NOTICE OF HEARING (AUTOMATIC FINE)

A hearing will be held in this case before the Florida Elections Commission on, **February 28, 2017 at 11:00 am, or as soon thereafter as the parties can be heard**, at the following location: **Senate Office Building, 404 South Monroe Street, Room 110-S, Tallahassee, Florida 32399**

Failure to appear in accordance with this notice will constitute a waiver of your right to participate in the hearing. Continuances will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

This hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, which governs your participation as follows:

If you are the Respondent, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are the Complainant, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are an Appellant, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

Please refer to the information below for further instructions related to your particular hearing:

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

SUMMARY: Liberty Dog is a political committee (PC) registered with the State of Florida. The PC's chair is Ms. Jennifer J. Green and its treasurer is Ms. Melanie S. Bostick.

The PC is appealing the fine claiming that unusual circumstances existed that caused the 2016 P1 Report to be untimely filed. According to Ms. Green, "I am submitting this Notice of Appeal and asking the Florida Elections Commission (FEC) for hearing on the DOE's automatically assessing a late fine of \$250 for a Liberty Dog (PC) campaign treasurer's report that was due on July 1, 2016 and allegedly filed on July 8, 2016. As the evidence demonstrates, the P1 report was not only timely filed, the P1 report was in fact filed early¹...On July 8, 2016 at 10:17 AM the P1 report was amended. The P1 report was amended to add one contribution prior to or in the same time frame as the P1A report was being timely filed. It is clear from the evidence that the PC did not just file a report waiver for the P1 report to make sure it was filed by the deadline (which apparently is DOE's assumption). The fact that the P1 was filed early demonstrates this fact. The PC discovered that one check for \$1,000 should have actually been reported on the P1 instead of the P1A report. As soon as the PC discovered the de minimus oversight, the PC amended the P1 report to report it in the proper time period. In both instances the PC acted in good faith and filed timely reports".

- The 2016 P1 Report covers the time period from 6/1/16 through 6/24/16.
- The 2016 P1 Queued-Transactions Report reflects that this report was created on 6/28/16 at approximately 1:35 pm, before being filed on 6/28/16 at approximately 1:35 pm².
- In a 10/26/16 email with Kristi Reid-Bronson, FEC staff was informed, "The committee filed a notice of no activity (waiver) on 6-28-16. A waiver is not a report. On 7-8-16, the committee filed a report showing \$1000 of activity. The fine is based on 25% of the activity.

RE: Notice of Appeal for Liberty Dog PC – PAC 65253

To Whom It May Concern:

The Liberty Dog (PC) received a letter from the Florida Division of Elections (DOE) on Friday, August 5, 2016. The PC argues that the *Florida Rules of Civil Procedure* govern the computation of time in this matter, and the twenty (20) day clock to respond to the DOE's letter began upon receipt on August 5th.

I am submitting this Notice of Appeal and asking the Florida Elections Commission (FEC) for hearing on the DOE's automatically assessing a late fine of \$250 for a Liberty Dog (PC) campaign treasurer's report that was due on July 1, 2016 and allegedly filed on July 8, 2016 (See *Exhibit #1*). As the evidence demonstrates, the P1 report was not only timely filed, the P1 report was in fact filed early. (See *Exhibit #2 and Exhibit #3*.)

Exhibit #3 is an email receipt from the DOE confirming the timely filing of the PC's P1 report. The PC filed a timely P1 report on June 28, 2016 at 1:35 PM. The DOE's allegations should be dismissed and a ruling in the PC's favor should be rendered on this fact alone. The P1 report was not late; it was filed early as demonstrated by *Exhibit #3*.

On July 8, 2016 at 10:17 AM the P1 report was amended (See *Exhibit #4*). The P1 report was amended to add one contribution prior to or in the same time frame as the P1A report was being timely filed. It is clear from the evidence that the PC did not just file a report waiver for the P1 report to make sure it was filed by the deadline (which apparently is DOE's assumption). The fact that the P1 was filed early demonstrates this fact. The PC discovered that one check for \$1,000 should have actually been reported on the P1 instead of the P1A report. As soon as the PC discovered the de minimus oversight, the PC amended the P1 report to report it in the proper time period. In both instances the PC acted in good faith and filed timely reports.

Other than the possibility of the DOE running out-of-date or faulty computer system, the only plausible explanation is the DOE is automatically imposing the 25% penalty on anyone who amends a timely filed waiver report with subsequent transactions. The DOE is assuming the PC acted willfully to withhold the \$1,000 check and that should not be the case. By imposing penalties for amending timely filed waiver reports, the DOE is, and the FEC would be, disincentivizing accurate reporting and encouraging falsification of future reports. Such a fine stifles compliance with reporting laws or rule, encourages officers to act in bad faith, and has a chilling effect on the PC's, and the PC's officers', free speech. Should the FEC find that an automatic fine should be applied, the PC argues that the fine should be dismissed under the above described circumstances as they fall under, or should fall under, *Rule 2B-1.0055 Late-filed Reports; Unusual Circumstances*.

Also, the DOE's letter (See *Exhibit #1*) fails to state or disclose under which rule or statute or case law or advisory opinion the PC is being fined. The DOE also fails to state or disclose under which rule or statute or case law or advisory opinion that a timely waiver report may not be amended. The DOE fails to state or disclose the controlling law that requires the DOE or FEC to automatically impose a fine for amending a timely filed waiver report. The DOE's lack of specifying the specific rule, statute, or case law empowering them to levee such an automatic fine amounts to a trial by ambush and violates the PC's, and the PC's officers', right to due process or ability to mount a proper legal defense.

Therefore, the PC and the PC's officers appeal the DOE's fine and request a hearing. Here is the required information required by Rule 2B-1.005 Appeal of Fines Imposed by Filing Officers.

1. The Notice of Appeal has been filed with the FEC, and a copy has been filed with the filing officer, which is the DOE, within 20 days of the PC's receipt of notice that a fine is being imposed.
