NOTICE OF HEARING (INFORMAL HEARING)

A hearing will be held in this case before the Florida Elections Commission on, **November 28, 2017 at 8:30 am, or as soon thereafter as the parties can be heard**, at the following location: **412 Knott Building, Pat Thomas Committee Room, 404 South Monroe Street, Tallahassee, Florida 32399.**

Failure to appear in accordance with this notice will constitute a waiver of your right to participate in the hearing. Continuances will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

This hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, which governs your participation as follows:

If you are the Respondent, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are the Complainant, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are an Appellant, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

Please refer to the information below for further instructions related to your particular hearing:

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

ORDER OF PROBABLE CAUSE

THIS MATTER was heard by the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) at its regularly scheduled meeting on August 16, 2017, in Tallahassee, Florida.

On May 16, 2017, Staff recommended to the Commission that there was probable cause to believe that the Florida Election Code was violated. The facts articulated in Staff's Recommendation are adopted by reference and incorporated herein. Based on the Complaint, Report of Investigation, Staff's Recommendation, and oral statements (if any) made at the probable cause hearing, the Commission finds that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with the following violation(s):

Count 1:

On or about April 10, 2015, Respondent violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when Respondent failed to notify the Division of Elections in writing on or before April 10, 2015, that Respondent would not be filing its 2015 M3 Report on the prescribed due date.

Count 2:

On or about June 10, 2016, Respondent violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when Respondent failed to notify the Division of Elections in writing on or before June 10, 2016, that Respondent would not be filing its 2016 M5 Report on the prescribed due date.

Count 3:

On or about July 15, 2016, Respondent violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when Respondent failed to notify the Division of Elections in writing on or before July 15, 2016, that Respondent would not be filing its 2016 P2 Report on the prescribed due date.

Count 4:

On or about August 5, 2016, Respondent violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when Respondent failed to notify the Division of Elections in writing on or before August 5, 2016, that Respondent would not be filing its 2016 P4 Report on the prescribed due date.


Count 5:

On or about August 12, 2016, Respondent violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when Respondent failed to notify the Division of Elections in writing on or before August 12, 2016, that Respondent would not be filing its 2016 P5 Report on the prescribed due date.

Count 6:

On or about August 19, 2016, Respondent violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when Respondent failed to notify the Division of Elections in writing on or before August 19, 2016, that Respondent would not be filing its 2016 P6 Report on the prescribed due date.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO A HEARING

As the Respondent, you may elect to resolve this case in several ways. First, you may elect to resolve this case by consent order where you and Commission staff agree to resolve the violation(s) and agree to the amount of the fine. The consent order is then presented to the Commission for its approval. To discuss a consent order, contact the FEC attorney identified in the Order of Probable Cause.

Second, you may request an informal hearing held before the Commission, if you do not dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. You have 30 days from the date the Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission to request such a hearing. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order. At the hearing, you will have the right to make written or oral arguments to the Commission concerning the legal issues related to the violation(s) and the potential fine. At the request of Respondent, the Commission will consider and determine willfulness at an informal hearing. Otherwise, live witness testimony is unnecessary.

Third, you may request a formal hearing held before an administrative law judge in the Division of Administrative Hearings (DOAH), if you dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. You have 30 days from the date the Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission to request such a hearing. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order. At the hearing, you will have the right to present evidence relevant to the violation(s) listed in this order, to cross-examine opposing witnesses, to impeach any witness, and to rebut the evidence presented against you.

If you do not elect to resolve the case by consent order or request a formal hearing at the DOAH or an informal hearing before the Commission within 30 days of the date this Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission, the case will be sent to the Commission for a formal or informal hearing, depending on whether the facts are in dispute. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(c), Florida Statutes, undersigned staff counsel files this written recommendation for disposition of the complaint in this case recommending that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating **Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes**. Based upon a thorough review of the Report of Investigation submitted on April 13, 2017, the following facts and law support this staff recommendation.

