If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

CONSENT ORDER

Respondent, Stacey Werling, and the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) agree that this Consent Order resolves all of the issues between the parties in this case. The parties jointly stipulate to the following facts, conclusions of law, and order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On October 3, 2016, the staff of the Commission issued a Staff Recommendation, recommending to the Commission that there was probable cause to believe that Respondent violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.
- 2. On November 16, 2016, the Commission voted to find that there was probable cause to charge the Respondent with the following violations:

Count 1:

On or about December 20, 2015, Respondent violated Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, when the Respondent failed to file an addendum to Emmanuel G. Morel's 2015 M10 Report correcting the errors identified by the Division of Elections within seven days of receiving notice from the filing officer that the Report was incomplete.

- 3. Respondent expressed a desire to enter into negotiations directed toward reaching a consent agreement.
 - 4. Respondent and staff stipulate to the following facts:
 - Α. Respondent was the treasurer for Emmanuel G. Morel, a 2016 candidate for the office of State Senate, District 27.
 - В. Respondent filed the campaign's 2015 M10 treasurer's report, but the report was incomplete.
 - $\mathbf{C}_{\cdot \cdot}$ Respondent was notified by the Division of Elections that the report was incomplete and that Respondent had seven days to correct the errors and file an amended report.
 - D. Respondent failed to file an amended 2015 M10 treasurer's report correcting the errors identified by the Division of Elections within seven days of receiving notice from the filing officer that the report was incomplete.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 5. The Commission has jurisdiction over the parties to and subject matter of this cause, pursuant to Section 106.26, Florida Statutes.
- 6. The Commission staff and the Respondent stipulate that although the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause may not have been knowingly committed all elements of the violations can be proven by clear and convincing evidence.

ORDER

- 7. Respondent and the staff of the Commission have entered into this Consent Order voluntarily and upon advice of counsel.
- 8. Respondent shall bear her own attorney's fees and costs that are in anyway associated with this case.
 - 9. The Commission will consider the Consent Order at its next available meeting.
- 10. Respondent voluntarily waives the right to any further proceedings under Chapters 104, 106, and 120, Florida Statutes, and the right to appeal the Consent Order.

- 11. This Consent Order is enforceable under Sections 106.265 and 120.69, Florida Statutes. Respondent expressly waives any venue privileges and agrees that if enforcement of this Consent Order is necessary, venue shall be in Leon County, Florida, and Respondent shall be responsible for all fees and costs associated with enforcement.
- 12. If the Commission does not receive the signed Consent Order and the penalty by December 13, 2016, the staff withdraws this offer of settlement and will proceed with the case.
- 13. Payment of the civil penalty by cashier's check, or money order, good for at least 120 days, or attorney trust account check, is a condition precedent to the Commission's consideration of the Consent Order.

PENALTY

WHEREFORE, based upon the foregoing facts and conclusions of law, the Commission finds that the Respondent has violated the following provisions of Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, and imposes the following fines:

Respondent has violated Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, on 1 A. occasion for failing to file an addendum to Emmanuel G. Morel's 2015 M10 Report correcting the errors identified by the Division of Elections within seven days of receiving notice from the filing officer that the Report was incomplete. Therefore it is

ORDERED that the Respondent shall remit to the Commission a civil penalty in the amount of \$100.00, inclusive of fees and costs. The civil penalty shall be paid cashier's check or money order, good for at least 120 days, or attorney trust account check. The civil penalty shall be payable to the Florida Elections Commission, 107 West Gaines Street, Collins Building, Suite 224, Tallahassee, Florida, 32399-1050.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(c), Florida Statutes, undersigned counsel files this written recommendation for disposition of the referral in this case recommending that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating **Section 106.07(2)(b)1.**, **Florida Statutes**. Based upon a thorough review of the Report of Investigation submitted on September 16, 2016, the following facts and law support this staff recommendation:

- 1. On January 27, 2016, the Florida Elections Commission ("Commission") received a referral from the Division of Elections ("Division") alleging Stacey Werling ("Respondent") violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.
- 2. Respondent was the treasurer for Emmanuel Morel, a candidate for the Florida Senate, District 27, in the 2016 election. An Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Candidates form ("DS-DE 9") appointing Respondent as Mr. Morel's treasurer was filed with the Division on August 17, 2015. (ROI Exhibit 2)²
- 3. By letter dated August 10, 2016, the Executive Director notified Respondent that Commission staff would investigate the following statutory provision:

Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes: Respondent is the treasurer for Emmanuel G. Morel, a 2016 candidate for the office of State Senate, District 27. Respondent failed to timely make necessary amendments to the campaign's 2015 M10 treasurer's report, as alleged in the complaint.

