A hearing will be held in this case before the Florida Elections Commission on February 23, 2021 at 8:30 am, EST, or as soon thereafter as the parties can be heard.

Please note that because of COVID-19, this will be a virtual meeting conducted by remote video or teleconference. If you wish to speak before the Commission, you will need to appear by webcam and will be sworn in remotely. Please be advised that the Commission will consider multiple cases, so you will need to wait until your case is considered. If you have any questions, please contact Commission staff at (850) 922-4539.

Failure to appear in accordance with this notice will constitute a waiver of your right to participate in the hearing. Continuances will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

This hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, which governs your participation as follows:

If you are the Respondent, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have 5 minutes to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which motions to dismiss or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are the Complainant, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which motions to dismiss or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are an Appellant, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have 5 *minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing*. The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

SUMMARY: Scott Boyes was a candidate for Manatee County School Board, District 3 in the 2020 elections. Stephen D. Boyes was his treasurer.

Scott Boyes is appealing the fine claiming that this is his first campaign and he was unaware that the report was due earlier than usual. According to Mr. Boyes, reports were always due on the following 10th of the month. He states that his report was filed by "8:30am the morning of the fourth day, before the opening of business hours" and asks that the fine be reduced by the "fourth day amount of \$500.00". Mr. Boyes notes that all other reports were filed ahead of time and states that he was unaware that the penalty accrued on weekends.

- The 2020 P1 Original Report covers the period from 06/01/20-06/12/20; it was due on 06/19/20.
- The 2020 P1 Original Report shows that it was filed on 06/23/20.
- Scott Boyes reported receiving 2 contributions, while making 3 expenditures.
- The Manatee County Supervisor of Elections office does not have notes that pertain to Scott Boyes's 2020 P1 report.

Dear Mr. Boyes,

Your campaign treasurer's report, which was due on Friday, June 19, 2020 was received on Tuesday, June 23, 2020.

Section 106.07(2)(8), Florida Statutes (see enclosed), requires that the filing officer notify you of your failure to file said report and that a fine be assessed for each day late. As you see from the statutes, any candidate failing to file a report on the designated date shall be subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first 3 days late and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each day late, <u>not to exceed 25 percent of the total receipts or expenditures</u>, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. The fine must be paid from the candidate's <u>personal funds</u> – not campaign funds.

- Report 4 days late
- Calculation of fine using daily method = 3 days x \$50 per day = \$150.00 + 1 day x \$500 per day = \$650.00
- Calculation of fine using percentage method = \$2750.00 contributions x 25% = \$687.50 \$2751.20 expenditures x 25% = \$687.80
- Fine to be imposed = \$650.00

A check in the amount of \$650.00 should be made out to the Manatee County Supervisor of Elections.

Any candidate may appeal or dispute the fine, based upon, but not limited to, unusual circumstances surrounding the failure to file on the designated due date, and may request a hearing before the Florida Elections Commission – (850) 922-4539. Any such request shall be made within 20 days after receipt of the notice of payment due. If filing an appeal, notify the filing officer in writing of your intention to bring the matter before the commission.
