If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

SUMMARY: Prosperity for All Political Committee is a political committee (PC) registered with the State of Florida. The PC's chair is Ms. Anna Lopez Brosche and its treasurer is Mr. Kevin Andrew Doyle.

The PC is appealing the fine claiming that unusual circumstances prevented them from timely filing the 2015 M10 Report. According to Mr. Doyle, "On behalf of Prosperity for All Political Committee, we are appealing the fine that was referenced in the letter that we received from the Division of Elections. It stated that a treasurer's report that was due on November 10, 2016 was filed on December 7, 2015. As the date of the report is not due until November 10, 2016, we should not be fined for a report that is not due until the future. Furthermore it should be noted that this letter was received over six months after the date of December 7, 2015."

- The 2015 M10 Report covers the time period from 10/1/15 through 10/31/15.
- The 2015 M10 Queued-Transactions Report reflects that this report was created on 11/2/15 at approximately 2:03 pm, before being filed on 11/2/15 at approximately 2:04 pm².
- In a 11/10/16 email with Kristi Reid-Bronson, FEC staff was informed, "The committee filed a notice of no activity (waiver) on 11-2-15. A waiver is not a report. On 12-7-15, the committee filed a report showing \$1000 of activity. The fine is based on 25% of the activity.

¹ Respondent initially filed a waiver that reflected no activity occurred during the 2015 M10 reporting period. Respondent later filed a 2015 M10 Report to reflect financial activity.

² The report discussed in this bullet refers to the waiver that reflected zero activity.




