However, some cases (including those in which motions to dismiss or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are the Complainant, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which motions to dismiss or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are an Appellant, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have 5 *minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

SUMMARY: The Honorable William Ira Altfield was a candidate for 11th Circuit County Court Judge, Group 13, in the 2020 elections. Enrique "Rick" Yabor, Esquire is his treasurer and is representing Judge Altfield in this matter.

Rick Yabor, Esquire, is appealing the fine. According to Mr. Yabor, the report was filed late due to a clerical error on his part. He states that Judge Altfield was elevated to Circuit Court by the Governor. As a result, they submitted an Oath of Withdrawal for his county seat.

On October 7, 2019, he received an email stating that the 19TRF report would be due on January 05, 2020. Mr. Yabor, states he erroneously scheduled it on his calendar for January 5, 2021. He also notes that during this time he was "following two other congressional campaigns". Once he realized the report was late, he immediately filed. He requests that the fine be removed or reduced.

- The 2019TRF Original Report covers the period from 10/01/19-01/05/20; it was due on 01/05/20.
- The 2019TRF Report shows that it was filed on 01/27/2020.
- Judge William Ira Altfield reported receiving 1 contribution, while making 21 expenditures.
- The Miami Dade Supervisor of Elections has one note that pertains to Judge Altfield's 2019TRF report. A staff member contacted Mr. Yabor on 01/28/2020 and discussed the fine for the late 2019TRF report.

The grounds for my appeal is a clerical error on my part. I seek a removal or reduction of the fine.

Judge Altfield was elevated to Circuit Court by the Governor, and as such, we submitted an Oath of Withdrawal for his County Court seat. On October 7, 2019, I received an email from elections (Exhibit A), indicating that 19TRF, termination report, was due on 01-05-2020. I erroneously scheduled it on my calendar for 01-05-2021, and as such missed the due date. Please keep in mind that during this time I was following two other congressional campaigns, which reporting deadlines were January 31, 2020. In addition, normally the Miami-Dade Elections Department emails reminders to the candidates that the due date is approaching. (See Exhibit2, several reminders by Miami-Dade Elections to submit reports). I did not receive any reminders from Miami-Dade Elections and, a such, did not consider the fact that we missed the deadline. B

From October, 2019 through January, 2020 we were busy closing out the campaign and reimbursing funds to those that contributed. Again, I mistakenly thought that the due date was later in the month of January, rather than on January 5th. By the time I logged on to start inputting the termination report the deadline had passed. That is when I noticed that the termination report was past due. We immediately submitted the late report.

The tardiness of the report is completely my fault and not the Judge's. I respectfully request that the fine be removed or reduced. I, at all times, was moving forward with the termination of this campaign in good faith and missed the deadline.



The 19TRF Campaign Treasurer's Report filed with our office was submitted on 1/27/2020 (#1198257). Since this report was not filed by the appropriate filing date, a fine is being assessed for each late day pursuant to Florida Statute 106.07(8)(b).

As such, . These fines are not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. Therefore, since the report was 22 days late, the fine is \$1,100.00, which is 22 days at \$50 per day. Said fine must be received by our office at 2700 NW 87th Avenue, Miami, FL 33172 within twenty (20) days of your receipt of this notice. The check should be made payable to Miami-Dade County paid only from candidate's personal funds.

Florida Statute 106.07(8)(b) goes on to say that the fine may be appealed or disputed based upon unusual circumstances surrounding the failure to file by the designated due date. A hearing before the Florida Elections Commission may be requested, which shall have the authority to waive the fine in part or whole. Any such request must be submitted in writing and must be received by the Florida Elections Commission within 20 days of your receipt of this notice. To request an appeal, please write to the Florida Elections Commission, 107 West Gaines Street, Collins Building, Suite 224, Tallahassee, FL 32399-1050. Our office must also be notified of the intent to bring this matter before the Commission.

I urge you to promptly resolve this matter. If not, in accordance with Florida Statute 106.07(8)(d), we will be required to notify the Florida Elections Commission of this late filing and failure to pay the imposed fine.

