A hearing will be held in this case before the Florida Elections Commission on, **August 16, 2017 at 8:30 am,** or as soon thereafter as the parties can be heard, at the following location: **Senate Office Building, 404 South Monroe Street, Room 110-S, Tallahassee, Florida 32399**

Failure to appear in accordance with this notice will constitute a waiver of your right to participate in the hearing. Continuances will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

This hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, which governs your participation as follows:

If you are the Respondent, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have 5 minutes to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are the Complainant, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are an Appellant, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have 5 *minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing*. The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

SUMMARY: Local Home Builders PAC is a political committee (PC) registered with the State of Florida. The PC's chair is Ms. Suzanne Graham and its treasurer is Mr. Douglas Buck. The PC is being represented in this matter by Attorney Ronald Meyer.

The PC is appealing the fine claiming that unusual circumstances existed that caused the 2015 M6 Report to be untimely filed. According to Mr. Meyer, "In March, 2015, the Association made the decision to establish a separate political committee to assist its local affiliates in pursuing their election-related activities. Accordingly, on April 27, 2015, the then Director of Accounting, Angela Kalfas, filed paperwork with the Division to create the Local Home Builders PAC political committee. Regrettably, the documents filed were deemed "incomplete" by the Division. However, it was not until May 15, 2015, before the Division notified the Local Home Builders PAC of the deficiencies. In the meantime, the Florida Home Builders PAC, under the belief that the Local Home Builders PAC had been created properly, made a startup contribution in the amount of \$52,913.53 to the Local Home Builders PAC to establish it. The contribution was reported by the Florida Home Builders PAC as an expenditure on its 2015 M3 report. However, at the time the Local Home Builders PAC received the contribution, it was not able to report receipt of the contribution due to the fact that its paperwork had been deemed incomplete. It was not until June 25, 2015, that the Division assigned PINs and Passwords to the Local Home Builders PAC. At that time, the former Director of Accounting, apparently was of the belief that the contribution had been reported. However, although it had been reported by the Florida Home Builders PAC, it had not been reported by the Local Home Builders PAC. It wasn't until February 15, 2017, when an audit report was furnished to the Local Home Builders PAC disclosing a deficit, that it became known that the founding contribution had not been reported. The Association engaged its accountants to review all filings and when it was determined that the initial report had not been made, the accountants filed the missing report on March 2, 2017. The Association also terminated its former Director of Accounting as a result of the failure to make the report and moved compliance responsibilities to its accountants. We respectfully submit that the untimely filing of the report stemmed from unusual circumstances which warrant excusing or reducing the fine".

- The 2015 M6 Queued-Transactions Report reflects that this report was created on 7/6/15 at approximately 5:17 pm, before being filed on 7/6/15 at approximately 5:17 pm.
- In a 4/13/17 email with Kristi Reid-Bronson, FEC staff was informed, "The committee filed a notice of no activity (waiver) on 7/6/15. A waiver is not a report. On 3/2/17, the committee filed a report showing \$55,842.75 of activity. The fine is based on 25% of the activity".

Dear Commissioner Thomas:

In this proceeding, an automatic fine in the amount of \$13,960.69 has been imposed by letter dated March 9, 2017, for the failure of a report due on July 10, 2015, to have been timely Due to the extenuating and unusual circumstances, the Local Home Builders PAC respectfully requests that the fine be abated or reduced since it stems from a single mistake made by an Association employee in connection with the startup of a new political committee. A fine in the amount sought is extremely disproportionate to the single error which was made.

The Florida Homebuilders Association maintains a political committee for its electionrelated activities (the Florida Home Builders PAC). In March, 2015, the Association made the decision to establish a separate political committee to assist its local affiliates in pursuing their election-related activities. Accordingly, on April 27, 2015, the then Director of Accounting, Angela Kalfas, filed paperwork with the Division to create the Local Home Builders PAC political committee. Regrettably, the documents filed were deemed "incomplete" by the Division (attachment 1). However, it was not until May 15, 2015, before the Division notified the Local Home Builders PAC of the deficiencies (attachment 2).

