A hearing will be held in this case before the Florida Elections Commission on, **March 13, 2018 at 10:00 am, or as soon thereafter as the parties can be heard**, at the following location: **Augustus B. Turnbull Conference Center, 555 West Pensacola Street, Room 103, Tallahassee, Florida 32301.**

Failure to appear in accordance with this notice will constitute a waiver of your right to participate in the hearing. Continuances will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

This hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, which governs your participation as follows:

If you are the Respondent, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are the Complainant, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are an Appellant, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

Please refer to the information below for further instructions related to your particular hearing:

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

CONSENT FINAL ORDER

Respondent, **Tamara K. Goudy**, and the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) agree that this Consent Order resolves all of the issues between the parties in this case. The parties jointly stipulate to the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On October 24, 2016, a complaint was filed with the Commission alleging that Respondent violated Florida's election laws.
2. The Commission has entered an Order of Probable Cause in this case finding there was probable cause to charge the Respondent with:

Count 1:

During her 2016 campaign for Bradenton City Council, Ward 1, Respondent violated Section 106.19(1)(b), Florida Statutes, when Respondent failed to report in-kind contributions from the West Bradenton Crime Watch to her campaign.

3. Respondent has expressed a desire to enter into negotiations directed toward reaching a consent agreement.

4. Staff can prove:
 - a. Respondent was a candidate for Bradenton City Council, Ward 1, in the 2016 election.
 - b. Respondent's campaign reports did not list a contribution from the West Bradenton Crime Watch, Inc.
5. Respondent neither admits nor denies the facts in paragraph four above.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

6. The Commission has jurisdiction over the parties to and subject matter of this cause, pursuant to Section 106.26, Florida Statutes.
7. Respondent neither admits nor denies the facts in paragraph four above.
8. Notwithstanding that Respondent neither admits nor denies the facts in paragraph four, the Respondent understands that by accepting this Consent Order, the Commission will find the facts in paragraph four true.
9. Respondent agrees that based upon finding the facts in paragraph four are true, the Commission could impose a civil penalty.

ORDER AND PAYMENT

10. The Respondent and the staff of the Commission have entered into this Consent Order freely, voluntarily, and upon advice of counsel.
11. The Respondent shall bear her own attorney's fees and costs that are in any way associated with this case.
12. The Commission will consider this Consent Order at its next available meeting. However, this Consent Order, fully executed by all parties, and payment of \$350 is a condition precedent to the Commission's consideration of this Consent Order.

13. Respondent voluntarily waives the right to any further proceedings under Chapters 104, 106, and 120, Florida Statutes, and the right to appeal this Consent Order.

14. This Consent Order is enforceable under Sections 106.265 and 120.69, Florida Statutes. Respondent expressly waives any venue privileges and agrees that if enforcement of this Consent Order is necessary, venue shall be in Leon County, Florida, and Respondent shall pay all fees and costs associated with enforcement.




Therefore, it is


ORDER CLOSING FILE AND RELINQUISHING JURISDICTION

ORDER OF PROBABLE CAUSE

THIS MATTER was heard by the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) at its regularly scheduled meeting on August 16, 2017, in Tallahassee, Florida.

On June 19, 2017, Staff recommended to the Commission that there was probable cause to believe that the Florida Election Code was violated. The facts articulated in Staff's Recommendation are adopted by reference and incorporated herein. Based on the Complaint, Report of Investigation, Staff's Recommendation, and oral statements (if any) made at the probable cause hearing, the Commission finds that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with the following violation(s):

Count 1:

During her 2016 campaign for Bradenton City Council, Ward 1, Respondent violated Section 106.19(1)(b), Florida Statutes, when Respondent failed to report an in-kind contributions from the West Bradenton Crime Watch to her campaign.

The Commission also finds there is no probable cause that Respondent violated Section 106.19(1)(a), Florida Statutes.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO A HEARING

As the Respondent, you may elect to resolve this case in several ways. First, you may elect to resolve this case by consent order where you and Commission staff agree to resolve the violation(s) and agree to the amount of the fine. The consent order is then presented to the Commission for its approval. To discuss a consent order, contact the FEC attorney identified in the Order of Probable Cause.

Second, you may request an informal hearing held before the Commission, if you do not dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. You have 30 days from the date the Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission to request such a hearing. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order. At the hearing, you will have the right to make written or oral arguments to the Commission concerning the legal issues related to the violation(s) and the potential fine. At the request of Respondent, the Commission will consider and determine willfulness at an informal hearing. Otherwise, live witness testimony is unnecessary.