4. By letter dated August 20, 2015, Kristi Reid Bronson, Division of Elections, Chief, Bureau of Election Records, notified Respondent her appointment as treasurer for Mr. Morel was filed with the Division on August 17, 2015. The letter also contained a security envelope with Respondent's confidential PIN number to access the Division's electronic filing system. (ROI Exhibit 3)

On May 9, 2016, Mr. Morel filed a DS-DE 9 with the Division redesignating the office for which he was running to State Senate, District 31. Mr. Morel was defeated in the August 30, 2016 primary election for that seat. (Attachment A)

The Report of Investigation shall be referred to herein as "ROI."

- 5. Ms. Bronson's August 20, 2015 letter also informed Respondent that all the Division's publications and reporting forms were available on the Division's website, including Chapters 104 and 106, Florida Statutes, the *Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook* and the *Calendar of Reporting Dates*. (Id.)
- 6. The 2015 M10 Report covering the dates of October 1, 2015, through October 31, 2015, was due on November 10, 2015. Respondent timely filed Mr. Morel's 2015 M10 Report; however, it was incomplete. (ROI Exhibit 1, page 1; ROI Exhibit 8, page 2; and Attachment B)
- 7. On November 13, 2015, and November 30, 2015, the Division sent Respondent a letter notifying her that Mr. Morel's 2015 M10 Report was incomplete and Respondent had seven days to correct the errors in the attached Error Report and file an amended 2015 M10 Report. The Division's November 13, 2015 letter stated if the information was reported accurately, Respondent should provide a written explanation to the Division addressing the issues noted in the Error Report. (ROI Exhibits 4 and Exhibit 5)³
- 8. On December 11, 2015, the Division sent Respondent a letter marked Final Notice notifying Respondent that Mr. Morel's 2015 M10 Report remained incomplete and Respondent had seven days to correct the errors in the attached Error Report and file an amended 2015 M10 Report. The letter also stated if the information was reported accurately, Respondent should provide a written explanation to the Division addressing the issues noted in the Error Report. The December 11, 2015 letter was confirmed delivered on December 13, 2015. (ROI Exhibit 6)
- 9. On March 5, 2016, Respondent filed Mr. Morel's amended 2015 M10 Report correcting the errors identified by the Division. (Attachment C)
- 10. Based upon the information above, it appears Respondent failed to file Mr. Morel's amended 2015 M10 Report correcting the errors identified by the Division within seven days of receiving notice from the filing officer the report was incomplete.
- 11. "Probable Cause" is defined as a reasonable grounds of suspicion supported by circumstances sufficiently strong to warrant a cautious person in the belief that the person has committed the offense charged. Schmitt v. State, 590 So.2d 404, 409 (Fla. 1991). Probable cause exists where the facts and circumstances, of which an [investigator] has reasonably trustworthy information, are sufficient in themselves for a reasonable man to reach the conclusion that an offense has been committed. Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles v. Favino, 667 So.2d 305, 309 (Fla. 1st DCA 1995).

Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Fla. Stat. does not require a campaign treasurer to provide a written explanation to the Division addressing the issues noted in the Error Report if the information listed in the error report was properly reported.

12. The above facts show Respondent was the treasurer for Emmanuel Morel, a candidate for the Florida Senate in the 2016 election. Mr. Morel's 2015 M10 Report was timely filed; however, it was incomplete. The Division sent letters on November 13, 2015, November 30, 2015, and December 11, 2015, notifying Respondent the Report was incomplete and Respondent had seven days from receipt of the letter to correct the errors and file an amended 2015 M10 Report. Respondent filed an amended 2015 M10 Report on March 5, 2016, 76 days after she received notification from the filing officer the Report was incomplete.

Based upon these facts and circumstances, I recommend that the Commission find probable cause to charge Respondent with the following:

Count 1:

On or about December 20, 2015, Respondent violated Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, when Respondent failed to file an addendum to Emmanuel G. Morel's 2015 M10 Report within seven days of receiving notice from the filing officer the Report was incomplete.



