Failure to appear in accordance with this notice will constitute a waiver of your right to participate in the hearing. Continuances will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

This hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, which governs your participation as follows:

If you are the Respondent, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have 5 minutes to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are the Complainant, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are an Appellant, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have 5 *minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failer, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

SUMMARY: Richard Llerena is a candidate for County Court Judge, Group 5 in the 2018 elections. Mr. Llerena is his own treasurer.

Richard Llerena is appealing the fine claiming that he timely filed an electronic copy of his 2018 M4 report on May 10, 2018 using the C-Finance system. According to Richard Llerena, once he was advised that a physical signature on the summary page was required, he printed and signed the report on June 1st at the Supervisor of Elections office. Mr. Llerena states that the Supervisor of Elections office "encourages" the use of the electronic filing system. Mr. Llerena notes that his is first election and that the 2018 M4 was his first report due for the campaign. He respectfully requests the commission to waive or reduce the fine.

- The 2018 M4 Original Report covers the period from 04/01/18-04/30/18; it was due on 05/10/18.
- The 2018 M4 Original Report shows that it was hand delivered on 06/01/18. The electronic filing history listed on the Palm Beach SOE website states that it was submitted on 05/10/18.
- Richard Llerena reported receiving 2 contributions, while making 2 expenditures.
- The Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections responded to FEC staff on July 2, 2018. The letter contains information pertaining to Richard Llerena's 2018 M4 report.

Please be advised our office received your Campaign Treasurer's Report that was due on May 10, 2018 by 5:00 p.m., on **June 1, 2018**.

Per Section 106.07 (8), F.S. states that a fine must be imposed if a Campaign Treasurer's Report is late. The fine consists of \$50.00 per day for the first 3 days late, and thereafter, \$500.00 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. Based on your report being twenty (20) days late using the date of **May 10, 2018**, you are hereby assessed a fine totaling **Two thousand dollars (\$2000.00)**.

Section 106.07 (8) (b), F.S. require that you pay this fine within (20) days of your receipt of this Notice, unless you decide to appeal to the Florida Elections Commission in Tallahassee. If such an appeal is made, it must be done within twenty (20) days and you must notify this office in writing, of your intention to bring this matter before the Commission.

APPEAL OF DELINQUENCY FINE

COMES NOW, the Appellant, RICHARD LLERENA, and hereby files this Appeal of Delinquency Fine, as set forth in a letter issued by Susan Bucher, Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections (hereinafter "Appellee") dated June 1, 2018, pursuant to Fla. Stat. § 106.07(8), whereby a monetary fine has been assessed by Appellee against the Appellant in the amount of Two Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$2,000.00). The Letter is attached hereto as Exhibit 1. In support of the appeal, the Appellant hereby states as follows:

Appeal of Delinquency Fine, In re: Richard Llerena v. Susan Bucher Page 1 of 13

UNDISPUTED FACTS

- Appellant qualified as a Candidate for County Court Judge Group 5 in Palm Beach County effective April 27, 2018, upon filing all appropriate paperwork and paying the qualifying fee needed to run for the open seat.
- 2. The election date is anticipated to be August 28, 2018.
- 3. The filing officer in charge of accepting campaign treasurer reports and other qualifying paperwork is Susan Bucher, Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections (Appellee) because the open seat is a county-wide seat, not state-wide or for circuit judge.
- 4. The first campaign treasurer's report required to be submitted by Appellant was the 2018-M4 report, which covered contributions and expenditures from the period 04/01/2018 through 04/30/2018.
- Pursuant to the schedule originally issued by Appellee, the 2018-M4 report was due on May 10, 2018. The calendar of reporting dates is attached hereto as Exhibit 2.
- 6. The Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections office "encourages" the use of the Campaign Finance Program a.k.a. "C-Finance" for all campaign treasurer reports to be filed with office of Appellee. Page 3 from the "Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections Campaign Finance Manual" is

attached hereto as Exhibit 3 and the first sentence of the introduction confirms the encouragement of using C-Finance.

- 7. In order to qualify for the privilege of using C-Finance, the Appellee requires the candidate to complete a "Candidate Information Sheet C-Finance – Electronic Campaign Finance Reporting" form and to input a password for usage of the system. A copy of the form as completed by the Appellant is attached hereto as Exhibit 4 (the password has been redacted for privacy reasons).
- 8. On April 20, 2018, Appellee's representative, Ed Sacerio, issued an email to the Appellant confirming that the Appellant was registered for C-Finance, and assigning a username to the password previously selected. The email dated 04/20/2018 is attached hereto as Exhibit 5 (the password has been redacted for privacy reasons).
- 9. Appellant timely submitted the 2018-M4 campaign treasurer report on May 10, 2018 utilizing the C-Finance electronic submission system encouraged by Appellee. By reviewing the website maintained by the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections, it clearly reflects that the 2018-M4 report was due and submitted on May 10, 2018. Printouts from the online system [available to the public] are attached hereto as composite Exhibit 6.

