If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

CONSENT FINAL ORDER

Respondent, Kimberly Daniels, and the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) agree that this Consent Order resolves all of the issues between the parties in this case. The parties jointly stipulate to the following facts, conclusions of law, and order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On March 2, 2015, a complaint was filed with the Commission alleging that Respondent violated Florida's election laws.
- 2. On February 28, 2017, the Commission entered an Order of Probable Cause finding there was probable cause to charge the Respondent with one count of violating Section 106.1405, Florida Statutes, one count of violating Section 106.19(1)(d), Florida Statutes, and one count of violating Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes.
- 3. The parties have expressed a desire to enter into negotiations directed toward reaching a consent agreement.
 - 4. Respondent and staff stipulate to the following facts:
 - a. Respondent was a 2015 candidate for re-election to the

Jacksonville City Council, At Large, Group 1.

- b. Respondent is an author and has published 16 books including, *The Demon Dictionary*.
- c. Respondent issued and signed Check No. 1003 from her campaign account to Shofar Magazine on March 1, 2014, in the amount of \$4,000 for the purpose of "advertisement."
- d. Respondent's treasurer filed Respondent's 2014 M3 Campaign Treasurer's Report and disclosed an expenditure to Shofar Magazine on March 1, 2014, in the amount of \$4,000 for the purpose of "advertisement."
- e. Shofar Magazine's 2014 Spring Edition issue contains a full-page advertisement titled, "The Demon Dictionary is released!" which encourages readers to purchase Respondent's book.
- f. Respondent disputed material issues of fact and elected to pursue a formal hearing before the Division of Administrative Hearings.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 5. The Commission has jurisdiction over the parties to and subject matter of this cause, pursuant to Section 106.26, Florida Statutes.
- 6. The Commission staff and the Respondent stipulate that staff can prove the facts in paragraph four above by clear and convincing evidence and to the Commission's ability to impose a civil penalty in this case.

ORDER

- 7. The Respondent and the staff of the Commission have entered into this Consent Order freely and voluntarily and upon advice of counsel.
- 8. The Respondent shall bear her own attorney's fees and costs that are in any way associated with this case.
 - 9. The Commission will consider this Consent Order at its next available meeting.
 - 10. Respondent voluntarily waives the right to any further proceedings under

Chapters 104, 106, and 120, Florida Statutes, and the right to appeal this Consent Order.

11. This Consent Order is enforceable under Sections 106.265 and 120.69, Florida Statutes. Respondent expressly waives any venue privileges and agrees that if enforcement of this Consent Order is necessary, venue shall be in Leon County, Florida, and Respondent shall pay all fees and costs associated with enforcement.

12. Payment of the civil penalty by cashier's check, or money order, good for at least 120 days, or attorney trust account check, is a condition precedent to the Commission's consideration of this Consent Order.

PENALTY

WHEREFORE, based upon the foregoing facts and conclusions of law, the Commission finds that the Respondent violated Section 106.1405, Florida Statutes, on one occasion, Section 106.19(1)(d), Florida Statutes, on one occasion, and Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, on one occasion, and imposes a civil penalty in the amount of \$1,500.

Therefore, it is

ORDERED that the Respondent shall remit to the Commission a civil penalty in the amount of \$1,500, inclusive of fees and costs. The civil penalty shall be paid cashier's check or money order, good for at least 120 days, or attorney trust account check. The civil penalty shall be payable to the Florida Elections Commission and sent to 107 West Gaines Street, Collins Building, Suite 224, Tallahassee, Florida, 32399-1050.

Count 2:

On or about March 1, 2014, Kimberly Daniels violated Section 106.19(1)(d), Florida Statutes, when she made or authorized an expenditure prohibited by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.

Count 3:

On or about April 9, 2014, Kimberly Daniels violated Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, when she falsely reported information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO A HEARING

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(c), Florida Statutes, undersigned staff counsel files this written recommendation for disposition of the sworn complaint in this case recommending that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating Sections 106.1405, 106.19(1)(c), and 106.19(1)(d), Florida Statutes Based upon a thorough review of the Report of Investigation submitted on January 13, 2016, the following facts and law support this staff recommendation:

- On March 2, 2015, the Florida Elections Commission ("Commission") received a sworn complaint from David Vandygriff ("Complainant"), alleging that Kimberly Daniels ("Respondent") violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes
- 2. Respondent was a 2015 candidate for re-election to the Jacksonville City Council, At Large, Group 1. Respondent's Statement of Candidate form ("DS-DE 84") was filed on September 12, 2013. (ROI Exhibit 15)¹
- 3 By letter dated September 18, 2015, the Executive Director notified Respondent that Commission staff would investigate the following statutory provisions:

Section 106.1405, Florida Statutes: Kimberly M. Daniels, a 2015 candidate for re-election to the Jacksonville City Council, appears to have used funds on deposit in her campaign account to defray normal living expenses, as alleged in the complaint

Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes: Kimberly M. Daniels, a 2015 candidate for re-election to the Jacksonville City Council, falsely reported or deliberately failed to include information in one or more campaign reports required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, as alleged in the complaint.

