If this is a hearing to consider an appeal from an automatic fine, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a probable cause hearing, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. 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## ORDER OF PROBABLE CAUSE

THIS MATTER was heard by the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) at its regularly scheduled meeting on November 28, 2017, in Tallahassee, Florida.

On August 3, 2017, Staff recommended to the Commission that there was probable cause to believe that the Florida Election Code was violated. The facts articulated in Staff's Recommendation are adopted by reference and incorporated herein. Based on the Complaint, Report of Investigation, Staff's Recommendation, and oral statements (if any) made at the probable cause hearing, the Commission finds that there is probable cause to charge Respondent with the following violation(s):

## Count 1:

On or about April 21, 2017, Tynisha R. Barnett violated Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, when she failed to timely file an addendum to the campaign's 2016 Termination Report within seven days after receiving notice from the Department of State, Division of Elections, that the report required amendment.

## NOTICE OF RIGHT TO A HEARING

As the Respondent, you may elect to resolve this case in several ways. First, you may elect to resolve this case by consent order where you and Commission staff agree to resolve the violation(s) and agree to the amount of the fine. The consent order is then presented to the Commission for its approval. To discuss a consent order, contact the FEC attorney identified in the Order of Probable Cause.

Second, you may request an informal hearing held before the Commission, if you do not dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. You have 30 days from the date the Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission to request such a hearing. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order. At the hearing, you will have the right to make written or oral arguments to the Commission concerning the legal issues related to the violation(s) and the potential fine. At the request of Respondent, the Commission will consider and determine willfulness at an informal hearing. Otherwise, live witness testimony is unnecessary.

Third, you may request a formal hearing held before an administrative law judge in the Division of Administrative Hearings (DOAH), if you dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. You have 30 days from the date the Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission to request such a hearing. The date this order was filed appears in the upper righthand corner of the first page of the order. At the hearing, you will have the right to present evidence relevant to the violation(s) listed in this order, to cross-examine opposing witnesses, to impeach

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## STAFF RECOMMENDATION FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(c), Florida Statutes, undersigned staff counsel files this written recommendation for disposition of the referral in this case recommending that there is probable cause to charge Respondent with violating Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes. Based upon a thorough review of the Report of Investigation. submitted on July 3, 2017, the following facts and law support this staff recommendation:

1. On May 8, 2017, the Florida Elections Commission ("Commission") received a referral from the Department of State, Division of Elections ("Division"), alleging that Tynisha R. Barnett ("Respondent") violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.
2. Respondent was the treasurer for Jacques Rene Gaillot, Jr., a 2016 candidate for State Representative, District 13. (ROI Exhibit 1) ${ }^{1}$
3. By letter dated June 12, 2017, the Executive Director notified Respondent that Commission staff would investigate the following statutory provision:

Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes: Respondent, treasurer for J.R. Gaillot, a 2016 candidate for the office of State Representative, failed to timely make necessary amendments to the campaign's 2016 termination report, as alleged in the complaint.
4. On May 20, 2016, Jacques Rene Gaillot, Jr., filed his Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Candidates form ("DS-DE 9") appointing Respondent as treasurer for his campaign. (ROI Exhibit 1)
5. By letter dated May 23, 2016, Kristi Reid Bronson, Chief, Bureau of Election Records, sent Mr. Gaillot a letter acknowledging that the Division had received his DS-DE 9 and that his name was placed on the 2016 active candidate list. (ROI Exhibit 8, page 1) A copy of the acknowledgment letter was sent to Respondent. (ROI Exhibit 8, page 3)
6. The acknowledgment letter advised Respondent that all candidates filing reports with the Division are required to use the electronic filing system ("EFS"), and provided Respondent with a user identification number and initial password to grant access to the EFS. (ROI Exhibit 8, page 1) The letter further advised Respondent that all of the Division's publications and reporting forms were available on its website and directed Respondent to print

