Please refer to the information below for further instructions related to your particular hearing:

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

**ORDER OF PROBABLE CAUSE**

**THIS MATTER** was heard by the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) at its regularly scheduled meeting on December 1, 2020, in Tallahassee, Florida.

On September 28, 2020, Staff recommended to the Commission that there was probable cause to believe that the Florida Election Code was violated. The facts articulated in Staff's Recommendation are adopted by reference and incorporated herein. Based on the Complaint, Report of Investigation, Staff's Recommendation, and oral statements (if any) made at the probable cause hearing, the Commission finds that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with the following violation(s):

**Count 1:**

On or about September 24, 2019, Respondent violated Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, when Respondent failed to file an addendum to his 2019 M1 Report within seven days of receiving notice from the filing officer that his 2019 M1 Report was incomplete.


**Count 2:**

On or about September 24, 2019, Respondent violated Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, when Respondent failed to file an addendum to his 2019 M3 Report within seven days of receiving notice from the filing officer that his 2019 M3 Report was incomplete.

**Count 3:**

On or about September 24, 2019, Respondent violated Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, when Respondent failed to file an addendum to his 2019 M7 Report within seven days of receiving notice from the filing officer that his 2019 M7 Report was incomplete.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO A HEARING**

As the Respondent, you may elect to resolve this case in several ways. First, you may elect to resolve this case by consent order where you and Commission staff agree to resolve the violation(s) and agree to the amount of the fine. The consent order is then presented to the Commission for its approval. To discuss a consent order, contact the FEC attorney identified in the Order of Probable Cause.

Second, you may request an informal hearing held before the Commission, if you do not dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. You have 30 days from the date the Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission to request such a hearing. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order. At the hearing, you will have the right to make written or oral arguments to the Commission concerning the legal issues related to the violation(s) and the potential fine. At the request of Respondent, the Commission will consider and determine willfulness at an informal hearing. Otherwise, live witness testimony

is unnecessary.

Third, you may request a formal hearing held before an administrative law judge in the Division of Administrative Hearings (DOAH), if you dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. You have 30 days from the date the Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission to request such a hearing. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order. At the hearing, you will have the right to present evidence relevant to the violation(s) listed in this order, to cross-examine opposing witnesses, to impeach any witness, and to rebut the evidence presented against you.

If you do not elect to resolve the case by consent order or request a formal hearing at the DOAH or an informal hearing before the Commission within 30 days of the date this Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission, the case will be sent to the Commission for a formal or informal hearing, depending on whether the facts are in dispute. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order.

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**STAFF RECOMMENDATION FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION**

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(c), Florida Statutes, undersigned counsel files this written recommendation for disposition of the referral in this case recommending there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating **Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes**. Based upon a thorough review of the Report of Investigation submitted on September 2, 2020, the following facts and law support this staff recommendation:

1. On October 8, 2019, the Florida Elections Commission (“Commission”) received a referral from the Division of Elections (“Division”) alleging Kyle C. Gibson (“Respondent”) violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.

2. Respondent is a candidate for Governor in the 2022 election. Respondent's Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Candidates form was filed with the Division on October 16, 2018. Respondent appointed himself as his campaign treasurer. (ROI Exhibit 1)<sup>1</sup>

3. By letter dated November 21, 2019, the Executive Director notified Respondent that Commission staff would investigate the following alleged violations:

**Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes:** Respondent, a 2022 candidate for the office of Governor, acting as his own treasurer, failed to timely make necessary amendments to the following campaign treasurer reports, as alleged in the complaint:

- 2019 M1
- 2019 M3
- 2019 M7

4. By letter dated October 18, 2018, Kristi Reid Willis, Division of Elections, Chief, Bureau of Election Records, notified Respondent his name had been placed on the 2022 active candidate list. The letter also advised Respondent that all candidates who file reports with the Division are required to use the electronic filing system (“EFS”) and provided Respondent with a user identification number and initial password to access the EFS. (ROI Exhibit 2, page 1)

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<sup>1</sup> The Report of Investigation shall be referred to herein as the “ROI.”