Section 106.19(1)(d), Florida Statutes: Kimberly M. Daniels, a 2015 candidate for re-election to the Jacksonville City Council, made or authorized one or more expenditures prohibited by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, as alleged in the complaint

¹ The Report of Investigation is referred to herein as "ROI"

Complainant alleged that Respondent violated Florida's election laws by using funds on deposit in her campaign account to defray normal living expenses when she purchased advertising space in Shofar Magazine to promote her book, *The Demon Dictionary*, and therewith, made or authorized an expenditure prohibited by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes. Complainant also alleged that Respondent falsely reported or deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, with regard to the reporting of an expenditure to Shofar Magazine.

Alleged Violation: Section 106.1405, Florida Statutes

- 5 Complainant alleged that Respondent used funds on deposit in her campaign account to defray normal living expenses when she purchased advertising space in Shofar Magazine to promote her book, *The Demon Dictionary*
- Respondent is an author and has published 13 books including, *The Demon Dictionary*.
- 7 Respondent's 2014 M3 Report reflects an expenditure to Shofar Magazine on March 1, 2014, in the amount of \$4,000 for the purpose of "advertisement" (ROI Exhibit 4, page 5)
- 8. Shofar Magazine's Spring Edition issue contains a one page article titled, "Leader-Shift" which discusses issues relating to leadership in the City of Jacksonville. The article does not contain express advocacy (ROI Exhibit 3, page 2) The magazine also contains a full page advertisement titled, "The Demon Dictionary is released!" which encourages readers to purchase Respondent's book (ROI Exhibit 3, page 3)
- Respondent stated that she paid Katina Mickens \$4,000 to help with advertising for her campaign, including media coverage of campaign events and managing her Facebook account. She stated that Ms. Mickens did not fulfill her obligations. She also stated that she has never paid any fees to Shofar Magazine for advertising and that the article and advertisement were free. (ROI Exhibit 5, page 1) Respondent stated that she was responsible for the information in the "Leader-Shift" article but that Ms. Mickens did the ad for *The Demon Dictionary*. (ROI Exhibit 6, page 3) She stated that the parties did not have a written contract, but that she paid \$4,000 upfront to Katina Mickens for her anticipated services. (Attachment A, Phone Log Entry 1)
- A subpoena was issued to Respondent's designated campaign depository Respondent's bank records show one check expenditure (#1003) to Shofar Magazine dated March 1, 2014, in the amount of \$4,000 with the memo line reading "advertisement" It should be noted that the campaign check was paid to Shofar Magazine, which published *The Demon Dictionary* advertisement, and not to Katina Mickens, who Respondent alleges was hired as a political advertising consultant (ROI Exhibit 7)
- 11 Katina Mickens, editor of Shofar Magazine, stated that Respondent placed the order for the "Leader-Shift" article and Demon Dictionary advertisement (ROI Exhibit 8, page

- 1) Ms Mickens stated that the \$4,000 check was for the purchase of space in Shofar Magazine for the two pieces. She stated that the check was not for campaign advertising and that there was no contract between Shofar Magazine or Katina Mickens and Respondent's campaign (Attachment A, Phone Log Entry 4) Ms. Mickens stated that she has never designed political advertisements, published political advertisements, or worked as an advertising consultant for a political campaign. (Attachment B) Ms. Mickens provided Shofar Magazine's price listings showing that a double page spread in one issue of the magazine costs \$2,000. (ROI Exhibit 9) It is unclear what the remaining \$2,000 of the \$4,000 check expenditure to Shofar Magazine was attributable to. (ROI Exhibit 6)
- 12. It appears that Respondent used funds on deposit in her campaign account to defray normal living expenses when she purchased advertising space in Shofar Magazine to promote her book, *The Demon Dictionary*.

Alleged Violation: Section 106.19(1)(d), Florida Statutes

- 13. Complainant alleged that Respondent violated Florida's election laws by making or authorizing an expenditure prohibited by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, with regard to the expenditure to Shofar Magazine.
- Based on the above analysis, it appears that Respondent used funds on deposit in her campaign account to defray normal living expenses when she purchased advertising space in Shofar Magazine to promote her book, *The Demon Dictionary*, which is a violation of Section 106 1405, Florida Statutes. Therefore, Respondent violated Section 106 19(1)(d), Florida Statutes, as she made or authorized an expenditure prohibited by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.