On January 27, 2016, the Florida Elections Commission ("Commission") received a sworn complaint alleging that Respondent violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes. Commission staff investigated whether Respondent violated the following statute:

Section 106.07(2)(b)1, Florida Statutes, failure of the treasurer of a candidate to file an addendum to an incomplete report after receiving notice from the filing officer.

I. Preliminary Information:

- 1. Respondent served as the Campaign Treasurer for her father, Emmanuel Morel's, 2016 election campaign for State Senator. Mr. Morel lost his election bid. This was Respondent's first time serving as a Campaign Treasurer.
 - 2. Complainant is the Division of Elections.
- 3. Respondent's filing officer is Kristi Reid-Bronson, Chief, Bureau of Election Records.

II. Alleged Violation of Section 106.07(2)(b)1, Florida Statutes:

- 4. I investigated whether Respondent violated this section of the election laws by not filing an addendum to the 2015 M10 Report, after receiving notice that it was incomplete.
- 5. A DOE staff representative, Kristi Reid-Bronson, submitted a sworn affidavit dated January 26, 2016 regarding Respondent's failure to file addendums to the 2015 M10 Report. To view a copy of the January 26, 2016 sworn affidavit, refer to exhibit 1.
- 6. On August 17, 2015, the Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository form (DS-DE 9) was filed with Respondent's filing officer. Respondent was appointed as the campaign treasurer for Emmanuel Morel's election campaign. To view a copy of Respondent's DS-DE 9 form, refer to exhibit 2.
- 7. On August 20, 2015, Complainant mailed Respondent a letter acknowledging receipt of the DS-DE 9 form. This letter also advised Respondent of her confidential pin number to access the Division's Electronic Filing System (EFS) for submitting campaign treasurer's

reports. To view a copy of the August 20, 2015 acknowledgement letter, refer to exhibit 3.

- 8. On November 13, 2015, Complainant mailed Respondent a letter informing her that the 2015 M10 Report was incomplete. Complainant attached a list of errors to this letter that specifically stated the errors that required amending. This letter was sent to the address Respondent provided on the DS-DE 9 form (Exhibit 2). To view a copy of the November 13, 2015 incomplete-report letter, refer to exhibit 4.
- 9. On November 30, 2015, Complainant mailed Respondent a second letter informing her that the 2015 M10 Report remained incomplete. Complainant attached a list of errors to this letter that specifically stated the errors that required amending. This letter was also sent to the address Respondent provided on the DS-DE 9 form (Exhibit 2). To view a copy of the November 30, 2015 incomplete-report letter, refer to exhibit 5.
- 10. On December 11, 2015, Complainant mailed Respondent a certified letter titled "Final Notice" informing her that the 2015 M10 Report remained incomplete. Complainant included a list of errors with this letter that specifically stated what required amending. This letter was also sent to the address Respondent provided on the DS-DE 9 form (Exhibit 2). This letter included a delivery confirmation receipt. To view a copy of the December 11, 2015 "Final Notice" with delivery confirmation receipt, refer to exhibit 6.
- 11. On March 6, 2016, DOE records reflect that an amended 2015 M10 Report was filed with Respondent's filing officer. To review a copy of Respondent's 2015 M10 Report, refer to exhibit 7. To view a copy of Respondent's filing history, refer to exhibit 8.
- 12. On September 16, 2016, FEC staff made contact via email with DOE representative, Ms. Kristi Reid-Bronson, to inquire about the status of the 2015 M10 Report. Ms. Bronson advised FEC staff that this report is now considered complete. To review the September 16, 2016 email communication, refer to exhibit 9.
- 13. There is a record that Respondent has previously violated this section of the election laws.

IV. FEC History:

14. Respondent has been involved in one prior investigation. In FEC 15-436; Respondent agreed to a minor-violation consent order with a civil penalty in the amount of \$375.00 for an alleged violation of 106.07(2)(b)1; the civil penalty was paid on April 4, 2016.