Third, you may request a formal hearing held before an administrative law judge in the Division of Administrative Hearings (DOAH), if you dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. You have 30 days from the date the Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission to request such a hearing. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order. At the hearing, you will have the right to present evidence relevant to the violation(s) listed in this order, to cross-examine opposing witnesses, to impeach any witness, and to rebut the evidence presented against you.

If you do not elect to resolve the case by consent order or request a formal hearing at the DOAH

or an informal hearing before the Commission within 30 days of the date this Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission, the case will be sent to the Commission for a formal or informal hearing, depending on whether the facts are in dispute. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order.

RESPONDENT GOUDY'S RESPONSE TO STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS
FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION

Respondent, Tamara Goudy, through her undersigned counsel, responds to the Staff Recommendation as follows:

Because of the staff recommendation of a finding that the Respondent did not accept an excessive contribution and in an attempt to succinctly address the remaining issues at hand, we will focus primarily on matters for which there is a dispute with the staff recommendation.

Introductory Paragraphs 1 through 10

Respondent admits Paragraph 1, but does not admit any of the allegations contained in the complaint. Respondent admits Paragraphs 2, 3, 4 and 5. Respondent admits Paragraph 6, but does not admit to any of the allegations contained in the complaint. Respondent admits to Paragraphs 7 and 8. In regard to Paragraph 9, Respondent states that neither the Respondent, nor her staff, recall being advised to download copies of publications from the Manatee County Supervisor of Elections Office Website or the Divisions Website, but acknowledges the existence of the Affidavit. Respondent admits to Paragraph 10.

**Section 106.19(1)(a), Florida Statutes Allegations
Paragraphs 11 through 14, inclusive**

Without going through each paragraph individually, Respondent concurs with the Staff Recommendation of no violation as to Section 106.19(1)(a), Florida Statutes.

**Section 106.19(1)(b), Florida Statutes
Paragraphs 15-21, inclusive**

The Respondent does not believe that she violated Section 106.19(1)(b), Florida Statutes. Section 106.19(1)(b), Florida Statutes states as follows:

- (1) Any candidate; campaign manager, campaign treasurer, or deputy treasurer of any candidate; committee chair, vice chair, campaign treasurer, deputy treasurer, or other officer of any political committee; agent or person acting on behalf of any candidate or political committee; or other person who *knowingly* and *willfully*:

.

(b) Fails to report any contribution required to be reported by this chapter;
(*emphasis added*)

Respondent, who was a first time candidate for public office, attempted to comply with all of the rules and requirements of the state statutes and elections laws. As she had questions, she would contact the Manatee County Supervisor of Elections (“MCSOE”) Office for guidance, either through e-mails or telephone calls. Although she was trying not to be a nuisance to the MCSOE, she contacted the MCSOE on a number of occasions during her campaign with compliance questions.

When she decided to run for City Council in 2016, Respondent had been active in the West Bradenton Crime Watch (“WBCW”) for years, and has been President of WBCW. She prepared the website and the electronic newsletter for WBCW, which newsletter was placed on the website. In addition, she emailed a list of weekly crime statistics and information to interested parties and members of the public.

After declaring, Respondent signed her name at the bottom of each email noting her title and, among other things, that she was a candidate for public office. She also noted her website (these references are collectively referred to as “Information”). WBCW did not charge for placing announcements, notices or items similar to the Information for any interested party. WBCW did not charge Respondent for running notices, announcements or similar information on its website, in its electronic newsletter or within the weekly crime statistics email. There was no cost to WBCW in the preparation or distribution of the newsletter. Because there was no charge to Respondent for including the Information in any WBCW newsletter, Respondent was not aware that she had to report the inclusion of the Information as a contribution. Additionally, if she had known it, she would have had to completely fabricate a value for the placement of the Information, which the Respondent would have thought was dishonest as the fair market value of placement of the Information was \$0.00. Further, any attempt to upload the acknowledgement on the MCSOE website would not have been accepted with a valuation of \$0.00, and thus, an acknowledgement with a valuation of \$0.00 would not be possible.

It should be noted that prior to placing any announcement in the newsletter or in an email, she contacted the MCSOE to determine whether she was required to place any qualifying information with the announcement. The MCSOE office staff member suggested that, in an abundance of caution (presumably to ensure compliance with Section 106.143, Florida Statutes) she should identify that it was “Paid by Tamara K. Goudy for Bradenton City Council Ward 1.” Based on this recommendation, the Respondent included this language even though no payment or sum would be required for this or any similar announcement by her or any member of the public. For many forums, it is noteworthy that this type of information is exempt from the requirements of Section 106.143, Florida Statutes, pursuant to subsection 10 of Section 106.143, Florida Statutes, for example when placed on an internet website for which there is no cost to post content for public users and/or was part of an unpaid profile which is available to the public without charge and the Respondent had thought it was exempt here as well.