1. On September 30, 2016, the Florida Elections Commission (“Commission”) received a referral from the Division of Elections (“Division”) alleging that Justice-2-Jesus (“Respondent” or “Committee”) violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.

2. Respondent is a political committee registered with the Division. On December 12, 2007, Respondent’s Statement of Organization of Political Committee form and Respondent’s Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Political Committees form was filed with the Division. Brian Pitts was identified as the Committee’s chair and treasurer. (ROI Exhibit 1; ROI Exhibit 11; and Attachment A)¹

3. On January 27, 2017, the Executive Director sent Respondent notification that Commission staff would investigate the following alleged violations:

Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes: As alleged in the complaint, for each of the following reporting periods, Respondent failed to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed on that date because it had not received funds, made contributions, or expended reportable funds during the reporting periods:

- 2015 M3
- 2016 M5
- 2016 P2
- 2016 P4
- 2016 P5
- 2016 P6

¹ The Report of Investigation shall be referred to herein as “ROI.”

4. By letter dated December 14, 2007, Kristi Bronson, Chief, Bureau of Election Records, sent a letter to Respondent's chair notifying Respondent that the name of the organization had been placed on the Division's active committee list as a political committee that supports issues. The letter advised Respondent that all political committees filing reports with the Division of Elections are required to use the electronic filing system ("EFS") and provided Respondent with a user identification number and initial password to access to the EFS. (ROI Exhibit 2, page 1)

5. Ms. Bronson's December 14, 2007 letter further advised Respondent that all of the Division's publications and reporting forms were on the Division's website and directed Respondent to print a copy of the *2006 Committee and Campaign Treasurer Handbook* ("Handbook"), the *2007-2008 Calendar of Reporting Dates*, and other documents. (ROI Exhibit 2, page 3)

6. Page 55 of the Handbook states:

When there has been no activity in the campaign account during a reporting period (no funds expended or received) the filing of the report may be waived by notifying the filing officer in writing that no activity has occurred. This notification must be made on the prescribed reporting date.

(Section 106.07, F.S.)

(ROI Exhibit 3, pages 1 and 9)

7. Pages 12, 13, 45, and 46 of the *Political Committee EFS User's Guide* ("Guide") explains the steps a political committee should take to notify the Division in writing on the prescribed reporting date that no report will be filed for the reporting period using the EFS. Specifically, at the top of page 13, the Guide instructs the user to click the box next to "Waiver" if there is no financial activity to report. (ROI Exhibit 4, pages 1, 5, 6, 7, and 8)

8. Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, provides:

Notwithstanding any other provisions of this chapter, in any reporting period during which a candidate or political committee has not received funds, made any contributions, or expended any reportable funds, the filing of the required report for that period is waived. However, the next report filed must specify that the report covers the entire period between the last submitted report and the report being filed, and any candidate or political committee not reporting by virtue of this subsection on dates prescribed elsewhere in this chapter **shall notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that no report is being filed on that date.** (Emphasis added)

9. The table below reflects Respondent's untimely written notifications to the Division:

10. Investigator Hinson attempted to contact Respondent's chair, Brian Pitts, by telephone on March 2, 2017, and March 27, 2017, without success. On both occasions, Investigator Hinson left a voice message requesting Mr. Pitts to return her call, which he failed to do. Investigator Hinson also attempted to contact Mr. Pitts twice by telephone on April 11, 2017. No one answered either of Investigator Hinson's phone calls and there was no voice mail on which Investigator Hinson could leave a message. (ROI Exhibit 8, Phone Log Entries 6, 9, 10, and 11)

11. Respondent has successfully filed reports using the Division's EFS on several other occasions. (ROI Exhibit 5)

12. "Probable Cause" is defined as reasonable grounds of suspicion supported by circumstances sufficiently strong to warrant a cautious person in the belief that the person has committed the offense charged. *Schmitt v. State*, 590 So.2d 404, 409 (Fla. 1991). Probable cause exists where the facts and circumstances, of which an [investigator] has reasonably trustworthy information, are sufficient in themselves for a reasonable man to reach the conclusion that an offense has been committed. *Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles v. Favino*, 667 So.2d 305, 309 (Fla. 1st DCA 1995).

