A hearing will be held in this case before the Florida Elections Commission on, May 14, 2019 at 8:30 am, or as soon thereafter as the parties can be heard, at the following location: Senate Office Building, 404 South Monroe Street, Room 110-S, Tallahassee, Florida 32399. Due to heightened security access requirements, please bring only essential items into the building and plan to arrive early to allow for delays coming through security.

Failure to appear in accordance with this notice will constitute a waiver of your right to participate in the hearing. Continuances will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

This hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, which governs your participation as follows:

If you are the Respondent, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have 5 minutes to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are the Complainant, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are an Appellant, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have 5 *minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

SUMMARY: Electing Women in Northwest Dade is a political committee (PC) registered with the State of Florida. The PC's chair and treasurer is Ivette Gonzalez Petkovich.

The PC is appealing the fine. According to Ms. Gonzalez Petkovich, the report was filed five minutes after the deadline because she had difficulty maneuvering through the electronic filing system. She notes that the PC was officially organized on or about October 3, 2018. Ms. Gonzalez Petkovich also states that this was her first-time reporting expenditures and that she is still learning how to navigate the EFS system. Due to these circumstances and in light of the short period within which the PC was formed, Ms. Ms. Gonzalez Petkovich requests that the commission consider reducing the fine.

- The 2018 D6 Original Report covers the period from 10/31/18-30/31/18; it was due on 11/02/18.
- The 2018 D6 Queued Transaction Report shows that it was created on 01/01/18 at approximately 11:20pm and filed on 1102/18 at approximately 12:16am.
- Electing Women in Northwest Dade reported receiving 3 contributions, while making 2 expenditures.
- The Division of Elections does not have any notes that pertain to Electing Women in Northwest Dade's 2018 D6 report.

Re: Appeal of Fine - Campaign Treasurer's Report due November 1, 2018 (D6)

Please accept this correspondence as a formal appeal of the fine your Commission and/or the Division of Elections imposed on the political committee ("PC") Electing Women in Northwest Dade as a result of the PC's late filing which was due November 2, 2018. More specifically, while the filing was due November 1, 2018, the PC did not file its report until November 2, 2019 at 12:05 a.m., just 5 minutes past the midnight deadline. The reason for the late filing was because I, as chairwoman and treasurer, had difficulty maneuvering through the electronic filing system in order to properly input the requisite information necessary to generate the report. As your records will reflect, the PC was organized on or about October 3, 2018. The late report at issue here and for which I am writing an appeal, was just the first filing where I was required to report expenditures. Unfortunately, I do not believe there are any accessible resources either by way of training or online resources for example, which offer guidance to a chairperson or treasurer of a PC on how to navigate the Division's Online Reporting System. Thus, the report was filed five minutes late because I was essentially new to the system, still learning, and admittedly struggling, on how to use it. While I recognize that the above referenced explanation is not one of the enumerated uncommon circumstances listed in Rule 2B-1.0055(1)(a)-(g), Rule 2B-1.0055(1) does state that "[u]nusual circumstances shall include, but are not limited to," (emphasis added) those listed in subsection (a) through (g). As such I would humbly ask the Commission via this appeal and the explanation provided herein to deem the PC's failure to timely file the November 2, 2018 report an unusual circumstance. Alternatively, I would ask the Commsion that in light of the short period within which the PC was formed and the explanation provided including, most importantly, the fact that the tardiness of the report was at most five (5) minutes, please consider waiving the fine altogether, or alternatively, reducing the fine to fifty dollars (\$50).

I am hopeful that you will understand the circumstances surrounding the violation and determine that a waiver of the fine is appropriate in this case. If you have any questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to contact me at (305) 358-8003.

A notice of hearing will be mailed to you approximately two weeks before the scheduled meeting. Please notify our office immediately should your address change in order to ensure timely receipt of future correspondence from the Commission.

In reaching its decision, the Commission will consider the documents gathered by Commission staff and any documents you submit for the Commission's consideration before the hearing. Unless good cause is shown, the Commission will not consider at the hearing any written document unless it has been filed with the Commission Clerk at least ten days before the hearing. Rules 2B-1005 and 1.0055, *Florida Administrative Code*, are the Commission's rules on the appeal of automatic fines; a copy of the rules is enclosed.

The Commission will uphold the fine imposed by the filing officer unless you present credible evidence that the report was timely filed or credible evidence that unusual circumstances caused the report to be filed late.

2B-1.005 Appeal of Fines Imposed by Filing Officers.