Because the Commission is dealing with a civil statute of a penal nature, any ambiguity in the statute must be construed in favor of the Respondent. Diaz de la Portilla v. Florida Elections Com’n, 857 So.2d. 913 (Fla. 3d DCA 2003), rehearing denied, 872 So.2d 898, review denied, 872 So.2d 899 (Fla. 2004). The standard of proof for a violation of election law is clear and convincing evidence. Diaz de la Portilla v. Florida Elections Com’n, Id. Respectfully, the evidence does not support a finding that the Respondent either willfully or knowingly violated the statutes as alleged by the Complainant.


Conclusion

Respondent, Tamara Goudy, attempted and fully intended to comply with the Florida election law requirements. Respondent did not believe that the law required the report of an "in-kind contribution" from WBCW to her campaign related to the announcement and notifications in the newsletter. If reporting is required, she will fully comply in any future campaign, although she would appreciate guidance on how to value such an in-kind "contribution" where there is no charge involved.

Respondent, respectfully, requests the Commission find no probable cause to charge Respondent with violating either:

- a. Section 106.19(1)(a), Florida Statutes, and
- b. Section 106.19(1)(b), Florida Statutes.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(c), Florida Statutes, undersigned counsel files this written recommendation for disposition of the complaint in this case recommending that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating **Section 106.19(1)(b), Florida Statutes**, and **no probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating **Section 106.19(1)(a), Florida Statutes**. Based upon a thorough review of the Report of Investigation submitted on May 24, 2017, the following facts and law support this staff recommendation:

1. On October 24, 2016, the Florida Elections Commission (“Commission”) received a complaint from Jesse D. Carr, Sr. (“Complainant”) alleging that Tamara K. Goudy (“Respondent”) violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.

2. Respondent was a candidate for the Bradenton City Council, Ward 1, in the 2016 election. Two Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Candidates forms for Respondent's campaign were filed with the Manatee County Supervisor of Elections (“MCSOE”) on January 29, 2016. Respondent appointed herself as her deputy treasurer. (ROI Exhibit 11)¹

3. By letter dated January 25, 2017, the Executive Director notified Respondent that Commission staff would investigate the following statutory provisions:

Section 106.19(1)(a), Florida Statutes: Tamara Goudy, a 2016 candidate for election to the Bradenton City Council, Seat 1, accepted one or more contributions in excess of the limits prescribed by Section 106.08, Florida Statutes, as alleged in the complaint.

Section 106.19(1)(b), Florida Statutes: Tamara Goudy, a 2016 candidate for election to the Bradenton City Council, Seat 1, failed to report one or more contributions required to be reported by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, as alleged in the complaint.

¹ The Report of Investigation shall be referred to herein as “ROI.”

4. Respondent is the president and registered agent of West Bradenton Crime Watch, Inc. ("WBCW"), a Florida not-for-profit corporation. WBCW distributes a newsletter ("Newsletter") containing crime prevention information and crime statistics in West Bradenton. (ROI Exhibit 2; ROI Exhibit 4; ROI Exhibit 5; and Attachment A)²

5. Section 106.011(15), Florida Statutes, provides:

"Political advertisement" means a paid expression in a communications medium prescribed in subsection (4), whether radio, television, newspaper, magazine, periodical, campaign literature, direct mail, or display or by means other than the spoken word in direct conversation, which expressly advocates the election or defeat of a candidate or the approval or rejection of an issue.

6. With his complaint, Complainant provided copies of WBCW's May 7, 2016, May 22, 2016, July 23, 2016, October 7, 2016 and two May 17, 2016 emails informing readers that Respondent was a candidate for Bradenton City Council, Ward 1, and contained a link to either www.electtamigoudy.com (Respondent's campaign website), www.votefortamigoudy.com, or both websites. The links that were in the Newsletters were political advertisements. (ROI Exhibit 5; Attachment B; Attachment C; Attachment D; Attachment E; and Section 106.011(15), Florida Statutes)³

7. Throughout the investigation, Respondent maintained there was no cost for WBCW to send out its Newsletter electronically. In her November 14, 2016 response ("Response") to the complaint, Respondent stated WBCW did not make any expenditures to circulate the Newsletter, and no webmaster was paid to add links to the Newsletter. (ROI Exhibit 3, page 2; ROI Exhibit 4, page 2; ROI Exhibit 6, page 1; and ROI Exhibit 7, page 1)⁴

