ORDER OF PROBABLE CAUSE

THIS MATTER was heard by the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) at its regularly scheduled meeting on February 26, 2019, in Tallahassee, Florida.

On January 17, 2019, Staff recommended to the Commission that there was probable cause to believe that the Florida Election Code was violated. The facts articulated in Staff's Recommendation are adopted by reference and incorporated herein. Based on the Complaint, Report of Investigation, Staff's Recommendation, and oral statements (if any) made at the probable cause hearing, the Commission finds that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with the following violations:

Count 1:

On or about February 6, 2017, Respondent violated Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes, when Respondent failed to file her 2016 Termination Report reflecting the disposition of all remaining campaign funds.

Count 2:

On or about February 6, 2017, Respondent violated Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, when Respondent failed to include information on her 2016 Termination Report required to be reported by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, when she failed to file her 2016 Termination Report.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO A HEARING

As the Respondent, you may elect to resolve this case in several ways. First, you may elect to resolve this case by <u>consent order</u> where you and Commission staff agree to resolve the violation(s) and agree to the amount of the fine. The consent order is then presented to the Commission for its approval. To discuss a consent order, contact the FEC attorney identified in the Order of Probable Cause.

Second, you may request an <u>informal hearing</u> held before the Commission, if you <u>do not</u> dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. You have 30 days from the date the Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission to request such a hearing. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order. At the hearing, you will have the right to make written or oral arguments to the Commission concerning the legal issues related to the violation(s) and the potential fine. At the request of Respondent, the Commission will consider and determine willfulness at an informal hearing. Otherwise, live witness testimony is unnecessary.

Third, you may request a <u>formal hearing</u> held before an administrative law judge in the Division of Administrative Hearings (DOAH), if you dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. After the campaign was over, I was working under some extreme hostile circumstances that no one should ever endure. It was quite traumatic. This lead to my termination of employment and then later settled in a legal matter that I am legally not allowed to discuss.

During this turmoil I realized that my termination report was past due. I honestly just did not know how to rectify it as I was no longer employed and had late fees to pay.

I tried to work with the Commissions office this past fall to settle but I have not been gainfully employed. I'm still willing to do so and I'm willing to submit my final termination report.

I'm not making excuses other than what I was enduring at that time; was sincere severe conditions.

I'll accept whatever actions the Commission takes and I will rectify the problem as quickly as I can.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(c), Florida Statutes, undersigned staff counsel files this written recommendation for disposition of the complaint in this case recommending that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating **Sections 106.141(1) and 106.19(1)(c)**, **Florida Statutes.** Based upon a thorough review of the Report of Investigation submitted on January 8, 2019, the following facts and law support this staff recommendation.

- 1. On March 2, 2017, the Florida Elections Commission ("Commission") received a complaint from Susan Bucher, the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections, ("Complainant") alleging that Michelle Damone ("Respondent") violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.
- 2. Respondent was a candidate for the Indian Trail Improvement District ("ITID"), Seat 4, in the 2016 election. Complainant was Respondent's filing officer. Respondent's Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Candidates form was filed with the Palm Beach Supervisor of Elections office ("PBSOE") on June 23, 2016. (ROI Exhibit 1)¹
- 3. On July 25, 2018, the Executive Director sent Respondent notification that Commission staff would investigate the following sections of law:

Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2016 candidate for re-election to the Indian Trail Improvement District (ITID), failed to timely file a termination report reflecting the disposition of all remaining campaign funds.

Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes Respondent, a 2016 candidate for re-election to the Indian Trail Improvement District (ITID), falsely reported or deliberately failed to include information in one or more campaign treasurer reports, as required by Chapter 106.²

¹ The Report of Investigation shall be referred to herein as "ROI."

² The Report of Investigation focuses on Respondent's 2016 Termination Report.

4. On June 23, 2016, Respondent acknowledged that she received written notice that The Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook ("Handbook"), published by the Division of Elections, a Compilation of Elections laws, and other documents for use during her campaign were available on the Division of Elections website: dos.myflorida.com/elections. (ROI Exhibit 7)

Sections 106.141(1) and 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes.