- (1) To appeal a fine imposed pursuant to Sections 106.04(8) or 106.07(8). FS, the party against whom the fine is levied shall file a notice of appeal with the Commission, and a copy filed with the filing officer, within 20 days of the appealing party's receipt of notice that a fine is being imposed The notice of appeal shall contain:
 - (a) The name, address and telephone number of the appealing party;
 - (b) A copy of the notice of imposition of fine issued by the filing officer; and
 - (c) A request for hearing if a personal appearance before the Commission is desired, If no hearing request is made, the appeal shall be decided solely on the documents submitted by the appealing party and Commission staff.
 - (2) Upon receipt of a timely notice of appeal, the Commission staff shall notify the appealing party that the appeal has been

accepted The appealing party shall have 20 days from acceptance of the appeal to submit any documents supporting the appeal. Any subsequent supplemental documents shall be filed no later than five business days before the hearing..

(3) The Commission shall uphold the fine imposed by the filing officer unless the appealing party demonstrates that the report was timely filed or that there were unusual or other circumstances beyond the control of the candidate or committee that caused the report to be filed late.

2B-1.0052 Fine Imposed; Timely Filed Reports.

2B-1.0055 Late-filed Reports; Unusual Circumstances.

- (1) Unusual circumstances mean uncommon, rare or sudden events over which the actor has no control and which directly result in the failure to act according to the filing requirements. Unusual circumstances must occur within a time period that would clearly prevent the person legally responsible for filing the report from doing so in a timely manner. Unusual circumstances shall include, but are not limited to, the following circumstances:
- (a) Natural disaster or other emergency that prevented timely filing, Evidence submitted shall include copies of newspaper reports or other documents from an independent and reliable source that document the nature, date, and location of the natural disaster or emergency.
- (b) Death of the candidate or campaign treasurer or an immediate family member of the candidate or campaign treasurer.

Evidence submitted shall include a copy of the death certificate, newspaper obituary, or funeral program or notice.

- (c) Serious illness, disability or non-elective surgery of the candidate or campaign treasurer, Evidence submitted shall include a physician's certification on professional letterhead stationery that includes the dates of the illness, disability, or surgery; a statement regarding the period of time that the patient was incapacitated; and a statement that surgery, if any, was not elective. The period of incapacitation may also be shown by copies of hospital records reflecting the dates of hospitalization.
- (d) Serious illness, disability or non-elective surgery of the candidate's or campaign treasurer's immediate family member, Evidence submitted shall include evidence of the candidate or treasurer's relationship to the family member, the location of the family member, and the reason the candidate or campaign treasurer's presence was required. Evidence submitted shall also include a physician's certification on professional letterhead stationery that includes the dates of the illness, disability or surgery; a statement regarding the period of time that the patient was incapacitated; a statement that surgery, if any, was not elective; and a statement that the patient required the care of a family member.
- (e) Computer or equipment failure caused by events that could not have been anticipated and that made timely filing of the report impossible.

- (f) The abrupt and unexpected loss of the campaign treasurer; over which the appealing party had no control. The loss of the campaign treasurer shall not constitute unusual circumstances if the appealing party failed to monitor the campaign treasurer's performance before his or her departure or if' the appealing party failed to assure prompt preparation of the report after the treasurer's departure.
- (g) Failure of the filing officer to e-mail, telephone, or mail a letter to the candidate, chairman of a political committee, or treasurer of a committee of continuous existence that a report is late no later than seven days after the report was due shall constitute unusual circumstances if the appealing party establishes that lack of notice clearly interfered with the timely filing of the report. The fine imposed by the filing officer shall be reduced to the amount that would have been imposed had the report been filed 13 days.
 - (2) Unusual circumstances shall not include:
 - (a) Failure of the United States Postal Service or other mail delivery service to postmark an envelope, legibly postmark an envelope, or timely deliver mail.
 - (b) Failure of the sender to affix sufficient postage to a report that is being mailed.



All reports must be completed and filed through the EFS no later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the due date. Reports not filed by midnight of the due date are late filed and subject to

the penalties in Section 106.07(8), Florida Statutes. In the event that the EFS is inoperable on the due date, the report will be accepted as timely filed if filed no later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the first business day the EFS becomes operable. No fine will be levied during the period the EFS was inoperable.

Any political committee failing to file a report on the designated due date is subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first 3 days and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for the reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

Electronic Receipts

The person submitting the report on the EFS will be issued an electronic receipt indicating and verifying the report was filed. Each campaign treasurer's report filed by means of the EFS is considered to be under oath by the chairperson and campaign treasurer and such persons are subject to the provisions of Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes.

Instructions and Assistance

An online instruction guide is available to you on the EFS to assist with navigation, data entry, and submission of reports. The Division of Elections will also provide assistance to all users by contacting the EFS Help Desk at (850) 245-6280.

All of the Division's publications and reporting forms are available on the Division of Elections' website at http://dos.myflorida.com/elections/. It is your responsibility to read, understand, and follow the requirements of Florida's election laws.
