ORDER OF PROBABLE CAUSE

The Commission also finds there is no probable cause to charge Respondent with violating Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes for certifying his 2017 SG2 Report was true, correct and complete.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(c), Florida Statutes, undersigned staff counsel files this written recommendation for disposition of the complaint in this case recommending that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating **Sections 106.07(5)**, and 106.141(1), **Florida Statutes**, Based upon a thorough review of the Report of Investigation submitted on November 25, 2019, the following facts and law support this staff recommendation.

- 1. On August 8, 2018, the Florida Elections Commission ("Commission") received a referral from the Division of Elections ("Division") alleging Jose Vazquez ("Respondent") violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.
- 2. Respondent was a candidate in the December 19, 2017 special election for the House of Representatives, District 58. He was defeated. (Attachment A) Respondent's initial Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Candidates form ("DS-DE 9") was filed with the Division on August 7, 2017. Respondent appointed himself as his own campaign treasurer. (Attachment B) Respondent filed a second DS-DE 9 on August 16, 2017, appointing Michael A. Steinberg as his new campaign treasurer. (ROI Exhibit 1) ¹
- 3. By letter dated February 14, 2019, the Executive Director notified Respondent that Commission staff would investigate the following alleged violations:

Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2017 special election candidate for State Representative, may have certified one or more campaign treasurer reports were true, correct, and complete when they were not.

Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2017 special election candidate for State Representative, filed a 2018 Termination Report that may have failed to accurately reflect the disposition of all remaining campaign funds.

4. By letter dated August 7, 2017, Kristi Reid Willis, Chief, Bureau of Election Records, Division of Elections, notified Respondent that his name had been placed on the active candidate list for the 2017 Special Election for State Representative, District 58. The letter

advised Respondent that all candidates who file reports with the Division are required to use the Division's Electronic Filing System ("EFS") and provided Respondent with a user identification number and initial password to access the EFS. The letter also stated that, "Each campaign treasurer's report filed by means of the EFS is considered to be under oath by the candidate and campaign treasurer and such persons are subject to the provisions of Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes." (ROI Exhibit 13)

5. Ms. Willis' August 7, 2017 letter further advised Respondent that all the Division's publications and reporting forms were available on the Division's website and directed Respondent to print a copy of Chapters 104 and 106, Florida Statutes, the *Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook* ("Handbook"), and the *Calendar of Reporting Dates* as well as other documents. (ROI Exhibit 13, page 2)

Sections 106.07(5) and 106.141(1), Florida Statutes:

6. The referral alleged Respondent certified his 2017 SG2 and 2018 Termination Reports ("TR") were true, correct, and complete when they were not, and Respondent failed to timely file a report accurately reflecting the disposition of all remaining campaign funds.

2017 SG2 Report

- 7. Respondent's 2017 SG2 Report covering the dates of November 7, 2017, through December 14, 2017, was due on December 15, 2017. (Attachment C, page 3; Attachment D) Respondent filed his original 2017 SG2 Report on December 14, 2017. (Attachment D) Respondent filed amended 2017 SG2 Reports on December 18, 2017, June 19, 2018, July 2, 2018, and January 24, 2019. Respondent certified his original and amended 2017 SG2 Reports were true, correct, and complete. (Attachment E)
- 8. On his original 2017 SG2 Report, Respondent listed a \$60 cash contribution from Gary Gibbons. (Attachment E, page 1, sequence 9) On his June 19, 2019 amended SG2 Report, Respondent changed the amount of the cash contribution from \$60 to \$50. (Attachment E, page, page 9, sequence 9)² Therefore, when Respondent certified his original 2017 SG2 Report was true, correct, and complete, it was not.

2018 Termination Report³

9. Respondent's 2018 TR covering the dates of December 15, 2017, through March 18, 2018, was due on March 19, 2018. (Attachment C, page 4; Attachment D) Respondent filed his original 2018 TR on March 18, 2018. (Attachment D) Respondent filed amended 2018 TRs on March 19, 2018, June 19, 2018, July 2, 2018, January 24, 2019, and January 31, 2019. Respondent certified each report was true, correct, and complete. (Attachment F)

The maximum cash contribution a person can give a candidate is \$50 per election. §106.09, Fla. Stat.

The Termination Report is due within 90 days of a candidate being elected, being defeated, withdrawing his candidacy or becoming unopposed. §106.141(1), Fla. Stat.