[^0]out the Calendar of Reporting Dates as well as other relevant documents. (ROI Exhibit 8, page 3)
7. The campaign's 2016 Termination Report was due on November 28, 2016, and was filed on January 19, 2017. The report was incomplete when filed.
8. The Division sent three letters notifying Respondent that the campaign's report was incomplete and that Respondent was required to amend the report within 7 days of receipt of the notification. A Compliance Report showing why the report was incomplete was attached to each notification. (ROI Exhibits 2-4) The final notification was confirmed delivered. (ROI Exhibit 4, page 4) As of June 28, 2017, Respondent had not filed the required amendments to the campaign's report. (ROI Exhibit 7)
9. Respondent stated that Mr. Gaillot's father passed away in August 2016 and her communication with him was limited as he traveled out of the country to handle his father's funeral and estate. Respondent stated that she received the Division's notices regarding the incomplete report and told Mr. Gaillot that she needed him to gather all of the campaign's financial activity in order to be able to complete the report. (Attachment A) She also stated that she was delayed in amending the report because she had shredded all of the information she received from the Division, and had to contact the Division to request a new EFS PIN number. (Attachment B)
10. Mr. Gaillot stated that he was out of the country due to his father becoming ill and that he was in possession of the campaign's bank records. (Attachment B) Mr. Gaillot provided a death certificate showing that Jacques Rene Gaillot, Sr., passed away on August 17, 2016. (ROI Exhibit 6)
11. "Probable Cause" is defined as reasonable grounds of suspicion supported by circumstances sufficiently strong to warrant a cautious person in the belief that the person has committed the offense charged. Schmitt v. State, 590 So. 2d 404, 409 (Fla. 1991). Probable cause exists where the facts and circumstances, of which an [investigator] has reasonably trustworthy information, are sufficient in themselves for a reasonable man to reach the conclusion that an offense has been committed. Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles v. Favino, 667 So. 2d 305, 309 (Fla. 1st DCA 1995).
12. The facts set forth above show that Respondent was the treasurer for Jacques Rene Gaillot, Jr., a 2016 candidate for State Representative, District 13. Respondent failed to timely file the required amendment to the campaign's 2016 Termination Report within 7 days of receiving notification from the Division that the report was incomplete and required amendment.

Based upon these facts and circumstances, I recommend that the Commission find probable cause to charge Respondent with violating the following:

## Count 1:

On or about April 21, 2017, Tynisha R. Barnett violated Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, when she failed to timely file an addendum to the campaign's 2016 Termination Report within seven days after receiving notice from the Department of State, Division of Elections, that the report required amendment.

# FLORIDA ELECTIONS COMMISSION REPORT OF INVESTIGATION Case No.: FEC 17-191 

Respondent: Tynisha Barnett

Complainant: Division of Elections

Pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, on May 8, 2017, the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) received information from the Division of Elections alleging that Respondent violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes. Commission staff, therefore, investigated whether Respondent violated the following statute:

Section 106.07(2)(b)1, Florida Statutes, failure of the treasurer of a candidate to file an addendum to an incomplete report after receiving notice from the filing officer.

## I. Preliminary Information:

1. Respondent was the treasurer for J.R. Gailot, a 2016 candidate for the office of State Representative, District 13. Mr. Gailot filed his Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Candidates form (DS-DE 9) on May 20, 2016, naming Respondent as his campaign treasurer. To review the DS-DE 9, refer to Exhibit 1.
2. Complainant is the Division of Elections (Division).
3. Respondent's filing officer is Kristi Reid-Bronson, Chief, Bureau of Elections Records.

