Failure to appear in accordance with this notice will constitute a waiver of your right to participate in the hearing. Continuances will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

This hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, which governs your participation as follows:

If you are the Respondent, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are the Complainant, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are an Appellant, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

Please refer to the information below for further instructions related to your particular hearing:

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

SUMMARY: Cocoa Beach Hotel & Motel Association Political Action Committee is a political committee (PC) registered with the State of Florida. The PC's chair is Tom Williamson and its treasurer is Tom C. Hermansen.

The PC is appealing the fine. According to Alex Vagelakos, Certified Public Accountant for the PC, they reported the 2022 G3A financial activity on the 2022 G3 Report due to the impending natural disaster of Hurricane Ian. Mr. Vagelakos also states that since they reported the activity early, they filed a waiver for the 2022 G3A reporting period. Thereafter, the committee received a notice from the Division that the 2022 G3 Report contained errors as the financial activity was reported in the wrong coverage period. The committee then filed a report to disclose a portion of the financial activity during the 2022 G3A reporting period. The report did not disclose two checks that the committee stated were returned to contributors (\$1,000 total) and disclosed an additional expenditure in the amount of \$84.09.

- The 2022 G3A Original Report covers the period from 09/24/22-09/30/22; it was due on 10/07/22.
- The 2022 G3A Queued Transaction Report shows that it was created and filed on 10/07/22.¹
- Cocoa Beach Hotel & Motel Association Political Action Committee reported receiving zero contributions, while making 6 expenditures.
- FEC staff was advised, "The committee filed a notice of no activity (waiver) on 10/07/22. A waiver is not a report. On 10/27/22, the committee filed a report showing \$4,084.09 of activity. The fine is based on 25% of the activity.
- The Division of Elections does not have any notes that pertain to Cocoa Beach Hotel & Motel Association Political Action Committee's 2022 G3A report.

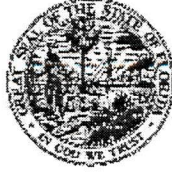

The Following is the timeline of events that shows that the report referenced in the Late Fine Notice (Attachment A) was timely filed.

- On 9/28 – 9/29 the area in which the committee resides was greatly affected by Hurricane Ian. This natural disaster (FAC 2B-1.0055 (1)(a)) is documented through the Florida Today Newspaper Article Dated 10/18/22 (Attachment H) which details the nature (Hurricane Ian with \$14 Million in damages), date (FEMA activated 9/28 – 9/29) and location (Article is specific to Brevard county) of the disaster.
- The expenditures in question occurred on 9/26/22. In an attempt to document the expenditures taking into account that the impending natural disaster may affect business operations of both the PAC and the Florida Department of State, the report 2022-G3-203, which was due on 9/30 was filed (Attachment B) on 9/27 including these expenditures. The filing system did not prevent this report from being filed due to errors.
- Since these expenditures were included in the report 2022-G3-203 (Attachment B), they were omitted from **report 2022-G3A-204 (Attachment C), due 10/7, which was filed on 10/7. Attachment C shows the report that the notice is concerning was timely filed.**
- On 10/21, two checks originally included in Report 2022-G3-203 (Attachment B) were returned (Attachment D), and thus the report needed to be amended to remove those expenditures.
- A Notice of Error dated 10/10 (Attachment E) was received by the agent in charge of reporting on 10/27. Florida Statute 106.07(2)(B)1 states that an incomplete report must be accepted on a conditional basis and an addendum must be filed within 7 days of receipt (not 7 days after the notice date). Here the receipt of the Notice of Error by the agent in charge of reporting may have been affected by the previously mentioned Natural Disaster (FAC 2B-1.0055 (1)(a)).
- This Notice of Error (Attachment E) showed that the expenditures on 9/26 were after the coverage period for the filing of 2022-G3-203. This did not originally prevent the filing.
- Upon receipt of this notice of error, amendments were immediately filed to the report 2022-G3-203 (originally due 9/30) (Attachment F) and report 2022-G3A-204 (Originally due 10/7) (Attachment G) on 10/27/22. These amendments removed the expenditures originally filed from the report due on 9/30, and added the same expenditures to the report filed on 10/7. The two expenditures for the returned checks were also removed.

Beaches hard-hit as Brevard County reports millions of dollars overall in Hurricane Ian costs

Brevard County government departments say Hurricane Ian caused a total of \$14 million in damage to county facilities and added expenses.

More than half of that total is related to damage to Brevard's beaches.

Meanwhile, the number of Brevard County residents who have applied for individual assistance from the Federal Emergency Management Agency has reached 4,203.

Hit to the South Beaches: Ian takes a big bite out of South Beaches but spares most Space Coast shoreline

Help from FEMA: Brevard residents with Hurricane Ian damage can apply for assistance through FEMA

Here is a breakdown of hurricane costs by county department:

Beach damage: County officials said a preliminary assessment of impacts from Ian found that \$8.43 million of the \$14 million total is related to damage to the county's beaches, primarily on the southern end of Brevard.

Mike McGarry, Brevard County's beach renourishment coordinator, said the county's inspections show that the south beaches suffered a similar quantity of erosion to what occurred during Hurricane Matthew in 2016 and Hurricane Dorian in 2019.

"Thankfully, our maintenance of the beach over recent years helped protect upland infrastructure and structures," McGarry said.