- 10. Respondent's bank records show that Respondent received contributions and made expenditures that he failed to list on his original and amended 2018 TRs.⁴ (ROI Exhibits 4-8 and Attachment F)⁵
- 11. Based on the information above, it appears Respondent may have certified campaign reports were true, correct and complete when they were not. It also appears Respondent may have failed to file a termination report that accurately reflected the disposition of all remaining campaign funds within 90 days of being defeated.
- 12. During a November 19, 2019 telephone conversation, Respondent told Investigator Smith that to his knowledge everything was reported and that his reports were filed based on activity from his bank statements. Respondent stated that he previously ran for public office and he did not fully read Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, or the Handbook, because Spanish was Respondent's primary language and he had some difficulties reading the materials. Respondent told Investigator Smith that he was responsible for entering contributions and expenditures submitted to the Division and that he personally reviewed his campaign reports along with his campaign bank statements. (ROI Exhibit 12, Phone Log Entry 4)
- 13. "Probable Cause" is defined as a reasonable ground of suspicion supported by circumstances sufficiently strong to warrant a cautious person in the belief that the person has committed the offense charged. Schmitt v. State, 590 So.2d 404, 409 (Fla. 1991). Probable cause exists where the facts and circumstances, of which an [investigator] has reasonably trustworthy information, are sufficient in themselves for a reasonable man to reach the conclusion that an offense has been committed. Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles v. Favino, 667 So.2d 305, 309 (Fla. 1st DCA 1995).
- 14. Respondent was a candidate for the House of Representatives, District 58, in the December 19, 2017 special election. Respondent was defeated. Respondent's initial Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Candidates form was filed with the Division on August 7, 2017. Respondent appointed himself as his own campaign treasurer. Respondent filed a second on August 16, 2017, appointing Michael A. Steinberg as his new campaign treasurer.
- 15. The above facts also show that Respondent timely filed his original 2017 SG2 Report and 2018 Termination Report. Respondent certified each report was true, correct, and complete when it was not.
- 16. Additionally, the above facts show that even though Respondent was required to file a termination report that accurately reflected the disposition of all remaining campaign funds within 90 days of being defeated, he failed to do so.

⁴ Respondent's original 2018 TR listed one expenditure and Respondent made a total of 10 corrections on his amended 2018 TRs. (Attachment F)

Respondent's bank records show Respondent made two expenditures after the termination reporting period. (ROI Exhibit 7)

Based on the foregoing, I recommend the Commission find probable cause to charge Respondent with the following violations:

Count 1:

On or about December 14, 2017, Respondent violated Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes, when Respondent certified his 2017 SG2 Report was true, correct, and complete when it was not.

Count 2

On or about March 18, 2018, Respondent violated Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes, when Respondent certified his 2018 Termination Report was true, correct, and complete when it was not.

Count 3:

On or about March 18, 2018, Respondent violated Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes, when Respondent failed to file a termination report accurately reflecting the disposition of all remaining campaign funds.

Section 2.



- 3. Full and Public Disclosure of Financial Interests (2016 CE Form 6). A public officer who has filed a full and public disclosure or statement of financial interests for the year 2016 with the Commission on Ethics prior to qualifying for office may file a copy of that disclosure at the time of qualifying. NOTE: If you are an incumbent and will be filing a copy of CE Form 6 for 2016 as a qualifying requirement, the copy must be filed stamped by the Florida Commission on Ethics (COE). In the alternative, you may provide a cover letter with your signature stating that the original CE Form 6 for 2016 has been filed with the COE.

In addition to the three forms referenced above, a candidate qualifying by the fee method must submit a properly executed campaign check signed by the treasurer or a deputy treasurer in the amount of \$1,781.82 (partisan) or \$1,187.88 (no party affiliation.)

<u>Candidates who seek to qualify by the use of candidate petitions</u> must submit the petitions to the Hillsborough County Supervisor of Elections by 5:00 p.m., August 9, 2017. The required number of verified candidate petitions is <u>236</u>. Obtaining the required number of signatures only excuses the candidate from paying the qualifying fee and party assessment.

Section 106.07, Florida Statutes, requires you and your campaign treasurer to file reports of all contributions received and expenditures made. Your Calendar of Reporting Dates is listed below.

ADDITIONAL FILING REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Although not required for qualifying, each candidate must file a Statement of Candidate (DS-DE 84) with the Division of Elections within 10 days after filing the Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository. Willful failure to file this form is a violation of Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.
- 2. In addition, Section 106.141, Florida Statutes, requires that each candidate who withdraws his or her candidacy, becomes unopposed, or is eliminated or elected to office, within 90 days, dispose of the funds on deposit in his or her campaign account and file a termination report reflecting the disposition of all remaining funds.

FLORIDA ELECTIONS COMMISSION REPORT OF INVESTIGATION

Case No.: FEC 18-208

Respondent: Jose Vazquez

Complainant: Division of Elections

On August 8, 2018, the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) received information from the Division of Elections (Division) alleging that Respondent violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes. Commission staff investigated whether Respondent violated the following statutes:

Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes, prohibiting a candidate from certifying to the correctness of a campaign treasurer's report that is incorrect, false, or incomplete; and

Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes, failure of a candidate to dispose properly of funds remaining in his campaign account within 90 days after he withdrew, became unopposed, was eliminated, or elected.