8. In a March 14, 2017 affidavit, Respondent stated she contacted the Manatee County Supervisor of Elections ("MCSOE") for assistance to determine her responsibilities under Florida's Election Laws, she did not possess or read Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, she did not have or ever receive a copy of the *Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook* ("Handbook"), and she had never read the Handbook. Respondent also stated she received a summary booklet on political advertisement requirements. (ROI Exhibit 3)

² Respondent has been known as Tamara K Spyker Goudy, Tamara Kay Goudy, Tamara Spyker Goudy, Tami Spyker, and Tami Goudy. (ROI Exhibit 2, page 5; ROI Exhibit 7; ROI Exhibit 12; and ROI Exhibit 13)

³ When this case was investigated and when this Staff Recommendation was written, the websites were not viewable by the public.

⁴ It appears Respondent believes that if there was no cost to distribute WBCW's Newsletter electronically, then WBCW did not make a contribution to her campaign and there was nothing that needed to be reported. Respondent's position is not supported by the facts or law in this case.

9. However, in a March 27, 2017 affidavit, Sharon Stief, Chief Deputy of the MCSOE office stated that publications were available in the MCSOE office and candidates and/or her staff were advised to pick-up the publications. Ms. Stief added that candidates and/or her staff were advised to download copies of publications from the MCSOE website or the Division's website. (ROI Exhibit 13, page 2)

10. On January 29, 2016, Respondent signed a Statement of Candidate stating that she had been provided access to read and understand the requirements of Chapter 106, Florida Statutes. (ROI Exhibit 12)

Section 106.19(1)(a), Florida Statutes.

11. Complainant alleged that Respondent accepted an excessive in-kind contribution from WBCW for campaign advertising in WBCW's Newsletter.

12. Section 106.011(5)(a), Florida Statutes, defines a contribution as:

A gift, subscription, conveyance, deposit, loan, payment, or distribution of money or **anything of value, including contributions in kind having an attributable monetary value in any form, made for the purpose of influencing the results of an election** or making an electioneering communication. (Emphasis added)

13. Respondent's advertisements in WBCW's Newsletter were in-kind contributions with an attributable monetary value from WBCW to Respondent's campaign. However, because it is difficult to establish the attributable monetary value for Respondent's campaign related links to appear in WBCA's Newsletter, it is also difficult to ascertain if the in-kind contribution was excessive. Section 106.011(5)(a), Florida Statutes.⁵

14. Based on the information above, it appears that Respondent did not accept an excessive contribution.

Section 106.19(1)(b), Florida Statutes.

15. Complainant alleged Respondent failed to list the advertisements (website links) on her campaign reports.

16. Despite the difficulty in determining the attributable monetary value of the in-kind contributions from WBCW to Respondent's campaign, Respondent was required to list the in-kind contributions on her campaign reports, which she failed to do. (ROI Exhibit 10)

⁵ Candidates running for a county wide public office are allowed to accept a maximum of \$1000 per election. §106.08(1)(a)2., Fla. Stat.

17. Based on the above facts and circumstances, it appears Respondent may have failed to report in-kind contributions for advertising that appeared in WBCW's newsletters.

18. "Probable Cause" is defined as reasonable grounds of suspicion supported by circumstances sufficiently strong to warrant a cautious person in the belief that the person has committed the offense charged. *Schmitt v. State*, 590 So.2d 404, 409 (Fla. 1991). Probable cause exists where the facts and circumstances, of which an [investigator] has reasonably trustworthy information, are sufficient in themselves for a reasonable man to reach the conclusion that an offense has been committed. *Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles v. Favino*, 667 So.2d 305, 309 (Fla. 1st DCA 1995).

19. The facts above show Respondent was a candidate for the Bradenton City Council, Ward 1, in the 2016 election. During her campaign, Respondent served as the president of the West Bradenton Crime Watch which electronically distributes a Newsletter with crime prevention information and crime statistics to approximately 875 email addresses.

20. The facts above additionally show that during her campaign, the West Bradenton Crime Watch placed at least one link to Respondent's campaign related websites in several of its newsletters. Respondent claimed there was no cost associated with disseminating the newsletter electronically and therefore she did not violate Florida's election laws. However, even if the West Bradenton Crime Watch did not incur any expenses to electronically distribute its newsletter, it still made several in-kind contributions with an attributable monetary value to Respondent's campaign that Respondent was required to list on her campaign reports, but failed to do so.