13. The above facts show that Respondent is a political committee registered with the Division. Brian Pitts is Respondent's chair and treasurer. Respondent failed to notify its filing officer in writing on the prescribed due dates for the 2015 M3, 2016 M5, 2016 P2, 2016 P4, 2016 P5, and 2016 P6 Reports that it would not be filing a report for the applicable reporting period.

Based on the foregoing, I recommend that the Commission find probable cause to charge Respondent with the following violations:

Count 1:

On or about April 10, 2015, Respondent violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when Respondent failed to notify the Division of Elections in writing on or before April 10, 2015, that Respondent would not be filing its 2015 M3 Report on the prescribed due date.

Count 2:

On or about June 10, 2016, Respondent violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when Respondent failed to notify the Division of Elections in writing on or before June 10, 2016, that Respondent would not be filing its 2016 M5 Report on the prescribed due date.

Count 3:

On or about July 15, 2016, Respondent violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when Respondent failed to notify the Division of Elections in writing on or before July 15, 2016, that Respondent would not be filing its 2016 P2 Report on the prescribed due date.

Count 4:

On or about August 5, 2016, Respondent violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when Respondent failed to notify the Division of Elections in writing on or before August 5, 2016, that Respondent would not be filing its 2016 P4 Report on the prescribed due date.

Count 5:

On or about August 12, 2016, Respondent violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when Respondent failed to notify the Division of Elections in writing on or before August 12, 2016, that Respondent would not be filing its 2016 P5 Report on the prescribed due date.

Count 6:



3. Justice-2-Jesus (45755) is a Political Committee registered with the Division. On December 12, 2007, Brian Pitts filed the DSDE 5 and DSDE 6 with the Division of Elections indicating that he was the chairperson and treasurer for the committee. (See attached documents and acknowledgment letter.)
4. The 2015 M3 campaign treasurer's report was due on April 10, 2015. Mr. Pitts failed to notify the Division that no report was being filed on the prescribed reporting date. Mr. Pitts filed a notification of no activity on April 11, 2015. (See attached letter and file receipt.)
5. The 2016 M5 campaign treasurer's report was due on June 10, 2016. Mr. Pitts failed to notify the Division that no report was being filed on the prescribed reporting date. Mr. Pitts filed a notification of no activity on June 14, 2016. (See attached letter and file receipt.)
6. The 2016 P2 campaign treasurer's report was due on July 15, 2016. Mr. Pitts failed to notify the Division that no report was being filed on the prescribed reporting date. Mr. Pitts filed a notification of no activity on July 18, 2016. (See attached letter and file receipt.)
7. The 2016 P4 campaign treasurer's report was due on August 5, 2016. Mr. Pitts failed to notify the Division that no report was being filed on the prescribed reporting date. Mr. Pitts filed a notification of no activity on August 6, 2016. (See attached letter and file receipt.)
8. The 2016 P5 campaign treasurer's report was due on August 12, 2016. Mr. Pitts failed to notify the Division that no report was being filed on the prescribed reporting date. Mr. Pitts filed a notification of no activity on August 13, 2016. (See attached letter and file receipt.)



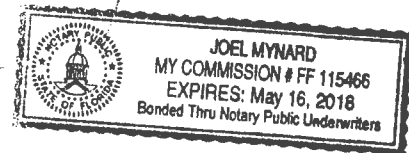

Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, failure of a political committee that did not receive any contributions or make any expenditures during a reporting period to notify timely the filing officer, in writing, that no report is being filed.