I. Preliminary Information:

- 1. Respondent, Jose Vazquez, was a candidate for the 2017 Special Election for State Representative, District 58; he was defeated in the election held on December 19, 2017. Respondent has previously sought the same office in 2012, 2014, and 2016, having been defeated twice and eventually withdrawing as a write-in candidate on one occasion.
- 2. On August 16, 2017, Respondent's "APPOINTMENT OF CAMPAIGN TREASURER AND DESIGNATION OF CAMPAIGN DEPOSITORY FOR CANDIDATES" form (DS-DE 9) was filed with the Division. Respondent appointed Michael A. Steinberg, as his campaign treasurer. To review Form DS-DE 9, refer to Exhibit 1.
 - 3. Complainant is the Division
- 4. Respondent's filing officer was Kristi Reid Willis, Chief, Bureau of Election Records.

II. Alleged Violation of Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes:

5. I investigated whether Respondent violated this section of the election laws by certifying to the correctness of campaign treasurer reports as true, correct, and complete, when they were not.

- 6. Complainant included with the referral a copy of a printout, Sum of Contributions vs Expenditures. The printout reflects a balance of \$932.20 after the filing of the termination-report, suggesting that a campaign report or multiple campaign reports, may be incorrect, false, or incomplete. To review the Sum of Contributions vs Expenditures printout, refer to Exhibit 2.
- 7. Respondent's campaign account records were subpoenaed from his designated campaign depository, Fifth Third Bank, and compared to his campaign reports on file with the Division. Discrepancies were found between the bank records and Respondent's 2018 Termination-Report, covering the reporting period of December 15, 2017 to March 18, 2018.
- 8. Respondent's 2018 Termination-Report was initially filed with the Division on March 18, 2018 and was amended on March 19, 2018, June 19, 2018, July 2, 2018, January 24, 2019 and January 31, 2019¹. Respondent certified each campaign report as true, correct and complete. To review a copy of the 2018 Termination-Report, refer to Exhibit 3.

Expenditures (Withdrawals/Debits)

9. Table 1 below lists the expenditures not reported in Respondent's 2018 Termination-Report from December 15 – December 31, 2017.

12. Respondent's campaign account records also disclosed a \$3.00 Service Charge on March 12, 2018 that was not disclosed in Respondent's 2018 Termination-Report. To review the monthly bank statement for March 2018, refer to Exhibit 7.

Contributions (Deposits/Credits)

13. In addition to the expenditures not reported in the 2018 Termination-Report, campaign account records disclose that a number of contributions, made through an on-line vendor, were not reported during the reporting period covering the 2018 Termination-Report, which covered December 15, 2017 – March 18, 2018. Table 4 below lists the contributions not reported.

In addition to the expenditures and contributions not reported as reflected in paragraphs 9 – 13, Respondent's 2018 Termination-Report disclosed an expenditure to Hillsborough County Democratic Executive Committee in the amount of \$49.93 on January 30, 2018; the bank records are void of any expenditure in the amount of \$49.93. To review the 2018 Termination-Report, refer to Exhibit 3.

- 15. Complainant notified Respondent that an expenditure to Metro Meat Market in his 2017 SG2 campaign report did not include an amount for the expenditure. Respondent's 2017 SG2 campaign report, covering the reporting period of November 7 December 14, 2017, was originally filed with the Division on December 14, 2017. Respondent certified the original report as true, correct, and complete. To review the error report, refer to Exhibit 9. To review the 2017 SG2 campaign report, refer to Exhibit 10.
- 16. Respondent's 2017 SG2 campaign report was amended on December 18, 2017, June 19, 2018 and July 2, 2018; Respondent certified each amended report as true, correct, and complete. Respondent's amended 2017 SG2 campaign report filed on July 2, 2018 disclosed an expenditure to Metro Meat Market in the amount of \$42.20 for the purpose of "Food for Kick off the vote event 11/19." The expenditure in the amount of \$42.20 is reflected in Respondent's campaign account records as a debit-card purchase on November 20, 2017. To review the November 2017 bank statement, refer to Exhibit 11.
 - 17. Respondent did not offer a response to the referral.
- 18. In a telephone interview on November 19, 2019, Respondent said to his knowledge everything was reported. Respondent stipulated that he was responsible for entering the contribution and expenditure activity in his campaign reports and that he personally reviewed each campaign report. Respondent added that he filed his campaign reports based on the activity from his bank statements. To review the phone log, refer to Exhibit 12.
- 19. No record was found to indicate that Respondent has previously violated this section of the election laws.