Alleged Violation: Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes

- 15. Complainant alleged that Respondent violated Florida's election laws by falsely reporting or deliberately failing to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, with regard to the reporting of an expenditure to Shofar Magazine.
- Respondent's 2014 M3 Report reflects an expenditure to Shofar Magazine on March 1, 2014, in the amount of \$4,000 for the purpose of "advertisement" (ROI Exhibit 4, page 5)
- Respondent stated that she paid Katina Mickens \$4,000 to help with advertising for her campaign, including media coverage of campaign events and managing her Facebook account. She stated that she has never paid any fees to Shofar Magazine for advertising and that the article and advertisement were free (ROI Exhibit 5, page 1)
- 18. Katina Mickens, editor of Shofar Magazine, stated that Respondent placed the order for the "Leader-Shift" article and Demon Dictionary advertisement. (ROI Exhibit 8, page 1) Ms. Mickens stated that the \$4,000 check was for the purchase of space in Shofar Magazine for the two pieces. She stated that the check was not for campaign advertising. (Attachment A, Phone Log Entry 4)

- The reporting of the expenditure to Shofar Magazine appears to be improper. The stated purpose of the expenditure suggests that the expenditure was for an advertisement for Respondent's campaign. However, the expenditure was for an advertisement promoting Respondent's book and for an article that discusses issues relating to leadership in the City of Jacksonville, but does not contain express advocacy. Therefore, it appears that Respondent falsely reported information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes
- "Probable Cause" is defined as reasonable grounds of suspicion supported by circumstances sufficiently strong to warrant a cautious person in the belief that the person has committed the offense charged Schmitt v State, 590 So. 2d 404, 409 (Fla 1991). Probable cause exists where the facts and circumstances, of which an [investigator] has reasonably trustworthy information, are sufficient in themselves for a reasonable man to reach the conclusion that an offense has been committed Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles v Favino, 667 So. 2d 305, 309 (Fla 1st DCA 1995).
- 21. The facts set forth above show that Respondent was a 2015 candidate for reelection to the Jacksonville City Council, At Large, Group 1. It appears that Respondent used funds on deposit in her campaign account to defray normal living expenses when she purchased advertising space in Shofar Magazine to promote her book, *The Demon Dictionary* Therefore, Respondent made or authorized an expenditure prohibited by Chapter 106. It also appears that Respondent falsely reported information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, with regard to the reporting of an expenditure to Shofar Magazine

Based upon these facts and circumstances, I recommend that the Commission find **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating the following:

Count 1:

On or about March 1, 2014, Kimberly Daniels violated Section 106.1405, Florida Statutes, when she used funds on deposit in her campaign account to defray her normal living expenses.

Count 2:

On or about March 1, 2014, Kimberly Daniels violated Section 106.19(1)(d), Florida Statutes, when she made or authorized an expenditure prohibited by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.

Count 3:

On or about April 9, 2014, Kimberly Daniels violated Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, when she falsely reported information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes

On March 2, 2015, the Florida Elections Commission received a sworn complaint alleging that Respondent violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes. Commission staff investigated whether Respondent violated the following statute:

Section 106.1405, Florida Statutes, prohibiting a candidate from using funds from her campaign account to defray normal living expenses;

Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, prohibiting a person or organization from falsely reporting or deliberately failing to report information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes; and

Section 106 19(1)(d), Florida Statutes, prohibiting a person or organization from making or authorizing any expenditure prohibited by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes

I. Preliminary Information:

- 1 Respondent was a candidate for re-election to the Jacksonville City Council She was defeated by Anna Lopez Brosche in the May 19, 2015 general election
- 2 Respondent is the founder of Spoken Word Ministries and she is the author of 13 books; her latest book is The Demon Dictionary, Volumes 1 and 2
- 3. Mark Herron represented Respondent during the investigation On October 1, 2015, he filed a Motion to Dismiss. To review the Motion to Dismiss, refer to Exhibit 1
- 4 Complainant is the manager of CityXtra, Incorporated, an online LGBT publication.

