Failure to appear in accordance with this notice will constitute a waiver of your right to participate in the hearing. Continuances will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

This hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, which governs your participation as follows:

If you are the Respondent, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are the Complainant, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are an Appellant, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

Please refer to the information below for further instructions related to your particular hearing:

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

SUMMARY: New Leadership PC is a political committee (PC) registered with the State of Florida. The PC's chair is Jose R. Santamaria and its treasurer is Alberto J. Ibarra.

The PC is appealing the fine claiming that unusual circumstances existed that caused the report to be filed untimely. According to Mr. Santamaria, "The PAC had a change of Treasurer which created the situation that unfolded as a late filing of the treasurer's report. The transition was done in an orderly fashion and the pack took measures to assure that the report due was file timely, however the change of treasurer's pin 2 days before the due date of the report was not an expected situation. The lack of experience of the new treasurer in this matters and the fact that he was unable to communicate with DOE officials on time to retrieve a new pin via telephone constitute an **Unusual Circumstance**. We understand that rule 2B-1.005(2)(a) clearly states that "**failure of the USPS of other mail delivery service to postmark an envelope, legibly postmark an envelope, or timely delivery mail**" shall not constitute an unusual circumstance, this clearly refers to correspondence mail to DOE **not to correspondence mailed by DOE**. DOE officials who diligently processed the change of treasurer and cancelled the old treasurer's pin two days prior to deadline for submission of such reports are not to be blamed. It was just a case in which an unforeseen and unusual chain of events developed in the inability by the pack to timely file the treasurer's report for the first time."

- The 2015 M6 Report covers the time period from 6/1/15 through 6/30/15.
- The PC reported receiving 1 contribution, while making 1 expenditure during this reporting period.
- The 2015 M6 Queued-Transactions Report reflects that this report was created on 7/6/15 at approximately 1:52 p.m., reviewed twice, before being filed on 7/15/15 at approximately 3:56 p.m.
- On 9/3/15, FEC staff made contact with the Chairperson to ensure that he was aware of this automatic fine appeal.
- A review of the DOE's chronological notes reflects that the only contact the PC had with the DOE occurred on 8/20/15 as a result of this automatic fine investigation.

**Appeal of Fines Imposed by Filing Officers pursuant to Section 106.04(8) or
106.07(8) under rules 2B-1.005 and 2B-1.0055**

We are formally appealing the automatically assessed fine for late filing the June 2015 treasurer's report due on July 10, 2015 in the amount \$1,150.00 under rules 2B-1.005 and 2B-1.0055 due to unusual and unforeseen circumstances.

Facts of the matter

- On July 1, 2015 a new treasurer was appointed by the PAC and paperwork was mailed to DOE via USPS
- DOE website shows that the paperwork was received on July 7, 2015
- DOE website shows that the response letter with the new pin was issued on July 8, 2015.
- On July 9, 2015, the PAC's CPA notified the new treasurer that the old pin was changed and the report was due the next day.
- On July 9 and 10, 2015 the new treasurers tried with no results to communicate via telephone with DOE to retrieve the new PIN Number required to submit the Treasurer's Report
- The correspondence from DOE arrived on July, 15, 2015 and the report was promptly filed.

Plea

Rule 2B-1.0055 Late filed reports define unusual circumstances as those ***"mean uncommon, rare or sudden events over which the actor has no control and which directly result in failure to act according to the filing requirements. Unusual circumstances shall include, but are not limited to the following circumstances: (f) The abrupt and unexpected loss of the campaign treasurer...."***

The Pack had a change of Treasurer which created the situation that unfolded as a late filing of the treasurer's report. The transition was done in an orderly fashion and the pack took measures to assure that the report due was file timely, however the change of treasurer's pin 2 days before the due date of the report was not an expected situation. The lack of experience of the new treasurer in this matters and the fact that he was unable to communicate with DOE officials on time to retrieve a new pin via telephone constitute an **Unusual Circumstance**.

We understand that rule 2B-1.005(2)(a) clearly states that ***"failure of the USPS or other mail delivery service to postmark an envelope, legibly postmark an envelope, or timely deliver mail"*** shall not

constitute an unusual circumstance, this clearly refers to correspondence mail to DOE **not to**
correspondence mailed by DOE. DOE officials who diligently processed the change of treasurer and
cancelled the old treasurer's pin two days prior to deadline for submission of such reports are not to be
blamed. It was just a case in which an unforeseen and unusual chain of events developed in the inability
by the pack to timely file the treasurer's report for the first time.

Based on the aforementioned facts and plea we have certainly demonstrated that unforeseen and
unusual circumstances beyond our control prevented us from filing the report on time. We respectfully
request your consideration to our formal Appeal in a hearing in which we can appear by telephone or
other electronic media at your earliest convenience.

Dear Mr. Ibarra:

Our records indicate that you have not filed either your campaign treasurer's report or notification that no reportable activity occurred, whichever is applicable. The filing date was July 10, 2015.

The law (s. 106.07(8)(b), Fla. Stat.) requires the filing officer to immediately notify you about the missed filing date and the automatic fines that will be assessed for late filing of a report, if a report was due.

- If reportable activity occurred and you have not filed a report, statutory fines are automatically assessed as follows until you file your report:
 - \$50 for the first 3 days late
 - \$500 per day for each day after the 3rd day late
 - If the required report immediately precedes a primary and general election, the automatic fine is \$500 for each late day.

The total fine for the untimely report cannot exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the cover period. Even if you end up filing your report late, we cannot waive the statutory fines. We will notify you of the specific amount of fines owed once you file your report. You have 20 days from the day you receive the notice to pay the fine or to appeal the fine to the Florida Elections Commission.

- If no reportable activity occurred for the report date(s), you are still required to notify us in writing, via the Division's Electronic Filing System, that no reportable activity occurred. No automatic fines are statutorily assessed.

However, in all cases, failure to file and/or untimely filing of a report of reportable activity, or if applicable, a notice that no reportable activity occurred, may constitute an apparent violation of chapter 106, Fla. Stat. If we refer such matter to the Florida Elections Commission, the Commission may subsequently impose a civil penalty for each violation under chapter 106.265(1), Fla. Stat.