21. The facts above also show that Respondent stated she did not have and did not read Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, did not have or ever receive a copy of the *Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook* ("Handbook"), and had never read the Handbook. However, Respondent signed a Statement of Candidate admitting that she had been provided access to read and understand the requirements of Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, and she received a summary booklet on political advertisement requirements. Additionally, election law publications were available at the MCSOE's office for Respondent and her staff to pick-up and candidates were also advised to download copies of the publications from the MCSOE website or the Division of Elections' website.

Based upon the foregoing, I recommend the Commission find probable cause that Respondent committed the following violation:

Count 1:


During her 2016 campaign for Bradenton City Council, Ward 1, Respondent violated Section 106.19(1)(b), Florida Statutes, when Respondent failed to report in-kind contributions from the West Bradenton Crime Watch to her campaign.

I further recommend that the Commission find there is no probable cause to charge Respondent with violating Sections 106.19(1)(a), Florida Statutes.

Tamara Goudy responds to the Report of the Investigation, through her counsel and states the following:


Tamara (Tami) Goudy did not report the alleged in-kind donation because there was no cost for the placement of information in the Crime Watch newsletter. She did include the disclaimer based on a recommendation of staff of the Supervisor of Election's office. In an abundance of caution she included the disclaimer in the newsletter although there was no cost to her or others. Because there was no cost for placing such information in the newsletter, she would have reported the value at \$0.

It should be noted that Ms. Goudy had contacted the Supervisor of Elections Office on several occasions to obtain information in an attempt to ensure compliance with her statutory requirements. This is partially reflected in the Investigation Report.

Ms. Goudy, respectfully, did not knowingly or willfully violate the Florida Statutes as alleged. She is willing to contribute \$200 to cover state investigative expenses to resolve this matter.

On October 24, 2016, the Florida Elections Commission (“Commission”) received a sworn complaint alleging that Respondent violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes. Commission staff investigated whether Respondent violated the following statutes:

Section 106.19(1)(a), Florida Statutes, accepting one or more contributions in excess of the limits prescribed by Section 106.08, Florida Statutes; and

Section 106.19(1)(b), Florida Statutes, failing to report one or more contributions required to be reported by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.

I. Preliminary Information:

1. Respondent was a first-time candidate seeking the office of Bradenton City Council, Ward 1, in the 2016 general election. She was one of three candidates vying for the seat. Respondent received 29.07% of the vote, and placed second in the race. She is also the registered agent and president of West Bradenton Crime Watch, Inc, a not for profit corporation. (501(c)(3) corporation).
2. Respondent’s attorney is Mark P. Barnebey with Blalock Walters Attorneys at Law.
3. Complainant is a home owner in Bradenton, Florida, and is the registered agent of two for-profit corporations, Bacarr Inc., and Carr Construction & Company Inc.

II. Alleged Violation of Section 106.19(1)(a), Florida Statutes:

4. I investigated whether Respondent violated this section of the election laws when she allegedly accepted a contribution in excess of the limits prescribed by the Florida Statutes.
5. According to Complainant, Respondent accepted contributions over the legal limit by using advertising space provided by the 501(c)(3) corporation that she runs.
6. Included in the complaint was one newsletter titled, “West Bradenton Crime Watch Heritage Gazette: Neighborhood Watch Feb-April 2016”. The fourth page of the electronic newsletter is a full-page press-release entitled “Tami is running for Bradenton City Council”. At the bottom of the press-release is the web address of her campaign website,

www.electtamigoudy.com and an electronic mail (e-mail) address to contact Respondent, votefortamigoudy@aol.com. To review the newsletter press-release, refer to Exhibit 1.

7. During my investigation, I located an archived Neighborhood Crime Watch newsletter dated July 2015 on the West Bradenton Crime Watch website. On the fifth page of the newsletter, it states, "Any business that wishes to advertise should contact Tami Spyker (Goudy)...We can discuss costs involved in advertising both on the website and the monthly newsletter...These funds will help support your neighborhood watch program." To review a copy of the July 2015 newsletter, refer to Exhibit 2.

8. In a questionnaire-affidavit dated March 14, 2017, Respondent indicated there was no cost for a business to advertise in the Neighborhood Crime Watch newsletter, other than a voluntary donation received from "time to time". To review the March 14, 2017 affidavit, please refer to Exhibit 3.

9. In a questionnaire-affidavit dated April 25, 2017, Respondent indicated that there has only been one donation collected in the past for advertising space in the Neighborhood Crime Watch newsletter. This donation occurred in March 2015, and totaled \$100.00. Since then, no one has donated to the newsletter, and the link to donate for advertising in the newsletter was removed from the website. To review a copy of the April 25, 2017 affidavit, refer to Exhibit 4.