In the meantime, the Florida Home Builders PAC, under the belief that the Local Home Builders PAC had been created properly, made a startup contribution in the amount of \$52,913.53 to the Local Home Builders PAC to establish it. The contribution was reported by

the Florida Home Builders PAC as an expenditure on its 2015 M3 report (attachment 3). However, at the time the Local Home Builders PAC received the contribution, it was not able to report receipt of the contribution due to the fact that its paperwork had been deemed incomplete. It was not until June 25, 2015, that the Division assigned PINs and Passwords to the Local Home Builders PAC (attachment 4).

At that time, the former Director of Accounting, apparently was of the belief that the contribution had been reported. However, although it had been reported by the Florida Home Builders PAC, it had not been reported by the Local Home Builders PAC.

It wasn't until February 15, 2017, when an audit report was furnished to the Local Home Builders PAC disclosing a deficit, that it became known that the founding contribution had not been reported (attachment 5). The Association engaged its accountants to review all filings and when it was determined that the initial report had not been made, the accountants filed the missing report on March 2, 2017. The Association also terminated its former Director of Accounting as a result of the failure to make the report and moved compliance responsibilities to its accountants.

We respectfully submit that the untimely filing of the report stemmed from unusual circumstances which warrant excusing or reducing the fine.

The delay of the Division in notifying the Local Home Builders PAC of the deficiencies in its original filing and the concomitant inability of the Local Home Builders PAC to access the Electronic Filing System added to the problem. Pursuant to Section 106.07(8)(b), Florida Statutes, "[u]pon determining a report is late, the filing officer shall immediately notify the candidate or chair of the political committee as to the failure to file a report by the designated due date and that a fine is being assessed for each late day" (underlining supplied for emphasis). The Division did not notify the committee of the late-filing of the July 10, 2015, report until February 15, 2017, when it sent the audit letter, not immediately, but nearly a year and a half after the report was due. As soon as practical after receipt of the audit letter and investigation of the cause of the deficit noted, the committee filed the missing report on March 2, 2017.

At a minimum, the amount of the fine being sought should reflect no more than \$6,150 which would be the amount for the 15 days which passed after the initial notice from the Division until the date the report was filed. However, given the overall circumstances, we submit that unusual circumstances warranting setting the entire fine aside are present. To be remembered is that the contribution to the Local Home Builders political committee was reported by its sister committee, the Florida Home Builders PAC. This is not a circumstance where any effort to conceal the transaction is present. Moreover, a committee must rely upon the

actions of the persons entrusted to oversee reporting to file reports. When it was discovered that its employee created the error, she was swiftly terminated and the mistake was corrected.

In sum, we respectfully request the Commission to take the overall circumstances into account and set aside the automatic fine which has been assessed. Alternatively, the fine should be reduced to a reasonable amount given the extenuating circumstances.



Credentials and Sign-ons

Below is the web address to access the EFS and the committee's user identification number. The enclosed sealed envelope contains the committee's initial password. Once you have logged in using the initial password, you will be immediately prompted to change it to a confidential signon. The chairperson, campaign treasurer, and deputy treasurers are responsible for protecting this password from disclosure and are responsible for all filings using these credentials, unless the Division is notified that your credentials have been compromised.

Pin Numbers

Pin numbers are confidential secure credentials that allow you to submit reports and update information. The enclosed sealed envelope provides a confidential pin number for the chairperson. By copy of this letter, a confidential pin number to access the EFS was sent to the treasurer.

Each political committee chairperson is required to provide the Division of Elections with confidential personal information that may be used to allow access in the event that the password is forgotten or lost. When you enter the campaign account screen, there will be a drop down box where you pick a question (such as What is your mother's maiden name?) and supply an answer. All passwords and answers to questions are stored as encrypted data and cannot be viewed by Division staff and given out over the phone. Please notify the Division if your credentials have been compromised.

Timely Filing

All reports must be completed and filed through the EFS no later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the due date. Reports not filed by midnight of the due date are late filed and subject to the penalties in Section 106.07(8), Florida Statutes. In the event that the EFS is inoperable on the due date, the report will be accepted as timely filed if filed no later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the first business day the EFS becomes operable. No fine will be levied during the period the EFS was inoperable.

Any political committee failing to file a report on the designated due date is subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first 3 days and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for the reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

Electronic Receipts

The person submitting the report on the EFS will be issued an electronic receipt indicating and verifying the report was filed. Each campaign treasurer's report filed by means of the EFS is considered to be under oath by the chairperson and campaign treasurer and such persons are subject to the provisions of Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes.


