I, PAMELA OHAB, Affiant, after first being duly sworn on oath, depose and I do hereby swear or affirm that:

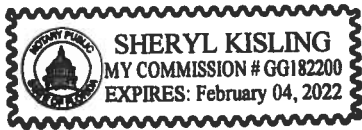
1. My name is Pamela Ohab. I am over the age of eighteen (18) years, fully competent to make this affidavit, and have personal knowledge of the facts stated herein.
2. I fully understand the meaning of all the terms of this affidavit.
3. I am a Certified Public Accountant and have served as the treasurer for many candidates over the past 15 years.
4. I am the Campaign Treasurer for Rhiannon Arnold, a candidate for Circuit Judge in the Ninth Judicial Circuit and I held that position beginning in January of 2019 and continue to do so.
5. As part of my duties, I am tasked with assisting with the financial account and all things financial with the Campaign to Elect Rhiannon Arnold, Circuit Court Judge.
6. I have been the only campaign treasurer since Ms. Arnold filed on January 8, 2019.
7. During the servicing of this campaign, I have been the person responsible for electronically filing the treasurer's report.
8. In January 2019, as I prepared a list of dates that reports were due to the Division of Elections, I went to the website and retrieved a calendar of due dates for the treasurer's reports.
9. The listed due date for February was February 12, 2019. This is the day that I submitted the report electronically.
10. We received a notification in March 2019 that the report was in fact late and the campaign was assessed a fine.
11. Upon receipt of the letter, I immediately called the Division of Elections Help Desk to inquire about the late file notice. The representative that assisted me looked on the website and located the same calendar I had utilized in my list of due dates. It also showed that February's report was due on February 12th.

12. After looking into the matter further, the representative located an updated calendar showing a due date of February 11th.
13. This calendar was not available at the time I was searching the website.
14. I relied on the calendar posted on the website in January 2019 to determine the due dates for the treasurer's reports.
15. The filing of the report on February 12th (when the actual due date was the 11th) was not a willful or intentional act to file the report late.
16. I was provided an updated calendar and all subsequent reports have been filed timely.

NOTICE OF HEARING (AUTOMATIC FINE)

A hearing will be held in this case before the Florida Elections Commission on, **August 13, 2019 at 8:30 am**, *or as soon thereafter as the parties can be heard*, at the following location: **Senate Office Building, 404 South Monroe Street, Room 110-S, Tallahassee, Florida 32399**. Due to heightened security access requirements, please bring only essential items into the building and plan to arrive early to allow for delays coming through security.

Failure to appear in accordance with this notice will constitute a waiver of your right to participate in the hearing. Continuances will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

This hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, which governs your participation as follows:

If you are the Respondent, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are the Complainant, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are an Appellant, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

If you require an accommodation due to a disability, contact Donna Ann Malphurs at (850) 922-4539 or by mail at 107 West Gaines Street, The Collins Building, Suite 224, Tallahassee, Florida 32399, at least 5 days before the hearing.

Please refer to the information below for further instructions related to your particular hearing:

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

SUMMARY: Rhiannon Arnold is a candidate for Circuit Judge, Circuit 9, Group 1 in the 2020 elections. Pamela Ohab is her treasurer.

Rhiannon Arnold is appealing the fine. According to Pamela Ohab, campaign treasurer, she followed the calendar of reporting dates retrieved from the Division of Elections website in January of 2019. She states that the calendar listed February 12th as the due date. Ms. Ohab also states that after receiving the late notice, she called the Division of Elections help desk and a representative retrieved the same incorrect calendar that she pulled from the website. She notes that after further review, the representative located an updated calendar with the due date of February 11th. Ms. Ohab states that this calendar was not available at the time and this was not a willful action to file the report after the due date.

- The 2019 M1 Original Report covers the period from 01/08/19-01/31/18; it was due on 02/11/19.
- The 2019 M1 Queued Transaction Report shows that it was created on 2/10/19 and filed on 2/12/19 at approximately 2:34pm.
- Rhiannon Arnold reported receiving 20 contributions, while making 15 expenditures.
- The Division of Elections does not have any notes that pertain to Rhiannon Arnold's 2019 M1 report.

Dear Ms. Arnold:

Our records indicate that you have not filed either your campaign treasurer's report or notification that no reportable activity occurred, whichever is applicable. The filing date was February 11, 2019.

The law (s. 106.07(8)(b), Fla. Stat.) requires the filing officer to immediately notify you about the missed filing date and the automatic fines that will be assessed for late filing of a report, if a report was due.

- If reportable activity occurred and you have not filed a report, statutory fines are automatically assessed as follows until you file your report:
 - \$50 per day for the first 3 days late
 - \$500 per day for each day after the 3rd day late
 - If the required report immediately precedes a primary and general election, the automatic fine is \$500 for each late day.

The total fine for the untimely report cannot exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the cover period. Even if you end up filing your report late, we cannot waive the statutory fines. We will notify you of the specific amount of fines owed once you file your report. You have 20 days from the day you receive the notice to pay the fine or to appeal the fine to the Florida Elections Commission.

- If no reportable activity occurred for the report date(s), you are still required to notify us in writing, via the Division's Electronic Filing System, that no reportable activity occurred. No automatic fines are statutorily assessed.

However, in all cases, failure to file and/or untimely filing of a report of reportable activity, or if applicable, a notice that no reportable activity occurred, may constitute an apparent violation of chapter 106, Fla. Stat. If we refer such matter to the Florida Elections Commission, the Commission may subsequently impose a civil penalty for each violation under chapter 106.265(1), Fla. Stat.

In the event that the EFS is inoperable on the due date, the report will be accepted as timely filed if filed no later than midnight of the first business day the EFS becomes operable. No fine will be levied during the period the EFS was inoperable.

Any candidate failing to file a report on the designated due date shall be subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first 3 days late and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

Electronic Receipts

The person submitting the report on the EFS will be issued an electronic receipt indicating and verifying the report was filed. Each campaign treasurer's report filed by means of the EFS is considered to be under oath by the candidate and campaign treasurer and such persons are subject to the provisions of Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes.