II. Alleged Violation of Section 106.1405, Florida Statutes:

- 5. I investigated whether Respondent violated this section of the election laws when she used funds from her campaign account to defray normal living expenses.
- On September 11, 2013, Respondent filed the Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Candidates form (DS-DE 9) Respondent named herself deputy treasurer for her campaign. On January 24, 2014, Respondent filed another DS-DE 9 form naming Sebrena Delong as her treasurer. To review the DS-DE 9 forms, refer to Exhibit 2.
- 7 According to Complainant, Respondent used money from the campaign depository to pay for advertisements to promote her personal book, The Demon Dictionary Complainant provided copies of the advertisements from the 2014 Spring Edition of *Shofar*

Magazine with the complaint. One advertisement is entitled "Leader-shift" and talks about Respondent's ideas on leadership and local issues. The second advertisement is entitled "The Demon Dictionary is released!" The ad talks about the book and encouraged readers to purchase the book. To review the ads, refer to Exhibit 3.

8. Complainant also provided a copy of Respondent's 2014 M3 Report. The report lists an expenditure on March 1, 2014 to *Shofar Magazine* for \$4,000. The entry from the campaign report is illustrated in the table below.

To review the 2014 M3 Report, refer to Exhibit 4.

Respondent submitted a non-sworn response to the complaint. Respondent stated, I hired Katina Mickens, the owner of Shofar Magazine to help with advertising my campaign. This included media coverage of campaign events and her managing my Face Book account. Ms. Mickens was paid \$4000 but did not fulfill her obligations. She did manage my Face Book account for a short period and covered my kick-off campaign event."

To review Respondent's written statement, refer to Exhibit 5.

- Subsequently, I interviewed Respondent by telephone. Respondent stated that the \$4,000 that she paid Katina Mickens was for advertising for her campaign and not for the ads in the magazine regarding her books. When asked if there was a written agreement between Ms. Mickens and the campaign, Respondent stated that there was an oral agreement but not a written agreement. She stated that the articles in the magazine did not cost her anything.
- I sent Respondent a questionnaire affidavit. When asked if she was responsible for the content of the ads, Respondent replied, "Yes, I was responsible for the information in the column leader shift. Katina Mickens did the ad for the dictionary." When asked why she chose Ms. Mickens to do her advertising, Respondent stated, "She was a member of my church. She was starting over and coming from prison. I wanted to help her. This is common for me." I asked for copies of the invoices and payment instruments, Respondent replied, "None" To review the affidavit, refer to Exhibit 6.
- 12. I subpoena records from the campaign depository Bank records show that Respondent's campaign issued check #1003 on March 1, 2014 for \$4,000. The check was made payable to *Shofar Magazine* (not Katina Mickens). The memo line on the check indicates that the check is for "advertisement" To review the check, refer to Exhibit 7.
- 13. On October 23, 2015, I interviewed Ms Mickens by telephone. She stated that the \$4000 was not for campaign advertising. She added that there was not a contract with

Respondent's campaign. She stated that they had discussed doing some advertising for the campaign but nothing was finalized. I asked her if she had worked for any other political campaigns, she stated that she had not. I asked if she had any experience designing political campaigns, she stated she had not. I asked her what the \$4000 paid for; she stated that \$4000 was to pay for the space for the two articles. To review Ms. Mickens affidavit, refer to Exhibit 8. To review the ads, refer to Exhibit 3.

- Ms. Mickens mailed the magazine that contained the two articles, the Spring Edition. She also provided a payment listing that showed a "double page" advertisement cost \$2000. As previously stated the check to the magazine totaled \$4000. It is unclear what the additional \$2000 paid for. I attempted to clarify the discrepancy with Ms. Mickens; however, she did not return my telephone calls. To review the price listing for *Shofar Magazine*, refer to Exhibit 9.
- 15 I called Tallahassee Woman Magazine to query about the cost of publishing a full page ad in their magazine. The sales representative explained that the cost to publish a full page ad in one issue of the magazine is \$2240 (Therefore, the double page spread, like Respondent's, would cost \$4480) She explained that the magazine is published six times a year. She stated that customers get a discount for purchasing multiple ads. She stated that "open" on the rate schedule means the ad was only published one time. To review the price listing for the Tallahassee Woman Magazine, refer to Exhibit 10
- No record of Respondent having previously violated this section of the election laws was found.

III. Alleged Violation of Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes:

- 17 I investigated whether Respondent violated this section of the election laws by falsely reporting or deliberately failing to report information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.
- As discussed in paragraph eight of this report, the entry on the 2014 M3 Report lists the purpose of the expenditure as "advertisement." This description appears to be vague. The reader does not know if there was one ad or multiple ads; if the ads were solely with the magazine or multiple venues.
- 19 To review additional information pertaining to this section of law, refer to paragraphs 6 through 15.
- 20 No record of Respondent having previously violated this section of the election laws was found

