NOTICE OF HEARING (AUTOMATIC FINE)

A hearing will be held in this case before the Florida Elections Commission on, **May 14, 2019 at 8:30 am**, or *as soon thereafter as the parties can be heard*, at the following location: **Senate Office Building, 404 South Monroe Street, Room 110-S, Tallahassee, Florida 32399**. Due to heightened security access requirements, please bring only essential items into the building and plan to arrive early to allow for delays coming through security.

Failure to appear in accordance with this notice will constitute a waiver of your right to participate in the hearing. Continuances will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

This hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, which governs your participation as follows:

If you are the Respondent, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are the Complainant, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are an Appellant, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

Please refer to the information below for further instructions related to your particular hearing:

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

THIS MATTER was heard by the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) at its regularly scheduled meeting on February 26, 2019, in Tallahassee, Florida.


Respondent filed a Motion to Continue.

SUMMARY: Americans for Prosperity Action, Inc. is a political committee (PC) registered with the State of Florida. The PC's chair is Victor Bernson and its treasurer is Gary Casetllaw.

The PC is appealing the fine claiming that they were unable to file the report due to unusual circumstances beyond their control. According to Victor Bernson, the PC attempted to register and begin reporting to DOE on September 27th, however, the initial registration was not accepted due to an "unpublished requirement that the required registered agent must be a natural person, not a corporation".

Mr. Bernson states that due to office closures from Hurricane Michael their registration with the Division was delayed further and not approved until October 25th. During the time Mr. Bernson states that the PC made expenditures that needed to be reported and that DOE staff informed them that they should file the 2018 D1 report on November 2nd. He notes that DOE staff did not expressly mention that the PC would be subject to a fine when it submitted the report as instructed. He requests that the commission waive or reduce the fine due to these circumstances.

- The 2018 D1 Original Report covers the period from 10/20/18-10/26/18; it was due on 10/27/18.
- The 2018 D1 Queued Transaction Report shows that it was created and filed on 11/02/18.
- Americans for Prosperity Action, Inc. reported receiving zero contributions, while making 7 expenditures, all 7 of which were reported as having occurred prior to 10/20/18.
- The Division of Elections has two notes that pertain to Americans for Prosperity Action, Inc's 2018 D1 report. A phone call was noted on 10/26/18 and 11/02/18 regarding credentials.


On behalf of Americans for Prosperity Action (AFPA), I respectfully request a waiver or reduction of a proposed fine assessed due to the late filing of a campaign treasurer's report due on October 27, 2018 as contemplated by Fla. Adm. Code Rules 2B-1.005 & 2B-1.0055. As described in detail below, AFPA was unable to file this report due to unusual circumstances beyond its control followed by detrimental reliance on reporting guidance received directly from Division of Elections (DOE) staff.

AFPA attempted to register and begin reporting to DOE on September 27, 2018. DOE initially did not accept AFPA's registration because of an unpublished requirement that the required registered agent must be a natural person, not a corporation. Hurricane Michael then struck, shutting down DOE offices, and delaying AFPA's registration further. Due to these unanticipated and unforeseeable delays, DOE did not get around to approving AFPA's registration until October 25, 2018.

Between AFPA's initial registration filing on September 27, 2018 and final approval of the registration on October 25, 2018, AFPA made expenditures that needed to be reported. AFPA was in constant contact with DOE staff throughout this process in a good faith attempt to comply with Florida law. DOE staff ultimately informed AFPA that it should file the 2018 D1 on November 2, 2018 to report transactions from October 1, October 10, and October 15 because the DOE system would not permit earlier reporting of transactions that occurred prior to the final registration approval on October 25. DOE staff expressly did not mention that AFPA would be subject to a fine when it submitted the D1 form on November 2, as instructed.

Based on the foregoing unusual circumstances, AFPA believes the Commission should waive or reduce the late fine.

Dear Mr. Bernson:

Our records indicate that you have not filed either your campaign treasurer's report or notification that no reportable activity occurred, whichever is applicable. The filing date was October 27, 2018.

The law (s. 106.07(8)(b), Fla. Stat.) requires the filing officer to immediately notify you about the missed filing date and the automatic fines that will be assessed for late filing of a report, if a report was due.

- If reportable activity occurred and you have not filed a report, statutory fines are automatically assessed as follows until you file your report:
 - \$50 per day for the first 3 days late
 - \$500 per day for each day after the 3rd day late
 - If the required report immediately precedes a primary and general election, the automatic fine is \$500 for each late day.

The total fine for the untimely report cannot exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the cover period. Even if you end up filing your report late, we cannot waive the statutory fines. We will notify you of the specific amount of fines owed once you file your report. You have 20 days from the day you receive the notice to pay the fine or to appeal the fine to the Florida Elections Commission.

- If no reportable activity occurred for the report date(s), you are still required to notify us in writing, via the Division's Electronic Filing System, that no reportable activity occurred. No automatic fines are statutorily assessed.

However, in all cases, failure to file and/or untimely filing of a report of reportable activity, or if applicable, a notice that no reportable activity occurred, may constitute an apparent violation of chapter 106, Fla. Stat. If we refer such matter to the Florida Elections Commission, the Commission may subsequently impose a civil penalty for each violation under chapter 106.265(1), Fla. Stat.







However, for the reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

Electronic Receipts

The person submitting the report on the EFS will be issued an electronic receipt indicating and verifying the report was filed. Each campaign treasurer's report filed by means of the EFS is considered to be under oath by the chairperson and campaign treasurer and such persons are subject to the provisions of Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes.
