A hearing will be held in this case before the Florida Elections Commission on, August 16, 2017 at 8:30 am, *or as soon thereafter as the parties can be heard*, at the following location: Senate Office Building, 404 South Monroe Street, Room 110-S, Tallahassee, Florida 32399

Failure to appear in accordance with this notice will constitute a waiver of your right to participate in the hearing. Continuances will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

This hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, which governs your participation as follows:

If you are the Respondent, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have 5 minutes to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are the Complainant, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are an Appellant, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have 5 *minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

Executive Director Florida Elections Commission August 1, 2017 Please refer to the information below for further instructions related to your particular hearing:

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing*. The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

SUMMARY: Andy Thomas is a candidate for Public Defender in the 2020 elections. Mr. Thomas is his own treasurer.

The Honorable Andy Thomas is appealing the fine claiming that he filed the close out report for the 2016 campaign that included a "roll-over" of \$10,000 into his new 2020 campaign. According to Mr. Thomas, he assumed that by reporting a roll-over of \$10,000 to his campaign account, that he had, in fact reported money for 2020. He states that he realized, long after he filed the waiver on September 12, 2016, that he should report the \$10,000 roll-over in the 2020 campaign account. He claims that he tried to do so several times before realizing he could not amend a waiver and would have to file an entirely separate report.

Between May 2016 and January 2017, Mr. Thomas states that he was transitioning from Chief Assistant Public Defender to elected constitutional officer. He also notes that he worked 12 hour days, sometimes 6 days a week.

- The 2016 M8 Original Report covers the period from 08/01/16-08/31/16; it was due on 09/12/16.
- The 2016 M8 Queued Transaction Report shows that a report was created and filed on 09/12/16. The report was also amended on 10/06/16.²
- Andy Thomas reported receiving 1 contribution, while making zero expenditures.
- FEC staff was advised, "The candidate filed a notice of no activity (waiver) on 09/12/16. A waiver is not a report. On 11/09/16, the candidate filed a report showing \$10,000.00 of activity. The fine is based on 25% of the activity.
- The Division of Elections does not have any notes that pertain to Andy Thomas's 2016 M8 report.

¹ Respondent initially filed a waiver that reflected no activity occurred during the 2016 M8 reporting period. Respondent later filed a 2016 M8 report to reflect financial activity.

² The report discussed in this bullet refers to the waiver that reflected zero activity.

Dear Commissioners:

Please accept this letter as explanation and mitigation for the late filing referenced above. I attempted to present this information to the Division in hopes of obtaining forgiveness of the imposed fine (\$2,500.00), but was informed my only recourse was the appeals process. A combination of factors, some within my control and some outside of my control, resulted in the tardy filing and I believe, once explained they qualify as "unusual circumstances."

I am 62 years old and until 2013, I had not run for *any* public office, nor had I contemplated doing so. When our long-serving Public Defender Nancy Daniels decided to retire after her last term expired, with her encouragement and endorsement, I filed to run for Public Defender. I have been a career defender of poor people accused of crimes, having represented everyone from children in Juvenile Court to men and women on Death Row. I am very familiar with the Rules of Criminal and Appellate Procedure and our many criminal statutes, but elections law and regulations were all new to me. The most I had ever done was fill out the Financial Disclosure "short form." I downloaded the Candidate Handbook and read it several times and I have attempted to comply with all requirements. So, factor one is this: *I was – and still am - a novice in the political world, with no prior experience with filing campaign reports.*

In an effort to fully comply with election law and regulations – and to avoid this very situation - I solicited a friend, Thomas Clark, to serve as Campaign Treasurer during my 2016 campaign. Review of the enclosed reports and the details available on-line (between September 23, 2013 and close out on August 3, 2016), prove we were extremely diligent and detailed, in addition to timely, during that campaign. We had one audit letter, but with the assistance of the Help Desk, we responded and resolved the issues. Factor two: *I knew what I didn't know and found someone who did to help me during the 2016 campaign*.

