ORDER OF PROBABLE CAUSE

THIS MATTER was heard by the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) at its regularly scheduled meeting on February 23, 2021, in Tallahassee, Florida.

On December 17, 2020, Staff recommended to the Commission that there was probable cause to believe that the Florida Election Code was violated. The facts articulated in Staff's Recommendation are adopted by reference and incorporated herein. Based on the Complaint, Report of Investigation, Staff's Recommendation, and oral statements (if any) made at the probable cause hearing, the Commission finds that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with the following violation(s):

Count 1:

On or about December 29, 2018, Javier Estevez violated Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, when he failed to timely file an addendum to the campaign's 2018 G5 Report within seven days after receiving notice from the Department of State, Division of Elections, that the report required amendment.

Count 2:

On or about December 29, 2018, Javier Estevez violated Section

106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, when he failed to timely file an addendum to the campaign's 2018 G6 Report within seven days after receiving notice from the Department of State, Division of Elections, that the report required amendment.

Count 3:

On or about February 8, 2019, Javier Estevez violated Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, when he failed to timely file an addendum to the campaign's 2018 G7 Report within seven days after receiving notice from the Department of State, Division of Elections, that the report required amendment.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO A HEARING

As the Respondent, you may elect to resolve this case in several ways. First, you may elect to resolve this case by <u>consent order</u> where you and Commission staff agree to resolve the violation(s) and agree to the amount of the fine. The consent order is then presented to the Commission for its approval. To discuss a consent order, contact the FEC attorney identified in the Order of Probable Cause.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(c), Florida Statutes, undersigned staff counsel files this written recommendation for disposition of the referral in this case recommending that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating **Section 106.07(2)(b)1.**, **Florida Statutes**. Based upon a thorough review of the Report of Investigation submitted on April 13, 2020, the following facts and law support this staff recommendation:

- 1. On February 11, 2019, the Florida Elections Commission ("Commission") received a referral from the Department of State, Division of Elections ("Division" or "Complainant"), alleging that Javier Estevez ("Respondent") violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.
- 2. Respondent was a 2018 candidate for State Representative, District 105. (ROI Exhibit 1)¹
- 3. By letter dated March 27, 2019, the Executive Director notified Respondent that Commission staff would investigate the following statutory provision:

Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2018 candidate for the office of State Representative, acting as his own treasurer, may have failed to timely make necessary amendments to the following campaign reports, as alleged in the complaint:

- 2018 G5
- 2018 G6
- 2018 G7
- 4. On September 6, 2017, Respondent filed his Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Candidates form ("DS-DE 9") appointing himself as treasurer for his campaign. (ROI Exhibit 1, page 1)
- 5. By letter dated September 7, 2017, Kristi Reid Willis, Chief, Bureau of Election Records, sent Respondent a letter acknowledging that the Division had received his DS-DE 9 and that his name was placed on the 2018 active candidate list. (ROI Exhibit 2, page 1)
- 6. The acknowledgment letter advised Respondent that all candidates filing reports with the Division are required to use the electronic filing system ("EFS"), and provided Respondent with a user identification number and initial password to grant access to the EFS. (ROI

Exhibit 2, page 1) The letter further advised Respondent that all of the Division's publications and reporting forms were available on its website and directed Respondent to print out Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, and the *Calendar of Reporting Dates*, as well as other relevant documents. (ROI Exhibit 2, page 2)

- 7. The campaign's 2018 G5, 2018 G6, and 2018 G7 reports were incomplete when filed. See Compl.
- 8. The Division sent seven letters notifying Respondent that the campaign's reports were incomplete and that Respondent was required to amend the reports within 7 days of receipt of the notification. An Error or Compliance Report showing why the reports were incomplete was attached to each notification. (ROI Exhibits 3-6) The final notifications were confirmed delivered. (ROI Exhibit 4, page 4; ROI Exhibit 6, page 3) As of March 27, 2020, Respondent had not filed the required amendments to his reports. (ROI Exhibit 7)
- 9. Respondent was given multiple opportunities to respond to Commission staff's investigation, but failed to do so. (ROI, p. 2, ¶¶9-11; ROI Exhibit 8)
- 10. "Probable Cause" is defined as reasonable grounds of suspicion supported by circumstances sufficiently strong to warrant a cautious person in the belief that the person has committed the offense charged. *Schmitt v. State*, 590 So. 2d 404, 409 (Fla. 1991). Probable cause exists where the facts and circumstances, of which an [investigator] has reasonably trustworthy information, are sufficient in themselves for a reasonable man to reach the conclusion that an offense has been committed. *Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles v. Favino*, 667 So. 2d 305, 309 (Fla. 1st DCA 1995).
- 11. The facts set forth above show that Respondent was a 2018 candidate for State Representative, District 105. Respondent failed to timely file the required amendments to the campaign's 2018 G5, 2018 G6, and 2018 G7 reports within 7 days of receiving notification from the Division that the reports were incomplete and required amendment.

