NOTICE OF HEARING (AUTOMATIC FINE)

A hearing will be held in this case before the Florida Elections Commission on **February 25, 2014, at 9:00 am, or as soon thereafter as the parties can be heard**, at the following location: **Senate Office Building, Room S-110, 404 South Monroe Street, Tallahassee, FL 32399.**

Failure to appear in accordance with this notice will constitute a waiver of your right to participate in the hearing. Continuances will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

This hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, which governs your participation as follows:

If you are the Respondent, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are the Complainant, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are an Appellant, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

Please refer to the information below for further instructions related to your particular hearing:

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

SUMMARY: William Robert Falik is a candidate for Circuit Judge, Circuit 8 Group 11 in the 2014 elections. William Falik is his own treasurer.

William Robert Falik is appealing the fine claiming that he uploaded the file and received a notice that the file was successful. According to William Robert Falik, after receiving the failure to file letter on October 17, 2013 he contacted the Division and spoke with Donna Brown. According to Mr. Falik, his report was rejected because he mistakenly chose that the loan he made to his campaign, which exceeded \$500, was a campaign contribution from him. He also states that by the close of business on October 17, 2013 the error had been corrected and the report filed. Mr. Falik also notes that he would have complied sooner if the letter he received was generated on October 11 and received on October 14. He states that his fine would have been \$150.00. Mr. Falik asks that the commission considers with lenity and that he rectified the misunderstanding the day he received notice.

- The 2013 Q3 report covers the time period of 9/16/13-9/30/13.
- The 2013 Q3 Queued transaction report shows that the file was created on 10/10/13 at approximately 7:30pm. A file was also uploaded on 10/10/13; however, the file was reviewed on 10/17/13 and submitted on 10/17/13 at 4:05pm.
- Reminder emails and letters are a courtesy and are not required by Statute.

Please allow this letter to serve as my notice of appeal of a fine imposed in the amount of \$2,150.00 resulting from a late filing of my campaign treasurer's report due October 10, 2013.

Pursuant to Florida Administrative Code 2B-1.005, I am providing the following information:

I understand that pursuant to Florida Administrative Code 2B-1.0052 my campaign treasurer's report was due by October 10, 2013. Although the rule speaks mainly to reports filed by mail, my understanding from the rule's intent is that my report would be timely so long as it was submitted with an October 10, 2013 date.

October 10, 2013 was the deadline for my first report. I had one transaction which was a loan from me to my campaign. I used the Electronic Filing System wherein I had to upload a text file that met certain parameters. To comply, I downloaded a program suggested by the Division of Elections as one that complies with the parameters. I entered my one transaction and saved the text file.

I uploaded the text file and received a notice on the computer screen that the file was successfully uploaded. I logged out.

On October 17, 2013, I received a letter from the Division of Elections that I had not

complied with my filing requirement. I contacted your office and received exceptional service from one of your representatives. She explained to me that although the program indicated the file was successfully uploaded, it was later rejected. The rejection came from my mistakenly choosing that the loan I made to my campaign which exceeded \$500.00 was a campaign contribution from me. By the close of business on October 17, 2013, I had corrected the error. Additionally, your representative walked me through an additional step in the submission process using the EFS. The report was now successfully filed.

Pursuant to Florida Administrative Code 2B-1.0055, I must show unusual circumstances existed. I rely on subsection 1(e) regarding unanticipated computer or equipment failure and that unusual circumstances are not limited to these subsections. The Commission should be able to see from the October 10, 2013 upload that the transactions were disclosed and were the correct amounts. The mistake came in the classification.

I understand that I made a mistake. However, the issue as to whether I filed my report on October 10, 2013 will turn on what it means to file. The rules specifically address deadlines as related to postmarks. Clearly these rules have become more specific in response to factual scenarios that have arisen. I am not aware of a rule addressing my situation.


The letter informing me that I had not complied was generated in your office on October 14, 2013. I received it on October 17, 2013 and complied on October 17, 2013. Had the letter been generated on October 11 and received on October 14, I would have complied on October 14. My fine in that case would have been \$150.00. Had your office not sent the letter until October 20, my fine would have been \$5,150.00.

I am fully aware now of the appropriate way to confirm that my text file is uploaded in the EFS. I am hoping that the Commission considers with lenity that I uploaded my text file on October 10, 2013, that I believed I had complied, and that I rectified my misunderstanding on the same day that I received notice.

I do want to thank your office for the assistance provided to me by your representative on October 17, 2013. Her name is Donna Brown.

Dear Mr Falik:

Your campaign treasurer's report, which was due October 10, 2013, has not been received

Section 106 07(8)(b), Florida Statutes, requires that the filing officer immediately notify you of the failure to file this report and that a fine will be assessed of \$50 per day for the first 3 days late and, thereafter \$500 per day, although a fine cannot exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for the reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

Once your report is filed, this office will notify you of the specific amount of your fine. Fines must be paid to the filing officer within 20 days of receipt of the payment due notice.

Please be advised, however, that failure to file a campaign treasurer's report may constitute a violation of Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, independent of the automatic fine violation referenced above. Therefore, if you fail to file a report, the division will turn the matter over to the Florida Elections Commission.

Section 106 265(1), Florida Statutes, authorizes the Florida Elections Commission to impose a civil penalty up to \$1,000 per count for each willful violation of Chapter 106.

Pin Numbers

Pin numbers are confidential secure credentials that allow you to submit reports and update personal information. The enclosed sealed envelope contains your confidential pin numbers.

Each candidate is required to provide the Division of Elections with confidential personal information that may be used to allow access in the event this password is forgotten or lost. When you enter the campaign account screen, there will be a drop down box where you pick a question (such as *What is your mother's maiden name?*) and supply an answer. All passwords and answers to questions are stored as encrypted data and cannot be viewed by Division staff and given out over the phone. Please notify the Division if your credentials have been compromised.

Timely Filing

All reports filed must be completed and filed through the EFS not later than midnight of the due date. Reports not filed by midnight of the due date are late filed and subject to the penalties in Section 106.07(8), Florida Statutes. In the event that the EFS is inoperable on the due date, the report will be accepted as timely filed if filed no later than midnight of the first business day the EFS becomes operable. No fine will be levied during the period the EFS was inoperable.

Any candidate failing to file a report on the designated due date shall be subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first 3 days late and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

Electronic Receipts

The person submitting the report on the EFS will be issued an electronic receipt indicating and verifying the report was filed. Each campaign treasurer's report filed by means of the EFS is considered to be under oath by the candidate and campaign treasurer and such persons are subject to the provisions of Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes.