Political Committee

I. Preliminary Information:

1. An Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository (Form DS-DE 6) was filed on December 12, 2007, identifying Brian Pitts as Respondent's campaign treasurer, and Washington Mutual Bank ("WaMu")¹ as its campaign depository. (Exhibit 1)

2. An acknowledgement letter was mailed to the address provided on Respondent's Form DS-DE 6 on December 14, 2007, advising Respondent that all the DOE's publications and reporting forms are available on its website, including Chapter 106, *Florida Statutes, 2006 Committee and Campaign Treasurer Handbook*, and the Calendar of Reporting Dates. (Exhibit 2)

3. The acknowledgement letter also states, "An online instruction guide is available to you on the EFS to assist with navigation, data entry, and submission of reports" and provides the telephone number for the DOE's EFS Help Desk. (Exhibit 2)

4. The *2006 Committee and Campaign Treasurer Handbook* discusses filing a waiver when there is no activity to disclose on page 55. And persons or organizations required to file reports with the DOE must file by means of the EFS, electronic filing system, as indicated on page 59. (Exhibit 3)

5. Pages 12, 13, 45, and 46 of the *Political Committee EFS User's Guide* discuss how to notify the DOE on the prescribed reporting date that no report will be filed using the EFS. Specifically, page 13 instructs the user to click the box next to "waiver" if there is no activity to disclose. (Exhibit 4)

6. In a telephone interview with Commission staff on April 2, 2014, Kristi Reid Bronson clarified that once the waiver box is chosen and a new report is opened as shown on page 12, the only available option on the report summary screen will be "Go To File Report" as shown on page 13. Choosing "Go To File Report" will take the user directly to the screens where the chairman/treasurer PINS are entered as shown on pages 45 and 46. (Exhibit 4)

II. Alleged Violation of Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes:

7. Respondent's filing history reflects the untimely filed notifications summarized on the next page. (Exhibit 5)

¹ (Note: WaMu was seized by the US Office of Thrift Supervision in September 2008, placed into receivership with the FDIC, and was turned over to JPMorgan Chase Bank, N.A. by federal regulators.)

8. Based upon Bank records secured by subpoena from Respondent's campaign depository, JPMorgan Chase Bank, N.A., Respondent's campaign account was closed on June 1, 2011, due to an overdraft write-off in the amount of \$782.45. The campaign account ending balance was \$0.00 on June 1, 2011. (Exhibit 6)

9. Based upon Respondent's campaign finance activity available on the DOE's website, a total of \$1,150 should be in the campaign depository. (Exhibit 7)

10. It is unclear why Respondent's registration as a political committee has not been revoked; it appears there has been no campaign finance activity since 2008. (Exhibit 7)

III. FEC History:

11. Respondent had a prior case before the Commission in FEC 08-392 for its failure to file its 2008 Q1 Report. A final judgment was entered against Respondent in the amount of \$2,362.50, on January 13, 2010. The fine is unpaid. And in FEC 15-181, the Division of Administrative Hearings assessed a civil penalty against Respondent in the amount of \$7,000.00 for violating section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, on seven occasions, as evidenced by a Summary Final Order entered January 28, 2016. The fine is unpaid.

Conclusion:

12. Respondent did not respond to the notice of the complaint or to Ms. Toman's letter of legal sufficiency. I attempted to contact the chairman of the political committee, Brian Pitts, by telephone on four occasions to give him an opportunity to discuss the allegations in the referral. A questionnaire-affidavit was e-mailed to Respondent on February 2 and 3, 2017, and was provided my contact number and e-mail address. And a letter with a questionnaire-affidavit was mailed to Respondent on February 3, 2017. As of the date of this report of investigation, neither Respondent nor its chairman has responded to the instant case, returned a questionnaire-affidavit nor has my correspondence been returned by the USPS. (Exhibits 8 through 10)

13. Because Respondent's chairman has not contacted Commission staff or returned a questionnaire-affidavit, I am unable to ascertain whether Respondent's chairman, on behalf of Respondent, has read Chapter 106, *Florida Statutes*, and/or the *Political Committee Handbook*. Brian Pitts signed its Statement of Organization form as chairman on December 11, 2007. (Exhibit 11)

14. The Investigative Phone Log is included with this report. (Exhibit 8)

Pin numbers are confidential secure credentials that allow you to submit reports and update information. The enclosed sealed envelope contains your confidential pin numbers.

