You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

### STAFF RECOMMENDATION FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(c), Florida Statutes, undersigned staff counsel files this written recommendation for disposition of the referral in this case recommending that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating **Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes**. Based upon a thorough review of the Report of Investigation submitted on December 8, 2020, the following facts and law support this staff recommendation:

1. On August 20, 2020, the Florida Elections Commission ("Commission") received a referral from the Department of State, Division of Elections ("Division" or "Complainant"), alleging that Danika Fornear ("Respondent") violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.

2. Respondent was a 2020 candidate for State Representative, District 79. (ROI Exhibit 1)<sup>1</sup>

3. By letter dated September 14, 2020, the Executive Director notified Respondent that Commission staff would investigate the following statutory provision:

Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2020 candidate for the office of State Representative, District 79, acting as her own treasurer, failed to timely make necessary amendments to the 2020 P1 campaign treasurer's report, as alleged in the complaint.

4. On May 26, 2020, Respondent filed her Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Candidates form ("DS-DE 9") appointing herself as treasurer for her campaign. (ROI Exhibit 1)

5. By letter dated May 27, 2020, Kristi Reid Willis, Chief, Bureau of Election Records, sent Respondent a letter acknowledging that the Division had received her DS-DE 9. (ROI Exhibit 2)

6. The acknowledgment letter advised Respondent that all candidates filing reports with the Division are required to use the electronic filing system ("EFS"), and provided Respondent with a user identification number and initial password to grant access to the EFS. The letter further advised Respondent that all of the Division's publications and reporting forms were

available on its website and directed Respondent to print out the *Calendar of Reporting Dates* as well as other relevant documents. (ROI Exhibit 2)

7. The campaign's 2020 P1 Report was incomplete when filed. See Compl.

8. The Division sent three letters notifying Respondent that the campaign's report was incomplete and that Respondent was required to amend the report within 7 days of receipt of the notification. An Error Report showing why the report was incomplete was attached to each notification. (ROI Exhibits 3 & 4) The final notification was confirmed delivered. (ROI Exhibit 4, page 6)

9. Respondent stated that she has fixed all of the errors on the campaign's report. (ROI Exhibit 6, page 1)

10. On September 8, 2020, Respondent filed an amendment to the campaign's report. The amendment was filed 29 days late and 78 days after the initial notification was mailed. The Division confirmed that the report was correctly amended. (ROI Exhibit 5)

11. "Probable Cause" is defined as reasonable grounds of suspicion supported by circumstances sufficiently strong to warrant a cautious person in the belief that the person has committed the offense charged. *Schmitt v. State*, 590 So. 2d 404, 409 (Fla. 1991). Probable cause exists where the facts and circumstances, of which an [investigator] has reasonably trustworthy information, are sufficient in themselves for a reasonable man to reach the conclusion that an offense has been committed. *Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles v. Favino*, 667 So. 2d 305, 309 (Fla. 1st DCA 1995).

12. The facts set forth above show that Respondent was a 2020 candidate for State Representative, District 79. Respondent failed to timely file the required amendment to the campaign's 2020 P1 Report within 7 days of receiving notification from the Division that the report was incomplete and required amendment.

Based upon these facts and circumstances, I recommend that the Commission find **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating the following:

### Count 1:

On or about August 10, 2020, Danika Fornear violated Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, when she failed to timely file an addendum to her 2020 P1 Report within seven days after receiving notice from the Department of State, Division of Elections, that the report required amendment.

### I. Preliminary Information:

1. I investigated whether Respondent violated this section of the election laws by failing to file amended report(s) for the following campaign treasurer's report(s) after receiving notice from the filing officer: 2020 P1.

2. An Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository (DS-DE 9) was filed on May 26, 2020. Respondent was named as the treasurer for her own campaign, a 2020 candidate for State Representative, District 79. To review the DS-DE 9, refer to Exhibit 1.

3. On May 27, 2020, the Division sent Respondent a letter acknowledging her appointment as the campaign treasurer for her 2020 campaign. The letter advised Respondent that all of the Division's publications and reporting forms are available on their website, including Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, the *Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook*, and the *Calendar of Reporting Dates*. The letter further advised Respondent that it was her responsibility to read, understand, and follow the requirements of Florida's election laws. To review a copy of the acknowledgement letter, refer to Exhibit 2.

### II. Alleged Violation of Section 106.07(2)(b)(1)., Florida Statutes:

4. On June 22, 2020 and July 10, 2020, the Division sent correspondence to Respondent informing her that one or more campaign reports were incomplete. The correspondence was sent to Respondent's address provided on the DS-DE 9 and included an error report referencing the following report: 2020 P1. To review the correspondence and error report, refer to Exhibit 3.

5. On July 29, 2020, the Division sent Respondent a letter marked "Final Notice" with delivery confirmation informing her that one or more campaign reports were incomplete. The letter was sent to Respondent's address provided on the DS-DE 9 and included an error report referencing the following report: 2020 P1. It was confirmed delivered on August 3, 2020. To review the Final Notice letter, error report and delivery confirmation, refer to Exhibit 4.

6. In an email dated November 9, 2020, Division staff confirmed that Respondent has correctly amended the report at issue. The 2020 P1 report was correctly amended on September 8, 2020. To review the emails from Division staff, refer to Exhibit 5.

7. Respondent did respond to the referral. Respondent acknowledged that she did have some mistakes on her 2020 P1 report and stated that she has since worked with "outside experts" to correct it. Respondent stated that the report has been resubmitted and shows no further errors. To review Respondent's response to the referral, refer to Exhibit 6.

8. Respondent did not respond to a questionnaire-affidavit. Because the affidavit has not been returned, I am unable to ascertain whether she has read Chapter 106, Florida Statutes and/or the *Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook*.

9. I attempted to contact Respondent on four occasions to give her an opportunity to discuss the allegation(s) made in the referral. As of the date of this report, Respondent has not returned my telephone calls. To review a copy of the phone log, refer to Exhibit 7.
