A hearing will be held in this case before the Florida Elections Commission on **February 25, 2014, at 9:00 am, or as soon thereafter as the parties can be heard**, at the following location: **Senate Office Building, Room S-110, 404 South Monroe Street, Tallahassee, FL 32399.**

Failure to appear in accordance with this notice will constitute a waiver of your right to participate in the hearing. Continuances will be granted only upon a showing of good cause

This hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106 25, Florida Statutes, which governs your participation as follows:

**If you are the Respondent**, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

**If you are the Complainant**, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

**If you are an Appellant**, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

Please refer to the information below for further instructions related to your particular hearing:

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

**SUMMARY:** Shannon Currie was a candidate for Florida House of Representatives, District 45 in the 2012 elections. Ms. Currie was defeated in the election. Diedra Cobaris was her campaign treasurer.

Ms. Currie is appealing the fine claiming that she was a first-time candidate who was not experienced in election laws. According to Ms. Currie, she was under the impression that all necessary steps had been taken to close out her campaign, due to her campaign not progressing to the general election period. Ms. Currie states that she was assisted by someone at the Division of Elections office who provided answers to all of her election questions. Ms. Currie states "I honestly did not know that I was required to file another report after the General election."

On March 9, 2012, the Division sent Ms. Currie a letter informing her that her name had been placed on the 2012 active candidate list. This letter also informed Ms. Currie, "All of the Division's publications and reporting forms are available on the Division of Elections' web site... It is your responsibility to read, understand, and follow the requirements of Florida's election laws. Therefore, please print a copy of the following documents: *Chapters 104 and 106, Florida Statutes, 2012 Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook, 2012 Calendar of Reporting Dates, and Rule 1S-2.017, Florida Administrative Code.*"

- The 2012 TR Report covers the time period from 8/10/12 through 11/12/12
- Ms. Currie reported making 34 expenditures
- The Queued Transactions Report for Ms. Currie's 2012 TR Report shows that the report was created on 1/2/13 at approximately 4:23 pm, reviewed on 1/2/13 and on 1/4/13, before being filed on 1/4/13 @ approximately 5:01 p.m.

Dear Elections Commission Members:

In reference to CAN 55827, On behalf of my I am requesting a hearing to provide information to the members of the Division of Elections Commission to appeal the fine issued to me for late filing of my 2012 campaign termination report. After the 2012 Primary, I accompanied my Treasurer designate, Diedra Cobaris during the report filing process in October. At that time, we were being assisted by someone in the Division of Elections office whom assisted us with the report filing process by providing answers to our questions. Upon completion of this process I was inquisitive about our final requirements in closing out our reporting process. Being that my campaign efforts was over after the primary election; I asked if this was the final step for the campaign. I was told that this was all that needed to be accomplished. At this time I asked all pertinent questions (I thought) regarding leftover campaign funds, and steps needed to finalize my campaign account and reporting. It was at this time I was reassured that there was nothing more for us to do. I truly thought -based on what I was told- that we had followed all necessary procedures to close out my campaign. Because my campaign did not progress to the General election period, I honestly did not know that I was required to file another report after the General election.

There were a series of conversations that took place during the filing process in October 2012. We sought guidance from the Division of Elections staff after discovering several discrepancies in the reports previously filed. At this time I became intricately engaged in the filing process to ensure that my treasurer had what was needed to complete her efforts properly. When we provided all that we had access to as per the instruction of a staff member in the Division of Elections office, I was reassured that our duties had been accomplished. As a first time candidate- with no campaign experience- it never occurred to me that my reporting responsibility would continue toward the General election period.

I was unaware of the attempts made to reach my treasurer partly because the P.O. Box used for the campaign had expired, and as a back up, all mail associated with financial reporting was set up to be sent to the treasure's home. Communication was not revealed to me that I was in violation of reporting requirements until I inquired about the notification of a report date being missed. When I personally received notice from the Division of Election Office I responded

immediately and worked with my treasurer to get the report filed. Shortly thereafter; I was made aware of the fine applied to me as a result of our late filing of the Campaign Termination Report.

In addition to the consequences of filing late, I am also in the process of reconciling our bank statements in preparation to amend all financial reporting during the campaign. I was notified by the Bureau of Elections that our financial reports needed to be reconciled because the financial balances were inaccurate. After the realization that my treasurer was not following through on the commitments she made to me and the representative working with us from the Bureau of Elections, I relieved her of her duties in July 2013, and inquired the support of a financial expert in campaign reporting.


Presently we have received all financial records from the bank that was used during the campaign and we are in the process of reconciliation. I will amend each report submitted during the campaign financial reporting period upon completion of our financial research.

Campaigning for an elected office was a new experience for me- one of which I enjoyed. As a first time candidate, I thought I had asked all the right questions and had done what was required of me. I have a passion for my community and the legislative process that impacts the quality of life for the district of which I want to serve, as well as for Floridians across our great State. I do not take my responsibility to this process lightly and have been working diligently to resolve the matter at hand. It took several months to realize that the necessary steps to resolve the financial requirements surrounding this process had not taken place. I have been working diligently to resolve this matter because I do not want to violate my good name and integrity with our State Government nor my community. It is my intention to pursue elected office again in the future therefore, it is critical that I ensure that my political aspirations are not jeopardized because of this unfortunate oversight.

Since my campaign last year I have been without gainful employment, and my family and I have experienced many financial hardships. I am happy to say since mid-August my stint with unemployment ended and we my husband and I are working hard to regain our financial responsibilities. I have not taken this situation lightly, which is why I have put my energies into resolving this matter as best possible.



Section 106.07(8)(b), Florida Statutes, requires that the filing officer immediately notify you of the failure to file said report. The fine for termination reports for candidates, shall be \$50 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25 percent of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

The first notice of the failure to file the above mentioned report was mailed, via regular mail, to the address on file with our office on November 13, 2012. As of this date, we do not show a record of receiving this report.

If the report is not received in our office within 14 days of the date this notice is received, our office will refer this matter to the Florida Elections Commission for further action. Section 106.265(1), Florida Statutes, authorizes the Florida Elections Commission, upon finding a willful violation of Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, to impose a civil penalty of up to \$1,000 per count.

### **Pin Numbers**

Pin numbers are confidential secure credentials that allow you to submit reports and update personal information. The enclosed sealed envelope contains confidential pin numbers for you. By copy of this letter, a confidential pin number to access the Division of Election's EFS was sent to your treasurer.

Each candidate is required to provide the Division of Elections with confidential personal information that may be used to allow access in the event this password is forgotten or lost. When you enter the campaign account screen, there will be a drop down box where you pick a question (such as *What is your mother's maiden name?*) and supply an answer. All passwords and answers to questions are stored as encrypted data and cannot be viewed by Division staff and given out over the phone. Please notify the Division if your credentials have been compromised.

### **Timely Filing**

All reports filed must be completed and filed through the EFS not later than midnight of the due date. Reports not filed by midnight of the due date are late filed and subject to the penalties in Section 106.07(8), Florida Statutes. In the event that the EFS is inoperable on the due date, the report will be accepted as timely filed if filed no later than midnight of the first business day the EFS becomes operable. No fine will be levied during the period the EFS was inoperable.

Any candidate failing to file a report on the designated due date shall be subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first 3 days late and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

### **Electronic Receipts**

The person submitting the report on the EFS will be issued an electronic receipt indicating and verifying the report was filed. Each campaign treasurer's report filed by means of the EFS is considered to be under oath by the candidate and campaign treasurer and such persons are subject to the provisions of Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes.