II. Alleged Violation of Section 106.19(1)(d), Florida Statutes:

- 21 I investigated whether Respondent violated this section of the election laws by making or authorizing expenditures prohibited by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes
- As previously discussed, Complainant alleged that Respondent used campaign funds to defray the normal cost of living by using campaign funds to pay for an advertisement to promote her book
- To review the information pertaining to this section of law, refer to paragraphs 6 through 15.
 - No record of Respondent having previously violated this section of the election

V. FEC History

25 Respondent was also named as Respondent in FEC 15-238; Complainant is also the Complainant in FEC 15-238. Complainant filed both cases on the same day

Conclusion:

- On January 13, 2016, I interviewed Mark Herron, Respondent's attorney, by telephone He stated he would make his final comments after reading the Report of Investigation
- According to Beth Fleet, Candidate Coordinator/Duval County Supervisor of Elections, stated that Respondent was first elected to the City Council as the member-at-large on May 17, 2011; she ran for re-election in 2015 and was defeated. Ms. Fleet stated that Respondent received copies of Chapter 106, Florida Statutes and the 2013 Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook Records show that there was a candidate workshop scheduled on January 29, 2015. The sign-in sheet lists a "Kim D" in attendance. To review relevant pages of the Affidavit of Filing Officer, refer to Exhibit 11. To review the Candidate Workshop sign-in sheet, refer to Exhibit 12, page, 5. To review the Confirmation of Access/Receipt of Campaign Materials form, refer to Exhibit 13.
- Respondent acknowledged that she received and read Chapter 106, Florida Statutes and the Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook. When asked what actions were taken to determine her responsibilities under Florida's election laws, she responded, "I was briefed by SOE office & read packets given to me." To review the relevant pages of the Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook, refer to Exhibit 14. To review Respondent's affidavit, refer to Exhibit 6.
- On September 12, 2013, Respondent signed a statement of candidate form certifying that she had been provided access to read and understand the requirements of Chapter 106, Florida Statutes To review the statement of candidate form, refer to Exhibit 15.

Kimberly M. Daniels, by and through undersigned counsel, moves to dismiss FEC Case No 15-239 as being legally insufficient and, in support thereof, states:

FEC Case No. 15-238

- 1. On March 2, 2015, David Vandygriff filed a complaint with the Florida Elections Commission (FEC) against Ms. Daniels. This complaint was designated as FEC Case No. 15-238.
- 2 On September 18, 2015, the Executive Director of the FEC notified Ms. Daniels that she had found the complaint to be legally sufficient to warrant investigation of the following alleged violations:

Section 106.19(1)(a), Florida Statutes: Kimberly M Daniels, a 2015 candidate for re-election to the Jacksonville City Council, f accepted one or more contributions in excess of the limits prescribed by Section 106.08(3)(b), Florida Statutes, as alleged in the complaint

Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes: Kimberly M. Daniels, 2015 candidate for reelection to the Jacksonville City Council, falsely reported or deliberately failed to include information in one or more campaign reports required by Chapter 1 06, Florida Statutes, as alleged in the complaint

FEC Case No. 15-239

3. On March 2, 2015, David Vandygriff filed a complaint with the Florida Elections Commission (FEC) against Ms. Daniels. This complaint was designated as FEC Case No. 15-239

On September 18, 2015, the Executive Director of the FEC notified Ms. Daniels that she had found the complaint to be legally sufficient to warrant investigation of the following alleged violations:

Section 106.1405, Florida Statutes: Kimberly M Daniels, a 2015 candidate for reelection to the Jacksonville City Council, appears to have used funds on deposit in her campaign account to defray normal living expenses, as alleged in the complaint

Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes: Kimberly M. Daniels, a 2015 candidate for re-election to the Jacksonville City Council, falsely reported or deliberately failed to include information in one or more campaign reports required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, as alleged in the complaint

Section 106.19(1)(d), Florida Statutes: Kimberly M. Daniels, a 2015 candidate for re-election to the Jacksonville City Council, made or authorized one or more expenditures prohibited by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, as alleged in the complaint

Prohibition Against Second Complaint from Same Person

5 Section 106 25(2), Florida Statutes, provides, in pertinent part, as follows:

The commission shall investigate only those alleged violations specifically contained within the sworn complaint. If any complainant fails to allege all violations that arise from the facts or allegations alleged in a complaint, the commission shall be barred from investigating a subsequent complaint from such complainant that is based upon such facts or allegations that were raised or could have been raised in the first complaint

Rule 2B-1.0025(3), Florida Administrative Code, provides as follows:

If a person files a second complaint against the same person, the executive director shall determine that the complaint and any material Commission staff has obtained in prior Commission investigations. In determining the legal sufficiency of a complaint alleging a violation of the campaign finance laws, the executive director shall also consider documents on file with the filing officer

Argument

It cannot be disputed that the two complaints were filed by the same person. The only issue is whether the second complaint "is based upon such facts or allegations that were raised or could have been raised in the first complaint."

