ORDER OF PROBABLE CAUSE

THIS MATTER was heard by the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) at its regularly scheduled meeting on January 24, 2023, in Tallahassee, Florida.

On August 22, 2022, Staff recommended to the Commission that there was probable cause to believe that the Florida Election Code was violated. The facts articulated in Staff's Recommendation are adopted by reference and incorporated herein. Based on the Complaint, Report of Investigation, Staff's Recommendation, and oral statements (if any) made at the probable cause hearing, the Commission finds that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with the following violation(s):

Count 1:

On or about August 31, 2017, Anthony "Tony" Knox violated Section 106.19(1)(d), Florida Statutes, when he made or authorized an expenditure prohibited by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.

Count 2:

On or about September 29, 2017, Anthony "Tony" Knox violated Section 106.19(1)(d), Florida Statutes, when he made or authorized an expenditure prohibited by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.

Count 3:

On or about October 31, 2017, Anthony "Tony" Knox violated Section 106.19(1)(d), Florida Statutes, when he made or authorized

an expenditure prohibited by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.

Count 4:

On or about November 30, 2017, Anthony "Tony" Knox violated Section 106.19(1)(d), Florida Statutes, when he made or authorized an expenditure prohibited by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.

Count 5:

On or about December 6, 2018, Anthony "Tony" Knox violated Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes, when he certified that the campaign's 2018 TR Report was true, correct, and complete when it was not.

Count 6:

On or around October 10, 2017, Anthony "Tony" Knox violated Section 106.19(1)(b), Florida Statutes, when he failed to report contributions required to be reported by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2017 M9 Report.

Count 7:

On or around December 5, 2018, Anthony "Tony" Knox violated Section 106.19(1)(b), Florida Statutes, when he failed to report contributions required to be reported by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2018 TR Report.

Count 8:

On or around October 10, 2017, Anthony "Tony" Knox violated Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, when he deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2017 M9 Report.

Count 9:

On or around December 5, 2018, Anthony "Tony" Knox violated Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, when he deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2018 TR Report.

The Commission finds that there is **no probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO A HEARING

As the Respondent, you may elect to resolve this case in several ways. First, you may elect to resolve this case by consent order where you and Commission staff agree to resolve the violation(s) and agree to the amount of the fine. The consent order is then presented to the Commission for its approval. To discuss a consent order, contact the FEC attorney identified in the Order of Probable Cause.

Second, you may request an informal hearing held before the Commission, if you do not dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. You have 30 days from the date the Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission to request such a hearing. STAFF RECOMMENDATION FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(c), Florida Statutes, undersigned staff counsel files this written recommendation for disposition of the referral in this case recommending that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating **Sections 106.07(5), 106.19(1)(b), 106.19(1)(c),** and **106.19(1)(d), Florida Statutes,** and **no probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating **Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes.** Based upon a thorough review of the Report of Investigation submitted on March 18, 2022, the following facts and law support this staff recommendation:

- 1. On February 13, 2019, the Florida Elections Commission ("Commission") received a referral from the Department of State, Division of Elections ("Division"), alleging that Anthony "Tony" Knox ("Respondent") violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.
- 2. Respondent was a 2018 candidate for Governor. Respondent's Statement of Candidate form ("DS-DE 84") was filed on May 8, 2017. (ROI Exhibit 3)¹
- 3. By letter dated May 30, 2019, the Executive Director notified Respondent that Commission staff would investigate the following statutory provisions:

Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2018 candidate for Governor, may have certified one or more campaign treasurer reports were true, correct, and complete when they were not, as alleged in the complaint.

Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2018 candidate for Governor, filed a 2018 Termination Report that may have failed to accurately reflect the disposition of all remaining campaign funds, as alleged in the complaint.

Section 106.19(1)(b), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2018 candidate for Governor, may have failed to report one or more contributions required to be reported by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, as alleged in the complaint.

Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2018 candidate for Governor, may have falsely reported or deliberately

failed to include information in one or more campaign treasurer reports, as required by Chapter 106, as alleged in the complaint.

Section 106.19(1)(d), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2018 candidate for Governor, may have made or authorized one or more expenditures prohibited by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, as alleged in the complaint.

