If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

ORDER OF PROBABLE CAUSE

THIS MATTER was heard by the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) at its regularly scheduled meeting on November 28, 2017, in Tallahassee, Florida.

On October 13, 2017, Staff recommended to the Commission that there was probable cause to believe that the Florida Election Code was violated. The facts articulated in Staff's Recommendation are adopted by reference and incorporated herein. Based on the Complaint, Report of Investigation, Staff's Recommendation, and oral statements (if any) made at the probable cause hearing, the Commission finds that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with the following violation(s):

Count 1:

On or about February 10, 2015, Committee to Amend to Recall violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2015 M1 Report.

Count 2:

On or about July 10, 2015, Committee to Amend to Recall violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the

filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2015 M6 Report.

Count 3:

On or about August 10, 2015, Committee to Amend to Recall violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2015 M7 Report.

Count 4:

On or about September 10, 2015, Committee to Amend to Recall violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2015 M8 Report.

Count 5:

On or about November 10, 2015, Committee to Amend to Recall violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2015 M10 Report.

Count 6:

On or about December 10, 2015, Committee to Amend to Recall violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2015 M11 Report.

Count 7:

On or about January 11, 2016, Committee to Amend to Recall violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2015 M12 Report.

The Commission finds that there is **no probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, and **no probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, regarding the 2015 M9 report.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO A HEARING

As the Respondent, you may elect to resolve this case in several ways. First, you may elect to resolve this case by <u>consent order</u> where you and Commission staff agree to resolve the violation(s)s and agree to the amount of the fine. The consent order is then presented to the Commission for its approval. To discuss a consent order, contact the FEC attorney identified in the Order of Probable Cause.

Second, you may request an <u>informal hearing</u> held before the Commission, if you <u>do not</u> dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. You have 30 days from the date the Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission to request such a hearing. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order. At the hearing, you will have the right to make written or oral arguments to the Commission concerning the legal issues related to the violation(s) and the potential fine. 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STAFF RECOMMENDATION FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(c), Florida Statutes, undersigned staff counsel files this written recommendation for disposition of the referral in this case recommending that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating **Section 106.07(7)**, **Florida Statutes**, and **no probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating **Section 106.19(1)(c)**, **Florida Statutes**. Based upon a thorough review of the Report of Investigation submitted on September 25, 2017, the following facts and law support this staff recommendation:

- 1. On October 6, 2015, the Florida Elections Commission ("Commission") received a referral from the Department of State, Division of Elections ("Division"), alleging that Committee to Amend to Recall ("Respondent") violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.¹
- 2. Respondent is a political committee registered with the Division. An Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Political Committees form ("DS-DE 6") appointing Robert Abston as Respondent's treasurer was filed with the Division on July 18, 2012. Mr. Abston is also Respondent's chairman. (ROI Exhibit 3)²
- 3. By letter dated July 27, 2017, the Executive Director notified Respondent that Commission staff would investigate the following statutory provision:

Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes: As alleged in the complaint, Respondent may have failed to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed on that date because it had not received funds, made contributions, or expended reportable funds during the following reporting periods:³

- 2015 M1
- 2015 M6
- 2015 M7
- 2015 M8

¹ Four referrals were received by the Commission between October 6, 2015, and February 2, 2016, which were consolidated into this case because each made similar allegations against Respondent, but each dealt with different reporting periods.

² The Report of Investigation is referred to herein as "ROI."

³ The letter dated July 27, 2017, references the 2016 M11 and 2016 M12 reports. However, this was a scrivener's error. The referral references the 2015 M11 and 2015 M12 reports, and the investigation dealt with those reports.

- 2015 M9⁴
- 2015 M10
- 2015 M11
- 2015 M12

Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes: As alleged in the complaint, Respondent may have falsely reported or deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, when it failed to file a report on the prescribed reporting date for the following reporting periods:

- 2015 M1
- 2015 M6
- 2015 M7
- 2015 M8
- 2015 M9⁵
- 2015 M10
- 2015 M11
- 2015 M12
- 4. By letter dated July 20, 2012, Kristi Reid Bronson, Division of Elections, Chief, Bureau of Election Records, sent Respondent's treasurer a letter acknowledging that the Division had received Respondent's DS-DE 6 form designating him treasurer. The acknowledgment letter advised Respondent that all of the Division's publications and reporting forms were available on its website, including Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, the *Political Committee Handbook*, and the *Calendar of Reporting Dates*. The letter warned Respondent that it was their responsibility to read, understand, and follow the requirements of Florida's election laws. (ROI Exhibit 4, page 1)
- 5. For each reporting period listed above, Respondent failed to timely file either a campaign treasurer's report or waiver of report. Respondent ultimately filed waivers of all the reports at issue. The table on the following page presents information regarding each of the reporting periods at issue, including the date the report was due, when the waiver of report was filed, the number of days late that the waiver of report was filed, and the date(s) that failure to file letters were sent to Respondent by the Division regarding the reporting period: (ROI Exhibits 5-8 and Exhibits 10-13)