Page 2 of 4

The allegations that form the basis for FEC Case No. 15-238 were grounded in the campaign finance reports of the Kimberly Daniels Campaign for October and November of 2014. The allegations that form the basis for FEC Case No. 15-239 were grounded in the campaign finance reports of the Kimberly Daniels Campaign for March 2014. The complaints were filed in March of 2015

9 The campaign finance reports on which both complaints are based were available to the complainant for review at the time he filed his initial complaint Thus, FEC Case No 15-239 is based on allegations could have been raised in FEC Case No. 15-238, but were not

Conclusion

Based on the forgoing, inasmuch the complaint designated as FEC Case No 15-238 was filed by the same individual as the complaint designated as FEC Case No. 15-239, and because it is based upon facts or allegations that could have been raised in FEC Case No 15-238, the FEC is barred from investigating the complaint designated as FEC Case No. 15-239 Consistent with Section 106.25(2), Florida Statutes, and Rule 2B-1 0025(3), Florida Administrative Code, the complaint designated as FEC Case No 15-239 should have been determined to be legally insufficient and dismissed.





I hired Katina Mickens, the owner of Shofar Magazine to help with advertising my campaign. This included media coverage of campaign events and her managing my Face Book account. Ms. Mickens was paid \$4000 but did not fulfill her obligations. She did manage my Face Book account for a short period and covered my kick-off campaign event. There is footage of this event on my Face Book (February 2014).

I am a published author and do not pay for ads for my books. If you have questions about the Demon Dictionary you may call Strang Communications at (407) 333-0600. The marketing manager is Margarita Henry.

Also, please note that Shofar Magazine does not have status to charge \$4000 for an advertisement. This is a local, starter magazine with no defined based and ads simply do not cost \$4000. FYI a full color page in the Florida Times Union on Sunday cost \$5500.

Ms. Mickens was recently released from prison and became a member of my church. I agreed to be in her magazine to help her. She used my brand to increase her audience. Lisa Ray (Celebrity On the cover of magazine in question) did not pay for her picture on the issue and I have never paid any fees to Shofar Magazine for advertising anything in the magazine. The company name is Shofar Magazine. The article and advertisement that related to me were not for my campaign. Both were free.

After doing research, I found out that Ms. Mickens has quite a tracking record of fraud and criminal activity. I was under the impression that she was incarcerated once. If I am guilty of anything, it is not checking her background before I allowed her in my space. See attachment #1. Chapter 1: Background

The information contained in this publication is intended as a quick reference guide only and is current upon publication. To the extent that this handbook covers material beyond that contained in law or rule, the Division of Elections (Division) offers such material to candidates as guidelines Chapters 97-106, Florida Statutes, the Constitution of the State of Florida, Division of Elections' opinions and rules, Attorney General opinions, county charters, city charters and ordinances, and other sources should be reviewed in their entirety for complete information regarding campaign financing and qualifying

Chapter 2: The Campaign Financing Act

Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, regulates campaign financing for all candidates, including judicial candidates, political committees, electioneering communication organizations, affiliated party committees, and political parties It does not regulate campaign financing for candidates for federal office or individuals seeking a publicly elected position on a political party executive committee.

The Division of Elections:

- Oversees the interpretation of and provides guidance on the election laws.
- Provides advisory opinions to supervisors of elections, candidates, local officers having election related duties, political parties, political committees, or other persons or organizations engaged in political activity, relating to any provisions or possible violations of Florida election laws with respect to actions such person or entity has taken or proposes to take.
- Conducts audits with respect to reports and statements filed under chapter 106
- Reports to the Florida Elections Commission any apparent violations of Chapter 106.
- Prescribes rules and regulations to carry out the provisions of Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.

(Sections 106.22 and 106.23, F.S.)

Contribution Limits for Candidates

IMPORTANT: Except for political parties or affiliated party committees, no person or political committee may make contributions in excess of: (1) \$3,000 to a candidate for statewide office or for retention as a justice of the Supreme Court. Candidates for the offices of Governor and Lieutenant Governor on the same ticket are considered a single candidate for the purpose of this section; (2) \$1,000 to a candidate for retention as a judge of a district court of appeal; a candidate for legislative office; a candidate for multicounty office; a candidate for county-wide office or in any election conducted on less than a countywide basis; or a candidate for county court judge or circuit judge. The primary and general elections are separate elections. (See Glossary for the definition of "person.")

(Section 106 08(1)(a) F.S.)

