#### FINAL ORDER

**THIS MATTER** was heard by the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) at its regularly scheduled meeting held on January 24, 2023, in Tallahassee, Florida.

#### **FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. The Commission is charged with enforcing Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, the campaign financing law.

2. Respondent's campaign treasurer's report was not filed with the filing officer on June 24, 2022, the designated due date.

3. The filing officer fined the Respondent \$445.45 for the late filing of the report. Respondent timely appealed claiming that he made a mistake and by the time he made a subsequent filing to correct the mistake the report was late.

4. Respondent filed a waiver, pursuant to Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, prior to the designated due date and subsequently filed a report disclosing reportable financial activity.

#### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

5. The Commission has jurisdiction over the parties to and subject matter of this case, pursuant to Section 106.07, Florida Statutes.

6. A waiver filed pursuant to Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, is not a report.

7. Respondent's claim that he made a mistake does not justify the Respondent's failure to timely file the report.

8. In determining the amount of the fine, if any, to be waived, the Commission considered the mitigating and aggravating circumstances set forth in Section 106.265(2), Florida Statutes.

#### ORDER

Based on the foregoing facts and conclusions of law, the Commission finds that the Respondent failed to file the report on June 24, 2022, the designated due date. Therefore, it is

**ORDERED** that the assessed fine of \$445.45 is affirmed. The fine shall be paid to the Division of Elections 500 S. Bronough Street, Room 316, Tallahassee, FL 32399 within 30 days of the date this Final Order is filed with the Commission.

- The 2022 P1 Queued Transaction Report shows that it was created and filed on 06/23/22.<sup>1</sup>
- Christian De La Torre reported receiving 2 contributions, while making 1 expenditure.
- FEC staff was advised, "The candidate filed a notice of no activity (waiver) on 06/23/22. A waiver is not a report. On 08/05/22, the candidate filed a report showing \$1,781.82 of activity. The fine is based on 25% of the activity.
- The Division of Elections does not have any notes that pertain to Christian De La Torre's 2022 P1 report.