⁴ Allegations under Sections 106.07(7), and 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, pertaining to the 2015 M9 report were already investigated in case 15-507. A final order was entered by the Commission on November 30, 2016, in which a fine of \$500 was imposed for one count of violating Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes. On January 13, 2016, the same issues pertaining to the 2015 M9 report were inadvertently referred to the Commission by the Division a second time, and it was included in this case by error. Pursuant Section 106.25(2), Florida Statutes, the Commission is barred from investigating issues that were raised in a prior complaint if those allegations are raised again in a subsequent complaint. Therefore, I recommend that the Commission find no probable cause to charge Respondent with any issues pertaining to its 2015 M9 report.

- 6. A subpoena was issued to Respondent's designated campaign depository to ascertain whether any contributions were received or expenditures were made by Respondent during the relevant reporting periods. The depository was unable to locate any records for Respondent pertaining to any of the reporting periods. (ROI Exhibit 14)
- 7. Pursuant to Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, in any reporting period during which a political committee has not received funds, made any contributions, or expended any reportable funds, the filing of the required report for that period is waived. However, the political committee is required to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that no report is being filed on that date.
- 8. Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, prohibits a political committee from falsely reporting or deliberately failing to include any information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.
- 9. Respondent was offered multiple opportunities to respond to Commission staff's investigation, but failed to do so.
- 10. Based on the information above, since there is no record of reportable financial activity during any of the reporting periods at issue, Respondent was not required to file campaign treasurer's reports for any of those periods. However, Respondent was required to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting dates that no reports would be filed. Respondent failed to do so for all reports at issue in this referral.

- 11. "Probable Cause" is defined as reasonable grounds of suspicion supported by circumstances sufficiently strong to warrant a cautious person in the belief that the person has committed the offense charged. Schmitt v. State, 590 So. 2d 404, 409 (Fla. 1991). Probable cause exists where the facts and circumstances, of which an [investigator] has reasonably trustworthy information, are sufficient in themselves for a reasonable man to reach the conclusion that an offense has been committed. Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles v. Favino, 667 So. 2d 305, 309 (Fla. 1st DCA 1995).
- 12. The facts set forth above show that Respondent is a political committee registered with the Division. For each of the reporting periods at issue, Respondent failed to either file the campaign treasurer's report or to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed. The investigation determined that there is no record of reportable financial activity during any the relevant reporting periods. Therefore, Respondent was not required to file campaign treasurer's reports, and there is no record of contributions received or expenditures made by Respondent which were not reported or falsely reported. However, since there was no reportable financial activity during any of the reporting periods at issue, Respondent was required to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting dates that no reports would be filed, yet Respondent failed to do so for all the reports at issue in this referral.

Based upon these facts and circumstances, I recommend that the Commission find no probable cause to charge Respondent with violating Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, and find no probable cause to charge Respondent with violating Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, regarding the 2015 M9 report, but find probable cause to charge Respondent with violating the following:

Count 1:

On or about February 10, 2015, Committee to Amend to Recall violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2015 M1 Report.

Count 2:

On or about July 10, 2015, Committee to Amend to Recall violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2015 M6 Report.

Count 3:

On or about August 10, 2015, Committee to Amend to Recall violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2015 M7 Report.

Count 4:

On or about September 10, 2015, Committee to Amend to Recall violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2015 M8 Report.

Count 5:

On or about November 10, 2015, Committee to Amend to Recall violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2015 M10 Report.

Count 6:

On or about December 10, 2015, Committee to Amend to Recall violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2015 M11 Report.

Count 7:

On or about January 11, 2016, Committee to Amend to Recall violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2015 M12 Report.

On October 6, 2015, the Florida Elections Commission ("Commission") received a sworn complaint alleging that Respondent violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes. Commission staff investigated whether Respondent violated the following statutes:

Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, failure of a political committee that did not receive any contributions or make any expenditures during a reporting period to notify timely the filing officer, in writing, that no report is being filed; and

Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, prohibiting a person or organization from falsely reporting or deliberately failing to report information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.