10. Additionally, in the April 25, 2017 questionnaire-affidavit, Respondent stated that no donation was necessary for the campaign to release a press-release in the newsletter, and no expense was incurred by the West Bradenton Crime Watch; Exhibit 4.

11. Complainant also submitted copies of e-mail communications from West Bradenton Crime Watch, which included signature lines with a link for Respondent's non-profit organization's e-mail, as well as links titled www.electtamigoudy.com or www.votefortamigoudy.com, both of which are followed by a disclaimer reading, "Paid by Tamara K. Goudy for Bradenton City Council Ward 1." To view the e-mail communications, refer to Exhibit 5.

12. Email correspondence was submitted by the Manatee Supervisor of Elections Office on March 27, 2017. In an e-mail chain dated May 06, 2016, Respondent inquired whether she needed to add an advertisement statement to emails sent to supporters, even though "the emails that are sent out are not paid for." The Manatee Supervisor of Elections e-mailed a response the same day, stating that the Candidate Disclaimer needed to be put on any political advertisement that was paid for by a candidate, and that "you do pay for (e-mails) the way you are paying for an email provider which makes it a paid advertisement." To review the May 6, 2016 e-mail chain, please refer to Exhibit 6.

13. In an e-mail response from Respondent dated November 14, 2016, Respondent stated that the "non-profit utilizes two email systems, AOL and Mail Chimp, both of which are free of charge." To read the response e-mail, refer to Exhibit 7.

14. During my investigation, I researched the e-mail system Mail Chimp. Pricing data indicates Mail Chimp offers free e-mail usage when there are 2,000 or fewer subscribers, and when there were only 12,000 e-mails sent per month. To review the pricing guide for Mail Chimp, refer

to Exhibit 8.

15. Also during my investigation, I researched the e-mail system AOL Mail. Pricing data indicates AOL Mail is a free e-mail system for all usage. To review the AOL Mail features, refer to Exhibit 9.

16. In the April 25, 2017 questionnaire-affidavit, Respondent stated there were approximately 875 people on the West Bradenton Crime Watch's e-mail list; Exhibit 4.

17. No record of Respondent having previously violated this section of law was found.

III. Alleged Violation of Section 106.19(1)(b), Florida Statutes:

18. I investigated whether Respondent violated this section of the election laws by failing to report one or more contributions required by the Florida Statutes.

19. According to Complainant, Respondent omitted in-kind contributions related to advertising placed in her own 501(c)(3) corporation's electronic material, including links in e-mail communications and newsletters; Exhibit 1; Exhibit 5.

20. Complainant provided an itemized list of campaign treasurer's reports submitted to the Manatee County Supervisor of Elections. A list of the In-Kind Contributions reported to the filing officer does not include a contribution from "Crime Watch Bradenton". To review the campaign treasurer's report, refer to Exhibit 10.

21. Additionally, in the campaign treasurer's reports that were submitted to the filing officer, expenditures were included. The reports do not indicate any expenditures made to "Crime Watch Bradenton" for advertisement space; Exhibit 10.

22. In the November 14, 2016 e-mail response from Respondent, she stated that she was a first-time candidate seeking local office, and was not aware that including the news of her candidacy in the West Bradenton Crime Watch would violate election laws. She stated, "news that one active volunteer of the non-profit is running for City Council is appropriately included in the non-profit's newsletter and on its Facebook page."; Exhibit 7.

23. As previously discussed in paragraphs 8 through 15, Respondent indicated there was no cost for advertising in the newsletter or through e-mail, and that no donation was necessary for her campaign as no expenses were incurred by the West Bradenton Crime Watch 501(c)(3).

24. No record of Respondent having previously violated this section of law was found.

IV. FEC History:

25. Respondent has no prior history with the Florida Elections Commission.

26. Complainant has no prior history with the Florida Elections Commission.

Conclusion:

27. In her November 14, 2016 e-mail response, Respondent stated she was a first-time candidate, and was not aware that including information regarding her campaign in the West Bradenton Crime Watch would violate election laws; Exhibit 7.

28. In the April 25, 2017 questionnaire-affidavit, Respondent indicated that no donation to the West Bradenton Crime Watch was necessary, as no expense was incurred for placing news of her candidacy in e-mails and in the electronic newsletter; Exhibit 4.


29. On January 29, 2016, Respondent filed the Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository (DS-DE 9 form) with the Manatee County Supervisor of Elections. She appointed Elizabeth D. Paganello as her campaign treasurer, and herself as deputy treasurer. To review the DS-DE 9 form, refer to Exhibit 11.