## II. Alleged Violation of Section 106.07(2)(b)1, Florida Statutes:

4. I investigated whether Respondent violated this section of the election laws by failing to file an amended 2016 termination report (TR) after receiving notice from the filing officer.
5. According to Complainant, Respondent was notified that the 2016 TR was incomplete; however, after receiving notice she did not file an amendment.
6. On January 24, 2017, the Division mailed a letter to Respondent. The letter reads, "The Division of Elections has determined that one or more campaign reports are incomplete...you have 7 days from receipt of this notice to file an amended report to correct errors or provide missing information." The letter included an error report that listed the specific deficiencies on the 2016 TR. To review the letter and error report, refer to Exhibit 2.
7. On March 21, 2017, the Division mailed a "Second Notice" to Respondent regarding the incomplete report. An error report was also included with the letter. To review the Second Notice and error report, refer to Exhibit 3.
8. On April 12, 2017, the Division mailed a 'Final Notice" to Respondent with delivery confirmation informing her that one or more campaign treasurer's reports were incomplete. An error report was also included with the letter. To review the Final Notice, error report and delivery confirmation, refer to Exhibit 4.
9. On June 26, 2017, I interviewed Respondent by telephone. She acknowledged that there was a delay in filing the amendment to the TR. She stated the candidate, Mr. Gailot, was out of the country and he had all of the bank records. She stated that the candidate handled everything, she just entered the information into the electronic filing system.
10. On June 26, 2017, I interviewed Mr. Gailot by telephone. He stated that it was his fault that the amended report was filed late. He stated that he had all the bank records. He stated that his father became ill; therefore, he was out of the country with his family and forgot about filing the report. He stated that his father eventually died and he has been struggling with his father's death. He stated that he is currently in grief counseling. Respondent provided a copy of his boarding pass and death certificate. To review the boarding pass and death certificate, refer to Exhibits 5 and 6, respectively.
11. According to an email from Ms. Bronson, Respondent filed an amended 2016 TR but the amended report did not correct the deficiencies. To review the email, refer to Exhibit 7.
12. No record of Respondent having previously violated this section of the election laws was found.

## IV. FEC History:

13. Respondent has no prior cases.

## Conclusion:

14. On July 3, 2017, I interviewed Respondent by telephone. I summarized the issues addressed in the Report of Investigation and asked her if she had any additional comments. She stated that she did not have any additional comments.
15. On May 23, 2016, Ms. Bronson mailed a letter to the candidate acknowledging that Respondent's name had been placed on the 2016 active candidate list. (The letter indicates that a copy of the letter was also sent to Respondent.) The letter reads,

It is your responsibility to read, understand, and follow the requirements of Florida's election laws. Therefore, please print a copy of the following documents: Chapters 104 and 106, Florida Statutes, Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook, Calendar of Reporting Dates, and Rule 1S-2.017, Florida Administrative Code.

## Credentials and Sign-ons

Below is the web address to access the EFS and your user identification number. The enclosed sealed envelope contains your initial password. Once you have logged in using the initial password, you will be immediately prompted to change it to a confidential sign-on. You, your campaign treasurer, and deputy treasurers are responsible for protecting this password from disclosure and are responsible for all filings using these credentials, unless the Division is notified that your credentials have been compromised.

## Pin Numbers

Pin numbers are confidential secure credentials that allow you to submit reports and update personal information. The enclosed sealed envelope contains confidential pin numbers for you. By copy of this letter, a confidential pin number to access the EFS was sent to your treasurer.

Each candidate is required to provide the Division of Elections with confidential personal information that may be used to allow access in the event this password is forgotten or lost. When you enter the campaign account screen, there will be a drop down box where you pick a question (such as What is your mother's maiden name?) and supply an answer. All passwords and answers to questions are stored as encrypted data and cannot be viewed by Division staff and given out over the phone. Please notify the Division if your credentials have been compromised.

## Timely Filing

All reports filed must be completed and filed through the EFS not later than midnight of the due date. Reports not filed by midnight of the due date are late filed and subject to the penalties in Section 106.07(8), Florida Statutes. In the event that the EFS is inoperable on the due date, the report will be accepted as timely filed if filed no later than midnight of the first business day the EFS becomes operable. No fine will be levied during the period the EFS was inoperable.

Any candidate failing to file a report on the designated due date shall be subject to a fine of $\$ 50$ per day for the first 3 days late and, thereafter, $\$ 500$ per day for each late day, not to exceed $25 \%$ of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be $\$ 500$ per day for each late day, not to exceed $25 \%$ of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

## Electronic Receipts

The person submitting the report on the EFS will be issued an electronic receipt indicating and verifying the report was filed. Each campaign treasurer's report filed by means of the EFS is considered to be under oath by the candidate and campaign treasurer and such persons are subject to the provisions of Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes.