These limits do not apply to contributions made by a state or county executive committee of a political party or affiliated party committee regulated by Chapter 103, F.S., or to amounts contributed by a candidate to his own campaign. The contribution limits do not apply to individuals seeking election to a political party executive committee because they are not "candidates."

A candidate may **not**:

- Accept contributions until Form DS-DE 9, Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Candidates, is filed with the filing officer;
- Accept a contribution in excess of the above limits from any one person per election, provided the candidate is an opposed candidate and the contribution is received

within the timeframe applicable to each election:

- Accept contributions from family members in excess of the above limits per election;
- Accept contributions from a county executive committee of a political party whose contributions in the aggregate exceed \$50,000, or from the national or state executive committees of a political party, including any subordinate committee of such political party or affiliated party committees, who contributions in the aggregate exceed \$50,000 Polling services, research services, cost for campaign staff, professional consulting services, telephone calls are not contributions to be counted toward the contribution limits, but must still be reported by the candidate. All other contributions are counted toward the contribution limits:
- A candidate for statewide (Governor, Cabinet and Supreme Court Justice) office may not accept contributions from a national, state, or county executive committee of a political party, including any subordinate committee of a national, state, or county committee of a political party, or affiliated party committee, which contributions in the aggregate exceed \$250,000; or
- Accept contributions after the date he or she withdraws his or her candidacy, is defeated, becomes unopposed or is elected.

(Sections 106.08 and 106.19, F.S.)

Foreign Contributions

Federal law prohibits contributions from foreign nationals to any federal, state, or local

candidate, unless the foreign national possesses a green card Further information can be accessed by contacting the Federal Election Commission at 1-800-424-9530 or on their website at www.fec.gov

Violations

Any candidate, campaign manager, campaign treasurer, or deputy treasurer of any candidate, agent or person acting on behalf of any candidate, or other person who knowingly and willfully:

- Accepts a contribution in excess of the limits prescribed by Section 106.08, F.S;
- Fails to report any contribution required to be reported by Chapter 106, F.S;
- Falsely reports or deliberately fails to include any information required by Chapter 106, F.S.; or
- Makes or authorizes any expenditure in violation of Section 106 11(4), F.S., or any other expenditure prohibited by Chapter 106, F.S.; is guilty of a misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as provided in Section 775 082 or Section 775 083, F.S.

(Section 106.19, F.S.)

2014 Deadlines for Accepting Contributions

Any contribution received by a candidate with opposition in an election, or the campaign treasurer or deputy campaign treasurer, on the day of that election or less than five days prior to the day of that election must be returned to the contributor It may not be used or expended by or on behalf of the candidate.

Dear Ms. Daniels:

On March 2, 2015, the Florida Elections Commission received a complaint alleging that you violated Florida's election laws. I have reviewed the complaint and find that it contains one or more legally sufficient allegations. The Commission staff will investigate the following alleged violations:

Section 106.1405, Florida Statutes: Kimberly M. Daniels, a 2015 candidate for re-election to the Jacksonville City Council, appears to have used funds on deposit in her campaign account to defray normal living expenses, as alleged in the complaint

Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes Kimberly M. Daniels, a 2015 candidate for re-election to the Jacksonville City Council, falsely reported or deliberately failed to include information in one or more campaign reports required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, as alleged in the complaint

Section 106.19(1)(d), Florida Statutes: Kimberly M Daniels, a 2015 candidate for re-election to the Jacksonville City Council, made or authorized one or more expenditures prohibited by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, as alleged in the complaint

You may respond to the allegations above by filing a notarized statement providing any information regarding the facts and circumstances surrounding the allegations. Your response will be included as an attachment to the investigator's report.

When we conclude the investigation, a copy of the Report of Investigation will be mailed to you at the above address. You may file a response to the report within 14 days from the date the report is mailed to you. Based on the results of the investigation, legal staff will make a written

recommendation to the Commission on whether there is probable cause to believe you have violated Chapter 104 or 106, Florida Statutes. A copy of the Staff Recommendation will be mailed to you and you may file a response within 14 days from the date the recommendation is mailed to you. Your timely filed response(s) will be considered by the Commission when determining probable cause.

The Commission will then hold a hearing to determine whether there is probable cause to believe you have violated Chapters 104 or 106, Florida Statutes. You and the complainant will receive a notice of hearing at least 14 days before the hearing. The notice of hearing will indicate the location, date, and time of your hearing. You will have the opportunity to make a brief oral statement to the Commission, but you will not be permitted to testify or call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence.

At any time before a probable cause finding, you may notify us in writing that you want to enter into negotiations directed towards reaching a settlement via consent agreement

The Report of Investigation, Staff Recommendation, and Notice of Hearing will be mailed to the above address as this letter. Therefore, if your address changes, you must notify this office of your new address. Otherwise, you may not receive these important documents. Failure to receive the documents will not delay the probable cause hearing.

