Failure to appear in accordance with this notice will constitute a waiver of your right to participate in the hearing. Continuances will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

This hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, which governs your participation as follows:

If you are the Respondent, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are the Complainant, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are an Appellant, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

Please refer to the information below for further instructions related to your particular hearing:

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

Adner Marcelin is appealing the fine claiming that he was inadvertently provided with the incorrect due date by the Leon County Supervisor of Elections office. According to Mr. Marcelin, he did not receive a courtesy phone call indicating that his report was due or late. He notes that all other campaign reports were filed timely and requests a waiver of the fine.

- The 2022 T3 Original Report covers the period from 08/23/22-11/21/22; it was due on 11/21/22.
- The 2022 T3 Report shows that it was filed on 12/02/22.
- Adner Marcelin reported receiving zero contributions, while making 9 expenditures.
- The Leon County Supervisor of Elections office does not have any notes that pertain to Adner Marcelin's 2022 T3 report.

Appeal of Fine for Leon County Supervisor of Election Candidate Report 22T3

Dear Members of the Florida Commission of Elections,

I am writing to appeal the December 5, 2022, fine that was imposed against my campaign by the Leon County Supervisor of Elections office for the late filing of my campaign's final termination report. In support of my request, I present the commission with the following:

1. I was defeated in the primary election on August 23, 2022 in my run for the Tallahassee City Commission Seat 5 race.
2. This was my first time running for public office and I entered the race very late in the cycle.
3. During the course of my campaign, my campaign team filed every financial report in a timely manner.
4. If my campaign came close to missing any deadline, my treasurer and I both would receive a separate courtesy call from Cory Logan, an employee at the LCSE's office, who was tasked with working with all candidates for office in Leon County.
5. Following my defeat, I contacted the Leon County Supervisor of Elections office in regards to the due date of my final termination report, and I was invertedly given the date for general candidates February 6, 2023. Thus the incorrect date was placed on my calendar to submit my finalized report. The information was given in the absence of Mr. Logan who was not in the office on the date my campaign manager and I called the SOE's office.
6. I received no phone call from Mr. Logan or anyone from the Leon County Supervisor of Elections office making me aware that my report was coming due or that I failed to turn it in, contrary to the practice being done for each election report date, and I only learned of the tardiness of my report when I received a certified letter via snail mail from the supervisor's office.
7. Within a few hours of speaking with Mr. Logan, I promptly submitted my report and explained the mishap and misinformation given to my campaign treasurer and I.
8. Mr. Logan explained the situation to his supervisors after receiving my report within hours of me speaking to him, and they unfortunately decided to impose a fine.

In light of this honest mistake, I am foregoing a request for hearing before the Commission, and request this appeal to be decided solely on the appeal and documents submitted by the appealing party. I am asking the commission to abate the \$550 fine imposed. I am available if the commission would like to hear more for me, and I thank each of the members for their service to this committee. A copy of the appeal must also be submitted to our office.

Should you decide to file an appeal, you must state any unusual circumstances surrounding your failure to file your campaign finance report on time. Include all supporting evidence you wish the Florida Elections Commission to consider, such as affidavits, witness statements, etc. If you appeal, in addition to submission of written documentation, you also have the right to request a personal hearing before the Commission. The appeal must be submitted within the prescribed 20 days or automatically waive your right to appeal.
