A hearing will be held in this case before the Florida Elections Commission on, **August 16, 2017 at 8:30 am,** or as soon thereafter as the parties can be heard, at the following location: **Senate Office Building, 404 South Monroe Street, Room 110-S, Tallahassee, Florida 32399**

Failure to appear in accordance with this notice will constitute a waiver of your right to participate in the hearing. Continuances will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

This hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, which governs your participation as follows:

If you are the Respondent, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have 5 minutes to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are the Complainant, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are an Appellant, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have 5 *minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing*. The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

The PC is appealing the fine claiming that unusual circumstances existed that caused the 2016 M11 Report to be untimely filed. According to Mr. Meyer, "Floridians for Solar Choice (FSC) Treasurer, George Cavros, who resides in Florida, compiles and confirms monthly expenses and contributions prior to the filing of reports with the Division of Elections. Mr. Cavros utilizes an assistant, Lisa Petrosky, who resides in Tennessee, to perform the ministerial duty of electronically filing the required DOE reports for FSC. On Friday, December 9, 2016, Mr. Cavros compiled and confirmed all of FSC's expenses and, after discussing and providing them to Ms. Petrosky, it was understood that Ms. Petrosky would file the 2016 M11 report on Monday, December 12, 2016...Mr. Cavros was out of the office beginning on December 17th on an out-of-town holiday vacation. He did not return to the office until the second week of January. Unbeknownst to Mr. Cavros, Ms. Petrosky failed to file the 2016 M11 report on December 12, 2016, as expected. Letters that were mailed to Mr. Cavros and the FSC Chair, Tory Perfetti, to the FSC office address, arrived after December 16, 2016, hence Mr. Cavros did not see the letters until arriving back to the office in January. Ms. Petrosky has been struggling with migraines, as a result of an automobile accident in late 2014. She continues to see a neurologist on injuries related to the accident related to heahaches and pain. On December 9th, she left the office early with complications related to an ongoing migraine and sinus infection. Dear Commissioner Scott:

In this proceeding, an automatic fine in the amount of \$9,973.05 has been imposed by letter dated January 24, 2017, for the failure of a report due on December 12, 2016, to have been timely filed. There are unusual circumstances present which caused the report to be filed late. Therefore, the committee respectfully requests that the fine be set aside.

Floridians for Solar Choice (FSC) Treasurer, George Cavros, who resides in Florida, compiles and confirms monthly expenses and contributions prior to the filing of reports with the Division of Elections. Mr. Cavros utilizes an assistant, Lisa Petrosky, who resides in Tennessee, to perform the ministerial duty of electronically filing the required Division of Elections reports for FSC. On Friday, December 9, 2016, Mr. Cavros compiled and confirmed all of FSC's expenses and, after discussing and providing them to Ms. Petrosky, it was understood that Ms. Petrosky would file the 2016 M11 report on Monday, December 12, 2016.

A confluence of unusual subsequent events led to the late filing of the 2016 M11 report. Mr. Cavros was out of the office beginning on December 17th on an out-of-town holiday vacation. He did not return to the office until the second week of January. Unbeknownst to Mr. Cavros, Ms. Petrosky failed to file the 2016 M11 report on December 12, 2016, as expected. Letters that were mailed to Mr. Cavros and the FSC Chair, Tory Perfetti, to the FSC office address, arrived after December 16, 2016, hence Mr. Cavros did not see the letters until arriving back to the office in January.

She returned to the office late on Monday, December 12th still suffering from her conditions. During this time, she was attempting to work on bookkeeping duties for various entities. Ms. Petrosky believed that she had filed the M11 report, when in-fact she had not. Mr. Cavros also had no reason to believe the report had not been filed, as he did not receive actual notice nor was he informed of the problem by Ms. Petrosky who continued to believe she had filed the report as instructed. Ms. Petrosky only became aware that the report had not been filed when she attempted to file the M12 report. At that time, she immediately filed the M11 report as well as the M12 report.



Dear Mr. Cavros:

Our records indicate that you have not filed either your campaign treasurer's report or notification that no reportable activity occurred, whichever is applicable. The filing date was December 12, 2016.

The law (s. 106.07(8)(b), Fla. Stat.) requires the filing officer to immediately notify you about the missed filing date and the automatic fines that will be assessed for late filing of a report, if a report was due.

- If reportable activity occurred and you have not filed a report, statutory fines are automatically assessed as follows until you file your report:
 - \$50 for the first 3 days late
 - \$500 per day for each day after the 3rd day late
 - If the required report immediately precedes a primary and general election, the automatic fine is \$500 for each late day.

The total fine for the untimely report cannot exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the cover period. Even if you end up filing your report late, we cannot waive the statutory fines. We will notify you of the specific amount of fines owed once you file your report. You have 20 days from the day you receive the notice to pay the fine or to appeal the fine to the Florida Elections Commission.

• If no reportable activity occurred for the report date(s), you are still required to notify us in writing, via the Division's Electronic Filing System, that no reportable activity occurred. No automatic fines are statutorily assessed.

However, in all cases, failure to file and/or untimely filing of a report of reportable activity, or if applicable, a notice that no reportable activity occurred, may constitute an apparent violation of chapter 106, Fla. Stat. If we refer such matter to the Florida Elections Commission, the Commission may subsequently impose a civil penalty for each violation under chapter 106.265(1), Fla. Stat.

Pin Numbers

Pin numbers are confidential secure credentials that allow you to submit reports and update information. The enclosed sealed envelope provides a confidential pin number for the chairperson. By copy of this letter, a confidential pin number to access the EFS was sent to the treasurer.

Each political committee chairperson is required to provide the Division of Elections with confidential personal information that may be used to allow access in the event that the password is forgotten or lost. When you enter the campaign account screen, there will be a drop down box where you pick a question (such as What is your mother's maiden name?) and supply an answer. All passwords and answers to questions are stored as encrypted data and cannot be viewed by Division staff and given out over the phone. Please notify the Division if your credentials have been compromised.

Timely Filing

All reports must be completed and filed through the EFS no later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the due date. Reports not filed by midnight of the due date are late filed and subject to the penalties in Section 106.07(8), Florida Statutes. In the event that the EFS is inoperable on the due date, the report will be accepted as timely filed if filed no later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the first business day the EFS becomes operable. No fine will be levied during the period the EFS was inoperable.

Any political committee failing to file a report on the designated due date is subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first 3 days and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for the reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

Electronic Receipts

The person submitting the report on the EFS will be issued an electronic receipt indicating and verifying the report was filed. Each campaign treasurer's report filed by means of the EFS is considered to be under oath by the chairperson and campaign treasurer and such persons are subject to the provisions of Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes.
