DEFAULT FINAL ORDER

THIS MATTER was referred to the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) by the filing officer for failure of the Respondent to pay the assessed fine

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The Commission is charged with enforcing Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, the campaign financing laws
- 2. Respondent is a political committee registered with the City of Palm Beach Gardens. Respondent's 2014 P2 campaign treasurer's report was not filed with the filing officer on July 11, 2014, the designated due date
- 3. On September 17, 2014, the filing officer sent a final fine notice to the Respondent by delivery confirmation advising them that the amount of the fine was \$256.83. The notice also advised Respondent, as required by Section 106.07(8)(b), Florida Statutes, that they must either pay the fine or appeal to the Florida Elections Commission within 20 days after receipt of the notice of payment due.
 - 4. Respondent has failed to pay the assessed fine or to appeal to the Commission

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

5. The Commission has jurisdiction over the parties to and subject matter of this case, pursuant to Section 106 07, Florida Statutes

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL

This order is final agency action. Any party who is adversely affected by this order has the right to seek judicial review pursuant to Section 120.68, Florida Statutes, by filing a notice of administrative appeal pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure, with the Clerk of the Florida Elections Commission at 107 West Gaines Street, Suite 224, Collins Building, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-1050, and by filing a copy of the notice of appeal with the appropriate district court of appeal. The party must attach to the notice of appeal a copy of this order and include with the notice of appeal filed with the district court of appeal the applicable filing fees. The notice of administrative appeal must be filed within 30 days of the date of this order is filed with the Commission. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order.

Notice to Filing Officer

The Clerk of the Florida Elections Commission will send a copy of this order to Respondent. The Final Order directs the Respondent to pay the Filing Officer. If the Filing Officer is not paid within 30 days of the date the Final Order is filed with the Commission, the Filing Officer can file an enforcement action in circuit court to enforce the fine that is due and owing to the county or municipality. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of this order.