III. Alleged Violation of Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes:

20. I investigated whether Respondent violated this section of the election laws by filing a 2018 Termination-Report that may have failed to reflect the disposition of all remaining

campaign funds.

- 21. Respondent was defeated in the special election held on December 19, 2017. Therefore, it appears that Respondent was required to dispose of his surplus funds by March 18, 2018. As previously addressed, Respondent filed his 2018 Termination-Report, covering the reporting period of December 15, 2017 March 18, 2018, with the Division on March 18, 2018.
- 22. As per paragraph six, a printout of Sum of Contributions vs Expenditures, included with the referral from the Division, indicated a balance of \$932.30 remained in the account after the filing of the 2018 Termination-Report. The monthly bank statement for March 2018 disclosed that the balance on March 18, 2018 was \$473.41. The campaign account had a zero balance on March 19, 2018, the day after. A check in the amount of \$313.48² was paid and a withdrawal, in the form of a cashier's check, in the amount of \$159.93³ was made; both transactions transpired on March 19, 2018. To review the March 2018 bank statement, refer to Exhibit 7.
- 23. No record was found to indicate that Respondent has previously violated this section of the election laws.

IV. FEC History:

24. Respondent has had prior cases before the Commission. In FEC 15-011, Respondent was found to have violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, on four occasions and was fined \$250. Respondent has also had two previous cases, FEC 15-382 and FEC 13-011, before the Commission relative to automatic fines. In FEC 13-204, no probable cause was found for Section 106.07(2)(b)1, Florida Statutes. None of the fines have been paid.

Conclusion:

- 25. In a telephone interview, Respondent said that he never fully read Chapter 106, Florida Statutes nor the *Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook* primarily due to his primary language being Spanish. Respondent reiterated that he believed everything had been reported as he reviewed his campaign reports against his bank statements. To review the phone log, refer to Exhibit 12.
- 26. In a letter dated August 7, 2017, Ms. Willis notified Respondent that his name had been placed on the active candidate list for the 2017 Special Election. The last paragraph of the letter informed Respondent that all of the Division's publications and reporting forms were available on the Division's website. The letter stated, "It is your responsibility to read, understand, and follow the requirements of Florida's election laws. Therefore, please print a copy of the following documents: Chapters 104 and 106, Florida Statutes, Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook, Calendar of Reporting Dates, and Rule 1S-2.017, Florida

Summary: Respondent called in response to having received a questionnaire-affidavit from me wherein one question was to why certain expenditures were not reported in his TR.

Respondent said that to his knowledge everything was reported. He added that his reports were filed based on activity from his bank statements. I informed Respondent that I had reviewed his bank account records and I was unable to locate six expenditures in the TR and informed him that he would receive a copy of my report of investigation, with exhibits, showing him what was found in my review. Respondent was advised to make sure that he thoroughly reviewed the report of investigation along with the exhibits and respond accordingly; he said he understood.

Respondent acknowledged that he had previously run for elective office prior to this election. When asked whether he read Chapter 106, Florida Statutes and the Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook, he said he never fully read it. He explained that his primary language is Spanish, and he had some difficulty reading the materials.

I inquired of him as to who was responsible for entering the contribution and expenditure activity in to his campaign reports that were eventually submitted to the Division for filing. He said that he was responsible and that he personally reviewed his campaign reports along with the bank statements.

On August 8, 2018, the Florida Elections Commission received a complaint alleging that you violated Florida's election laws. I have reviewed the complaint and find that it contains one or more legally sufficient allegations. The Commission staff will investigate the following alleged violations:

Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2017 special election candidate for State Representative, may have certified one or more campaign treasurer reports were true, correct, and complete when they were not.

Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2017 special election candidate for State Representative, filed a 2018 Termination Report that may have failed to accurately reflect the disposition of all remaining campaign funds.

When we conclude the investigation, a copy of the Report of Investigation (ROI) will be mailed to you at the above address. Based on the results of the investigation, a staff attorney will make a written recommendation (Staff Recommendation or SR) to the Commission as to whether there is probable cause to charge respondent with violating Chapters 104 or 106, Florida Statutes. You will have an opportunity to respond to both the ROI and the SR. The Commission will then hold one or more hearings to determine whether the alleged violations occurred and, if so, the amount of the fine to be imposed. You and the complainant will receive notice at least 14 days before any hearing at which your case is to be considered.

Please note that all documents related to this matter will be mailed to the above address unless you **notify us of a new address**. Also, please remember that complaints, Commission investigations, investigative reports, and other documents relating to an alleged violation of Chapters 104 or 106, Florida Statutes, are **confidential** until the Commission finds probable cause or no probable cause.