- 10.As of May 10, 2018, the general public was able to see all of the Appellant's contributions and expenditures for the period 04/01/2018 through 04/30/2018, which is the intent of the report submission.
- 11.On June 1, 2018, Appellant received an email from a representative from Appellee, Alexia Goods, stating that the Campaign Treasurer's Report or Waiver of Report due on May 10, 2018 had not been turned in. The email from Alexia Goods to Appellant is attached hereto as Exhibit 7.
- 12.As soon as the Appellant received the email attached hereto as Exhibit 7, he called Appellee's office, and was notified that Appellee desired a "physical" signature on the "Summary Page" of the campaign treasurer's report.
- 13.Upon hearing this, Appellant immediately printed out copies of the 2018-M4 report and physically drove to the office of the Appellee to inquire about this "physical signature" in an effort to expeditiously correct any error on the part of the Appellant.
- 14.On June 1, 2018, upon arriving at the office of Appellee, Appellant spoke in person with Alexia Goods. In front of her, Appellant physically signed the 2018-M4 summary page, which was clocked with a June 1, 2018 2:21PM date-stamp. The certified copy of the date-stamped 2018-M4 summary page is attached hereto as Exhibit 8.

- 15.At the same time, Appellant specifically requested from Appellee's representative, Alexia Goods, all evidence in their possession reflecting that the 2018-M4 report was submitted electronically by Appellant on May 10, 2018. The certified copy of the Appellee's computer screen shot reflecting a submission date of May 10, 2018 is attached hereto as Exhibit 9.
- 16.As of the date of the filing of this appeal, Appellant has abided by the request of Appellee in physically submitting a campaign treasurer's report with a physical signature. As an example, attached hereto as Exhibit 10 is a certified copy of the 2018-M5 report due on June 11, 2018 and date-stamped June 6, 2018 at 9:25AM, 5 days earlier than required.

ARGUMENT

Based on this appeal, this Honorable Commission must now determine whether the "automatic" fine imposed upon Appellant is proper and justified. The applicable law is Fla. Stat. § 106.07. The basic language of F.S. §106.07(1) states: "Each campaign treasurer designated by a candidate or political committee pursuant to s. 106.021 **shall file** regular reports of all contributions received, and all expenditures made, by or on behalf of such candidate or political committee [...]" (emphasis added).

The proper filing officer in the instant case was the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections. However, it should be noted that for state-wide elections, the Florida Division of Elections has imposed a requirement upon candidates required to file contribution and expenditure reports to do so by the Division's electronic filing system. *See Fla. Stat.* §106.0705(2). The filing officer in the instant case, the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections is also permitted to establish an electronic filing system by virtue of Fla. Stat. §106.07(2)(a)(2).

1) <u>The 2018-M4 campaign treasurer's report was in fact timely submitted</u> for the following reasons:

- a) Fla. Stat. §106.07(8)(b)(1.) states : "The filing officer shall determine the amount of the fine due based upon the earliest of the following: 1. When the report is actually received by such officer [...]" In fact, the report was received by the officer electronically on May 10, 2018, therefore, the Appellant cannot be subject to a fine.
- b) The Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections "encourages" the use of the electronic filing system established, known as C-finance, as indicated in the Campaign Finance Manual. Through C-Finance, the candidate reporting a contribution or expenditure is required to input the names, occupations, addresses and amounts contributed by contributors, as well as the business names, addresses, and purposes of all expenditures. This is probably done to ease the burden on the employees working for the Supervisor of Elections from electronically inputting information that

may be handed to them in writing or in type-written fashion by candidates not using the C-Finance system.

- c) A candidate for a county office in Palm Beach County does not automatically qualify to participate in utilizing the C-Finance system. Appellant was required to complete paperwork and be registered by a representative for Appellee with a username and password to be graced with the honor of using the C-Finance system. Every time a contribution or expenditure is input through the C-Finance system, the contribution or expenditure is available for public viewing (which is the original intent of campaign reporting). Once the term ends, the candidate is then able to submit a report containing a summary, along with a listing of all contributions and expenditures. The Appellant maintains that all 2018-M4 reports were submitted in a timely fashion on May 10, 2018.
- d) All material in the possession of the Appellee and published by the Appellee clearly states that the Appellant submitted all 2018-M4 reports on May 10, 2018. One document attempts to make a distinction between a "submission" and an "acceptance by the Appellee." Hypothetically, a candidate not utilizing C-Finance can physically submit a report timely, yet the Appellee may arbitrarily decide not to "accept" it for days or weeks later, which would be unjust and unethical.

e) The State of Florida Division of Elections has adopted an electronic system of reporting and has mandated its use, and Palm Beach County has implemented an electronic system of reporting, yet seems to have no interest in recognizing a candidate's use of it.

2) The Appellee failed to give proper notice of the "incompleteness," if any, to the Appellant, in violation of Fla. Stat. §106.07(2)(b)(1.)