- 4. On May 8, 2017, Respondent filed his Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Candidates form ("DS-DE 9") appointing Arianna Knox as treasurer for his campaign. (ROI Exhibit 2, page 1) On June 22, 2018, Respondent filed a subsequent DS-DE 9 appointing Vivian Knox as his campaign treasurer. (ROI Exhibit 2, page 2)
- 5. By letter dated May 9, 2017, Kristi Reid Bronson, Chief, Bureau of Election Records, sent Respondent a letter acknowledging that the Division had received his DS-DE 9 and that his name was placed on the 2018 active candidate list. (ROI Exhibit 4, page 1)
- 6. The acknowledgment letter advised Respondent that all candidates filing reports with the Division are required to use the electronic filing system ("EFS") and provided Respondent with a user identification number and initial password to grant access to the EFS. (ROI Exhibit 4, page 1) The letter further advised Respondent that all of the Division's publications and reporting forms were available on its website and directed Respondent to print out Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, and the *Calendar of Reporting Dates*, as well as other relevant documents. (ROI Exhibit 4, page 3)

Alleged Violation: Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes

- 7. Complainant alleged that Respondent violated Florida's election laws by failing to dispose of the funds on deposit in his campaign account. *See* Compl., pp. 6-7.
- 8. On September 6, 2018, Respondent was removed as a candidate because a running mate did not qualify by the deadline. (ROI Exhibit 1) Respondent was required to dispose of the funds on deposit in his campaign account within 90 days after being eliminated as a candidate.
- 9. A subpoena was issued to Respondent's designated campaign depository. The campaign's bank records show that Respondent had a zero balance as of the last day of the 2018 TR reporting period, i.e., December 5, 2018. (ROI Exhibit 6, page 27)
- 10. It does not appear that Respondent failed to dispose of the funds on deposit in his campaign account within 90 days after being eliminated as a candidate.

Alleged Violation: Section 106.19(1)(d), Florida Statutes

11. Complainant alleged that Respondent violated Florida's election laws by making or authorizing expenditures prohibited by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes. *See* Compl., pp. 5-7.

- 12. Complainant provided documentation showing that Respondent had a self-reported deficit balance in his campaign account during the 2017 M8, 2017 M9, 2017 M10, and 2017 M11 reporting periods. (ROI Exhibit 8)
- 13. Section 106.19(1)(d), Florida Statutes, prohibits candidates from making or authorizing expenditures in violation of Section 106.11(4), Florida Statutes. Section 106.11(4), Florida Statutes, prohibits candidates from authorizing expenditures or signing checks drawn on the campaign account without sufficient funds on deposit in the campaign account.
- 14. The 2017 M8, 2017 M9, 2017 M10, and 2017 M11 reporting periods ran from August 1, 2017 August 31, 2017, September 1, 2017 September 30, 2017, October 1, 2017 October 31, 2017, and November 1, 2017 November 30, 2017, respectively. Respondent's bank records show that Respondent's campaign depository had insufficient funds on deposit during the relevant reporting periods. In each instance, the campaign depository was overdrawn as a result of a \$14.00 monthly service fee initiated by the financial institution. (ROI Exhibit 6, pages 6, 8, 10, & 14; ROI, p. 2, \P 12)
- 15. Respondent made or authorized expenditures prohibited by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on four occasions.

Alleged Violation: Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes

- 16. Complainant alleged that Respondent violated Florida's election laws by certifying that his campaign treasurer reports were true, correct, and complete when they were not. The reporting periods at issue were the 2017 M8, 2017 M9, 2017 M10, 2017 M11, and 2018 TR.
- 17. Under Section 106.07, Florida Statutes, a campaign treasurer's report is required to contain all contributions received and all expenditures made during the reporting period.
- 18. On January 17, 2019, Respondent certified the campaign's 2017 M8 Report was true, correct, and complete. (ROI Exhibit 9, page 12) The campaign's report was true, correct, and complete as Respondent disclosed all relevant expenditures as reflected in the bank records. (ROI Exhibit 6, pages 5-6; ROI Exhibit 9, pages 7-11)
- 19. On October 10, 2017, Respondent notified the filing officer in writing that he would not be filing his 2017 M9 Report. (ROI Exhibit 9, page 13-18) The requirement under Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes, to certify as to the correctness of a report does not apply to notifications of no activity submitted to the filing officer pursuant to Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes.
- 20. On January 17, 2019, Respondent certified the campaign's 2017 M10 Report was true, correct, and complete. (ROI Exhibit 9, page 24) The campaign's report was true, correct, and complete as Respondent disclosed all relevant contributions and expenditures as reflected in the bank records. (ROI Exhibit 6, pages 9-12; ROI Exhibit 9, pages 19-23)
- 21. On January 17, 2019, Respondent certified the campaign's 2017 M11 Report was true, correct, and complete. (ROI Exhibit 9, page 30) The campaign's report was true, correct, and

complete as Respondent disclosed all relevant expenditures as reflected in the bank records. (ROI Exhibit 6, pages 13-15; ROI Exhibit 9, pages 25-29)

