Please refer to the information below for further instructions related to your particular hearing:

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

Notice is hereby given that LANELL WILLIAMS-YULEE, Prior-Candidate for Circuit Court Judge, 13th Judicial Circuit, Group 24 in the above-styled cause hereby files a Motion for Reconsideration/Rehearing of the fine accessed based on a late filing of a campaign treasurer report and states as follows as the basis of this appeal:

- On or about July 5, 2016 Williams-Yulee and her campaign treasurer received a letter via U.S. mail from the Florida Divisions of Elections that the pursuant to section 106.07 (8) (b), Florida Statutes that the filing officer shall immediately notify the candidate of a missed filing date and the automatic fines assessed thereto.
- 2. On July 17, 2016, Williams-Yulee and her campaign treasurer received a second letter dated July 11, 2016 from the Florida Division of Elections which indicated that the report in question was due July 1, 2016 but was filed on July 10, 2016 and that an automatic late fine was assessed in the sum of \$ 800.00
- 3. On July 26, 2016 Ms. Williams-Yulee filed a timely appeal to the fine with the Florida Elections Commission based on unusual circumstances. To wit: Ms. Williams-Yulee's sister was hospitalized in Pensacola, Florida and underwent a medically necessary surgical procedure, during the time in which the July 2016 filing was due, Williams-Yulee was out of the jurisdiction and present at the hospital for and during the medically- necessary surgical procedure.
- 4. An Order was entered by the Florida Elections Commission on November 16, 2016, affirming the fine in the sum of \$ 800.00.

- 5. Williams-Yulee, filed a timely appeal to the 1st DCA, alleging that the fine was erroneously entered. The basis of this appeal is premised on Rule 2B-1.0055 Late -filed Report Unusual Circumstances. Specifically, 2B-1.0055 (d) which addresses issues of serious illness, disability, or non-elective surgery of the candidate's or the campaign Treasurer's immediate family member, which prevented the timely filing of the report in question.
- 6. Furthermore, Williams-Yulee is designated as Josycln Williams (her sister's) health care agent and was required to travel from Tampa, Florida to Pensacola, Florida carry out her duties as Ms. Williams' health care agent such as providing consent as to all medical and surgical procedures.
- 7. To substantiate these facts of unusual circumstances pursuant to Rule 2B-1.0055, Williams-Yulee submitted a letter signed by treating physician for her sister titled "Verification of Family Member Attendance for Surgical Procedure and Appointment of Medical Care Agent.". (previously submitted)

Pursuant to conversation on January 5, 2017 with Amy Tomlin, Assistant General Counsel for Florida Elections Commission, this Motion is filed in lieu of continuing the pursuit of an appeal with the 1st DCA, to resolve the matter internally. Williams-Yulee will file a voluntary dismissal of the current appeal, preserving her right to appeal future rulings in this matter, if necessary.



Our records indicate that you have not filed either your campaign treasurer's report or notification that no reportable activity occurred, whichever is applicable. The filing date was July 1, 2016.

The law (s. 106.07(8)(b), Fla. Stat.) requires the filing officer to immediately notify you about the missed filing date and the automatic fines that will be assessed for late filing of a report, if a report was due.

- If reportable activity occurred and you have not filed a report, statutory fines are automatically assessed as follows until you file your report:
 - * \$50 for the first 3 days late
 - * \$500 per day for each day after the 3rd day late
 - If the required report immediately precedes a primary and general election, the automatic fine is \$500 for each late day.

The total fine for the untimely report cannot exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the cover period. Even if you end up filing your report late, we cannot waive the statutory fines. We will notify you of the specific amount of fines owed once you file your report. • If no reportable activity occurred for the report date(s), you are still required to notify us in writing, via the Division's Electronic Filing System, that no reportable activity occurred. No automatic fines are statutorily assessed.

However, in all cases, failure to file and/or untimely filing of a report of reportable activity, or if applicable, a notice that no reportable activity occurred, may constitute an apparent violation of chapter 106, Fla. Stat. If we refer such matter to the Florida Elections Commission, the Commission may subsequently impose a civil penalty for each violation under chapter 106.265(1), Fla. Stat.
