If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failer or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. As you are aware, during the time period in question, most the State of Florida, particularly the east coast was under a hurricane warning/watch. Our Certified Public Accountant to prepare the report. During this particular period, we had closed our office earlier in the week, as did our accountant. In an effort to comply with the filing requirements, and not having any information at the time, the accountant filed a waiver. When requesting the subsequent week's activity, it was noted that three expenditures occurred in the prior week. Our accountant filed an amended report to properly report the three transactions".

- The 2016 G3 Report covers the time period from 9/24/16 through 9/30/16.
- The 2016 G3 Queued-Transactions Report reflects that this report was created on 10/7/16 at approximately 2:15 pm, before being filed on 10/7/16 at approximately 2:15 pm.²
- In a January 17, 2017 email with Kristi Reid-Bronson, FEC staff was informed, "The committee filed a notice of no activity (waiver) on 10/10/16. A waiver is not a report. On 10/14/16, the committee filed a report showing \$2000 of activity. The fine is based on 25% of the activity.

PRIOR CASES: This PC has been involved in one prior FEC investigation. A \$1500.00 consent order was agreed to in FEC 15-168 for an alleged violation of 106.07(7).