Each political committee chairperson is required to provide the Division of Elections with confidential personal information that may be used to allow access in the event that the password is forgotten or lost. When you enter the campaign account screen, there will be a drop down box where you pick a question (such as *What is your mother's maiden name?*) and supply an answer. All passwords and answers to questions are stored as encrypted data and cannot be viewed by Division staff and given out over the phone. Please notify the Division if your credentials have been compromised.

Timely Filing

All reports must be completed and filed through the EFS not later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the due date. Reports not filed by midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the due date are late filed and subject to the penalties in Section 106.07(8), Florida Statutes. In the event that the EFS is inoperable on the due date, the report will be accepted as timely filed if filed no later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the first business day the EFS becomes operable. No fine will be levied during the period the EFS was inoperable.

Any political committee failing to file a report on the designated due date is subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first 3 days and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for the reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

Electronic Receipts

The person submitting the report on the EFS will be issued an electronic receipt indicating and verifying the report was filed. Each campaign treasurer's report filed by means of the EFS is considered to be under oath by the chairperson and campaign treasurer and such persons are subject to the provisions of Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes.

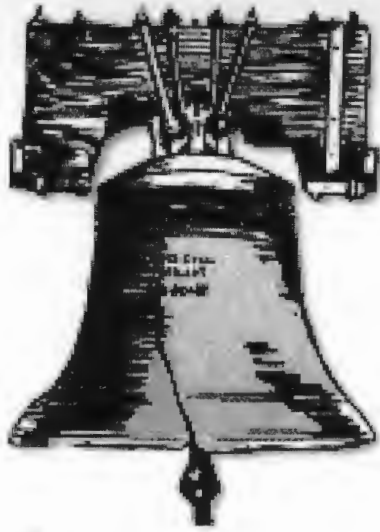

Chapter 2

The Campaign Financing Act

The Compilation of Election Laws covers Chapters 97-106, Florida Statutes. Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, regulates campaign financing for all candidates, including judicial candidates, political committees, committees of continuous existence, and political parties. It does not regulate campaign financing for candidates for federal office or candidates for a political party executive committee.

The Division of Elections:

- Oversees the interpretation of and provides guidance on the election laws.
- Provides advisory opinions to supervisors of elections, candidates, local officers having election related duties, political parties, political committees, committees of continuous existence, or other persons or organizations engaged in political activity, relating to any provisions or possible violations of Florida election laws with respect to actions such person or entity has taken or proposes to take. (*Section 106.23(2), F.S.*)
- Prescribes rules and regulations to carry out the provisions of Chapter 106, Florida Statutes. (*Section 106.22(9), F.S.*)

Chapter 15

Filing Campaign Reports

Political Committees: Each campaign treasurer designated by a political committee shall file regular reports of all contributions received and all expenditures made by or on behalf of such political committee. The chairperson and campaign treasurer shall certify as to the correctness of each report. Each person so certifying shall bear the responsibility for the accuracy and veracity of each report. Any campaign treasurer or chairperson who willfully certifies the correctness of any report while knowing that such report is incorrect, false or incomplete commits a misdemeanor of the first degree.

Committees of Continuous Existence: Each committee of continuous existence shall file regular reports with the Division of Elections at the same times and subject to the same filing conditions as established for candidate's reports. The treasurer of each committee of continuous existence shall certify to the correctness of each report and shall bear the responsibility for the accuracy and veracity. Any treasurer who willfully certifies to the correctness of a report while knowing that such report is incorrect, false or incomplete commits a misdemeanor of the first degree.

Electioneering Communication Organizations: These organizations are required to report contributions and expenditures in the same manner, at the same time, subject to the same penalties and with the same filing officer as a political committee.

Independent Expenditures: Each person who makes an independent expenditure in the amount of \$100 or more is required to report contributions and expenditures in the same manner, at the same time, subject to the same penalties and with the same filing officer as a political committee.

(Sections 106.011, 106.04 and 106.07, F.S.)

Where to File

Political Committees: A campaign treasurer is required to file campaign treasurer's reports with the officer with whom the committee registers.