- 22. On December 6, 2018, Respondent certified the campaign's 2018 TR Report was true, correct, and complete. (ROI Exhibit 9, page 36) The campaign's report was incomplete as Respondent failed to include three or more contributions totaling \$1,031.13 and seven expenditures totaling \$344.85. (ROI Exhibit 6, pages 20-28; ROI Exhibit 9, pages 31-35; *See* ROI, pp. 4-5)
- 23. Respondent certified that the campaign's 2018 TR Report was true, correct, and complete when it was not.

Alleged Violation: Section 106.19(1)(b), Florida Statutes

- 24. Complainant alleged that Respondent violated Florida's election laws by failing to report contributions required to be reported by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2017 M8, 2017 M9, 2017 M10, 2017 M11, and 2018 TR reports.
- 25. A subpoena was issued to Respondent's designated campaign depository to ascertain whether any contributions were received during the relevant reporting periods which were not reported.
- 26. Respondent's bank records show one or more contributions totaling \$9.41 that Respondent failed to disclose on the campaign's 2017 M9 Report. (ROI Exhibit 6, pages 7-8; ROI Exhibit 9; pages 13-17) In lieu of filing a report, Respondent filed a notice of no activity declaring that he had no reportable financial activity. (ROI Exhibit 9, pages 13-17; *See* ROI, p. 4)
- 27. Respondent's bank records show three or more contributions totaling \$1,031.13 that Respondent failed to disclose on the campaign's 2018 TR Report. (ROI Exhibit 6, pages 20-28; ROI Exhibit 9, pages 31-35; *See* ROI, pp. 4-5)
- 28. Based upon a review of Respondent's reports and the campaign's bank records, it does not appear that Respondent failed to report contributions required to be reported by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2017 M8, 2017 M10, and 2017 M11 reports. All relevant contributions and expenditures were reported; however, the reports were filed late. (ROI Exhibits 6 & 9)
- 29. Respondent failed to report contributions required to be reported by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2017 M9 and 2018 TR reports.

Alleged Violation: Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes

30. Complainant alleged that Respondent violated Florida's election laws by falsely reporting or deliberately failing to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2017 M8, 2017 M9, 2017 M10, 2017 M11, and 2018 TR reports.

- 31. A subpoena was issued to Respondent's designated campaign depository to ascertain whether any contributions were received, or expenditures were made which were not reported or falsely reported.
- 32. Respondent's bank records show one or more contributions totaling \$9.41 and one expenditure in the amount of \$14.00 that Respondent failed to disclose on the campaign's 2017 M9 Report. (ROI Exhibit 6, pages 7-8; ROI Exhibit 9; pages 13-17; *See* ROI, p. 4)
- 33. Respondent's bank records show three or more contributions totaling \$1,031.13 and seven expenditures totaling \$344.85 that Respondent failed to disclose on the campaign's 2018 TR Report. (ROI Exhibit 6, pages 20-28; ROI Exhibit 9; pages 31-35; See ROI, pp. 4-5) Had Respondent reported the financial activity that took place during the relevant reporting period, the report may have disclosed potential violations of the Florida Election Code as Respondent's bank records show that he accepted contributions after being eliminated. See §106.08(3)(b), Fla. Stat.
- 34. Respondent stated that his wife was responsible for filing his campaign reports, but she passed away in 2019. (ROI Exhibit 7, page 1) The reporting periods at issue in this matter run from August 1, 2017, through December 5, 2018. (ROI Exhibit 5)
- 35. Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, requires candidates to report any contributions received and any expenditures made for the purpose of influencing the results of an election. Respondent deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2017 M9 and 2018 TR reports.
- 36. "Probable Cause" is defined as reasonable grounds of suspicion supported by circumstances sufficiently strong to warrant a cautious person in the belief that the person has committed the offense charged. *Schmitt v. State*, 590 So. 2d 404, 409 (Fla. 1991). Probable cause exists where the facts and circumstances, of which an [investigator] has reasonably trustworthy information, are sufficient in themselves for a reasonable man to reach the conclusion that an offense has been committed. *Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles v. Favino*, 667 So. 2d 305, 309 (Fla. 1st DCA 1995).
- 37. The facts set forth above show that Respondent was a 2018 candidate for Governor. Respondent made or authorized expenditures prohibited by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on four occasions. Respondent certified that the campaign's 2018 TR Report was true, correct, and complete when it was not. Respondent failed to report contributions required to be reported by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2017 M9 and 2018 TR reports. Respondent deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2017 M9 and 2018 TR reports. It does not appear that Respondent failed to dispose of the funds on deposit in his campaign account within 90 days after being eliminated as a candidate.