- 7. Complainant alleged that Respondent failed to file her Termination Report ("TR") reflecting the disposition of all remaining campaign funds within 90 days of being defeated, and that Respondent falsely reported or deliberately failed to include information required to be reported on her TR.
- 8. Respondent's 2016 TR reflecting the disposition of all remaining funds on deposit in her campaign account was due by February 6, 2017. On January 30, 2017, Alexia Goods, from the PBSOE, sent Respondent an email reminder that her 2016 TR was due on February 6, 2017. However, Respondent failed to timely file her 2016 TR on the due date. (ROI Exhibit 2, ROI Exhibit 3; ROI Exhibit 6; and Attachment A)³
- 9. In a September 4, 2018 affidavit, Respondent stated that she owned and read a copy of Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, and she owned and read a copy of the Handbook which she first received around 2008. (ROI Exhibit 6)
- 10. Respondent also stated in her affidavit that she began a new job in 2016 and was working an average of 12 hours a day. Respondent stated that when she submitted previous reports late, she received a fine. Respondent forgot to submit her 2016 TR and when Respondent realized she had not filed the report, Respondent presumed she would receive a late fine and she did not know how to proceed. Respondent also promised she would rectify the situation and file her 2016 TR. However, as of January 7, 2019, Respondent has failed to file her 2016 TR. (ROI Exhibits 6 and Attachment A)
- 11. "Probable Cause" is defined as a reasonable ground of suspicion supported by circumstances sufficiently strong to warrant a cautious person in the belief that the person has committed the offense charged. Schmitt v. State, 590 So.2d 404, 409 (Fla. 1991). Probable cause exists where the facts and circumstances, of which an [investigator] has reasonably trustworthy information, are sufficient in themselves for a reasonable man to reach the conclusion that an offense has been committed. Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles v. Favino, 667 So.2d 305, 309 (Fla. 1st DCA 1995).

³ On February 14, 2017, Ms. Goods sent Respondent an email notification that her 2016 TR was past due. (ROI Exhibit 3)

12. The above facts show Respondent was an unsuccessful candidate for the Indian Trail Improvement District, Seat 4, in the 2016 general election. Respondent's filing officer was the Palm Beach Supervisor of Elections. Despite receiving an email reminder on January 30, 2017 from the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Election's office that her 2016 Termination Report was due on February 6, 2017, and a February 14, 2017 email notification that her 2016 Termination Report had not been filed, as of January 7, 2019, Respondent has failed to file her 2016 Termination Report.

Based on the foregoing, I recommend the Commission find probable cause to charge Respondent with the following violations:

Count 1:

On or about February 6, 2017, Respondent violated Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes, when Respondent failed to file her 2016 Termination Report reflecting the disposition of all remaining campaign funds.

Count 2:

On or about February 6, 2017, Respondent violated Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, when Respondent failed to include information on her 2016 Termination Report required to be reported by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, when she failed to file her 2016 Termination Report.

On March 2, 2017, the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) received a sworn complaint alleging that Respondent violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes. Commission staff investigated whether Respondent violated the following statutes:

Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes, failure of a candidate to dispose of funds remaining in her campaign account within 90 days after she withdrew, became unopposed, was eliminated, or elected and to file a report reflecting the disposition of all remaining funds; and

Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, prohibiting a person or organization from falsely reporting or deliberately failing to report information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.

I. Preliminary Information:

- 1. Respondent, Michelle Damone, was a 2016 candidate for re-election to the Indian Trail Improvement District (ITID) Board of Supervisors, Seat 4; she was defeated in the election held on November 8, 2016. Respondent was initially elected to office in 2008.
- 2. On June 23, 2016, Respondent's "APPOINTMENT OF CAMPAIGN TREASURER AND DESIGNATION OF CAMPAIGN DEPOSITORY FOR CANDIDATES" form (DS-DE 9) was filed with the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections office. Respondent appointed herself as campaign treasurer. To review the DS-DE 9 form, refer to Exhibit 1.
- 3. Complainant, Susan Bucher, is the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections and she was Respondent's filing officer for the 2016 election cycle.

II. Alleged Violation of Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes:

- 4. I investigated whether Respondent violated this section of the election laws when she failed to timely file her 2016 Termination Report reflecting the disposition of all remaining campaign funds.
 - 5. Complainant alleged that Respondent failed to file a termination report for her

2016 campaign.

