NOTICE OF RIGHT TO A HEARING

STAFF RECOMMENDATION FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(c), Florida Statutes, undersigned staff counsel files this written recommendation for disposition of the referral in this case recommending that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating **Section 106.07(2)(b)1.**, **Florida Statutes**. Based upon a thorough review of the Report of Investigation submitted on September 17, 2020, the following facts and law support this staff recommendation:

- 1. On May 15, 2020, the Florida Elections Commission ("Commission") received a referral from the Department of State, Division of Elections ("Division" or "Complainant"), alleging that Javier Estevez ("Respondent") violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.
- 2. Respondent was a 2020 candidate for State Representative, District 105. (ROI Exhibit 1)¹
- 3. By letter dated June 10, 2020, the Executive Director notified Respondent that Commission staff would investigate the following statutory provision:

Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2020 candidate for the office of State Representative, District 105, acting as his own treasurer, failed to timely make necessary amendments to the 2020 M1 campaign treasurer report, as alleged in the complaint.

- 4. On November 26, 2018, Respondent filed his Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Candidates form ("DS-DE 9") appointing himself as treasurer for his campaign. (ROI Exhibit 1)
- 5. By letter dated November 27, 2018, Kristi Reid Willis, Chief, Bureau of Election Records, sent Respondent a letter acknowledging that the Division had received his DS-DE 9 and that his name was placed on the 2020 active candidate list. (ROI Exhibit 2, page 1)
- 6. The acknowledgment letter advised Respondent that all candidates filing reports with the Division are required to use the electronic filing system ("EFS"), and provided Respondent with a user identification number and initial password to grant access to the EFS. (ROI Exhibit 2, page 1) The letter further advised Respondent that all of the Division's publications and reporting forms were available on its website and directed Respondent to print out Chapter 106,

Florida Statutes, and the *Calendar of Reporting Dates*, as well as other relevant documents. (ROI Exhibit 2, page 2)

- 7. The campaign's 2020 M1 Report was incomplete when filed. See Compl.
- 8. The Division sent three letters notifying Respondent that the campaign's report was incomplete and that Respondent was required to amend the report within 7 days of receipt of the notification. An Error Report showing why the report was incomplete was attached to each notification. (ROI Exhibits 3 & 4) The final notification was confirmed delivered. (ROI Exhibit 4, page 3) As of September 3, 2020, Respondent had not filed the required amendment to his report. (ROI Exhibit 5)
- 9. Respondent was given multiple opportunities to respond to Commission staff's investigation, but failed to do so. (ROI, pp. 1-2, ¶¶7-9; ROI Exhibit 6)
- 10. "Probable Cause" is defined as reasonable grounds of suspicion supported by circumstances sufficiently strong to warrant a cautious person in the belief that the person has committed the offense charged. Schmitt v. State, 590 So. 2d 404, 409 (Fla. 1991). Probable cause exists where the facts and circumstances, of which an [investigator] has reasonably trustworthy information, are sufficient in themselves for a reasonable man to reach the conclusion that an offense has been committed. Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles v. Favino, 667 So. 2d 305, 309 (Fla. 1st DCA 1995).
- 11. The facts set forth above show that Respondent was a 2020 candidate for State Representative, District 105. Respondent failed to timely file the required amendment to the campaign's 2020 M1 Report within 7 days of receiving notification from the Division that the report was incomplete and required amendment.

Based upon these facts and circumstances, I recommend that the Commission find **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating the following:

Count 1:

On or about April 2, 2020, Javier Estevez violated Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, when he failed to timely file an addendum to the campaign's 2020 M1 Report within seven days after receiving notice from the Department of State, Division of Elections, that the report required amendment.

I. Preliminary Information:

- 1. I investigated whether Respondent violated this section of the election laws by failing to file amended report for the following campaign treasurer's report after receiving notice from the filing officer: 2020 M1.
- 2. An Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository (DS-DE 9) was filed on November 26, 2018. Respondent was named as the treasurer for Javier Estevez, 2020 candidate for State Representative, District 105. To review the DS-DE 9, refer to Exhibit 1.
- 3. On November 27, 2018, the Division sent Respondent a letter acknowledging his appointment as the campaign treasurer for Javier Estevez's campaign. The letter advised Respondent that all of the Division's publications and reporting forms are available on their website, including Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, the *Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook*, and the *Calendar of Reporting Dates*. The letter further advised Respondent that it was his responsibility to read, understand, and follow the requirements of Florida's election laws. To review a copy of the acknowledgement letter, refer to Exhibit 2.

II. Alleged Violation of Section 106.07(2)(b)(1)., Florida Statutes:

- 4. On February 17, 2020 and March 5, 2020, the Division sent correspondence to Respondent informing him that one or more campaign reports were incomplete. The correspondence was sent to Respondent's address provided on the DS-DE 9 and included an error report referencing the following report: 2020 M1. To review the correspondence and error reports, refer to Exhibit 3.
- 5. On March 23, 2020, the Division sent Respondent a letter marked "Final Notice" with delivery confirmation informing him that one or more campaign reports were incomplete. The letter was sent to Respondent's address provided on the DS-DE 9 and included an error report referencing the following report: 2020 M1. It was confirmed delivered on March 26, 2020. To review the Final Notice letter, error report and delivery confirmation, refer to Exhibit 4.
- 6. In an email dated September 3, 2020, Division staff confirmed that Respondent has not correctly amended the report at issue. To review the email from Division staff, refer to Exhibit 5.
 - 7. Respondent did not respond to the referral.
- 8. Respondent did not respond to a questionnaire-affidavit. Because the affidavit has not been returned, I am unable to ascertain whether he has read Chapter 106, Florida Statutes and/or the *Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook*.

Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2020 candidate for the office of State Representative, District 105, acting as his own treasurer, failed to timely make necessary amendments to the 2020 M1 campaign treasurer report, as alleged in the complaint.

When we conclude the investigation, a copy of the Report of Investigation (ROI) will be mailed to you at the above address. Based on the results of the investigation, a staff attorney will prepare and present a written Staff Recommendation (SR) to the Commission as to whether there is probable cause to charge you, the Respondent, with violating Chapters 104 or 106, Florida Statutes. You will have an opportunity to respond to both the ROI and the SR.