Committees of Continuous Existence: Committees of continuous existence file campaign treasurer's reports with the Division of Elections. The committee is also required to file a duplicate copy of each report with the supervisor of elections in the county in which the committee maintains its books and records. If the county where the committee maintains its books and records is Leon County, no such duplicate report is required to be filed with the supervisor of elections.

Electioneering Communication Organizations: A campaign treasurer is required to file campaign treasurer's reports with the officer with whom the organization registers.

Committees and organizations filing reports with the Division of Elections are required to file by means of the **Electronic Filing System** (see Chapter 17, *Electronic Filing of Campaign Reports*). If the committee or organization's filing officer is other than the Division of Elections, contact the appropriate filing officer to find out their requirements.

(Section 106.07(2), F.S.)

When to File

Reports must be filed on the 10th day following the end of each calendar quarter (January, April, July and October) from the time the committee or organization registers, except that if the 10th day occurs on a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday, the report shall be filed on the next business day that is not a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday.

Following the last day of qualifying, the reports must be filed on the 32nd, 18th and 4th days immediately preceding the primary election and on the 46th, 32nd, 18th and 4th days immediately preceding the general election. Please refer to the **2006 Calendar of Reporting Dates** for specific dates for committees and organizations to file for the 2006 election cycle.

Pursuant to Section 106.0705, Florida Statutes, all reports filed with the Division of Elections must be filed electronically by midnight of the due date. Except as provided in Section 106.0705, Florida Statutes, reports shall be filed no later than 5 p.m. of the day designated. A report postmarked by the U.S. Postal Service no later than midnight of the day designated is deemed timely filed. A report received by the filing officer within 5 days after the designated due date that was delivered by the U.S. Postal Service is deemed timely filed unless it has a postmark indicating the report was mailed after the designated due date. A certificate of mailing obtained from and dated by the U.S. Postal Service at the time of mailing or a receipt from an established courier company, which bears a date on or before the date on which the report is due, is proof of mailing in a timely manner.

(Sections 106.07, 106.0705 and 106.141, F.S.)

Annual Report (Committees of Continuous Existence Only)

At the beginning of each calendar year, committees of continuous existence shall file an annual report on **Form DS-DE 1, Committee of Continuous Existence Annual Report**, an updated financial statement on **Form DS-DE 63, Annual Financial Statement**, a dues or assessment schedule, and a copy of the charter or bylaws. However, the charter or bylaws need not be filed if the annual report is accompanied with a sworn statement by the **chairperson** that no changes have been made to such charter or bylaws since the last filing. All items must be filed during the month of **January**.

(Section 106.04(4), F.S.)

Penalty for Late Filing

Political Committees and Electioneering Communication Organizations: Any political committee or electioneering communication organization failing to file a report on the designated due date shall be subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first three days late and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25 percent of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for the reports immediately preceding the primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25 percent of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

Committees of Continuous Existence: Any committee of continuous existence failing to file a report on the designated due date shall be subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first three days late, and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25 percent of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

(Sections 106.04(2),(8) and 106.07(8), F.S.)

Waiver of Report

When there has been no activity in the campaign account during a reporting period (no funds expended or received) the filing of the report may be waived by notifying the filing officer in writing that no activity has occurred. This notification must be made on the prescribed reporting date.

(Section 106.07, F.S.)

Special Election Reports

When a special election is called to fill a vacancy in office, all political committees, committees of continuous existence, and electioneering communication organizations making contributions or expenditures to influence the results of the special election shall file campaign treasurers' reports with the filing officer on the dates set by the Department of State pursuant to Section 100.111, F.S.

When an election is called for an issue to appear on the ballot at a time when no candidates are scheduled to appear on the ballot, all political committees and electioneering communication organizations making contributions or expenditures in support of or in opposition to such issue shall file reports on the 18th and 4th days prior to such election.

(Section 106.07(1), F.S.)

