal issues related to the violation(s) and the potential fine. At the request of Respondent, the Commission will consider and determine willfulness at an informal hearing. Otherwise, live witness testimony is unnecessary.

Third, you may request a <u>formal hearing</u> held before an administrative law judge in the Division of Administrative Hearings (DOAH), if you dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. You have 30 days from the date the Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission to request such a hearing. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order. At the hearing, you will have the right to present evidence

relevant to the violation(s) listed in this order, to cross-examine opposing witnesses, to impeach any witness, and to rebut the evidence presented against you.

If you do not elect to resolve the case by consent order or request a formal hearing at the DOAH or an informal hearing before the Commission within 30 days of the date this Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission, the case will be sent to the Commission for a formal or informal hearing, depending on whether the facts are in dispute. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(c), Florida Statutes, undersigned staff counsel files this written recommendation for disposition of the referral in this case recommending that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating **Section 106.021(1)(a)**, **Florida Statutes**. Based upon a thorough review of the Report of Investigation submitted on March 10, 2023, the following facts and law support this staff recommendation:

- 1. On December 21, 2020, the Florida Elections Commission ("Commission") received a referral from the Department of State, Division of Elections ("Division" or "Complainant"), alleging that Virginia Fuller ("Respondent") violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.
- 2. Respondent was a 2020 candidate for State Representative, District 9. Respondent's Statement of Candidate form ("DS-DE 84") was filed on June 9, 2020. (ROI Exhibit 2)¹ Respondent failed to qualify and was eliminated as a candidate. (ROI Exhibit 1, page 1)
- 3. By letter dated January 26, 2021, the Executive Director notified Respondent that Commission staff would investigate the following statutory provision:

Section 106.021(1)(a), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2020 candidate for State Representative, District 9, may have accepted one or more campaign contributions or incurred one or more campaign expenses before appointing a treasurer and designating a campaign depository, as alleged in the complaint.

- 4. On June 9, 2020, and June 10, 2020, Respondent attempted to file her Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Candidates form ("DS-DE 9"); however, the form was incomplete. (ROI Exhibit 3, pages 1 & 2) On June 11, 2020, Respondent filed her DS-DE 9 appointing herself as treasurer for her campaign. (ROI Exhibit 3, page 3)
- 5. Complainant alleged that Respondent violated Florida's election laws by accepting contributions before appointing a campaign treasurer and designating a campaign depository.
 - 6. Section 106.021(1)(a), Florida Statutes, provides:

¹ The Report of Investigation is referred to herein as "ROI."

A person may not accept any contribution or make any expenditure with a view to bringing about his or her nomination, election, or retention in public office, or authorize another to accept such contributions or make such expenditure on the person's behalf, unless such person has appointed a campaign treasurer and designated a primary campaign depository.

- 7. On June 11, 2020, Respondent appointed a campaign treasurer and designated a campaign depository. (ROI Exhibit 3, page 3)
- 8. On September 10, 2020, Respondent filed the campaign's 2020 P1 Report. (ROI Exhibit 4, page 3) The reporting period ran from June 11, 2020, through June 12, 2020. (ROI Exhibit 4, page 1) Respondent reported receiving three contributions totaling \$3,631.53 on April 24, 2020. The contributions were reported from Fred Ingley (\$100), Charlie Pitale (\$20), and a loan from self (\$3,511.53). (ROI Exhibit 4, page 2)
- 9. A subpoena was issued to Respondent's designated campaign depository to verify Respondent's reporting. Respondent's bank records show that the campaign depository was opened on June 12, 2020. (RO Exhibit 5, page 1) The records show a check from Fred Ingley III dated April 1, 2020, in the amount of \$100 with the memo "Political Contribution" (ROI Exhibit 5, page 6) and a check from Charles N. Pitale dated April 20, 2020, in the amount of \$20 with the memo "Virginia Fuller 4 Congress" (ROI Exhibit 5, page 7). The records also show a \$3,000 electronic transfer (credit) on June 12, 2020 from an unknown origin (ROI Exhibit 5, page 3), a check from Miami-Dade County Finance Department dated May 8, 2020, in the amount of \$450.50 with an after-the-fact hand-written memo stating, "Loan to campaign" (ROI Exhibit 5, page 8), and a cash deposit of \$61.03 on June 12, 2020, from an unknown origin (ROI Exhibit 5, page 5).
- 10. Respondent stated that she cannot help it when people send her checks and that the contributors would not take back their money. Respondent was not a first-time candidate. (ROI Exhibit 7, page 2)
- 11. Respondent accepted three check contributions totaling \$570.50 prior to appointing a campaign treasurer and designating a campaign depository.
- 12. "Probable Cause" is defined as reasonable grounds of suspicion supported by circumstances sufficiently strong to warrant a cautious person in the belief that the person has committed the offense charged. *Schmitt v. State*, 590 So. 2d 404, 409 (Fla. 1991). Probable cause exists where the facts and circumstances, of which an [investigator] has reasonably trustworthy information, are sufficient in themselves for a reasonable man to reach the conclusion that an offense has been committed. *Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles v. Favino*, 667 So. 2d 305, 309 (Fla. 1st DCA 1995).
- 13. The facts set forth above show that Respondent was a 2020 candidate for State Representative, District 9. Respondent accepted contributions prior to appointing a campaign treasurer and designating a campaign depository.