Conclusion:

- 15. Respondent was offered several opportunities to make comments regarding the findings of this investigation. Respondent did not respond to any of these attempts.
- 16. In the August 20, 2015 acknowledgement letter, Respondent was informed that all of the Division's publications were available online at DOE's website. In the letter, Respondent was admonished as follows: "It is your responsibility to read, understand, and follow the requirements of Florida's election laws. Therefore, please print a copy of the following







Dear Ms. Werling:

On January 27, 2016, the Florida Elections Commission received a complaint alleging that you violated Florida's election laws. I have reviewed the complaint and find that it contains one or more legally sufficient allegations. The Commission staff will investigate the following alleged violation:

Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes: Respondent is the treasurer for Emmanuel G. Morel, a 2016 candidate for the office of State Senate, District 27. Respondent failed to timely make necessary amendments to the campaign's 2015 M10 treasurer's report, as alleged in the complaint.

You may respond to the allegation above by filing a notarized statement providing any information regarding the facts and circumstances surrounding the allegation. Your response will be included as an attachment to the investigator's report.

When we conclude the investigation, a copy of the Report of Investigation will be mailed to you at the above address. You may file a response to the report within 14 days from the date the report is mailed to you. Based on the results of the investigation, legal staff will make a written recommendation to the Commission on whether there is probable cause to believe you have violated Chapter 104 or 106, Florida Statutes. A copy of the Staff Recommendation will be mailed to you and you may file a response within 14 days from the date the recommendation is mailed to you. Your timely filed response(s) will be considered by the Commission when determining probable cause.

The Commission will then hold a hearing to determine whether there is probable cause to believe you have violated Chapters 104 or 106, Florida Statutes. You and the complainant will receive a notice of hearing at least 14 days before the hearing. The notice of hearing will indicate the location, date, and time of your hearing. You will have the opportunity to make a brief oral

statement to the Commission, but you will not be permitted to testify or call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence.

At any time before a probable cause finding, you may notify us in writing that you want to enter into negotiations directed towards reaching a settlement via consent agreement.

The Report of Investigation, Staff Recommendation, and Notice of Hearing will be mailed to the above address as this letter. Therefore, if your address changes, you must notify this office of your new address. Otherwise, you may not receive these important documents. Failure to receive the documents will not delay the probable cause hearing.

Under section 106.25, Florida Statutes, complaints, Commission investigations, investigative reports, and other documents relating to an alleged violation of Chapters 104 and 106, Florida Statutes, are confidential until the Commission finds probable cause or no probable cause. The confidentiality provision does not apply to the person filing the complaint. However, it does apply to you unless you waive confidentiality in writing. The confidentiality provision does not preclude you from seeking legal counsel. However, if you retain counsel, your attorney must file a notice of appearance with the Commission before any member of the Commission staff can discuss this case with him or her.



Campaign Treasurer's Reports

Your first campaign treasurer's report will be due on May 11, 2015. The report will cover the period of April 1-30, 2015 (M4). All candidates who file reports with the Division of Elections are required to file by means of the Division's Electronic Filing System (EFS).

Credentials and Sign-ons

Below is the web address to access the EFS and your user identification number. The enclosed sealed envelope contains your initial password. Once you have logged in using the initial password, you will be immediately prompted to change it to a confidential sign-on. You, your campaign treasurer, and deputy treasurers are responsible for protecting this password from disclosure and are responsible for all filings using these credentials, unless the Division is notified that your credentials have been compromised.

Pin Numbers

Pin numbers are confidential secure credentials that allow you to submit reports and update personal information. The enclosed sealed envelope contains a confidential pin number for you. By copy of this letter, a confidential pin number to access the EFS was sent to your treasurer.

Each candidate is required to provide the Division of Elections with confidential personal information that may be used to allow access in the event this password is forgotten or lost. When you enter the campaign account screen, there will be a drop down box where you pick a question (such as What is your mother's maiden name?) and supply an answer. All passwords and answers to questions are stored as encrypted data and cannot be viewed by Division staff and given out over the phone. Please notify the Division if your credentials have been compromised.

Timely Filing

All reports filed must be completed and filed through the EFS no later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the due date. Reports not filed by midnight of the due date are late filed and subject to the penalties in Section 106.07(8), Florida Statutes. In the event that the EFS is inoperable on the due date, the report will be accepted as timely filed if filed no later than midnight of the first business day the EFS becomes operable. No fine will be levied during the period the EFS was inoperable.

Any candidate failing to file a report on the designated due date shall be subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first 3 days late and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

Electronic Receipts

The person submitting the report on the EFS will be issued an electronic receipt indicating and verifying the report was filed. Each campaign treasurer's report filed by means of the EFS is considered to be under oath by the candidate and campaign treasurer and such persons are subject to the provisions of Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes.


