Failure to appear in accordance with this notice will constitute a waiver of your right to participate in the hearing. Continuances will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

This hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, which governs your participation as follows:

If you are the Respondent, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have 5 *minutes* to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are the Complainant, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are an Appellant, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have 5 *minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO A HEARING

As the Respondent, you may elect to resolve this case in several ways. First, you may elect to resolve this case by <u>consent order</u> where you and Commission staff agree to resolve the violation(s)s and agree to the amount of the fine. The consent order is then presented to the Commission for its approval. To discuss a consent order, contact the FEC attorney identified in the Order of Probable Cause.

Second, you may request an <u>informal hearing</u> held before the Commission, if you <u>do not</u> dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. You have 30 days from the date the Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission to request such a hearing. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order. At the hearing, you will have the right to make written or oral arguments to the Commission concerning the legal issues related to the violation(s) and the potential fine. At the request of Respondent, the Commission will consider and determine willfulness at an informal hearing. Otherwise, live witness testimony is unnecessary.

Third, you may request a <u>formal hearing</u> held before an administrative law judge in the Division of Administrative Hearings (DOAH), if you dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. You have 30 days from the date the Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission to request such a hearing. The date this order was filed appears in the upper righthand corner of the first page of the order. At the hearing, you will have the right to present evidence relevant to the violation(s) listed in this order, to cross-examine opposing witnesses, to impeach any witness, and to rebut the evidence presented against you.

If you do not elect to resolve the case by consent order or request a formal hearing at the DOAH or an informal hearing before the Commission within 30 days of the date this Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission, the case will be sent to the Commission for a formal or informal hearing, depending on whether the facts are in dispute. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(c), Florida Statutes, undersigned staff counsel files this written recommendation for disposition of the referral in this case recommending there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating **Section 106.07(7)**, Florida Statutes Based upon a thorough review of the Report of Investigation submitted on May 6, 2016, the following facts and law support this staff recommendation.

1 On January 13, 2016, the Florida Elections Commission ("Commission") received a referral from Division of Elections ("Division") alleging that Ax the Tax ("Respondent" or "Committee") violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes

2. Respondent is a political committee registered with the Division. Its chairman is Doug Guetzloe. On February 26, 2004, Respondent filed its Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Political Committees form ("DS-DE 6") appointing Doug Guetzloe as its treasurer. (ROI Exhibit 1^1 and Attachment A)²

3 On April 20, 2016, the Executive Director sent Respondent notification that Commission staff would investigate the following section of law:

Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes: As alleged in the complaint, for each of the following reporting periods, Respondent failed to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed on that date because it had not received funds, made contributions, or expended reportable funds during the reporting periods:

- 2015 M4
- 2015 M6
- 2015 M11

¹ The Report of Investigation shall be referred to herein as "ROI."

² At all times pertinent to the issues in this case, Doug Guetzloe was Respondent's chairperson and treasurer. Mr Guetzloe has been actively involved in Florida politics for several years and knows Florida's reporting requirements (ROI Exhibit 4)

4 By letter dated February 28, 2004, Phyllis Hampton, Chief, Bureau of Election Records, notified Mr. Guetzloe that the Division had received Respondent's Statement of Organization and DS-DE 6, the information was placed on file in the Division's office on February 26, 2004, and the name of the organization had been included on the Division's committee list as a committee that supports issues. Ms. Hampton also enclosed several campaign resources with her letter including a copy of Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, a *Handbook for Committees*, a *Handbook for Treasurers*, and a 2004 Election Calendar of Reporting Dates. Additionally, Ms Hampton provided the name of a person at the Division that Mr. Guetzloe could call for further assistance (ROI Exhibit 2)

5 Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, provides:

Notwithstanding any other provisions of this chapter, in any reporting period during which a candidate or political committee has not received funds, made any contributions, or expended any reportable funds, the filing of the required report for that period is waived. However, the next report filed must specify that the report covers the entire period between the last submitted report and the report being filed, and any candidate or political committee not reporting by virtue of this subsection on dates prescribed elsewhere in this chapter shall notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that no report is being filed on that date. (Emphasis added)³

6 Additionally, page 18 of the Handbook, states:

When there has been no reportable activity in the campaign account during a reporting period (no funds expended or received) the filing of the report may be waived by notifying the filing officer in writing that no activity has occurred. This notification must be made on the prescribed reporting date

(Section 106 07, FS)

All waivers filed with the Division must be filed electronically using the Division's electronic filing system

(Section 106.0705, FS.)

³ The requirement to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that a committee would not be filing a report for the reporting period because it had no reportable financial transactions was also required by \$106.07(7), Fla Stat (2004).

7. Pages 12, 13, 45, and 46 of the *Political Committee EFS User's Guide* ("Guide") explain the steps a committee should take to notify the Division in writing on the prescribed reporting date that no report will be filed for the reporting period using the EFS. Specifically, at the top of page 13, the Guide instructs the user to click the box next to "Waiver" if there is no financial activity to report. (ROI Exhibit 3)

9 Respondent did not provide a written response to the Division's referral. Additionally, Investigator Oliver attempted to contact Respondent's chairman on two different occasions.⁵ Investigator Oliver left a voice message each time requesting Mr. Guetzloe to return the call. However, Respondent's chairman failed to respond to any of Investigator Oliver's messages (ROI Paragraph 6 and Attachment C)

10. "Probable Cause" is defined as reasonable grounds of suspicion supported by circumstances sufficiently strong to warrant a cautious person in the belief that the person has committed the offense charged. Schmitt v State, 590 So 2d 404, 409 (Fla 1991) Probable cause exists where the facts and circumstances, of which an [investigator] has reasonably trustworthy information, are sufficient in themselves for a reasonable man to reach the conclusion that an offense has been committed *Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles v Favino*, 667 So 2d 305, 309 (Fla 1st DCA 1995).