We raised over \$32,000 in campaign contributions, with a great deal of activity occurring between October, 2015 and April, 2016. My opponent did not qualify, so I was "elected" in May, essentially. I never went through a contested race and never learned all the nuances of filing reports. On August 3rd, 2016, we filed our close-out report, including charitable distributions and a "roll-over" of \$10,000 into my new 2020 campaign. I had just filed to run in 2020 on August 1, 2016 and thought the accounts were linked.

Factor three: I assumed that by reporting a roll-over of \$10,000 to my campaign account, that I had, **in fact**, reported the money for 2020.

I was mistaken thinking I would not need my treasurer for at least a couple of years. I thought we would have minimal activity for a good while. I didn't want to burden my friend Tom for four years. Checking my 2020 account, you can see I have had *multiple problems* with the electronic filing system (I must say it is one of the most counter-intuitive programs I have ever attempted to navigate). I have responded to each subsequent error or omission in timely fashion and am beginning to understand how to navigate the system with the Help Desk's guidance. Review of my records will reveal that I have attempted to amend what cannot be amended, submitted reports that did not, in fact, go through or were incomplete, and I referred to "expenditures" as "disposition of funds," among other errors. I have corrected the errors.

When I realized, through a conversation with my former treasurer long after I filed a waiver on September 12, 2017, that he **thought I should report the \$10,000 roll-over in the 2020 campaign account**, I tried to do so several times before realizing **I could not amend a waiver**. I had to file an entirely separate report and it did not revert back to the original September file date. I accomplished that with multiple calls to the Help Desk. Factor four: *I attempted to navigate the electronic filing system*, comply with all regulations and requirements, as evidenced by my numerous attempts to file a single report.

Between May, 2016 and January, 2017 I was transitioning from Chief Assistant Public Defender to elected constitutional officer with responsibility for over 125 employees and thousands of clients accused of crimes in six counties. I attended board meetings, conferences, seminars, and maintained a break neck pace to learn everything I needed to before taking office. Litigator to administrator was a huge leap. It was during this time that the error was made. I formed eight (8) office committees to study how we service our clients and how to improve. I was meeting with every employee in the Circuit to get their personal input. Our office space was being renovated and we had logistical issues to resolve. I add these few examples for this reason: I was working 12 hour days, sometimes 6 days a week, for long months *after* long months of gathering petition signatures and campaigning. Factor five: *During the relevant time period, I was sleep deprived and exhausted. I couldn't keep up with everything, hard as I tried.*

Finally: I had no evil intent or premeditated design to hide \$10,000 or avoid the reporting requirements. It was no doubt "excusable neglect" to not file the report. But, that requirement was not clear to me. I thought I had complied .Upon realizing I was wrong, I attempted to and finally did correct my error. It defies logic to think I would **report** the \$10,000 roll-over while closing the 2016 account if I possessed any intent to **hide** the same money in the 2020 account. My bank account has never been closed or changed throughout this process. The main thing that changed is I did not have my campaign treasurer, I thought I could do it myself, and I was sadly mistaken. I respectfully request that the Commission consider this information and forgive the fine in this one instance. I intend to recruit Mr. Clark to re-assume treasurer duties as soon as he is available. This will undoubtedly avoid any such problems in the future.

Pin Numbers

Each candidate is required to provide the Division of Elections with confidential personal information that may be used to allow access in the event that password is forgotten or lost. When you enter the campaign account screen, there will be a drop down box where you pick a question (such as *What is your mother's maiden name?*) and supply an answer. All passwords and answers to questions are stored as encrypted data and cannot be viewed by Division staff and given out over the phone. Please notify the Division if your credentials have been compromised.

<u>Timely Filing</u>

All reports filed must be completed and filed through the EFS no later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the due date. Reports not filed by midnight of the due date are late filed and subject to the penalties in Section 106.07(8), Florida Statutes. In the event that the EFS is inoperable on the due date, the report will be accepted as timely filed if filed no later than midnight of the first business day the EFS becomes operable. No fine will be levied during the period the EFS was inoperable.

Any candidate failing to file a report on the designated due date shall be subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first 3 days late and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

Electronic Receipts

The person submitting the report on the EFS will be issued an electronic receipt indicating and verifying the report was filed. Each campaign treasurer's report filed by means of the EFS is considered to be under oath by the candidate and campaign treasurer and such persons are subject to the provisions of Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes.