Miami-Dade County Elections Department Guidelines to Successful Campaign Treasurer's Reports (Per Chapter 106, Florida Statutes)

Contributions

- Contributions entered must fall within the time period covered by the report.
- All Contributions must have complete itemized information including the date, name, complete address, contribution type, occupation (if over \$100) and dollar amount.
- Occupation needs to be specific. Do not use "Businessman/ woman, Business Owner, Salesman/woman, Sales," etc. Examples of acceptable occupations include Car Sales, Printing Shop Owner, Bank Manager, Attorney, etc.
- 4. There is no contribution limit to a political committee.
- The maximum cash contribution per election is \$50. A cashier's check is considered as cash.
- The contribution limit to a candidate is \$1,000 per election.
 For reporting purposes, a credit card, debit card, money order, or Paypal contribution is considered a check.
- Contributions collected via Paypal or a third-party vendor to collect contributions must be reported in full (transaction fees are not deducted from the contribution amount, but rather reflected as an expenditure).
- The person signing the check is the contributor, except for a company check that is a "Business" entity.
- In-kind contributions are subject to contribution limitations (\$1,000 per election, per contributor).
- Candidates cannot accept contributions from an Electioneering Communications Organization (ECO).

Expenditures

- Expenditures entered must fall within the time period covered by the report.
- All expenditures must have complete Itemized Information including the date, name, complete address, purpose of expenditure, and dollar amount.
- A reimbursement from the campaign account is allowable directly to an individual/organization that has incurred approved expenses on behalf of the campaign. The report must include the full name, full address, specific purpose, and amount of reimbursement.
- Campaign accounts may not provide a direct payment to the credit card of an individual/organization as a form of reimbursement.
- Poll workers should be paid with a campaign check and each poll worker paid should be itemized.
- Bank fees and fees assessed by Paypal or a third-party vendor to collect contributions must be reported as expenditures (not deducted from the contribution amount).
- ECOs are limited to electioneering communications and may not make contributions to candidates or political parties.

Petty Cash

- The Petty Cash Withdrawn limit is \$500 per calendar quarter prior to the end of qualifying. Thereafter, \$100 per week.
- It shall be spent only in amounts less than \$100 and only for office supplies, transportation expenses and other necessities.
- Petty Cash may not be used for time, space, or services from communications media.

- The Petty Cash Withdrawn must be reported in the period that it was withdrawn from the bank.
- The Petty Cash Spent must also be reported in the period that it was spent. Petty Cash Spent does not impact the Total Expenditures for the period, only when it is withdrawn.
- Petty Cash Withdrawn and Petty Cash Spent must equal at the end of the campaign.

Notices

- You will be notified of any deficiencies or violations.
- Typical violations include late filing, fine due, and incomplete information on a campaign report.
- Following these guidelines will reduce notices sent to you and thus the number of amendment reports that will need to be filed.

Amending a Report

- To make any changes to a submitted report, click on the "amend" button of the Original Report to create an Amendment Report.
- In the Amendment Report, first click on the type of transaction to amend (i.e. "Enter Contributions", etc):
 - > To add new item, add a new sequence.
 - ➤To amend existing item, click "Amend item from Orig Report" to view list of all items previously submitted. Click on desired sequence, enter edits, and click submit. This will display two transactions (one to "delete" original item and one to "add" new item).
 - ➤ To delete existing item, click "Amend Item from Orig Report", click on desired sequence, and just click submit. This will display two transactions (one to "delete" original item and one to "add" new Item). Delete the "add" sequence, leaving only the "delete" sequence,

Fines

- Fines assessed to candidates must be paid from candidate's personal funds.
- Fines assessed to political parties, political action committees, electioneering communication organizations, and "independent expenditures over \$5,000" are to be paid from their campaign account.
- Fines must be paid to the filing officer within 20 days after receipt of the notice of payment due, unless an appeal is made to the Florida Elections Commission within 20 days after receipt of the notice of payment due.
- If fine was appealed to the Florida Elections Commission, and the fine is upheld, payment is due to the Elections Department as stated in the Final Order.
- 5. Reference Florida Statute 106.07(8)(b) for fine amounts.

Termination Report

- At the end of the campaign, or when closing out a political committee, the "Total Contributions to Date" and the "Total Expenditures to Date" on the Termination Report must equal; and, the campaign account must be closed.
- Prior to closing the campaign account, any remaining funds must be disposed of according to F.S. 106.141 (for candidates) and F.S. 106.03 (for political committees).