Based upon these facts and circumstances, I recommend that the Commission find **no probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating **Section 106.141(1)**, **Florida Statutes**, and find **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating the following:

Count 1:

On or about August 31, 2017, Anthony "Tony" Knox violated Section 106.19(1)(d), Florida Statutes, when he made or authorized an expenditure prohibited by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.

Count 2:

On or about September 29, 2017, Anthony "Tony" Knox violated Section 106.19(1)(d), Florida Statutes, when he made or authorized an expenditure prohibited by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.

Count 3:

On or about October 31, 2017, Anthony "Tony" Knox violated Section 106.19(1)(d), Florida Statutes, when he made or authorized an expenditure prohibited by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.

Count 4:

On or about November 30, 2017, Anthony "Tony" Knox violated Section 106.19(1)(d), Florida Statutes, when he made or authorized an expenditure prohibited by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.

Count 5:

On or about December 6, 2018, Anthony "Tony" Knox violated Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes, when he certified that the campaign's 2018 TR Report was true, correct, and complete when it was not.

Count 6:

On or around October 10, 2017, Anthony "Tony" Knox violated Section 106.19(1)(b), Florida Statutes, when he failed to report contributions required to be reported by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2017 M9 Report.

Count 7:

On or around December 5, 2018, Anthony "Tony" Knox violated Section 106.19(1)(b), Florida Statutes, when he failed to report contributions required to be reported by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2018 TR Report.

Count 8:

On or around October 10, 2017, Anthony "Tony" Knox violated Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, when he deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2017 M9 Report.

Count 9:

On or around December 5, 2018, Anthony "Tony" Knox violated Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, when he deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2018 TR Report.

I. Preliminary Information:

- 1. Respondent was a 2018 candidate for Governor; he was removed from his candidacy on September 6, 2018, because a running mate did not qualify by the deadline. Respondent was a first-time candidate. To review the email from the Division regarding Respondent's removal, refer to Exhibit 1.
- 2. An Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository (DS-DE 9) was filed on May 8, 2017. Arianna Knox was appointed as campaign treasurer. To review the DS-DE 9, refer to Exhibit 2.1
- 3. Respondent filed a Statement of Candidate with the Division on May 8, 2017, in which Respondent certified he had been provided access to read and understand Chapter 106, F.S. To review the Statement of Candidate, refer to Exhibit 3.
- 4. An acknowledgement letter was mailed to the address provided on the DS-DE 9 on May 9, 2017. The letter advised Respondent that all candidates filing reports with the Division are required to file by means of the Division's electronic filing system (EFS). Respondent was provided with a user identification number and initial password allowing access to the EFS.
- 5. The acknowledgement letter also advised Respondent that all of the Division's publications and reporting forms are available on their website, including Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, the *Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook* and the *Calendar of Reporting Dates*. The letter further advised that it was Respondent's responsibility to read, understand, and follow the requirements of Florida's election laws. When Respondent appointed a new treasurer, he was sent a copy of a similar letter. To review the acknowledgement letters, refer to Exhibit 4.

¹ Another form was subsequently filed appointing Vivian Knox as the new treasurer.