Based upon these facts and circumstances, I recommend that the Commission find **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating the following:

Count 1:

On or about December 29, 2018, Javier Estevez violated Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, when he failed to timely file an addendum to the campaign's 2018 G5 Report within seven days after receiving notice from the Department of State, Division of Elections, that the report required amendment.

Count 2:

On or about December 29, 2018, Javier Estevez violated Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, when he failed to timely file an

addendum to the campaign's 2018 G6 Report within seven days after receiving notice from the Department of State, Division of Elections, that the report required amendment.

Count 3:

On or about February 8, 2019, Javier Estevez violated Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, when he failed to timely file an addendum to the campaign's 2018 G7 Report within seven days after receiving notice from the Department of State, Division of Elections, that the report required amendment.

Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, failure of the treasurer for a candidate or political committee to file an addendum to an incomplete report after receiving notice from the filing officer.

Division of Elections (Division) Referral Filed: February 11, 2019

Respondent Type: Treasurer for Candidate

I. Preliminary Information:

1. I investigated whether Respondent violated this section of the election laws by failing to file amended reports for the following campaign treasurer's reports after receiving notice from the filing officer: 2018 G5, G6, G7.

- 2. An appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository (DS-DE 9) was filed on September 6, 2017. Respondent was named as the treasurer for his campaign for State Representative, District 105. To review the DS-DE 9, refer to Exhibit 1.
- 3. On September 7, 2017, the Division sent Respondent a letter acknowledging his appointment as the campaign treasurer for his campaign for State Representative. The letter advised Respondent that all of the Division's publications and reporting forms are available on their website, including Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, the *Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook*, and the *Calendar of Reporting Dates*. The letter further advised Respondent that it was his responsibility to read, understand, and follow the requirements of Florida's election laws. To review a copy of the acknowledgement letter, refer to Exhibit 2.

II. Alleged Violation of Section 106.07(2)(b)(1)., Florida Statutes:

- 4. On October 22, 2018, October 29, 2018 and November 15, 2018¹, the Division sent correspondence to Respondent informing him that one or more campaign reports were incomplete. The correspondence was sent to Respondent's address provided on the DS-DE 9 and included an error report referencing the following reports: 2018 G5 and G6. To review the correspondence and error report, refer to Exhibit 3.
- 5. On December 19, 2018, the Division sent Respondent a letter marked "Final Notice" with delivery confirmation informing him that one or more campaign reports were incomplete. The letter was sent to Respondent's address provided on the DS-DE 9 and included an error report referencing the following reports: 2018 G5 and G6. It was confirmed delivered on December 22, 2018. To review the Final Notice letter, error report and delivery confirmation, refer to Exhibit 4.
- 6. On November 5, 2018 and December 6, 2018, the Division sent correspondence to Respondent informing him that one or more campaign reports were incomplete. The correspondence was sent to Respondent's address provided on the DS-DE 9 and included an error report referencing the following reports: 2018 G7. To review the correspondence and error report, refer to Exhibit 5.

¹ The 2018 G5 and G6 notifications were combined in the second letter on November 15, 2018.

- 7. On January 30, 2019, the Division sent Respondent a letter marked "Final Notice" with delivery confirmation informing him that one or more campaign reports were incomplete. The letter was sent to Respondent's address provided on the DS-DE 9 and included an error report referencing the following report: 2018 G7. It was confirmed delivered on February 1, 2019. To review the Final Notice letter, error report and delivery confirmation, refer to Exhibit 6.
- 8. In an email dated March 27, 2020, Division staff confirmed that Respondent has not correctly amended any of the reports at issue. To review the email from Division staff, refer to Exhibit 7.



On February 11, 2019, the Florida Elections Commission received a complaint alleging that you violated Florida's election laws. I have reviewed the complaint and find that it contains one or more **legally sufficient allegations**. The Commission staff will investigate the following alleged violation:

Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2018 candidate for the office of State Representative, acting as his own treasurer, may have failed to timely make necessary amendments to the following campaign reports, as alleged in the complaint:

When we conclude the investigation, a copy of the Report of Investigation (ROI) will be mailed to you at the above address.
