Failure to appear in accordance with this notice will constitute a waiver of your right to participate in the hearing. Continuances will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

This hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, which governs your participation as follows:

If you are the Respondent, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are the Complainant, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are an Appellant, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

Please refer to the information below for further instructions related to your particular hearing:

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

SUMMARY: Frederick (Ted) Noftall was a candidate for Volusia County Council Member, District 3, in the 2022 elections. Heather Noftall was his treasurer.

Frederick (Ted) Noftall is appealing the fine claiming that it was a simple omission in which they “overlooked an abbreviated due date by one day.” According to Mr. Noftall, they “completed a tiring 9 of 11 days of early voting, and the reports of Hurricane Nicole incoming was distracting both on a campaign level and personal level.” He states that his storage warehouse had prior damage from Hurricane Ian and needed preparation to avoid further water damage. He also claims this is “the first and only time” he has ever had an incident with filing during the 2022 and prior two campaigns.

- The 2022 G6 Original Report covers the period from 10/22/22-11/03/22; it was due on 11/04/22.
- The 2022 G6 Report shows that it was filed on 11/05/22.
- Frederick (Ted) Noftall reported receiving 18 contributions while making 9 expenditures.
- The Volusia County Supervisor of Elections office does not have any notes that pertain to Frederick (Ted) Noftall’s 2022 G6 Report.

Dear Florida Elections Commission,

Please accept my appeal to waive or reduce the \$ 500 attached late filing fine.

The basis for my appeal is as follows.

- 1.) This is the first and only time I have ever had an incident with a filing, AND this report was late filed by only 13 hours and 35 minutes. This includes my 2022 campaign for County Council, as well as two prior city campaigns with no late filings.**
- 2.) This was a simple omission, with no mal-intent behind the late filing. Our campaign finances were managed entirely by myself and my daughter, and we both overlooked this abbreviated due date just one day after period end, which was an anomaly in the campaign finance calendar. We had just completed a tiring 9 of 11 days of early voting, and the reports of Hurricane Nicole incoming were distracting both on a campaign level (wondering what this would do to turnout both on Friday/Saturday and Election Day), and on a personal level (my moving and storage warehouse had water intrusion from roof damage from Hurricane Ian which is yet to be permanently repaired, and I needed to prepare to avoid further water damage from Nicole). We simply ran out of time and focus on Friday and did not think of the report until Saturday morning, at which time we completed and submitted as quickly as we could.**
- 3.) My campaign was self-funded with a \$ 10,000 candidate loan and \$ 7,500 in contributions from grass roots supporters. I entered this race on principle, and I am proud of the campaign I ran. I hope you will consider the disparity of impact and potential chilling effect of the threat of a \$500 fine is to other potential grassroots candidates, versus candidates funded by special interests who can afford to pay their campaign treasurers to maintain relentless focus on filing reports as they receive \$10,000s or \$100,000s in contributions**
I have hesitated on sending this appeal, because the fact is undisputed that I did submit the report late; however, I am appreciative of the process for consideration and would humbly

request your consideration to waive this fine.

5 - SEE RECEIPT

Florida Statute 106.07(8)(b) provides the following for late filing of Campaign Treasurer Reports –

The fine is \$50 per day for the first 3 days late and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25 percent of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for the reports immediately preceding each special primary election, special election, primary election, and general election, the fine is \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25 percent of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

You are being assessed a penalty of \$500.00. **The penalty must be paid from personal funds.**

Florida Statute 106.07(8)(b) also states...*such fine shall be paid to the filing officer within 20 days after receipt of the notice of payment due, unless appeal is made to the Florida Election Commission pursuant to paragraph (c).*

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF VOLUSIA COUNTY, FLORIDA, IMPLEMENTING THE PROVISIONS OF §106.07(2)(a)2, FLORIDA STATUTES, PERTAINING TO ELECTRONIC FILING REQUIREMENTS FOR THE CAMPAIGN FINANCE REPORTS OF LOCAL CANDIDATES AND POLITICAL COMMITTEES; PROVIDING DEFINITIONS; REQUIRING ELECTRONIC FILING OF CAMPAIGN FINANCE REPORTS OF LOCAL CANDIDATES AND POLITICAL COMMITTEES; PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN ELECTRONIC FILING SYSTEM; REQUIRING A WRITTEN ACKNOWLEDGEMENT REGARDING THE ELECTRONIC FILING SYSTEM; REQUIRING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN ALTERNATIVE PROCEDURE FOR FILING CAMPAIGN FILING REPORTS; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Acknowledgment: The Supervisor must require each person given a secure sign-on to the electronic filing system to sign a written statement on a form prepared by the Supervisor acknowledging the following:

- (Initials) [Signature] (a) Campaign finance reports must be completed and filed through the electronic filing system not later than midnight of the day required by law therefore.
- [Signature] (b) Campaign finance reports not filed by midnight of the required day are deemed late-filed and are subject to the penalties prescribed under Section 106.07(8), Florida Statutes.



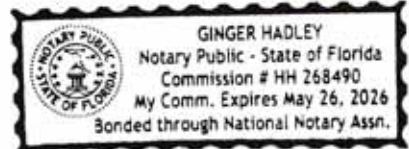
