A hearing will be held in this case before the Florida Elections Commission on, **December 1, 2020 at 8:30 AM**, *or as soon thereafter as the parties can be heard*, at the following location: **Senate Office Building, 404 South Monroe Street, Room 110-S, Tallahassee, Florida 32399.** Due to heightened security access requirements, please bring only essential items into the building and plan to arrive early to allow for delays coming through security.

Failure to appear in accordance with this notice will constitute a waiver of your right to participate in the hearing. Continuances will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

This hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, which governs your participation as follows:

If you are the Respondent, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have 5 minutes to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are the Complainant, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are an Appellant, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have 5 *minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

SUMMARY: The Honorable Bobby Payne is a candidate for State Representative, District 19 in the 2020 elections. Mary Kay Payne is his treasurer.

Representative Payne is appealing the fine claiming that he "has confirmation that the report was filed on 6/17/2020 indicating a waiver, since no campaign activity occurred during the time frame". According to Representative Payne, his treasurer realized that the qualifying fee for the campaign was not reported and submitted an amended report on July 2, 2020.

Representative Payne also notes that during this time, his treasurer's mother was dying and under hospice care and her father also has dementia. He states that he took possession of the check book in order to alleviate the burden of additional responsibilities for the treasurer. He also claims that there was an oversight in communication between him and the treasurer during this time. Upon realizing that the candidate wrote a check for filing fees, the treasurer amended the report to reflect that activity.

- The 2020 P1 Original Report covers the period from 06/01/20-06/12/20; it was due on 06/19/20.
- The 2020 P1 Queued Transaction Report shows that it was created and filed on 06/17/20.
- Representative Payne reported receiving zero contributions, while making 1 expenditure.
- FEC staff was advised, "The candidate filed a notice of no activity (waiver) on 06/17/20. A waiver is not a report. On 07/02/20, the candidate filed a report showing \$1,781.82 of activity. The fine is based on 25% of the activity.
- The Division of Elections has two notes that pertain to Rep. Bobby Payne's 2020 P1 report. He called regarding the fine notice issued for the 2020 P1 report on 08/04/20 and 08/05/20.

I am writing in response to a letter I received from your office related to an automatically assessed late fine of \$445.46 indicating that a campaign treasurer's report was due on June 19, 2020, was late filed on July 2, 2020.

I have the confirmation filing report from my Treasurer that a report was filed on 6/17/2020 indicating a Waiver, since no campaign contribution were collected for the time frame of 6/1/20 through 6/12/20. (Please see the attached documentation). The report was filed on 6/17/20 and was due on 6/19/20. Subsequent to that report my Treasurer realized that I had paid the qualifying filing fee for my campaign and submitted an amended report on July 2, 2020 in order to correct the mistake. Unfortunately, Candidate qualifying occurred in the same reporting time frame as the Treasurer's report.

The unusual circumstance associated with FAC 2B-1.0055, that I am requesting consideration for dismissal of fine is:

During the time frame in question, my Treasurer's mother was dying and was in hospice care. I had taken possession of the check book because she was dealing with a sick and dying Mother and I did not want to burden her with additional responsibilities. Her father also has dementia which adds to her stress and loss concerns for her mom. Therefore, it was an oversight in lack of communication between me and my Treasurer, for which I take full responsibility during this stressful time.

Upon realizing that I had written a check for filing fees at a later date, she filed an amended report of July 2, 2020 to reflect and correct the oversight. There was never any intention to mislead and in fact no contribution were received during this time, only payment of qualifying filing fees.

I hope that the Commission will review the Treasurer's report record from the last four years and see that my campaign records have always been very accurate and timely filed.

Thank you for this consideration, please accept my request to dismiss the "late or amended" filing fine.



Timely Filing

All reports filed must be completed and filed through the EFS not later than midnight of the due date. Reports not filed by midnight of the due date are late filed and subject to the penalties in Section 106.07(8), Florida Statutes. In the event that the EFS is inoperable on the due date, the report will be accepted as timely filed if filed no later than midnight of the first business day the EFS becomes operable. No fine will be levied during the period the EFS was inoperable.

Any candidate failing to file a report on the designated due date shall be subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first 3 days late and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

Electronic Receipts

The person submitting the report on the EFS will be issued an electronic receipt indicating and verifying the report was filed. Each campaign treasurer's report filed by means of the EFS is considered to be under oath by the candidate and campaign treasurer and such persons are subject to the provisions of Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes.

Instructions and Assistance

An online instruction guide is available to you on the EFS to assist with navigation, data entry, and submission of reports. The Division of Elections will also provide assistance to all users by contacting the EFS Help Desk at (850) 245-6280.

It is your responsibility to read, understand, and follow the requirements of Florida's election laws.