5. Ms. Willis's October 18, 2018 letter further advised Respondent that it was his responsibility to read, understand, and follow the requirements of Florida's election laws. Ms. Willis also informed Respondent all of the Division's publications and reporting forms were available on the Division's website and directed Respondent to print a copy of Chapters 104 and 106, Florida Statutes, the *Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook*, and the *Calendar of Reporting Dates*. (ROI Exhibit 2, page 2)

### **2019 M1, 2019 M3 and 2019 M7 Reports**

6. Respondent's 2019 M1 Report covering the dates of January 1, 2019, through January 31, 2019, was due on February 11, 2019. Respondent filed his 2019 M1 Report on March 28, 2019; however, it was incomplete. (Attachments A, B, and C)

7. Respondent's 2019 M3 Report covering the dates of March 1, 2019, through March 31, 2019, was due on April 10, 2019. Respondent filed his 2019 M3 Report on April 11, 2019; however, it was incomplete. (Attachments A, B, and C)

8. Respondent's 2019 M7 Report covering the dates of July 1, 2019, through July 31, 2019, was due on August 12, 2019. Respondent timely filed his 2019 M7 Report however it was incomplete. (Attachments A, B, and C)

9. On August 13, 2019, the Division sent notification to Respondent that his 2019 M1, 2019 M3, and 2019 M7 Reports were incomplete and Respondent had seven days from receipt of the notice to correct the errors on the attached Error Report and file an amended report providing the correct information. The letter also stated if the information was reported accurately, Respondent should provide a written explanation to the Division addressing the issues noted in the Error Report. (ROI Exhibit 3, pages 1-7)<sup>2</sup>

10. On August 27, 2019, the Division sent notification to Respondent that his 2019 M1, 2019 M3, and 2019 M7 Reports were still incomplete and Respondent had seven days from receipt of the notice to correct the errors on the attached Error Report and file an amended report for each reporting period providing the correct information. (ROI Exhibit 3, pages 8-14)

11. On September 11, 2019, the Division sent a "Final Notice" to Respondent notifying Respondent his 2019 M1, 2019 M3, and 2019 M7 Reports remained incomplete and Respondent had seven days from receipt of the notice to correct the errors on the attached Error Report and file amended 2019 M1, 2019 M3, and 2019 M7 Reports providing the correct information. The letter also stated that if the information was reported accurately, Respondent should provide a written explanation to the Division addressing the issues noted in the Error Report. (ROI Exhibit 4, pages 1-7) The Division's September 11, 2019 letter was confirmed delivered on September 17, 2019. (ROI Exhibit 4, page 8)

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<sup>2</sup> Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Fla. Stat. does not require that a written explanation be provided to the Division addressing the issues noted in an Error Report if the information was reported accurately.

12. As of July 20, 2020, Respondent has failed to correct the errors identified by the Division on Respondent's 2019 M1, 2019 M3, and 2019 M7 Reports and file an amended report with the correct information for any of the reporting periods. (ROI Exhibit 5)

13. On February 26, 2020, March 19, 2020, July 20, 2020, and July 22, 2020, Investigator Oliver attempted to speak with Respondent by telephone. On each occasion, Investigator Oliver reached Respondent's voice mail. Investigator Oliver left a message requesting Respondent to return the call, which Respondent failed to do. (ROI Exhibit 6)

14. Based upon the information above, it appears Respondent failed to file amended 2019 M1, 2019 M3, and 2019 M7 Reports correcting the errors and providing missing information identified by the Division on each report after receiving notification the report was incomplete.

