However, some cases (including those in which motions to dismiss or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

**If you are the Complainant**, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which motions to dismiss or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

**If you are an Appellant**, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have 5 *minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing*. The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

**SUMMARY:** Ruby Lenora Green was a candidate for Public Defender, Circuit 17 in the 2020 elections. Daphne Jean-Pierre was her treasurer.

Ruby Lenora Green is appealing the fine claiming that she was unaware reports increased in frequency as Election Day approached. According to Ms. Green, she filed the report for June on the 7th and believed reporting for the month was complete. Once she received multiple notices and the failure to file letter, she contacted her treasurer and they filed the late report along with the July 3, 2020 report. Ms. Green also notes that she contacted the Division of Elections on June 29th to explain the misunderstanding and was told that "this is a common problem" and that she could file an appeal. She also requests a hearing before the commission.

- The 2020 P1 Original Report covers the period from 06/01/20-06/12/20; it was due on 06/19/20.
- The 2020 P1 Queued Transaction Report shows that it was created and filed on 06/28/20.
- Ruby Lenora Green reported receiving 6 contributions, while making 2 expenditures.
- The Division of Elections does not have any notes that pertain to Ruby Lenora Green's 2020 P1 report.

#### Dear Florida Elections Commission:

This letter serves as an appeal to the late fine of \$190.15 imposed as a result of the late filing of the campaign treasurer's report due on June 19, 2020. I am requesting this fine be waived pursuant to Fla. Stat. 106.265(2).

By way of background, on June 16, 2020, I received an email from the Florida Division of Elections stating that my campaign treasurer's report is due on June 19, 2020. I did not communicate this information to my treasurer because I had already submitted my June 2020 report on June 7, 2020. I had no idea that we would have more frequent reports. On June 19, 2020, I received a 2<sup>nd</sup>email from the Florida Division of Elections notifying me that my campaign treasurer's report was due. However, I believed that since Covid19 that there was some extension granted to those who had yet to file their reports and I had no cause to worry because I had believed to had already filed my June 2020 report. On June 26, 2020 I received a letter in the mail from the division of elections and I went to pick up the letter from the mailbox on June 28, 2020 and it was stating that I failed to file. I immediately emailed the Division of elections thinking they had it all wrong and that we had filed the report for the month already and attached to the email the filed 6/7/2020 report. I then immediately contacted my treasurer to discuss the communications that I received from the Division of Elections. On June 28, 2020, we filed the June 19, 2020 report along with the July 3, 2020 report.

On June 29, 2020, I contacted the Division of Elections to explain the misunderstanding and was told that "this is a common problem" and that I could file an appeal once I received the Notice of Imposition of Fine.I was not aware that the frequency of the reporting would increase as Election Day grew near. I assumed, albeit falsely, that the Florida Division of Elections had mimicked the actions of various local, state and federal agencies who had granted extensions/reprieve on various deadlines due to the novel coronavirus or that they would email everyone to let them know that reports are due now more frequently.

Florida Statute 106.265(2) requires the commission consider among other mitigating and aggravating circumstances:

- (a) The gravity of the act or omission:
- (b) Any previous history of similar acts or omissions;
- (c) The appropriateness of such penalty to the financial resources of the person, political committee, affiliated party committee, electioneering communications organization, or political party; and
- (d) Whether the person, political committee, affiliated party committee, electioneering communications organization, or political party has shown good faith in attempting to comply with the provisions of this chapter or chapter 104.

With respect to subsection (a), (b) and (d), a review of my report submissions will demonstrate that I have never filed a late report. There was one issue with our pin numbers when we first began which was fixed. I am very intentional about filing timely reports. This recent occurrence was a fluke and I immediately sought to become in compliance once I learned about the mistake. Additionally, I have since obtained the reporting deadlines for this election cycle and have filed every report well before the deadline.

With respect to subsection (c), I do not believe this is an appropriate assessment given how elections campaigns have been substantially hindered by the novel coronavirus. The economy is in strife and prospective contributors are rightfully more conservative with spending. Furthermore, my finances will demonstrate that my fundraising efforts have not yielded significant results. My campaign is dependent on all monies, including my own, to continue my viability as a formidable candidate.

Dear Ms. Green:

Our records indicate that you have not filed either your campaign treasurer's report or notification that no reportable activity occurred, whichever is applicable. The filing date was June 19, 2020.

The law (s. 106.07(8)(b), Fla. Stat.) requires the filing officer to immediately notify you about the missed filing date and the automatic fines that will be assessed for late filing of a report, if a report was due.

- If reportable activity occurred and you have not filed a report, statutory fines are automatically assessed as follows until you file your report:
  - \$\$ \$50 per day for the first 3 days late
  - \* \$500 per day for each day after the 3rd day late
  - If the required report immediately precedes a primary and general election, the automatic fine is \$500 for each late day.

The total fine for the untimely report cannot exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the cover period. Even if you end up filing your report late, we cannot waive the statutory fines. We will notify you of the specific amount of fines owed once you file your report. You have 20 days from the day you receive the notice to pay the fine or to appeal the fine to the Florida Elections Commission.

• If no reportable activity occurred for the report date(s), you are still required to notify us in writing, via the Division's Electronic Filing System, that no reportable activity occurred. No automatic fines are statutorily assessed.

However, in all cases, failure to file and/or untimely filing of a report of reportable activity, or if applicable, a notice that no reportable activity occurred, may constitute an apparent violation of chapter 106, Fla. Stat. If we refer such matter to the Florida Elections Commission, the Commission may subsequently impose a civil penalty for each violation under chapter 106.265(1), Fla. Stat.



In the event that the EFS is inoperable on the due date, the report will be accepted as timely filed if filed no later than midnight of the first business day the EFS becomes operable. No fine will be levied during the period the EFS was inoperable.

Any candidate failing to file a report on the designated due date shall be subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first 3 days late and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.