Incomplete Reports

If a campaign treasurer files a report that is deemed incomplete, he or she will be notified by the filing officer as to why the report is incomplete. The campaign treasurer must file an addendum to the incomplete report within three days of notification. The addendum must include all necessary information to complete the report.

In lieu of a notice by registered mail, the qualifying officer may notify the campaign treasurer by telephone that the report is incomplete and request the information necessary to complete the report. If such information is not received by the qualifying officer within three days after the telephone request, notice shall be sent by registered mail.

(Section 106.07(2), F.S.)

Reporting Total Sums

Each campaign treasurer's report required by Chapter 106, F.S., shall contain the total sums of all loans, in-kind contributions, and other receipts, and total sums of all expenditures made during the reporting period. The reporting forms shall be designed to elicit separate totals for in-kind contributions, loans, and other receipts.

Form DS-DE 12, Campaign Treasurer's Report Summary is used to report totals for all contributions, in-kind contributions loans, and other receipts.

(Section 106.07, F.S.)

Reporting Contributions

Form DS-DE 13, Itemized Contributions is used to report all contributions received, regardless of the amount and must contain:

Chapter 16

Electronic Filing of Campaign Reports

The Electronic Filing System (EFS) is an Internet system for recording and reporting campaign finance activity by reporting period. Each political committee, committee of continuous existence, electioneering communication organization, or state executive committee required to file reports with the Division of Elections under Sections 106.04, 106.07 or 106.29, F.S., must file such reports with the division by means of the EFS. In addition, each person or organization required to file reports with the division under Section 106.071, F.S., must file such reports with the division by means of the EFS.

Reports filed pursuant to this section:

1. Shall be completed and filed through the EFS not later than midnight of the day designated. Reports not filed by midnight of the day designated are late filed and are subject to the penalties under Sections 106.04(8), 106.07(8) or 106.29(3), F.S., as applicable.
2. Is considered to be under oath by the chairperson and treasurer, whichever is applicable, and such persons are subject to provisions of Sections 106.04(4)(d), 106.07(5), or 106.29(2), as applicable. Persons given a secure sign-on to the EFS are responsible for protecting such from disclosure and are responsible for all filings using such credentials, unless they have notified the division that their credentials have been compromised.

(Sections 106.0705 and 106.0706, F.S.)

Accessing the EFS

From *Internet Explorer* you can access the EFS at <http://efs.dos.state.fl.us>. Each person filing a report is provided an identification number and initial password to gain entry. Once you log in using the initial password, you will be prompted to change it to a confidential one. You are responsible for protecting the password from disclosure. Contact the Division of Elections immediately if your password has been compromised.

Creating Reports

Campaign reports must be entered, saved, reviewed, and filed via the EFS either by directly entering data into the web application or by uploading data using an approved vendor's software. The division maintains a list of approved software vendors whose programs meet the file specifications for filing campaign reports. Instructions for uploading reports are provided in the *EFS Help Guide*.

Submitting Reports

Reports will be held in pending status until the report is ready to be filed. Each person eligible to file a report will receive a PIN (personal identification number) that allows the person to file reports via the EFS. A person's PIN is considered the same as that person's **signature** on a filed report.