Under section 106 25, Florida Statutes, complaints, Commission investigations, investigative reports, and other documents relating to an alleged violation of Chapters 104 and 106, Florida Statutes, are confidential until the Commission finds probable cause or no probable cause. The confidentiality provision does not apply to the person filing the complaint. However, it does apply to you unless you waive confidentiality in writing. The confidentiality provision does not preclude you from seeking legal counsel. However, if you retain counsel, your attorney must file a notice of appearance with the Commission before any member of the Commission staff can discuss this case with him or her.

I am a published author and do not pay for ads for my books. If you have questions about the Demon Dictionary you may call Strang Communications at (407) 333-0600. The marketing manager is Margarita Henry.

Also, please note that Shofar Magazine does not have status to charge \$4000 for an advertisement. This is a local, starter magazine with no defined based and ads simply do not cost \$4000. FYI a full color page in the Florida Times Union on Sunday cost \$5500.

Ms. Mickens was recently released from prison and became a member of my church. I agreed to be in her magazine to help her. She used my brand to increase her audience. Lisa Ray (Celebrity On the cover of magazine in question) did not pay for her picture on the issue and I have never paid any fees to Shofar Magazine for advertising anything in the magazine. The company name is Shofar Magazine. The article and advertisement that related to me were not for my campaign. Both were free.

After doing research, I found out that Ms. Mickens has quite a tracking record of fraud and criminal activity. I was under the impression that she was incarcerated once. If I am guilty of anything, it is not checking her background before I allowed her in my space. See attachment #1. 

Leader-Shift

Being a leader of any capacity is a privilege. Winning a political campaign as an elected official is another level of honor. It is a blessing for a person to have the title 'Honorable'

Since I have been on the City Council I have learned more about myself. I have learned that I need God more every day. The reality is that the more God gives you, more will be required of you. Working in a secular environment has put a demand on me to be able to shift (in my mindset or posture) when required to do so. Religion will cause you to be stuck. When I think of shifting I am reminded of a stick shift in a car. Before you can drive forward you must to be able to shift gears. Many leaders are stuck in pride, arrogance, tradition or even the 'same-o-same-o syndrome'. This is a subliminal full that causes people to get comfortable in the way that things have always been.

Jacksonville, Florida needs a leader-shift! This shift is not just related to the debate about sexual preference. - · (Most important) Removal of the part of the plant that is diseased

There are some diseases that are contagious. Division and strife in a city government can spread like a wildfire and cause the staff and officials to be so busy putting out fires, they will never be able to tend the 'forest of city affairs'. The purpose of the three branches of government is to release authority to separate areas of specialty, while at the same time, demand that a common ground be established to promote the healthiness of the overall cause.

The leader-shift that I am proposing is a shifting of mindsets that would cause leaders to be 'uniquely efficient and focused' on their particular areas of operation; but at the same time; 'commonly sensitive' to the needs of the people they serve. Rebellion against these two principles will cause leaders to be guilty of spreading professional blight.

Our city needs leaders that can work together to cross branches of government lines, racial lines, cultural lines, gender lines and lines that separate the 'good old boys' from the 'too wild and loose. There may not be a happy medium but for the sake of city vision. There has to be a leniency to break the lull that is hindering the shift to the next level. There is a next level for city government in Jacksonville. It will not be attained by special interests groups that think their money and power can fill seats. Actually they are a part of the problem and their money perish with them. Power that is not properly directed can turn on a person and cause an electrical overload. Power prowess-ness can cause you to get burnt.

A group of ladies in our city are vain enough to believe that they have the answer to every seat in the city. Even the arrogance of their vision for the city is the putrid type of blight Jacksonville, Florida just does not need.

Another group has dared to declare destruction to the lives of certain city of ficials, just to get their seats. Really? Is it that serious? Ecclesiastes says that a person that digs a pits for someone else will be buried in the very pit he has dug.

God, I don't want to be like them! Although I am believing for re-election, I humble myself to shift in my own mind-set to ask God to put individuals in seats that will serve His people and have a passion for the very fabric of what it means to be a citizen in Duval County.

As for me, I am at peace My life is not my own; my steps are not self-directed and my destiny is not in the hands of men. In the meantime, I walk by faith and not by sight. What I see does not move me. Again I say, great things are ahead for Jacksonville, Florida. I bless every political seat of authority being filled in the November 2014 election and the March/May 2015 election. Selah. (Pause and think on that!)


May the diseased parts of the vision for our city be removed and God have mercy on our souls.