II. Alleged Violation of Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes:

- 6. I investigated whether Respondent violated this section of the election laws by not disposing of all remaining campaign funds within 90 days of being removed. To review Respondent's filing history, refer to Exhibit 5.
- 7. On the date the 2018 TR was due, campaign account records reflect that the balance was \$0.00.² To review the relevant bank statement, refer to Exhibit 6, page 27.
- 8. Respondent did not respond to the referral. An affidavit posing questions about the referral was sent to Respondent, but it was not returned.
- 9. I called Respondent for the purpose of providing an opportunity to discuss the allegations made in the referral. Respondent stated his wife passed away in 2019, and she was the person responsible for filing the campaign reports. Respondent also stated that he shines shoes for a living and is the father of eight children. He acknowledged that he received and reviewed the election packet materials, including the *Calendar of Reporting Dates* and the *Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook*. To review the phone log, refer to Exhibit 7.

III. Alleged Violation of Section 106.19(1)(d), Florida Statutes:

- 10. I investigated whether Respondent violated this section of the election laws by making or authorizing one or more expenditure(s) prohibited by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.
- 11. The Division's Sum of Contributions vs. Expenditures report showed an apparent deficit balance in the following reporting period(s): 2017 M8, 2017 M9, 2017 M10, and 2017 M11 Reports. To review the report, refer to Exhibit 8.
- 12. I reviewed bank records from the designated campaign depository covering the following reporting period(s): 2017 M6, 2017 M7, 2017 M8, 2017 M9, 2017 M10, and 2017 M11. There were four instances during that timeframe in which the campaign account balance was taken negative.
 - \$14.00 bank monthly service fee on 08/31/17 took the account to a -\$11.75 balance.
 - \$9.41 deposit on 09/26/17, took the account back to a -\$2.34 balance.
 - \$14.00 bank monthly service fee on 09/29/17 took the account to a -\$16.34 balance.
 - \$16.34 deposit on 10/27/17, took the account back to a \$0.00 balance.
 - \$14.00 bank monthly service fee on 10/31/17 took the account to a -\$14.00 balance.
 - \$14.00 bank monthly service fee on 11/30/17 took the account to a -\$28.00 balance.

The balance was taken to \$1,972.00 on December 4, 2017, upon deposit of \$2,000.00. Three of the \$14.00 monthly service fees referenced above were reversed and credited to the account on December 8, 2017. To review the bank records, refer to Exhibit 6. To review bank statements reflecting the negative balances, refer to Exhibit 6, pages 6, 8, 10, and 14.

13. Respondent did not respond to the referral.

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² I subpoenaed campaign account records from the designated campaign depository.

IV. Alleged Violation of Sections 106.07(5), 106.141(1), 106.19(1)(b), and 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes:

- 14. I investigated whether Respondent violated these sections of the election laws by certifying that one or more campaign treasurer report(s) were true, correct, and complete when they were not, failing to report one or more contribution(s), falsely reporting or deliberately failing to include information in one or campaign treasurer report(s), and failing to accurately reflect disposition of all remaining campaign funds in a termination report due to an apparent surplus balance after the 2018 TR was filed and due to an apparent deficit balance in the following reporting periods: 2017 M8, 2017 M9, 2017 M10, and 2017 M11.
- 15. I reviewed bank records from the designated campaign depository and compared them with campaign treasurer reports covering the following reporting periods: 2017 M7, 2017 M8, 2017 M9, 2017 M10, 2017 M11, and 2018 TR.³ The results of my review are reflected in the table below. To review Respondent's filing history, refer to Exhibit 5. To review the bank records, refer to Exhibit 6. To review the campaign treasurer reports, refer to Exhibit 9.



On February 13, 2019, the Florida Elections Commission received a complaint alleging that you violated Florida's election laws. I have reviewed the complaint and find that it contains one or more **legally sufficient allegations**. The Commission staff will investigate the following alleged violations:

Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2018 candidate for Governor, may have certified one or more campaign treasurer reports were true, correct, and complete when they were not, as alleged in the complaint.

Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2018 candidate for Governor, filed a 2018 Termination Report that may have failed to accurately reflect the disposition of all remaining campaign funds, as alleged in the complaint.

Section 106.19(1)(b), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2018 candidate for Governor, may have failed to report one or more contributions required to be reported by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, as alleged in the complaint.

Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2018 candidate for Governor, may have falsely reported or deliberately failed to include information in one or more campaign treasurer reports, as required by Chapter 106, as alleged in the complaint.

Section 106.19(1)(d), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2018 candidate for Governor, may have made or authorized one or more expenditures prohibited by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, as alleged in the complaint.

When we conclude the investigation, a copy of the Report of Investigation (ROI) will be mailed to you at the above address. You will have an opportunity to respond to both the ROI and the SR.
