If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.





SUMMARY: Florida Restaurant and Lodging Association PAC, Inc is a political committee (PC) registered with the State of Florida. The PC's chair is Ms. Carol Dover and its treasurer is Mr. Bob Dearden.

The PC is appealing the fine claiming that unusual circumstances prevented the 2017 M1 Report to be untimely filed. According to Ms. Dover, "As the Chairwoman of the Florida Restaurant & Lodging Associations Political Action Committees, I am asking for you to consider the reduction, or elimination of the late fines assessed to PAC 60630 and PAC 60632. Unfortunately, on February 10, 2017, Jason Reynolds (Deputy Treasurer) was unable to file our M1 report due to a medical situation that required him to miss work and seek a medical professional. In an effort to comply with the report deadline, and the inability to access our PAC database, he filed a waiver for PAC 60630 and PAC 60632 with the intention of amending the report when he was physically capable. When Jason was able to return to work, he amended the waiver for both reports and submitted the amended reports on February 16. Our history of compliance and minimal number of issues should demonstrate the seriousness and pride the Florida Restaurant & Lodging Association takes in our PAC's and reporting".

- The 2017 M1 Report covers the time period from 1/1/17 through 1/31/17.
- The PC reported receiving 25 contributions, while making 14 expenditures during this reporting period.
- The 2017 M1 Queued-Transactions Report reflects that this report was created on 2/10/17 at approximately 6:16 pm, before being filed on 2/10/17 at approximately 6:16 pm.

In an effort to comply with the report deadline, and the inability to access our PAC database, he filed a waiver for PAC 60630 and PAC 60632 with the intention of amending the report when he was physically capable.

When Jason was able to return to work, He amended the waiver for both reports and submitted the amended reports on February 16. Our history of compliance and minimal number of issues should demonstrate the seriousness and pride the Florida Restaurant & Lodging Association takes in our PAC's and reporting.

I am appealing to the Florida Elections Commission to consider the unique set of circumstances that prevented us from filing by the deadline. I have included a copy of the waiver demonstrating it was filed on February 10, 2017. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact me.
