NOTICE OF HEARING (CONSENT ORDER)

A hearing will be held in this case before the Florida Elections Commission on, **February 28, 2017 at 11:00 am, or as soon thereafter as the parties can be heard**, at the following location: **Senate Office Building, 404 South Monroe Street, Room 110-S, Tallahassee, Florida 32399**

Failure to appear in accordance with this notice will constitute a waiver of your right to participate in the hearing. Continuances will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

This hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, which governs your participation as follows:

If you are the Respondent, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are the Complainant, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are an Appellant, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

Please refer to the information below for further instructions related to your particular hearing:

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

CONSENT ORDER

Respondent, Stacey Werling, and the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) agree that this Consent Order resolves all of the issues between the parties in this case. The parties jointly stipulate to the following facts, conclusions of law, and order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On October 3, 2016, the staff of the Commission issued a Staff Recommendation, recommending to the Commission that there was probable cause to believe that Respondent violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.
2. On November 16, 2016, the Commission voted to find that there was probable cause to charge the Respondent with the following violations:

Count 1:

On or about March 21, 2016, Respondent violated Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, when the Respondent failed to file an addendum to Emmanuel G. Morel's 2015 M11 Report correcting the errors identified by the Division of Elections within seven days of receiving notice from the filing officer that the Report was incomplete.

3. Respondent expressed a desire to enter into negotiations directed toward reaching a consent agreement.

4. Respondent and staff stipulate to the following facts:

- A. Respondent was the treasurer for Emmanuel G. Morel, a 2016 candidate for the office of State Senate, District 27.
- B. Respondent filed the campaign's 2015 M11 treasurer's report, but the report was incomplete.
- C. Respondent was notified by the Division of Elections that the report was incomplete and that Respondent had seven days to correct the errors and file an amended report.
- D. Respondent failed to file an amended 2015 M11 treasurer's report correcting the errors identified by the Division of Elections within seven days of receiving notice from the filing officer that the report was incomplete.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

5. The Commission has jurisdiction over the parties to and subject matter of this cause, pursuant to Section 106.26, Florida Statutes.

6. The Commission staff and the Respondent stipulate that although the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause may not have been knowingly committed all elements of the violations can be proven by clear and convincing evidence.

ORDER

7. Respondent and the staff of the Commission have entered into this Consent Order voluntarily and upon advice of counsel.

8. Respondent shall bear her own attorney's fees and costs that are in anyway associated with this case.

9. The Commission will consider the Consent Order at its next available meeting.

10. Respondent voluntarily waives the right to any further proceedings under Chapters 104, 106, and 120, Florida Statutes, and the right to appeal the Consent Order.

11. This Consent Order is enforceable under Sections 106.265 and 120.69, Florida Statutes. Respondent expressly waives any venue privileges and agrees that if enforcement of this Consent Order is necessary, venue shall be in Leon County, Florida, and Respondent shall be responsible for all fees and costs associated with enforcement.

12. If the Commission does not receive the signed Consent Order and the penalty by December 13, 2016, the staff withdraws this offer of settlement and will proceed with the case.

13. Payment of the civil penalty by cashier's check, or money order, good for at least 120 days, or attorney trust account check, is a condition precedent to the Commission's consideration of the Consent Order.


PENALTY

WHEREFORE, based upon the foregoing facts and conclusions of law, the Commission finds that the Respondent has violated the following provisions of Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, and imposes the following fines:

A. Respondent has violated Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, on 1 occasion for failing to file an addendum to Emmanuel G. Morel's 2015 M11 Report correcting the errors identified by the Division of Elections within seven days of receiving notice from the filing officer that the Report was incomplete. Therefore it is


ORDERED that the Respondent shall remit to the Commission a civil penalty in the amount of \$100.00, inclusive of fees and costs. The civil penalty shall be paid cashier's check or money order, good for at least 120 days, or attorney trust account check. The civil penalty shall be payable to the Florida Elections Commission, 107 West Gaines Street, Collins Building, Suite 224, Tallahassee, Florida, 32399-1050.

Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes. Respondent was the treasurer for Emmanuel G. Morel, a 2016 candidate for the office of State Senate, District 27. Respondent failed to timely make necessary amendments to the campaign's 2015 M11 treasurer's report, as alleged in the complaint.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO A HEARING

As the Respondent, you may elect to resolve this case in several ways. First, you may elect to resolve this case by consent order where you and Commission staff agree to resolve the violation(s) and agree to the amount of the fine. The consent order is then presented to the Commission for its approval. To discuss a consent order, contact the FEC attorney identified in the Order of Probable Cause.

Second, you may request an informal hearing held before the Commission, if you do not dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. You have 30 days from the date the Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission to request such a hearing. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order. At the hearing, you will have the right to make written or oral arguments to the Commission concerning the legal issues related to the violation(s) and the potential fine. At the request of Respondent, the Commission will consider and determine willfulness at an informal hearing. Otherwise, live witness testimony is unnecessary.

Third, you may request a formal hearing held before an administrative law judge in the Division of Administrative Hearings (DOAH), if you dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. You have 30 days from the date the Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission to request such a hearing. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order. At the hearing, you will have the right to present evidence relevant to the violation(s) listed in this order, to cross-examine opposing witnesses, to impeach any witness, and to rebut the evidence presented against you.

If you do not elect to resolve the case by consent order or request a formal hearing at the DOAH or an informal hearing before the Commission within 30 days of the date this Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission, the case will be sent to the Commission for a formal or informal hearing, depending on whether the facts are in dispute. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(c), Florida Statutes, undersigned counsel files this written recommendation for disposition of the referral in this case recommending that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating **Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes**. Based upon a thorough review of the Report of Investigation submitted on September 16, 2016, the following facts and law support this staff recommendation:

1. On June 16, 2016, the Florida Elections Commission (“Commission”) received a referral from the Division of Elections (“Division”) alleging Stacey Werling (“Respondent”) violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.

2. Respondent was the treasurer for Emmanuel Morel, a candidate for the Florida Senate, District 27, in the 2016 election.¹ An Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Candidates form (“DS-DE 9”) appointing Respondent as Mr. Morel’s treasurer was filed with the Division on August 17, 2015. (ROI Exhibit 2, page 1)²

3. By letter dated August 10, 2016, the Executive Director notified Respondent that Commission staff would investigate the following statutory provision:

Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes: Respondent is the treasurer for Emmanuel G. Morel, a 2016 candidate for the office of State Senate, District 27. Respondent failed to timely make necessary amendments to the campaign’s 2015 M11 treasurer report, as alleged in the complaint.

4. By letter dated August 20, 2015, Kristi Reid Bronson, Division of Elections, Chief, Bureau of Election Records, notified Respondent that her DS-DE 9 was filed with the Division on August 17, 2015. The letter also contained a security envelope containing Respondent’s confidential PIN number to access the Division’s electronic filing system. (ROI Exhibit 3, page 1)

¹ On May 9, 2016, Mr. Morel filed a DS-DE 9 with the Division redesignating the office for which he was running to Florida Senate, District 31. Mr. Morel was defeated in the August 30, 2016, primary election for State Senate, District 31.

² The Report of Investigation shall be referred to herein as “ROI.”

5. Ms. Bronson's August 20, 2015, letter also informed Respondent that all of the Division's publications and reporting forms were available on the Division's website, including Chapters 104 and 106, Florida Statutes, the *Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook*, and the *Calendar of Reporting Dates*. The letter notified Respondent that it was her responsibility to read, understand, and follow the requirements of Florida's election laws. (*Id.*)

6. The campaign's 2015 M11 Report covering the dates of November 1, 2015, through November 30, 2015, was due on December 10, 2015. Respondent filed the Report on December 11, 2015, which was one day late. Furthermore, the Report was incomplete. (ROI Exhibit 1, page 1; ROI Exhibit 8, page 2)

