You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

After many attempts to correct it an attempt to contact the Division of Elections Office for assistance resulted in being unable to reach anyone due to the impacts of Hurricane Hermine on the entire Tallahassee area...I am not denying that an honest mistake was made through the confusion of the frequent weekly reporting periods and the addition of the special 1 day reporting period. There was no deception meant as I provided the information just in the wrong report. Due to the closure of the Offices because of the Hurricane leading to the delay of getting Staff assistance, the writing of the letter of explanation, and the follow-up phone call asking about the missing report a period of some 3 weeks elapsed before anything was fully corrected".

In response to a letter sent out on September 26, 2016 and received on Friday September 30th, 2016, We are requesting to appeal the assessed late fine in the amount of \$1,389.15 for the Report 2016-P7-63 for the period covering 08/13/2016 - 08/25/2016 and due on 08/26/2016.

The report in question was prepared on Friday 8/26/2016. However upon attempts to review an error was discovered showing that the report was trying to be filed in the 2016-P7-64 reporting period instead of the P7-63. After many attempts to correct it an attempt to contact the Division of Elections Office for assistance resulted in being unable to reach anyone due to the impacts of Hurricane Hermine on the entire Tallahassee area.

Having no other choice the report was left it as it was with the intentions of calling first thing Monday morning August 29th to seek help. The Division of Elections offices were still closed. On Tuesday August 30th 2016 a successful contact was made with the office and with the guidance of a Staff worker things were able to be straightened out, upon asking if this would affect the filing date a no answer was given but with the understanding that there would probably be a forthcoming letter asking for an explanation as to what had happened.

The letter arrived a few days later and again a call was made for assistance to get help on what kind of information would need to put into the letter. A letter of explanation was composed and mailed to the Division of Elections on September 15th, 2016.

I am not denying that an honest mistake was made through the confusion of the frequent weekly reporting periods and the addition of the special 1 day reporting period. There was no deception meant as I provided the information just in the wrong report. Due to the closure of the Offices because of the Hurricane leading to the delay of getting Staff assistance, the writing of the letter of explanation, and the follow-up phone call asking about the missing report a period of some 3 weeks elapsed before everything was fully corrected.

I am asking that with all that transpired in those days surrounding the Hurricane event, the Proposed Fine be eliminated or reduced to a minimal amount of no more than a 5 day fine. The oversight was most unfortunate but was in no way done because of laziness or an attempt to hide information.

A copy of this letter is also being sent by US Mail to the Florida Division of Elections.