- a. Fla. Stat. §106.07(2)(b)(1.) states: "Any report that is deemed to be incomplete by the officer with whom the candidate qualifies **must be accepted on a conditional basis**. The campaign treasurer shall be notified by certified mail or by another method using a common carrier that provides a proof of delivery of the notice as to why the report is incomplete and within 7 days after receipt of such notice must file an addendum to the report providing all information necessary to complete the report in compliance with this section." (emphasis added).
- b. The Appellee never sent notice by certified mail or otherwise with a common carrier with proof of delivery reflecting that the 2018-M4 campaign finance report was incomplete, in the instant case, apparently not having a "physical signature." As such, the Appellant was required to have been given an opportunity within 7 days of first

being notified to be able to make any correction desired by the Appellee. This portion of the statute requires the Appellee to have accepted the report on a conditional basis; therefore, the Appellant should not be subject to a fine.

- c. It should also be noted that the first notice received by Appellant concerning this matter was via email on June 1, 2018, which was 22 days after the May 10, 2018 date (conceivably, the Appellee may have attempted to deliberately drive up the fine amount by delaying the notice, but this Commission should note that Appellant should have been given a 7 day window to correct it, and, in fact, Appellant corrected the Appellee's concern the same day Appellant was notified June 1, 2018).
- 3) <u>The Florida Elections Commission should consider waiving the subject</u> <u>fine in whole or, at least in part, based upon, but not limited to, unusual</u> <u>circumstances, and must consider mitigating and aggravating</u> <u>circumstances under Fla. Stat. §106.265(2).</u>
 - a) The circumstances surrounding the instant fine are quite unusual and of first impression before the Commission. The Appellant was unable to find a case with similar facts because the concepts of electronic filing and electronic signatures are novel, particularly with campaign

finance regulations. Pursuant to Fla. Stat. §106.07(8)(c), this Commission may waive or reduce the fine imposed by considering unusual circumstances as well as mitigating or aggravating factors pursuant to Fla. Stat. §106.265(2), which states: "In determining the amount of such civil penalties, the commission or administrative law judge shall consider, among other mitigating and aggravating circumstances:

- a. the gravity of the act or omission;
- b. any previous history of similar acts or omissions;
- c. the appropriateness of such penalty to the financial resources of the person [...]"
- b) The gravity of the act or omission (if any) at issue is non-existent. There was absolutely no harm in the absence of a "physical" signature on the 2018-M4 report from May 10, 2018 through June 1, 2018, because it had already been electronically filed and submitted on May 10, 2018 and the public was fully aware of all contributions and expenditures during the 04/01/2018-04/30/2018 period, as intended.
- c) In considering the instant case, the Appellant implores the Commission to consider the following:

- a. The Appellant is an attorney licensed to practice law in Florida since 2005 and in Washington D.C. since 2013 and has never had a Bar Complaint filed against him or been disciplined by any Bar.
- b. The Appellant is currently 36 years old and has no criminal record, has never been arrested, and has only been cited only twice in his entire life for 2 traffic infractions and never convicted of said traffic citations.
- c. The Appellant aspires to be a judge to serve his community; after years of successfully advocating on behalf of thousands in his community in various areas of law, including civil, criminal, and immigration, the Appellant aspires to be an instrumental part of the justice system. This the Appellant's first attempt to _at any election and has never before had a history of similar acts or omissions, and in fact, is aspiring to ensure that the Appellee's demands are met. The Appellant will aspire to ensure that campaign finance reports are not only electronically filed, but printed out and hand-delivered to the Appellee prior to the designated deadline.

CONCLUSION

The Appellant respectfully requests the Commission to consider waiving the fine, or, in the alternative, a significant reduction in the fine imposed by the Appellee. As the Commission has seen by the evidence on record, the Appellee contradicts herself by giving the impression that all campaign finance reports were timely submitted electronically, yet waits 22 days to file a notice with the Appellant to advise him that the campaign finance summary report is incomplete because she desires a "physical" signature on it. It is unjust to bait a candidate into using an electronic filing system, particularly where Appellant is a candidate for judicial office and an attorney; as a practicing attorney, Appellant has been required by the Florida Bar and the Florida Supreme Court to electronically file all documents and has been consistently encouraged to utilize electronic signature. Further, the Appellee could have provided the Appellant with the proper notice pursuant to Fla. Stat. (106.07(2))(b)(1.) prior to imposing the fine imposed. Lastly, this Commission should consider the character and integrity of the Appellant and judge him not by this one incident, but by years of service as an honorable practicing attorney before the tribunal and one who proudly serves his community as a Board member and treasurer of a non-profit organization in Palm Beach County.

The Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections office encourages the use of the Campaign Finance Program (C-Finance), for all Treasurer Reports that are filed with this office. This is an online program that is available for your use from any computer with internet access. The C-Finance program requires a username and password in order to access the program. A 'Candidate Information Sheet' must be completed and filed with our office for this purpose. The Supervisor of Elections office will enter the information into the C-Finance program and send an email to you and your campaign treasurer advising you of your username and selected password. Once you have received the email confirmation from our office you are ready to begin.

NOTE: If you do not have a username and password, you will not be able to access the C-Finance program. Please call our office and ask to speak with a member of the Candidate Department.