I. Preliminary Information:

- 1. Respondent is the Committee to Amend to Recall, a political committee that is registered with the Division of Elections. On April 20, 2012, this PAC was placed on the active committee list as a political committee that supports issues.
 - 2. Complainant is the Division of Elections.
- 3. Respondent's filing officer is Kristi Reid-Bronson, Chief, Bureau of Election Records.
- 4. A DOE staff representative, Kristi Reid-Bronson, submitted sworn-affidavits dated October 6, 2015; October 28, 2015; January 13, 2016; and February 2, 2016 regarding Respondent's failure to file several campaign reports. To review the sworn-affidavits, refer to exhibit 1.
- 5. On April 16, 2012, Respondent filed a Statement of Organization of Political Committee (DS-DE 5) form with the Division of Elections. The area, scope, and jurisdiction of the committee are listed as "To amend the constitution of the State of Florida to permit recall of state elected officials". To review a copy of the DS-DE 5 form, refer to exhibit 2.
- 6. On July 18, 2012, Respondent filed the current Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository (DS-DE 6) form with the Division of

Elections. Mr. Robert Abston was appointed as campaign treasurer. To review a copy of the July 18, 2012 DS-DE 6 form, refer to exhibit 3.

- 7. On July 20, 2012, Complainant mailed Respondent an acknowledgement letter informing Respondent of their "confidential pin number to access the Division of Election's electronic filing system (EFS) for submitting campaign treasurer's reports". To review a copy of the July 20, 2012 acknowledgement letter, refer to exhibit 4.
- 8. The allegations that Respondent failed to report campaign activity, or in the alternative, failed to notify the filing officer in writing, that no report would be filed for several reporting periods will be discussed in the following paragraphs.

II. Alleged Violation of Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes:

- 9. I investigated whether Respondent violated this section of the election laws by falsely reporting or deliberately failing to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, when it failed to file a treasurer's report, or a notice-of-no-activity, on the prescribed reporting dates, for several reporting periods.
- 10. Table 1 documents the information regarding notices-of-no-activity waivers that were untimely filed. To view a copy of Respondent's filing history, refer to exhibit 13.

- 11. I have subpoenaed depository records for this political committee for the time-periods associated with the reports in Table 1. The first report in question, the 2015 M1 Report, covers the time-period from January 1, 2015 through January 31, 2015. The last report in question, the 2015 M12 Report, covers the time-period from December 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015. The depository was unable to locate any records for Respondent pertaining to the 2015-2016 calendar year. As such, it appears Respondent should have provided timely written notices to the filing officer in regards to having no activity occurring during the reporting periods mentioned in Table 1; and advised that no report would be filed for these periods. To review a copy of records from the campaign depository, refer to exhibit 14.
- 12. There was no record found that Respondent has previously violated this section of the election laws.

III. Alleged Violation of Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes:

- 13. I investigated whether Respondent violated this section of the election laws by failing to timely notify the filing officer, in writing, that no report is being filed due to not receiving any contributions or making any expenditures during several reporting periods.
 - 14. To review a history of Respondent's filings/notifications, refer to Table 1.
 - 15. Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, states in part:

"Notwithstanding any other provisions of this chapter, in any reporting period during which a candidate or political committee has not received funds, made any contributions, or expended any reportable funds, the filing of the required report for that period is waived...any candidate or political committee not reporting by virtue of this subsection on dates prescribed elsewhere in this chapter shall notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that no report is being filed on that date."

- 16. In an email dated April 2, 2014, Ms. Bronson was asked to clarify the procedure regarding how to notify the Division in writing on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed. In her response, Ms. Bronson stated, "The notice that no report will be filed is the waiver, which must be filed in the EFS. We do not require anything separate in writing." To review a copy of Ms. Bronson's email, refer to exhibit 15.
- 17. Pages 12, 13, 45, and 46 of the Political Committee EFS User's Guide discusses how to notify the Division on the prescribed reporting date that no report will be filed using the EFS. Specifically, page 13 instructs the user to click the box next to "waiver" if there is no activity to disclose³. To review the relevant pages from the Political Committee EFS User's Guide, refer to exhibit 16.

18. There was a record found that Respondent has previously violated this section of the election laws.

IV. FEC History:

19. FEC 15-053; probable cause was found for a violation of 106.07(7). Respondent was fined \$1,500.00/there is no record that this fine has been paid. FEC 15-507; probable cause was found for a violation of 106.07(7), but no probable cause for 106.19(1)(c); fined in the amount of \$500.00/there is no record that this fine as been paid.