15. "Probable Cause" is defined as reasonable grounds of suspicion supported by circumstances sufficiently strong to warrant a cautious person in the belief that the person has committed the offense charged. *Schmitt v. State*, 590 So.2d 404, 409 (Fla. 1991). Probable cause exists where the facts and circumstances, of which an [investigator] has reasonably trustworthy information, are sufficient in themselves for a reasonable man to reach the conclusion that an offense has been committed. *Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles v. Favino*, 667 So.2d 305, 309 (Fla. 1<sup>st</sup> DCA 1995).

16. The above facts show Respondent is a candidate for Governor in the 2022 election. On August 13, 2019, August 27, 2019, and September 11, 2019, the Division notified Respondent his 2019 M1, 2019 M3, and 2019 M7 Reports were incomplete and Respondent had seven days from receipt of the notice to correct the errors on the attached Error Report and file amended reports providing the correct information. As of July 20, 2020, Respondent has failed to do so.

Based upon these facts and circumstances, staff recommends the Commission find probable cause to charge Respondent with the following:

**Count 1:**

On or about September 24, 2019, Respondent violated Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, when Respondent failed to file an addendum to his 2019 M1 Report within seven days of receiving notice from the filing officer that his 2019 M1 Report was incomplete.

**Count 2:**

On or about September 24, 2019, Respondent violated Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, when Respondent failed to file an addendum to his 2019 M3 Report within seven days of receiving notice from the filing officer that his 2019 M3 Report was incomplete.

**Count 3:**

On or about September 24, 2019, Respondent violated Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, when Respondent failed to file an addendum to his 2019 M7 Report within seven days of receiving notice from the filing officer that his 2019 M7 Report was incomplete.

#### I. Preliminary Information:

1. I investigated whether Respondent violated this section of the election laws by failing to file amended reports for the following campaign treasurer's reports after receiving notices from the filing officer: 2019 M1, 2019 M3, and 2019 M7.

2. An Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository (DS-DE 9) was filed on October 16, 2018. Respondent was named as the treasurer for Kyle Gibson, a 2022 candidate for Governor. To review the DS-DE 9, refer to Exhibit 1.

3. On October 18, 2018, the Division sent Respondent a letter acknowledging his appointment as the campaign treasurer for Kyle Gibson's campaign. The letter advised Respondent that all of the Division's publications and reporting forms are available on their website, including Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, the *Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook*, and the *Calendar of Reporting Dates*. The letter further advised Respondent that it was his responsibility to read, understand, and follow the requirements of Florida's election laws. To review a copy of the acknowledgement letter, refer to Exhibit 2.

#### II. Alleged Violation of Section 106.07(2)(b)(1), Florida Statutes:

4. On August 13, 2019 and August 27, 2019, the Division sent correspondence to Respondent informing him that one or more campaign reports were incomplete. The correspondence was sent to Respondent's address provided on the DS-DE 9 and included an error report referencing the following reports: 2019 M1, 2019 M3, and 2019 M7. To review the correspondence and error report, refer to Exhibit 3.

5. On September 11, 2019, the Division sent Respondent a letter marked "Final Notice" with delivery confirmation informing him that one or more campaign reports were incomplete. The letter was sent to Respondent's address provided on the DS-DE 9 and included an error report referencing the following reports: 2019 M1, 2019 M3, and 2019 M7. It was confirmed delivered on September 17, 2019. To review the Final Notice letter, error report and delivery confirmation, refer to Exhibit 4.

6. In an email dated July 20, 2020, Division staff confirmed that Respondent has not correctly amended any of the reports at issue. To review the email from Division staff, refer to Exhibit 5.

7. Respondent did not respond to the referral.

8. Respondent did not respond to a questionnaire-affidavit. Because the affidavit has not been returned, I am unable to ascertain whether he has read Chapter 106, Florida Statutes and/or the *Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook*.



9. I attempted to contact Respondent on four occasions to give him an opportunity to discuss the allegations made in the referral. As of the date of this report, Respondent has not returned my telephone calls. To review a copy of the phone log, refer to Exhibit 6.