McGarry said that, if the project to restore the beaches is found to be eligible for reimbursement from FEMA — as similar projects have in the past — in the end, Brevard would pay about 13% of the total cost, with the state and FEMA providing reimbursement for the remainder.

County money used to pay for beach renourishment come from Brevard's 5% Tourist Development Tax on hotel rooms and other short-term rentals.

FEMA pays on reimbursement — often several years after the fact — so the county has to front the money for these expenses.

The county currently has about \$10 million in reserves for storm events like this.

Other county departments reporting significant damage or expenses related to Hurricane Ian included mosquito control (\$2.40 million), parks and recreation (\$1.43 million), solid waste (\$569,604), public works (\$524,770), utility services (\$263,000) and fire rescue (\$220,163).

Mosquito control: Brevard County Communications Director Don Walker said the county's Mosquito Control Department had a wide range of damage.

According to preliminary assessments, mosquito impoundments incurred the majority of damage, with more than 14,000 linear feet of earthen dike significantly eroded, undercut and, in some areas, breached. Also, one impoundment pumphouse roof was damaged beyond repair.

Impoundments are salt marsh areas in which the county takes steps to control the mosquito population through proactively flooding the areas, eliminating mosquito breeding without using pesticides.

At the department's office facilities, some vinyl siding and shingles were missing from the buildings, and storage sheds were damaged. In addition, an electronic gate mechanism was water-damaged from flooding.

Aside from damages, mosquito control is planning to recoup some of the costs from storm-related mosquito and flood-control protective measures, which is included in the \$2.35 million estimate.

Brevard County Mosquito Control is conducting aerial and truck spraying, mosquito and disease monitoring, and other public health protection measures as a result of significant increases in standing water and mosquito activity related to Hurricane Ian.

It advises residents to take precautions and protect themselves from West Nile virus and other mosquito-borne illnesses by:

Draining and eliminating unnecessary water-holding containers.

Securing and repairing torn window screens

Reducing outdoor exposure during peak times of mosquito activity, such as dawn and dusk.

If outdoor exposure is unavoidable during peak times, residents should wear long-sleeved shirts and long pants, and apply mosquito repellent that is registered by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.

Parks and recreation: Parks and Recreation Department Director Mary Ellen Donner reported various boat ramp and campground site closures because of high water or damage, among other issues.

At Parrish Park Titusville, the boat ramp restroom is closed, and the north boat dock is closed because of high water. There is major erosion the north side of restrooms near the building foundation and seawall. The northwest corner of seawall is cordoned off with orange fencing. The county is consulting a structural engineer for assistance with repair design.

Other boat ramps that were closed as of Monday because of high water or damage included Bourbeau Boat Ramp; the east dock Eau Gallie Boat Ramp; Fox Lake Park; and the north dock at Jorgensens Boat Ramp.

Campgrounds with damage included Long Point, where 13 sites are unusable and will require site work and electrical pedestal replacement; and Manatee Hammock, where two sites are closed because of a downed tree.

At Kiwanis Park at Geiger Point, a pedestrian bridge is closed. The bridge is intact, but has been raised. The county is working with a structural engineer for assistance on repair design.

Hatbill Park is inaccessible because of flooding along State Road 46.

Solid waste: Solid Waste Management Department Director Tom Mulligan said almost all of his department's hurricane-related expenses of \$569,604 is related to a preliminary debris assessment performed across the county after the storm, and the estimated cost of collecting and final processing of storm debris.

Mulligan said the cost figure is likely to rise because of continued flooding in some areas, and people bringing additional vegetative debris out for collection.

Public works: Brevard County Public Works Director Marc Bernath said his department's \$524,770 in Hurricane Ian-related expenses included such things as labor and equipment for hurricane preparation, sandbag support, checking water elevations, monitoring portable and fixed pumps, driving known flooding areas and ensuring flow.

Additionally, Bernath said, a roof that was blown off on one of his department's pole barns and a soffit blew off on the deck of the Mathers Bridge tender house.

Emergency operations and shelters: Walker said the county has made a preliminary estimate of \$125,000 for the cost of operating the Emergency Operations Center and for opening three storm shelters during Ian.

The activation ran from 2 p.m. Sept. 28 to 8 p.m. Sept. 29.

Walker said the county will be working with FEMA and its insurance carrier to recover costs related to Hurricane Ian.

When you enter the campaign account screen, there will be a drop down box where you pick a question (such as *What is your mother's maiden name?*) and supply an answer. All passwords and answers to questions are stored as encrypted data and cannot be viewed by Division staff and given out over the phone. Please notify the Division if your credentials have been compromised.

Timely Filing

All reports must be completed and filed through the EFS no later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the due date. Reports not filed by midnight of the due date are late filed and subject to the penalties in Section 106.07(8), Florida Statutes. In the event that the EFS is inoperable on the due date, the report will be accepted as timely filed if filed no later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the first business day the EFS becomes operable. No fine will be levied during the period the EFS was inoperable.

Any political committee failing to file a report on the designated due date is subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first 3 days and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for the reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

Electronic Receipts

The person submitting the report on the EFS will be issued an electronic receipt indicating and verifying the report was filed. Each campaign treasurer's report filed by means of the EFS is considered to be under oath by the chairperson and campaign treasurer and such persons are subject to the provisions of Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes.