Conclusion:

- 20. Respondent was offered several opportunities to make comments regarding the findings of this investigation. Respondent did not respond to any of these attempts.
- 21. In a July 20, 2012 acknowledgement letter, Respondent was informed that all of the Division's publications were available online at the DOE's website. In the letter, respondent was admonished as follows: It is your responsibility to read, understand, and follow the requirements of Florida's election laws. Therefore, please print a copy of the following documents: Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, 2012 Political Committee Handbook, 2012 Calendar of Reporting Dates, and Rule 1S-2.017, Florida Administrative Code". To review a copy of the July 20, 2012 acknowledgement letter, refer to exhibit 4.







Each political committee chairperson is required to provide the Division of Elections with confidential personal information that may be used to allow access in the event that the password is forgotten or lost. When you enter the campaign account screen, there will be a drop down box where you pick a question (such as What is your mother's maiden name?) and supply an answer. All passwords and answers to questions are stored as encrypted data and cannot be viewed by Division staff and given out over the phone. Please notify the Division if your credentials have been compromised.

Timely Filing

All reports must be completed and filed through the EFS not later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the due date. Reports not filed by midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the due date are late filed and subject to the penalties in Section 106.07(8), Florida Statutes. In the event that the EFS is inoperable on the due date, the report will be accepted as timely filed if filed no later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the first business day the EFS becomes operable. No fine will be levied during the period the EFS was inoperable.

Any political committee failing to file a report on the designated due date is subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first 3 days and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for the reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

Electronic Receipts

The person submitting the report on the EFS will be issued an electronic receipt indicating and verifying the report was filed. Each campaign treasurer's report filed by means of the EFS is considered to be under oath by the chairperson and campaign treasurer and such persons are subject to the provisions of Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes.

You will have an opportunity to respond to both the ROI and the SR. The Commission will then hold one or more hearings to determine whether the alleged violations occurred and, if so, the amount of the fine to be imposed. You and the complainant will receive notice at least 14 days before any hearing at which your case is to be considered.

Timely Filing

All reports must be completed and filed through the EFS not later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the due date. Reports not filed by midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the due date are late filed and subject to the penalties in Section 106.07(8), Florida Statutes. In the event that the EFS is inoperable on the due date, the report will be accepted as timely filed if filed no later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the first business day the EFS becomes operable. No fine will be levied during the period the EFS was inoperable.

Any political committee failing to file a report on the designated due date is subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first 3 days and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for the reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

Electronic Receipts

The person submitting the report on the EFS will be issued an electronic receipt indicating and verifying the report was filed. 

Pin Numbers

Each political committee chairperson is required to provide the Division of Elections with confidential personal information that may be used to allow access in the event that the password is forgotten or lost. When you enter the campaign account screen, there will be a drop down box where you pick a question (such as What is your mother's maiden name?) and supply an answer. All passwords and answers to questions are stored as encrypted data and cannot be viewed by Division staff and given out over the phone. Please notify the Division if your credentials have been compromised.

Timely Filing

All reports must be completed and filed through the EFS not later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the due date. Reports not filed by midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the due date are late filed and subject to the penalties in Section 106.07(8), Florida Statutes. In the event that the EFS is inoperable on the due date, the report will be accepted as timely filed if filed no later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the first business day the EFS becomes operable. No fine will be levied during the period the EFS was inoperable.

Any political committee failing to file a report on the designated due date is subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first 3 days and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for the reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

Pin Numbers

Pin numbers are confidential secure credentials that allow you to submit reports and update information. The enclosed sealed envelope provides a confidential pin number for the chairperson. By copy of this letter, a confidential PIN number to access the Division of Election's electronic filing system (EFS) was sent to the treasurer.

Each political committee chairperson is required to provide the Division of Elections with confidential personal information that may be used to allow access in the event that the password is forgotten or lost. When you enter the campaign account screen, there will be a drop down box where you pick a question (such as What is your mother's maiden name?) and supply an answer. All passwords and answers to questions are stored as encrypted data and cannot be viewed by Division staff and given out over the phone. Please notify the Division if your credentials have been compromised.

Timely Filing

All reports must be completed and filed through the EFS not later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the due date. Reports not filed by midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the due date are late filed and subject to the penalties in Section 106.07(8), Florida Statutes. In the event that the EFS is inoperable on the due date, the report will be accepted as timely filed if filed no later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the first business day the EFS becomes operable. No fine will be levied during the period the EFS was inoperable.

Any political committee failing to file a report on the designated due date is subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first 3 days and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for the reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

Electronic Receipts

The person submitting the report on the EFS will be issued an electronic receipt indicating and verifying the report was filed. Each campaign treasurer's report filed by means of the EFS is considered to be under oath by the chairperson and campaign treasurer and such persons are subject to the provisions of Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes.