7. On February 4, 2016, and February 25, 2016, the Division sent Respondent a letter notifying her that the campaign's 2015 M11 Report was incomplete and that Respondent had seven days to correct the errors or provide the missing information noted in the attached Compliance Report. The letter dated February 4, 2016, also stated that if the information was reported accurately, Respondent should provide a written explanation to the Division addressing the issues noted in the Compliance Report attached to the notification letter. (ROI Exhibit 4 and Exhibit 5)

8. On March 9, 2016, the Division sent Respondent a letter marked Final Notice notifying Respondent that the campaign's 2015 M11 Report remained incomplete and Respondent had seven days to correct the errors or provide the missing information noted in the attached Compliance Report. The letter also stated that if the information was reported accurately, Respondent should provide a written explanation to the Division addressing the issues noted in the Compliance Report attached to the notification letter. The March 9, 2016, letter was confirmed delivered on March 14, 2016. (ROI Exhibit 6)

9. On March 16, 2016, Respondent filed the campaign's amended 2015 M11 Report. However, the 2015 M11 Report did not correct the errors noted in the Compliance Report. The Division made attempts by telephone to explain to Respondent how to correctly amend the Report on March 23, 2016, and May 4, 2016. (ROI Exhibit 8, page 1; Exhibit 9)

10. The Division confirmed via email that as of September 22, 2016, the campaign's 2015 M11 Report had not been corrected. (Attachment A)

11. Respondent was given multiple opportunities to respond to Commission staff's investigation, but failed to do so.

12. Based upon the information above, it appears that Respondent failed to file the campaign's amended 2015 M11 Report correcting all the errors identified by the Division within seven days of receiving notice from the filing officer that the Report was incomplete.

13. "Probable Cause" is defined as a reasonable grounds of suspicion supported by circumstances sufficiently strong to warrant a cautious person in the belief that the person has committed the offense charged. *Schmitt v. State*, 590 So.2d 404, 409 (Fla. 1991). Probable cause exists where the facts and circumstances, of which an [investigator] has reasonably trustworthy information, are sufficient in themselves for a reasonable man to reach the conclusion that an

offense has been committed. *Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles v. Favino*, 667 So.2d 305, 309 (Fla. 1st DCA 1995).


14. The above facts show that Respondent was the treasurer for Emmanuel Morel, a candidate for the Florida Senate in the 2016 election. The campaign's 2015 M11 Report was filed one day late on December 11, 2015. Furthermore, the Report was incomplete. The Division sent letters on February 4, 2016, February 25, 2016, and March 9, 2016, notifying Respondent that the campaign's 2015 M11 Report was incomplete and that Respondent had seven days from receipt of the letter to correct the errors noted in the attached Compliance Report and file an amended 2015 M11 Report. The facts also show that Respondent filed an amended 2015 M11 Report on March 16, 2016. However, the amended Report was also incomplete and did not correct the errors noted in the Compliance Report. Despite receiving three letters and two telephone calls from the Division, Respondent did not file an amended report correcting the noted errors, and the campaign's 2015 M11 Report had not been corrected as of September 22, 2016.

Based upon these facts and circumstances, I recommend that the Commission find probable cause to charge Respondent with the following:

Count 1:

On or about March 21, 2016, Respondent violated Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, when Respondent failed to file an addendum to the campaign's 2015 M11 Report correcting the errors identified by the Division within seven days of receiving notice from the filing officer that the Report was incomplete.

On June 16, 2016, the Florida Elections Commission (“Commission”) received a referral from the Division of Elections alleging that Respondent violated Chapters 104 or 106, Florida Statutes. Commission staff investigated whether Respondent violated the following statute:

Section 106.07(2)(b)1, Florida Statutes, failure of the treasurer of a candidate to file an addendum to an incomplete report after receiving notice from the filing officer.

I. Preliminary Information:

1. Respondent served as the Campaign Treasurer for her father, Emmanuel Morel’s, 2016 election campaign for State Senator. Mr. Morel lost his election bid. This was Respondent’s first time serving as a Campaign Treasurer.
2. Complainant is the Division of Elections.
3. Respondent’s filing officer is Kristi Reid-Bronson, Chief, Bureau of Election Records.