- 6. Respondent was a candidate in the 2016 election; she was defeated in the general election held on November 8, 2016. Therefore, Respondent was required to file a termination report and dispose of her surplus funds by February 6, 2017.
- 7. In an e-mail, dated January 30, 2017, Alexia Goods, a representative with Complainant's office, notified candidates, including Respondent, of the following: "Pursuant to Florida Statutes section 106.141, each candidate who withdraws his or her candidacy, becomes unopposed, is eliminated as a candidate or elected to office shall, within 90 days, dispose of the funds in his or her campaign account and file a report reflecting the disposition of all remaining funds." Respondent was informed that a termination report was due on February 6, 2017. To review the January 30, 2017 e-mail, refer to Exhibit 2.
- 8. In an e-mail, dated February 14, 2017, Ms. Goods notified certain candidates, including Respondent, that a termination report was past due. Respondent was reminded that the termination report was due February 6, 2017. To review the February 14, 2017 e-mail, refer to Exhibit 3.
- 9. On February 28, 2017, Complainant swore out a complaint against Respondent alleging that she had failed to dispose of funds and file a Termination-Report; the complaint was received in the office of the Florida Elections Commission on March 2, 2017.
- 10. I subpoenaed and reviewed Respondent's campaign account records from her campaign depository, Wells Fargo. The table below provides information from bank records for the months of November 2016 to May 2017. To review the monthly bank statements, refer to composite Exhibit 4.

- 11. Respondent was a candidate for the same office in 2008 and 2012. According to Complainant's office, she filed a termination report at the end of each campaign. To review documentation from the supervisor of elections office, refer to Exhibit 5.
 - 12. Respondent did not provide a response to the complaint.
- 13. In a questionnaire-affidavit, Respondent was to explain the reason for not filing her termination report to disclose the financial activity as reflected in her campaign account as shown above. Respondent stated, "During my 2016, I began a new job working an average of 12 hours a day. I submitted my treasurer's reports late and kept receiving a late fine. As soon as campaign was over focused back on my stressful job. I forgot to submit the termination report. Once I realized it I just assumed I'd receive additional fines and did not know how to proceed." To review Respondent's response to the questionnaire-affidavit, refer to Exhibit 6.
- 14. No record was found to indicate that Respondent has previously violated this section of the election laws.

III. Alleged Violation of Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes:

- 15. I investigated whether Respondent violated this section of the election laws by failing to report campaign activity during the 2016 termination-reporting period.
- 16. To review the circumstances regarding Respondent's campaign activity, please refer to paragraph 10 of this report.
- 17. No record was found to indicate that Respondent has previously violated this section of the election laws.

IV. FEC History:

18. In FEC 12-192, an order of probable cause was issued charging Respondent with violating Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes, on two occasions relative to her 2012 F1 and F2 campaign reports. An order of no probable cause was issued in two other cases against Respondent, FEC 12-306 and FEC 12-432, for no violation of Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes.

- 19. During a telephone interview on September 11, 2018, Respondent stated that during the campaign and around the time the campaign report was due, she was working for a company under "very strenuous conditions" for over 12 hours a day. She added that once the campaign ended, she focused on her job and she was trying to make do with what she was dealing with at work. Respondent added that she is aware that she "messed up" and that she wanted to move on and put this behind her.
- 20. Respondent signed a form, "NOTICE OF PUBLICATIONS," informing her that publications are available on the Division of Elections website for use during her campaign. The publications listed included, in part, the *Candidate and Campaign Treasure Handbook* as well as a Compilation of Election Laws. Respondent acknowledged that she received written notice of the publications. The form was filed with the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections office on June 23, 2016. To review the form, refer to Exhibit 7.
- 21. Respondent attested that she does possess and has read Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, as well as possessing and reading the *Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook*. To review Respondent's response to the questionnaire-affidavit, refer to Exhibit 6.
- 22. Respondent executed a Statement of Candidate form indicating that she had been provided access to read and understand the requirements of Chapter 106, Florida Statutes; the form is dated as having been signed June 23, 2016. To review a copy of the Statement of Candidate, refer to Exhibit 8.
- 23. The complaint was filed with the Commission staff on March 2, 2017 relative to Respondent's 2016 campaign; however, due to service issues, the complaint was not served on Respondent until June 15, 2018. In addition, in September 2018, a pre-probable cause consent order was prepared and forwarded to Respondent to pay a \$250 fine; however, the fine and the signed consent order was never returned.

Dear Ms. Damone:

On March 2, 2017, the Florida Elections Commission received a complaint alleging that you violated Florida's election laws. I have reviewed the complaint and find that it contains one or more **legally sufficient allegations**. The Commission staff will investigate the following alleged violations:

Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2016 candidate for re-election to the Indian Trail Improvement District (ITID), failed to timely file a termination report reflecting the disposition of all remaining campaign funds.