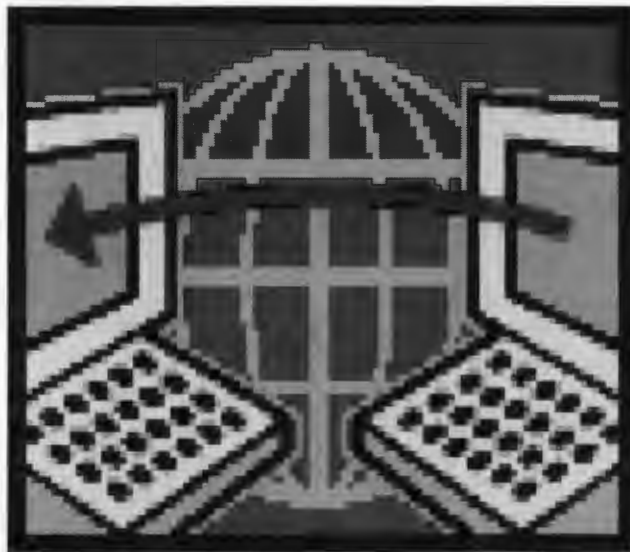

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Introduction

The Electronic Filing System (EFS) is located on the internet at <https://efs.dos.state.fl.us>. Each political committee required to file reports with the Division of Elections (DOE) is provided an identification number. Access to the system is gained by inputting the DOE assigned **Identification (ID) Number** and **Password**. The committee chairperson is provided an initial password to gain entry to the EFS. Upon logging into the system for the first time, the user will be prompted to change it.

Campaign reports are created by directly entering data into the DOE EFS or by uploading data from external systems that meet DOE electronic file specifications.

A report goes through a **three** step process before it is **filed** with the DOE:

FIRST, data is created or uploaded to the system. At this point it is a **pending** report.

SECOND, the user submits the pending report for review by the system for correctness and completeness. Errors can be corrected in pending reports via the EFS or by uploading additional data.

THIRD, the report is **filed**. Reports are filed using personal identification numbers (**PINs**), which are considered the same as a person's **signature** on the report.

Any changes to be made to a **filed** report must be done by filing an amendment. Amendments can be done directly through the EFS or by file upload.

On September 30, 2016, the Florida Elections Commission received a complaint alleging that your committee violated Florida's election laws. I have reviewed the complaint and find that it contains one or more legally sufficient allegations. The Commission staff will investigate the following alleged violation:

Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes: As alleged in the complaint, for each of the following reporting periods, Respondent failed to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed on that date because it had not received funds, made contributions, or expended reportable funds during the reporting periods:

- 2015 M3
- 2016 M5
- 2016 P2
- 2016 P4
- 2016 P5
- 2016 P6

You may respond to the allegation above by filing a notarized statement providing any information regarding the facts and circumstances surrounding the allegation. Your response will be included as an attachment to the investigator's report.

When we conclude the investigation, a copy of the Report of Investigation will be mailed to you at the above address. You may file a response to the report within 14 days from the date the report is mailed to you. Based on the results of the investigation, legal staff will make a written

recommendation to the Commission on whether there is probable cause to believe you have violated Chapter 104 or 106, Florida Statutes. A copy of the Staff Recommendation will be mailed to you and you may file a response within 14 days from the date the recommendation is mailed to you. Your timely filed response(s) will be considered by the Commission when determining probable cause.

The Commission will then hold a hearing to determine whether there is probable cause to believe you have violated Chapters 104 or 106, Florida Statutes. You and the complainant will receive a notice of hearing at least 14 days before the hearing. The notice of hearing will indicate the location, date, and time of your hearing. You will have the opportunity to make a brief oral statement to the Commission, but you will not be permitted to testify or call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence.


At any time before a probable cause finding, you may notify us in writing that you want to enter into negotiations directed towards reaching a settlement via consent agreement.

The Report of Investigation, Staff Recommendation, and Notice of Hearing will be mailed to the above address as this letter. Therefore, if your address changes, you must notify this office of your new address. Otherwise, you may not receive these important documents. Failure to receive the documents will not delay the probable cause hearing.

Under section 106.25, Florida Statutes, complaints, Commission investigations, investigative reports, and other documents relating to an alleged violation of Chapters 104 and 106, Florida Statutes, are confidential until the Commission finds probable cause or no probable cause. The confidentiality provision does not apply to the person filing the complaint. However, it does apply to you unless you waive confidentiality in writing. The confidentiality provision does not preclude you from seeking legal counsel. However, if you retain counsel, your attorney must file a notice of appearance with the Commission before any member of the Commission staff can discuss this case with him or her.



Timely Filing

All reports must be completed and filed through the EFS not later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the due date. Reports not filed by midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the due date are late filed and subject to the penalties in Section 106.07(8), Florida Statutes. In the event that the EFS is inoperable on the due date, the report will be accepted as timely filed if filed no later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the first business day the EFS becomes operable.