11 The facts above show that Respondent is a political committee registered with the Division Doug Guetzloe is Respondent's chairman and treasurer Respondent was required to notify its filing officer in writing on the prescribed due date for the 2015 M11 Report that the Committee would not be filing a 2015 M11 Report because it had no reportable contributions or expenditures during the reporting period However, Respondent failed to do so.

Based on the foregoing, I recommend that the Commission find probable cause to charge Respondent with violating the following provisions of law:

⁴ In FEC Case Number 15-402, the Commission determined Respondent violated §106.07(7), Fla. Stat, for failing to notify the filing officer on the prescribed due dates for the 2015 M4 and 2015 M6 Reports that the Committee would not be filing a report because it had no reportable financial transactions during the respective reporting periods. Therefore, the Commission is barred from proceeding against Respondent for the same violations in this case.

⁵ On both occasions, Investigator Oliver called Respondent at two different phone numbers

On or about December 10, 2015, Respondent violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when Respondent failed to notify the Division of Elections in writing on or before December 10, 2015, that Respondent would not be filing a 2015 M11 Report on the prescribed due date.

Waiver of Report

When there has been no reportable activity in the campaign account during a reporting period (no funds expended or received) the filing of the report may be waived by notifying the filing officer in writing that no activity has occurred. This notification must be made on the prescribed reporting date

(Section 106.07, F.S.)

All waivers filed with the Division must be filed electronically using the Division's electronic filing system.

(Section 106.0705, F.S.)

Special Election Reports

When a special election is called to fill a vacancy in office, all political committees making contributions or expenditures to influence the results of the special election shall file campaign treasurers' reports with the filing officer on the dates set by the Department of State pursuant to Section 100.111, F S.

When an election is called for an issue to appear on the ballot at a time when no candidates are scheduled to appear on the ballot, all political committees making contributions or expenditures in support of or in opposition to such issue shall file reports on the 18th and 4th days prior to such election.

Committees are to include on the special election campaign treasurer's reports only expenditures related to the special election made by the committee during the special election reporting periods. All contributions received and all expenditures made not related to the special election during the current quarter should be filed on the next quarterly report. Once a committee has participated in the special election and has filed a special election campaign report, all other special election reports remaining must also be filed by the committee, even if there is no further special election activity.

(Section 106.07(1), F.S.)

Incomplete Reports

Note: The Division's Electronic Filing System will allow a committee to file an incomplete report, however, filing a report that is incomplete means filing a report that is not in compliance with the Florida Statutes

If a campaign treasurer files a report that is deemed incomplete, he or she will be notified by the filing officer by certified mail, or by another method using a common carrier that provides a proof of delivery as to why the report is incomplete The campaign treasurer must file an addendum to the incomplete report within seven days of notification. The addendum must include all necessary information to complete the report. Failure to file a complete report after notice constitutes a violation of Chapter 106, F.S.

(Section 106.07(2), F.S.)

Reporting Total Sums

Each campaign treasurer's report required by Chapter 106, F.S., shall contain the total sums of all loans, in-kind contributions, and other receipts, and total sums of all expenditures made during the reporting period. The reporting forms shall be designed to elicit separate totals for in-kind contributions, loans, and other receipts.

(Section 106.07, F.S.)

Reporting Contributions

Each report must contain:

- Full name, address, specific occupation, amount, and date of each person making a contribution Reports must provide as clear a description as practicable of the principal type of business conducted for corporations contributing Occupations or principal type of business are not required if the contribution is \$100 or less
- 2 Name, address, amount, and date of each political committee or organization making any transfer of funds.

I. Preliminary Information:

1 An appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository (DS-DE 6) was filed on February 26, 2004. (Ex 1)

2. An acknowledgement letter was mailed to the address provided on Respondent's DS-DE 6 on February 28, 2004 advising Respondent that all of the Division's publications and reporting forms are available on their website, including Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, the *Political Committee Handbook*, and the Calendar of Reporting Dates (Ex 2)

3. Pages 12, 13, 45, and 46 of the *Political Committee EFS User's Guide* discuss how to notify the Division on the prescribed reporting date that no report will be filed using the EFS. Specifically, page 13 instructs the user to click the box next to "waiver" if there is no activity to disclose. (Ex. 3)

4. In a telephone interview on April 2, 2015, Kristi Reid-Bronson clarified that once the waiver box is chosen and a new report is opened as shown on Page 12, the only available option on the report summary screen will be "Go To File Report" as shown on Page 13. Choosing "Go To File Report" will take the user directly to the screens where the chairman/treasurer PINS are entered as shown on Pages 45 and 46

II Alleged Violation of Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes:

5 Respondent's filing history reflects the untimely filed notifications summarized below (Ex 4)

I determined that there were seven additional untimely notifications of no activity filed during this span. Prior to the 2015 M4 reporting period, Respondent was timely with his notifications of no activity for 10 periods in a row (Ex. 4)

10 I attempted to contact Respondent on several occasions to give him an opportunity to discuss the allegations in the referral Additionally, an affidavit was mailed to Respondent on April 20, 2016. As of the date of this report, Respondent has not returned my calls, nor has he returned a questionnaire-affidavit

11. Because Respondent has not contacted the Commission or returned a questionnaire-affidavit, I am unable to ascertain whether Respondent has read Chapter 106, Florida Statutes and/or the *Political Committee Handbook*