II. Alleged Violation of Section 106.07(2)(b)1, Florida Statutes:

4. I investigated whether Respondent violated this section of the election laws by not filing an addendum to the 2015 M11 Report, after receiving notice that it was incomplete.

5. A DOE staff representative, Kristi Reid-Bronson, submitted a sworn affidavit dated June 2, 2016 regarding Respondent’s failure to file an addendum to the 2015 M11 Report. To view a copy of the June 2, 2016 sworn affidavit, refer to exhibit 1.

6. On August 17, 2015, the Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository form (DS-DE 9) was filed with Respondent’s filing officer. Respondent was appointed as the campaign treasurer for Emmanuel Morel’s election campaign. To view a copy of Respondent’s DS-DE 9 form, refer to exhibit 2.

7. On August 20, 2015, Complainant mailed Respondent a letter acknowledging receipt of the DS-DE 9 form. This letter also advised Respondent of her confidential pin number to access the Division’s Electronic Filing System (EFS) for submitting campaign treasurer’s

reports. To view a copy of the August 20, 2015 acknowledgement letter, refer to exhibit 3.

8. On February 4, 2016, Complainant mailed Respondent a letter informing her that the 2015 M11 Report was incomplete. Complainant attached a list of errors to this letter that specifically stated the errors that required amending. This letter was sent to the address Respondent provided on the DS-DE 9 form (Exhibit 2). To view a copy of the February 4, 2016 incomplete-report letter, refer to exhibit 4.

9. On February 25, 2016, Complainant mailed Respondent a second letter informing her that the 2015 M11 Report remained incomplete. Complainant attached a list of errors to this letter that specifically stated the errors that required amending. This letter was also sent to the address Respondent provided on the DS-DE 9 form (Exhibit 2). To view a copy of the February 25, 2016 incomplete-report letter, refer to exhibit 5.

10. On March 9, 2016, Complainant mailed Respondent a certified letter titled "Final Notice" informing her that the 2015 M11 Report remained incomplete. Complainant included a list of errors with this letter that specifically stated what required amending. This letter was also sent to the address Respondent provided on the DS-DE 9 form (Exhibit 2). This letter included a delivery confirmation receipt. To view a copy of the March 9, 2016 "Final Notice" with delivery confirmation receipt, refer to exhibit 6.

11. On March 16, 2016, DOE records reflect that an amended 2015 M11 Report was filed with Respondent's filing officer. To review a copy of Respondent's amended 2015 M11 Report, refer to exhibit 7. To view a copy of Respondent's filing history, refer to exhibit 8.

12. DOE records reflect that Complainant contacted Respondent to instruct her on the correct way to amend the 2015 M11 Report. On March 23, 2016, records state that Complainant left a message for Respondent explaining how to amend the report correctly. On May 4, 2016, Complainant made contact with Respondent to recommend suggestions on how to properly amend the report. To review DOE records pertaining to contact made with Respondent on how to properly amend the 2015 M11 Report, refer to exhibit 9.

13. On September 16, 2016, FEC staff made contact via email with DOE representative, Ms. Kristi Reid-Bronson, to inquire about the status of the 2015 M11 Report. Ms. Bronson advised FEC staff that this report "has not been corrected". To review the September 16, 2016 email communication, refer to exhibit 10.

14. There is a record that Respondent has previously violated this section of the election laws.

IV. FEC History:


15. Respondent has been involved in two prior investigations. In FEC 15-436; Respondent agreed to a minor-violation consent order with a civil penalty in the amount of \$375.00 for an alleged violation of 106.07(2)(b)1; the civil penalty was paid on April 4, 2016. FEC 16-029 will be heard at the November 2016 Commission meeting for an alleged violation of 106.07(2)(b)1.

Conclusion:

16. Respondent was offered several opportunities to make comments regarding the findings of this investigation. Respondent did not respond to any of these attempts.