Based upon these facts and circumstances, I recommend that the Commission find

probable cause to charge Respondent with violating the following:

Count 1:

On or about April 1, 2020, Virginia Fuller violated Section 106.021(1)(a), Florida Statutes, when she accepted a contribution with a view to bringing about her election prior to appointing a campaign treasurer and designating a primary campaign depository.

Count 2:

On or about April 20, 2020, Virginia Fuller violated Section 106.021(1)(a), Florida Statutes, when she accepted a contribution with a view to bringing about her election prior to appointing a campaign treasurer and designating a primary campaign depository.

Count 3:

On or about May 8, 2020, Virginia Fuller violated Section 106.021(1)(a), Florida Statutes, when she accepted a contribution with a view to bringing about her election prior to appointing a campaign treasurer and designating a primary campaign depository.

FLORIDA ELECTIONS COMMISSION REPORT OF INVESTIGATION

Case No.: FEC 20-653

Respondent: Virginia Fuller

Complainant: Division of Elections

Pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, on December 21, 2020, the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) received an information from the Division of Elections (Division) alleging that Respondent violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes. Commission staff, therefore, investigated whether Respondent violated the following statute:

Section 106.021(1)(a), Florida Statutes, may have accepted one or more campaign contributions or incurred one or more campaign expenses before appointing a treasurer and designating a campaign depository.

I. Preliminary Information:

- 1. Respondent was a 2020 candidate for State Representative, District 9; she failed to qualify. Respondent was not a first-time candidate. To review the disqualification letter and returned filing fee cashier's check, refer to Exhibit 1.
 - 2. Respondent's filing officer was the Division.
- 3. On June 9, 2020, Respondent filed a Statement of Candidate with the Division whereby she listed her candidacy for State Representative, District 9, and acknowledged she had been provided access to read and understand the requirements of Chapter 106, Florida Statutes. To review the Statement of Candidate, refer to Exhibit 2.
- 4. On June 9, 2020, and June 10, 2020, Respondent filed two Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Candidates forms (DS-DE 9) with the Division. Both attempted to appoint Respondent as her own campaign treasurer and to designate Bank of America as her campaign depository. However, both DS-DE 9s were deemed incomplete by the Division. To review the incomplete DS-DE 9s, refer to Exhibit 3, pages 1-2.
- 5. On June 11, 2020, Respondent filed a third DS-DE 9 with the Division whereby Respondent appointed herself as campaign treasurer and designated Bank of America as her campaign depository. The DS-DE 9 was dated as having been signed by Respondent on June 9, 2020. To review the third DS-DE 9, refer to Exhibit 3, page 3.

II. Alleged Violation of Section 106.021(1)(a), Florida Statutes:

- 6. I investigated whether Respondent violated this section of the election laws by accepting one or more campaign contributions or incurring one or more campaign expenses before appointing a treasurer and designating a campaign depository.
- 7. On September 10, 2020, Respondent filed the 2020 P1 report, which covered the reporting period of June 11, 2020, to June 12, 2020. In the report, Respondent disclosed that on

April 24, 2020, she received the following three contributions: \$100.00 check from Fred Ingley; \$20.00 check from Charlie Pitale; and \$3,511.53 loan from Respondent. The reported date of receipt was thus prior to the date Respondent filed her DS-DE 9. To review the 2020 P1 report and filing history, refer to Exhibit 4.