30. Also on January 29, 2016, Respondent filed the Statement of Candidate (DS-DE 84) form, indicating she had been provided access to read and understand the requirements of Chapter 106, Florida Statutes. To review the DS-DE 84 form, refer to Exhibit 12.

31. In the March 14, 2017 questionnaire-affidavit, Respondent stated she had never read Chapter 104 or 106, Florida Statutes, and that she did not receive a copy of the Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook; Exhibit 3.

32. On March 27, 2017, a questionnaire-affidavit was completed by Sharon Stief, Chief Deputy of the Manatee Supervisor of Elections Office. It was noted that publications of the Florida Statutes and the Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook are available in the office. Respondent was advised to pick-up the publications for herself, and was advised to download copies of the publications from the website. To review the March 27, 2017 questionnaire-affidavit, please refer to Exhibit 13.

Count 1. Allegedly Unauthorized Expenditures: Emails

Denied. No expenditure of money is involved. The nonprofit utilizes two email systems, AOL and Mail Chimp, both of which are free of charge. The non profit's facebook page is free. In addition no webmaster was paid for the nonprofit webpage to add a link. Tamara Spyker Goudy serves as the voluntary administrator for the nonprofit West Bradenton Crime Watch, and there is no salary involved.

Candidate Tamara Spyker Goudy, as a first time candidate seeking local city office, was not aware that including news of her candidacy in the West Bradenton Crime Watch might violate election laws. She does not believe that any such violation occurred, because news that one active volunteer of the non-profit is running for City Council is appropriately included in the non-profit's newsletter and on its facebook page.

Without admitting that any violation of election law might have occurred, but to ensure that her campaign adhered to the spirit as well as the letter of the law, Candidate Goudy immediately contacted the U.S. Internal Revenue Service to self-report. The date of self reporting to the IRS was October 20, 2016, via telephone to Agents Perry # 1000-96-396 and Picard # 1000-571-575.

Tamara Syker Goudy in her capacity as President of the West Bradenton Crime Watch newsletter immediately removed all information having to do with the candidate's campaign from the non profit Facebook page and stopped including news of her candidacy in the Neighborhood Crime Watch newsletters.

Count 2. Allegedly Unauthorized Expenditures: 6 Postcard Stamps

The value of 6 postcard stamps @ \$0.34 each is \$2.04. This charge is clearly frivolous. There is no intent to defraud the U.S. Postal Service.

One volunteer placed postcard flyers in 6 mailboxes on one day, despite clear instructions from the campaign **not** to place flyers in mailboxes. When the volunteer realized that she had made the error, she self reported to the campaign. The campaign corrected the volunteer and notified all other volunteers again that mailboxes were NOT to be used. The campaign reiterated previous discussion indicating that volunteers were to not place any postcards in mailboxes but to personally hand the postcards to residents without leaving them behind on the property. There is clearly no intent to defraud the U.S. Postal Service.

Candidate Tamara Spyker Goudy respectfully requests that the Florida Election Commission find no probable cause that any violation of election law occurred.

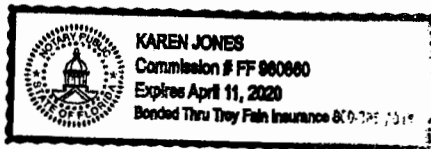

Section 106.19(1)(a), Florida Statutes: Tamara Goudy, a 2016 candidate for election to the Bradenton City Council, Seat 1, accepted one or more contributions in excess of the limits prescribed by Section 106.08, Florida Statutes, as alleged in the complaint.

Section 106.19(1)(b), Florida Statutes: Tamara Goudy, a 2016 candidate for election to the Bradenton City Council, Seat 1, failed to report one or more contributions required to be reported by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, as alleged in the complaint.

You may respond to the allegations above by filing a notarized statement providing any information regarding the facts and circumstances surrounding the allegations. Your response will be included as an attachment to the investigator's report.

When we conclude the investigation, a copy of the Report of Investigation will be mailed to you at the above address. You may file a response to the report within 14 days from the date the report is mailed to you. Based on the results of the investigation, legal staff will make a written recommendation to the Commission on whether there is probable cause to believe you have violated Chapter 104 or 106, Florida Statutes. A copy of the Staff Recommendation will be mailed to you and you may file a response within 14 days from the date the recommendation is mailed to you. Your timely filed response(s) will be considered by the Commission when determining probable cause.