17. In the August 20, 2015 acknowledgement letter, Respondent was informed that all of the Division's publications were available online at DOE's website. In the letter, Respondent was admonished as follows: "It is your responsibility to read, understand, and follow the requirements of Florida's election laws. Therefore, please print a copy of the following documents: Chapters 104 and 106, Florida Statutes, Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook, Calendar of Reporting Dates, and Rule 1S-2.017, Florida Administrative Code". To view a copy of the August 20, 2015 acknowledgement letter, refer to exhibit 3.

Timely Filing

All reports filed must be completed and filed through the EFS no later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the due date. Reports not filed by midnight of the due date are late filed and subject to the penalties in Section 106.07(8), Florida Statutes. In the event that the EFS is inoperable on the due date, the report will be accepted as timely filed if filed no later than midnight of the first business day the EFS becomes operable. No fine will be levied during the period the EFS was inoperable.

Any candidate failing to file a report on the designated due date shall be subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first 3 days late and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

Electronic Receipts

The person submitting the report on the EFS will be issued an electronic receipt indicating and verifying the report was filed. Each campaign treasurer's report filed by means of the EFS is considered to be under oath by the candidate and campaign treasurer and such persons are subject to the provisions of Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes.

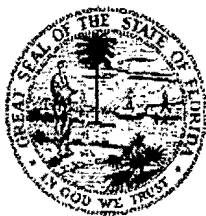

Dear Ms. Werling:

On June 16, 2016, the Florida Elections Commission received a complaint alleging that you violated Florida's election laws. I have reviewed the complaint and find that it contains one or more legally sufficient allegations. The Commission staff will investigate the following alleged violation:

Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes: Respondent is the treasurer for Emmanuel G. Morel, a 2016 candidate for the office of State Senate, District 27. Respondent failed to timely make necessary amendments to the campaign's 2015 M11 treasurer report, as alleged in the complaint.

You may respond to the allegation above by filing a notarized statement providing any information regarding the facts and circumstances surrounding the allegation. Your response will be included as an attachment to the investigator's report.

When we conclude the investigation, a copy of the Report of Investigation will be mailed to you at the above address. You may file a response to the report within 14 days from the date the report is mailed to you. Based on the results of the investigation, legal staff will make a written recommendation to the Commission on whether there is probable cause to believe you have violated Chapter 104 or 106, Florida Statutes. A copy of the Staff Recommendation will be mailed to you and you may file a response within 14 days from the date the recommendation is mailed to you. Your timely filed response(s) will be considered by the Commission when determining probable cause.

The Commission will then hold a hearing to determine whether there is probable cause to believe you have violated Chapters 104 or 106, Florida Statutes. You and the complainant will receive a notice of hearing at least 14 days before the hearing. The notice of hearing will indicate the location, date, and time of your hearing. You will have the opportunity to make a brief oral

statement to the Commission, but you will not be permitted to testify or call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence.


At any time before a probable cause finding, you may notify us in writing that you want to enter into negotiations directed towards reaching a settlement via consent agreement.

The Report of Investigation, Staff Recommendation, and Notice of Hearing will be mailed to the above address as this letter. Therefore, if your address changes, you must notify this office of your new address. Otherwise, you may not receive these important documents. Failure to receive the documents will not delay the probable cause hearing.

Under section 106.25, Florida Statutes, complaints, Commission investigations, investigative reports, and other documents relating to an alleged violation of Chapters 104 and 106, Florida Statutes, are confidential until the Commission finds probable cause or no probable cause. The confidentiality provision does not apply to the person filing the complaint. However, it does apply to you unless you waive confidentiality in writing. The confidentiality provision does not preclude you from seeking legal counsel. However, if you retain counsel, your attorney must file a notice of appearance with the Commission before any member of the Commission staff can discuss this case with him or her.

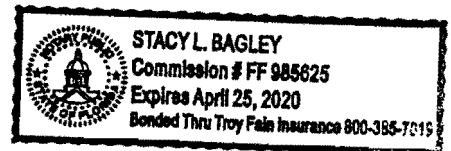