- 8. I subpoenaed campaign account records from Respondent's designated campaign depository. Bank records show Respondent opened the depository on June 12, 2020, with a \$631.53 deposit, which included: \$61.03 in cash; \$100.00 check from Fred Ingley III dated April 1, 2020, with "political contribution" on the memo line; \$20.00 check from Charles N. Pitale dated April 20, 2020, with "Virginia Fuller 4 Congress" on the memo line; and \$450.50 check from the Miami-Dade County Finance Department dated May 8, 2020, with "Loan to Campaign" on the memo line. To review the applicable bank records, refer to Exhibit 5, pages 1-8.
- 9. The bank records further show that on June 12, 2020, \$3,000.00 was electronically transferred into Respondent's account, and \$1,781.87 was withdrawn for purchase of a cashier's check. This is the same amount of the cashier's check submitted by Respondent to the Division for attempted payment of her filing fee, which was returned to her with the disqualification letter dated June 15, 2020. To review the cashier's check, which is dated June 12, 2020, refer to Exhibit 1, page 2. To review the applicable bank records, refer to Exhibit 5, pages 2-3 and 9-10.
- 10. The next activity through the campaign account was on June 25, 2020, when Respondent deposited the \$1,781.87 cashier's check that had been returned to Respondent by the Division with the disqualification letter. To review the applicable bank records, refer to Exhibit 5, pages 2-3 and 11-12.
- 11. The campaign account was zeroed out on July 23, 2020, upon withdrawal of \$120.00 in cash and electronic transfer of \$3,511.53 to a different account. On the 2020 Termination Report (TR), Respondent reported repayment of a \$3,511.53 loan to herself on July 23, 2020. In her 2020 TR, Respondent also reported refund of the \$100.00 contribution to Mr. Ingley and the \$20.00 contribution to Mr. Pitale on September 8, 2020. Campaign account records for September 2020 do not show record of these \$120.00 reported refunds, as the account had been zeroed out on July 23, 2020. However, as noted above, campaign account records do show withdrawal of \$120.00 in cash on July 23, 2020. To review the applicable bank records, refer to Exhibit 5, pages 14-16. To review the 2020 TR expenditure information, refer to Exhibit 6.
- 12. I called Respondent for the purpose of providing an opportunity to discuss the allegations made in the referral. When asked about accepting the checks dated April 1, 2020, and April 20, 2020, totaling \$120.00 when she did not file her DS-DE-9 until June 11, 2020, Respondent stated that she was her own treasurer and could not help when people sent her checks. Respondent stated that the contributors would not take the money back. She indicated that she deposited the checks because she thought it was alright to do so. Respondent acknowledged possessing and having read Chapter 106, Florida Statutes and the *Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook*. To review the phone log, refer to Exhibit 6.





On December 21, 2020, the Florida Elections Commission received a complaint alleging that you violated Florida's election laws. I have reviewed the complaint and find that it contains one or more **legally sufficient allegations**. The Commission staff will investigate the following alleged violation(s):

Section 106.021(1)(a), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2020 candidate for State Representative, District 9, may have accepted one or more campaign contributions or incurred one or more campaign expenses before appointing a treasurer and designating a campaign depository, as alleged in the complaint.

When we conclude the investigation, a copy of the Report of Investigation (ROI) will be mailed to you at the above address. Based on the results of the investigation, a staff attorney will prepare and present a written Staff Recommendation (SR) to the Commission as to whether there is probable cause to charge you, the Respondent, with violating Chapters 104 or 106, Florida Statutes. You will have an opportunity to respond to both the ROI and the SR. The Commission will then hold one or more hearings to determine whether the alleged violation(s) occurred and, if so, the amount of the fine to be imposed upon you. Notice will be mailed to you and the Complainant at least 14 days before any hearing at which your case is to be considered.

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(i)3., Florida Statutes, the Commission may enter into a consent agreement with a Respondent to settle a complaint prior to a finding of probable cause. If you are interested in entering negotiations directed towards reaching a consent agreement to resolve this matter, please contact the Commission and request to speak with the attorney assigned to this case.