The Commission will then hold a hearing to determine whether there is probable cause to believe you have violated Chapters 104 or 106, Florida Statutes. You and the complainant will receive a notice of hearing at least 14 days before the hearing. The notice of hearing will indicate the location, date, and time of your hearing. You will have the opportunity to make a brief oral statement to the Commission, but you will not be permitted to testify or call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence.


At any time before a probable cause finding, you may notify us in writing that you want to enter into negotiations directed towards reaching a settlement via consent agreement.

The Report of Investigation, Staff Recommendation, and Notice of Hearing will be mailed to the above address as this letter. Therefore, if your address changes, you must notify this office of your new address. Otherwise, you may not receive these important documents. Failure to receive the documents will not delay the probable cause hearing.

Under section 106.25, Florida Statutes, complaints, Commission investigations, investigative reports, and other documents relating to an alleged violation of Chapters 104 and 106, Florida Statutes, are confidential until the Commission finds probable cause or no probable cause. The confidentiality provision does not apply to the person filing the complaint. However, it does apply to you unless you waive confidentiality in writing. The confidentiality provision does not preclude you from seeking legal counsel. However, if you retain counsel, your attorney must file a notice of appearance with the Commission before any member of the Commission staff can discuss this case with him or her.

Count 1. Allegedly Unauthorized Expenditures: Emails

Denied. No expenditure of money is involved. The nonprofit utilizes two email systems, AOL and Mail Chimp, both of which are free of charge. The non profit's facebook page is free. In addition no webmaster was paid for the nonprofit webpage to add a link. Tamara Spyker Goudy serves as the voluntary administrator for the nonprofit West Bradenton Crime Watch, and there is no salary involved.

Candidate Tamara Spyker Goudy, as a first time candidate seeking local city office, was not aware that including news of her candidacy in the West Bradenton Crime Watch might violate election laws. She does not believe that any such violation occurred, because news that one active volunteer of the non-profit is running for City Council is appropriately included in the non-profit's newsletter and on its facebook page.

Without admitting that any violation of election law might have occurred, but to ensure that her campaign adhered to the spirit as well as the letter of the law, Candidate Goudy immediately contacted the U.S. Internal Revenue Service to self-report. The date of self reporting to the IRS was October 20, 2016, via telephone to Agents Perry # 1000-96-396 and Picard # 1000-571-575.

Tamara Syker Goudy in her capacity as President of the West Bradenton Crime Watch newsletter immediately removed all information having to do with the candidate's campaign from the non profit Facebook page and stopped including news of her candidacy in the Neighborhood Crime Watch newsletters.

Count 2. Allegedly Unauthorized Expenditures: 6 Postcard Stamps

The value of 6 postcard stamps @ \$0.34 each is \$2.04. This charge is clearly frivolous. There is no intent to defraud the U.S. Postal Service.

One volunteer placed postcard flyers in 6 mailboxes on one day, despite clear instructions from the campaign **not** to place flyers in mailboxes. When the volunteer realized that she had made the error, she self reported to the campaign. The campaign corrected the volunteer and notified all other volunteers again that mailboxes were NOT to be used. The campaign reiterated previous discussion indicating that volunteers were to not place any postcards in mailboxes but to personally hand the postcards to residents without leaving them behind on the property. There is clearly no intent to defraud the U.S. Postal Service.

Candidate Tamara Spyker Goudy respectfully requests that the Florida Election Commission find no probable cause that any violation of election law occurred.



Progress in Neighborhood Watch Program

Easy Pulled Pork

- 1 teaspoon vegetable oil
- 4 pound pork shoulder roast
- 1 cup of barbeque sauce
- 1/2 cup cider vinegar
- 1/2 cup chicken broth
- 1/4 light brown sugar
- 1 Tablespoon yellow mustard
- 1 Tablespoon Worcestershire sauce
- 1 Tablespoon chili powder
- 1 extra large onion, chopped
- 2 large cloves of garlic, crushed
- 1 1/2 teaspoons of dried thyme



Pour the oil into the bottom of a slow cooker. Place the roast into the slow cooker, pour in the barbeque sauce, vinegar, and broth. Stir the brown sugar, mustard, Worcestershire sauce, chili powder, onion, garlic and thyme. Cover and cook on high until the roast shreds easily with a fork, 5 to 6 hours. Remove the roast from the slow cooker, shred the meat using 2 forks. Return the shredded pork to the slow cooker and stir the meat into the juices. Spread the inside of both halves of a hamburger bun with butter. Toast the buns, butter side down, in a skillet over medium heat until golden brown. Spoon pork onto the buns and serve.

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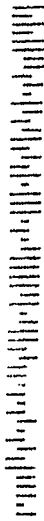
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
